DESCRIPTION

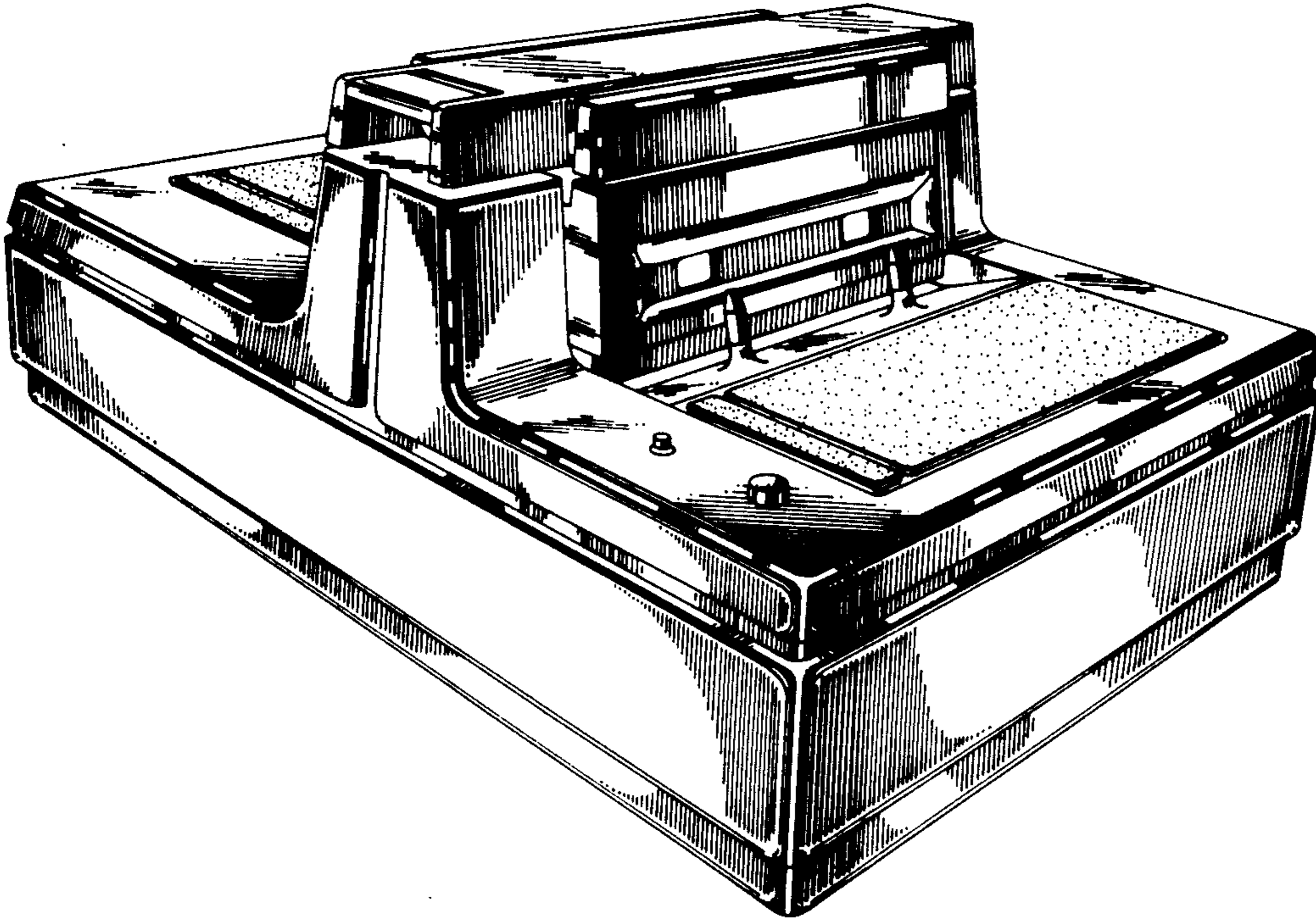
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the magnetic cassette duplicator;

FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof.



