[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a top water artificial fishing lure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation of the top water artificial fishing lure of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a plan view of the fishing lure of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the fishing lure of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation of the fishing lure of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation of the fishing lure of FIG. 1;
and
FIG. 6 is a side elevation of the artificial fishing lure of FIG. 1 with a hair-like tail trailing therefrom.

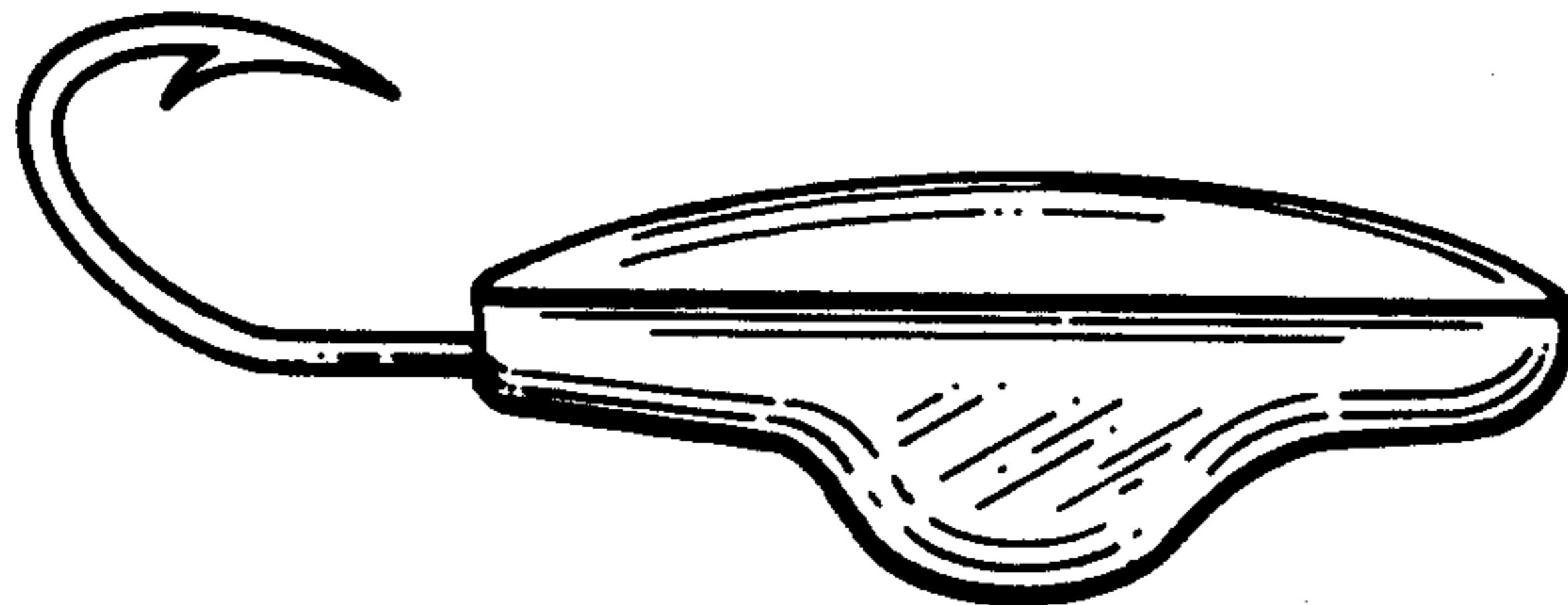

