The ornamental design for a carpet extractor solution and recovery apparatus, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a carpet extractor solution and recovery apparatus showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a carpet extractor solution and recovery apparatus;


FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof; and