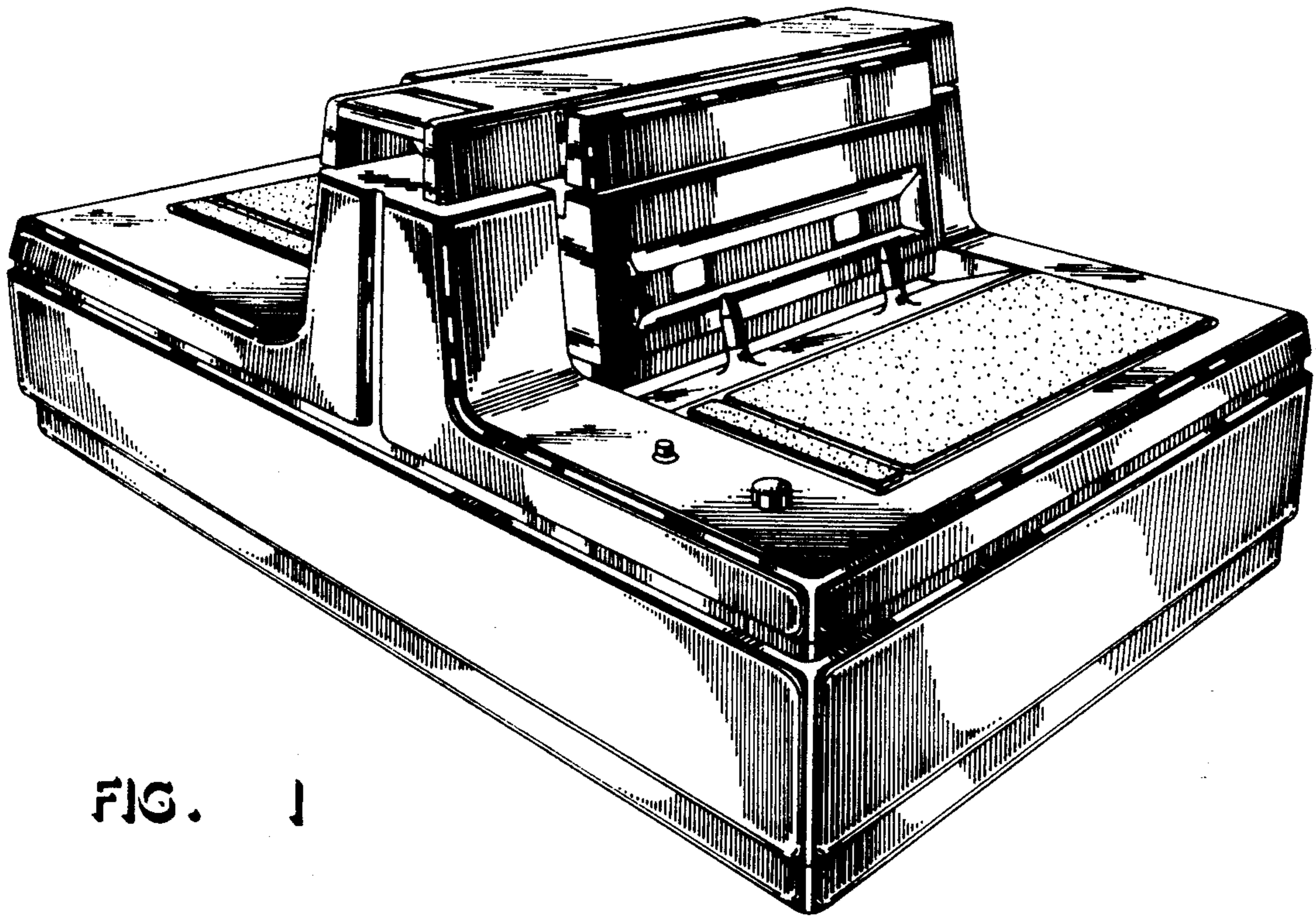