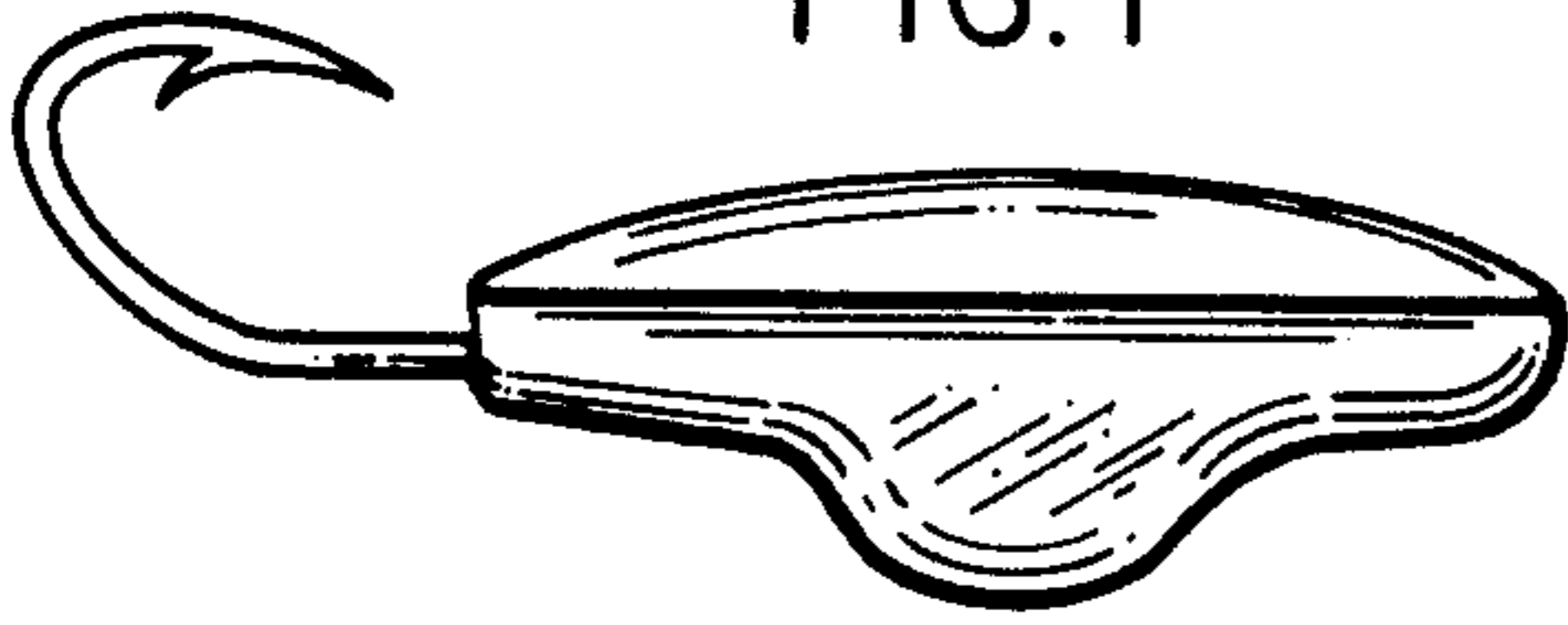

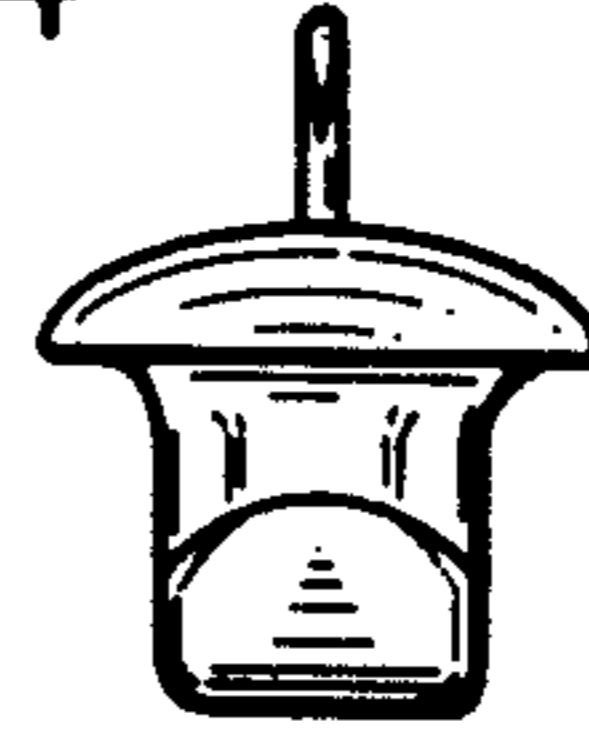

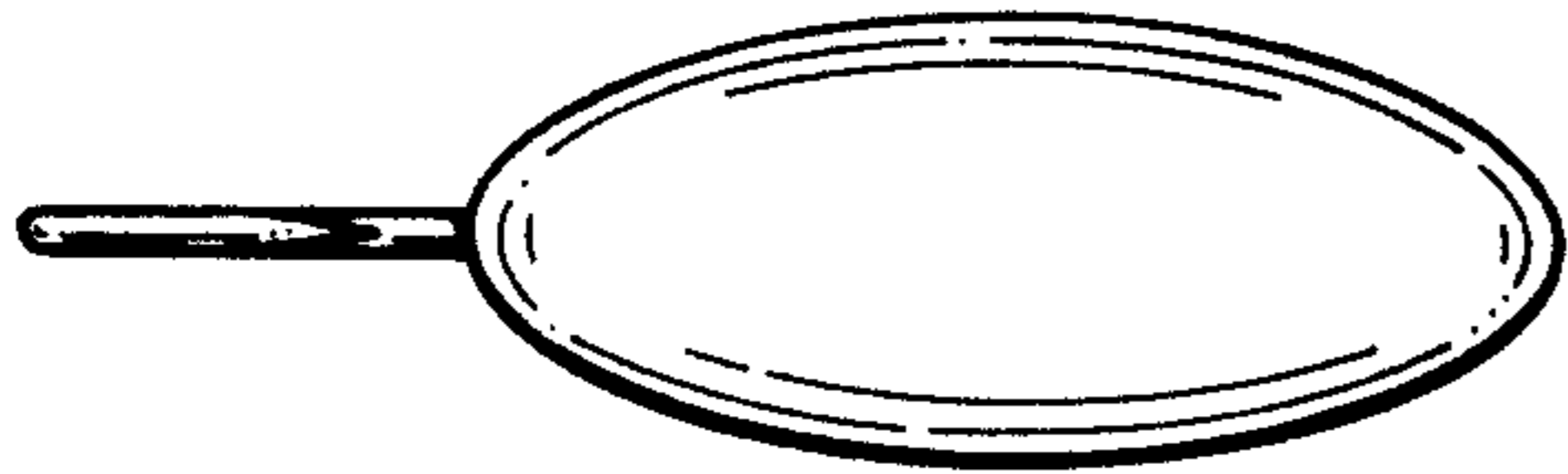

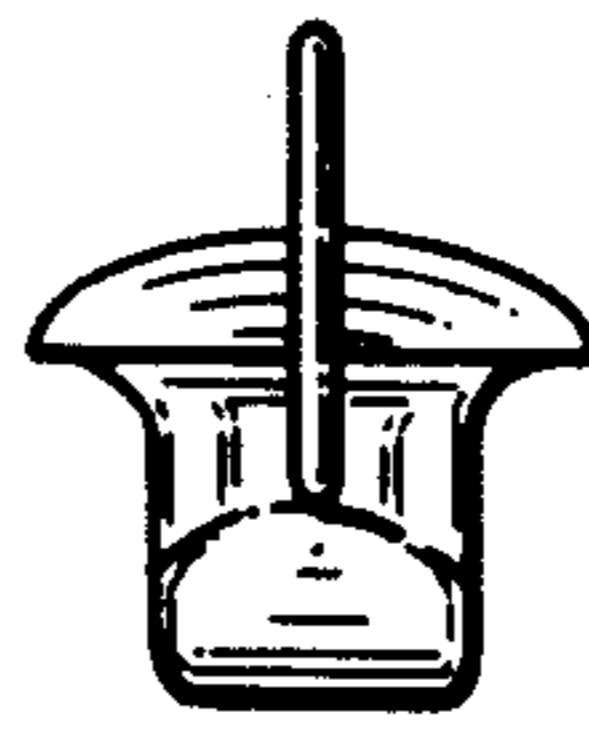
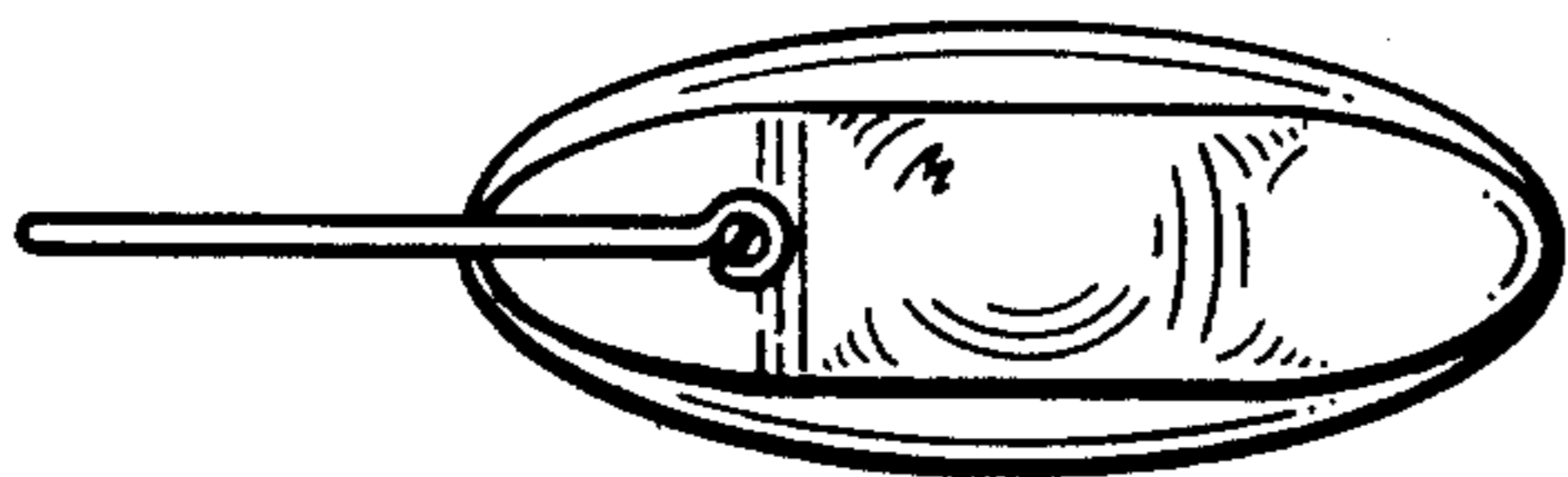

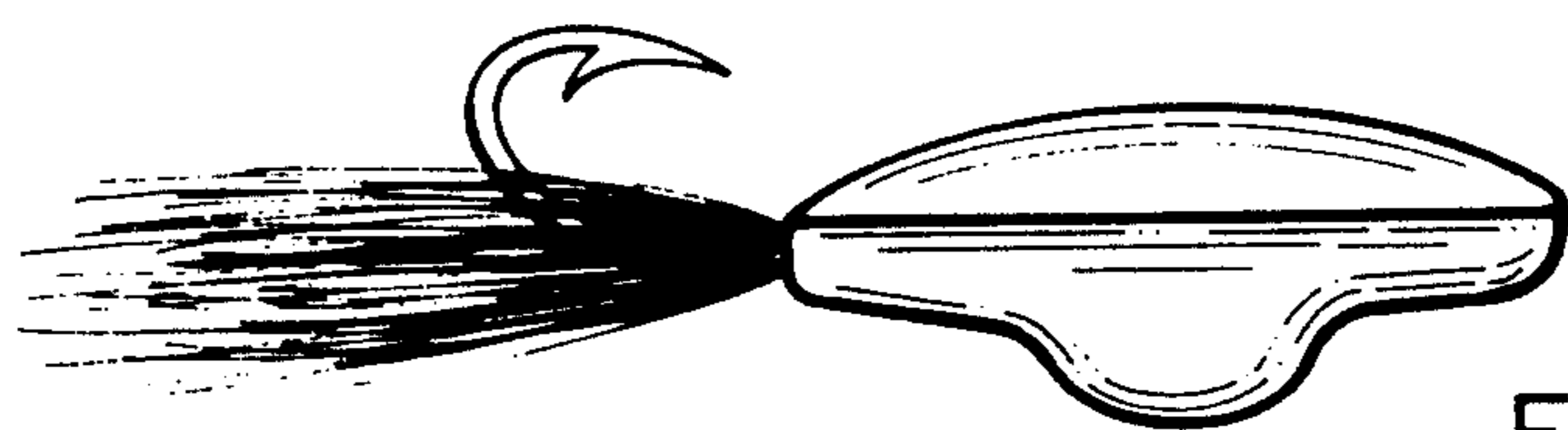
