DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a vehicle mounted vacuum sweeper showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the opposite side thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view taken along the line 3—3 of FIG. 2;


FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,


FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and

The broken line disclosure of a vehicle in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.