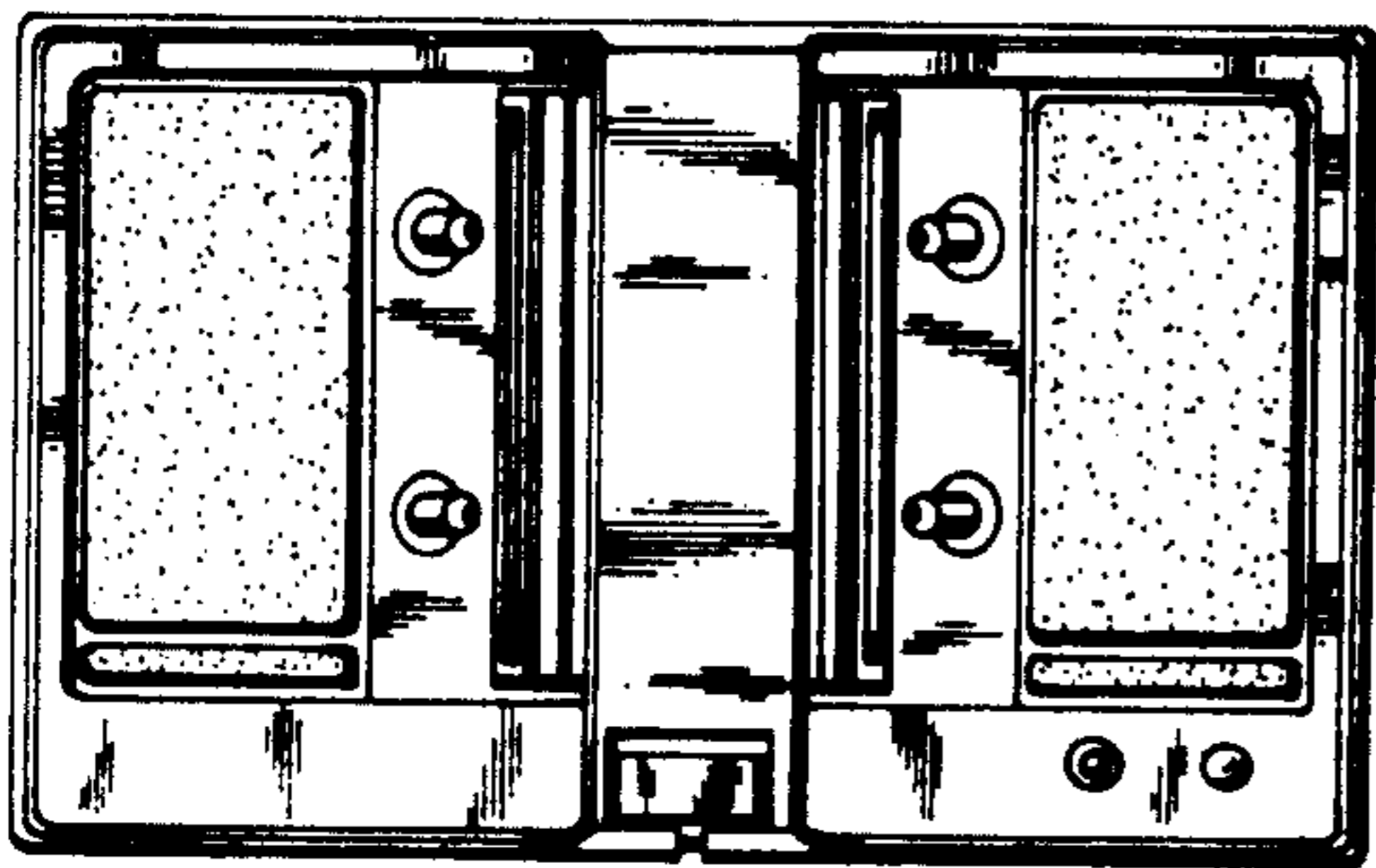

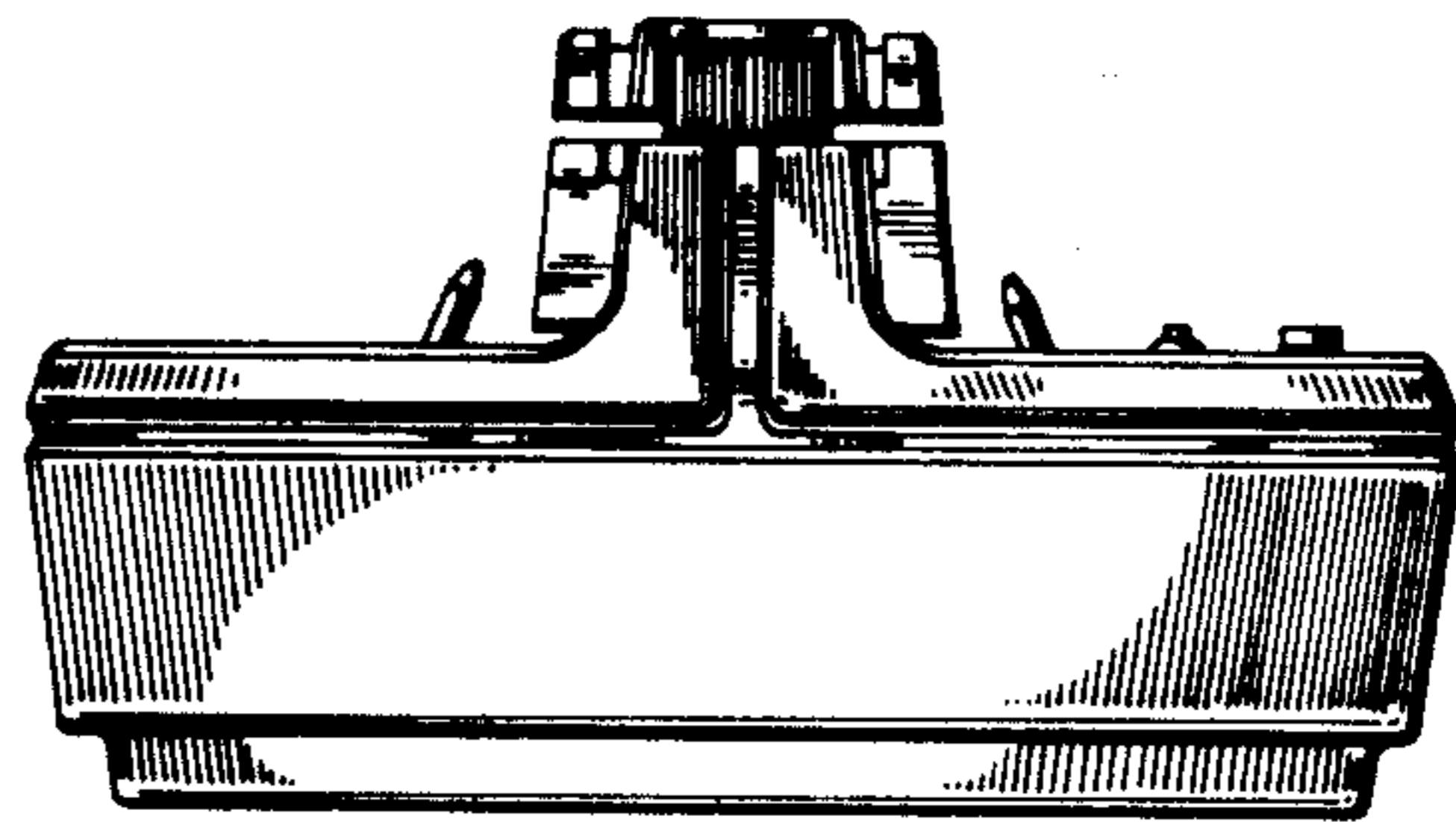

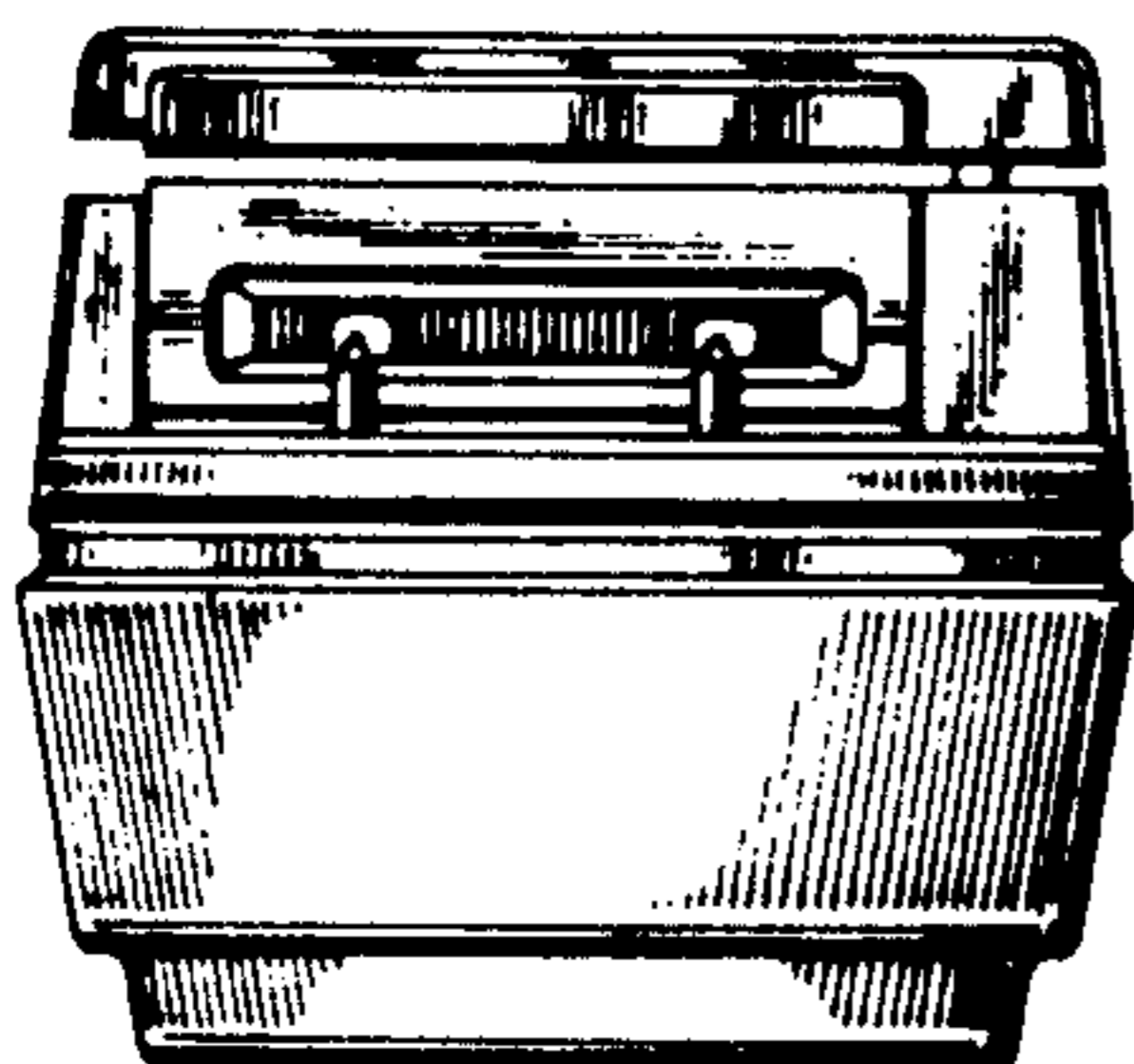

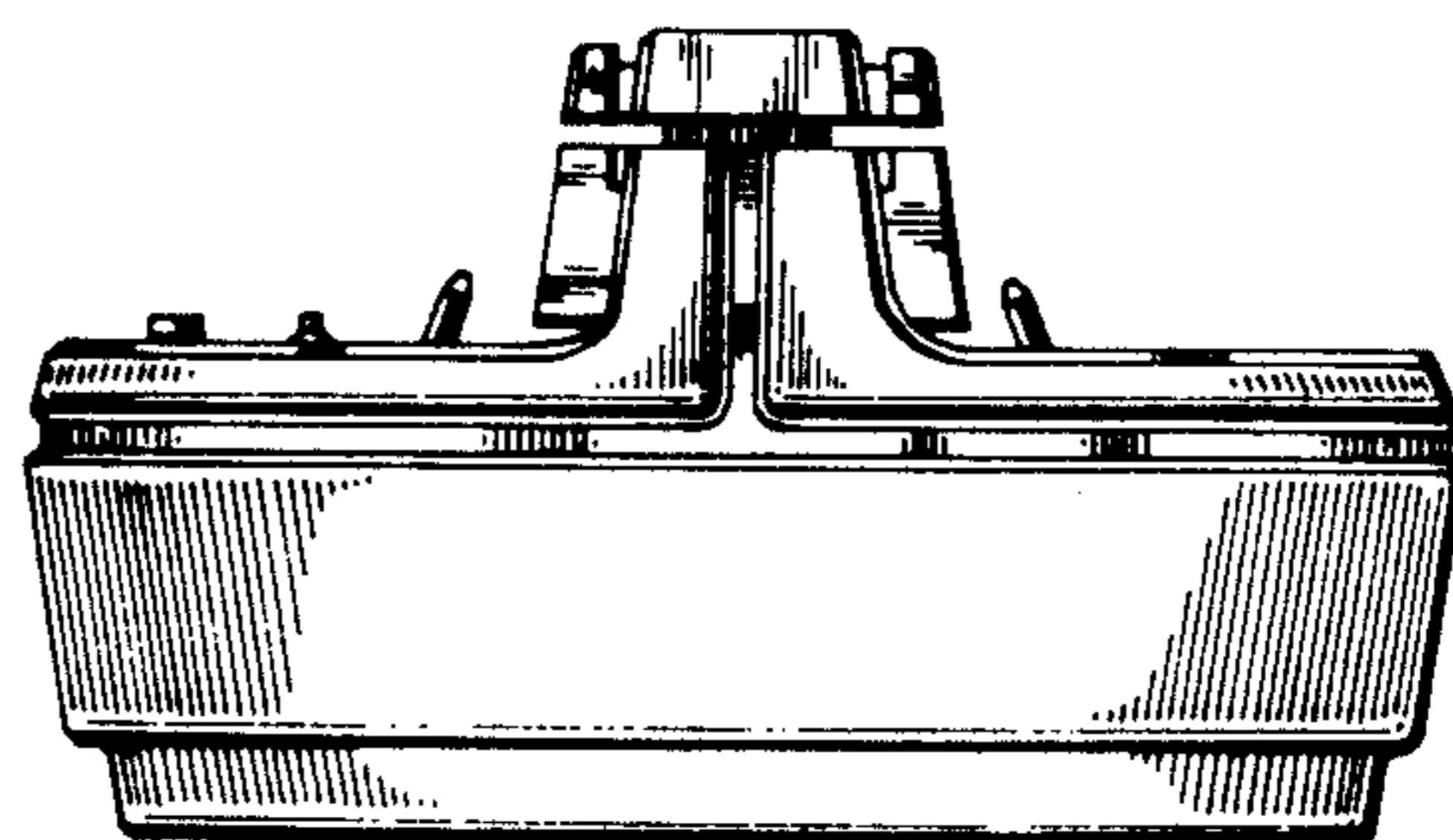
