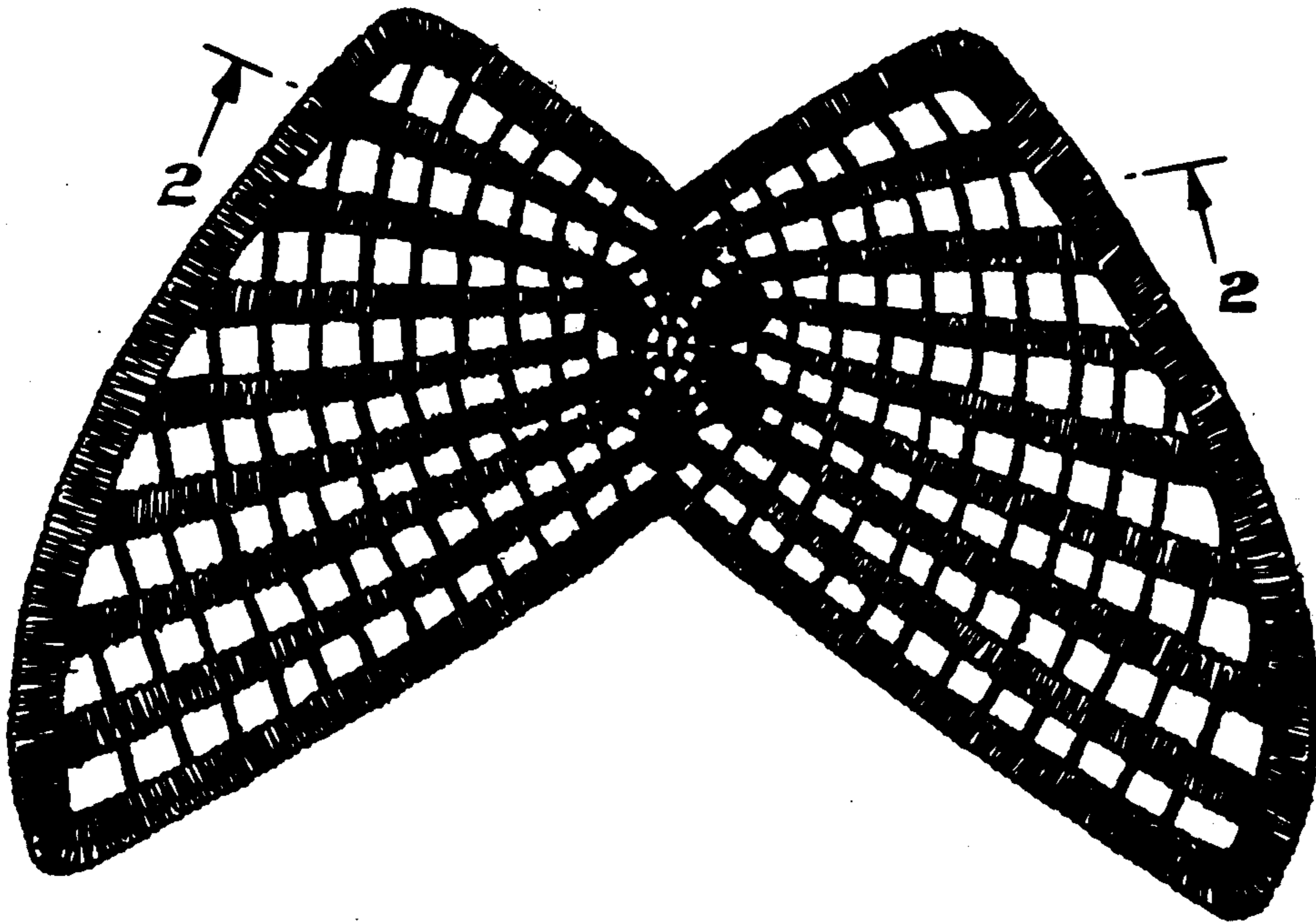

FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 2—2 of FIG. 1 thereof.



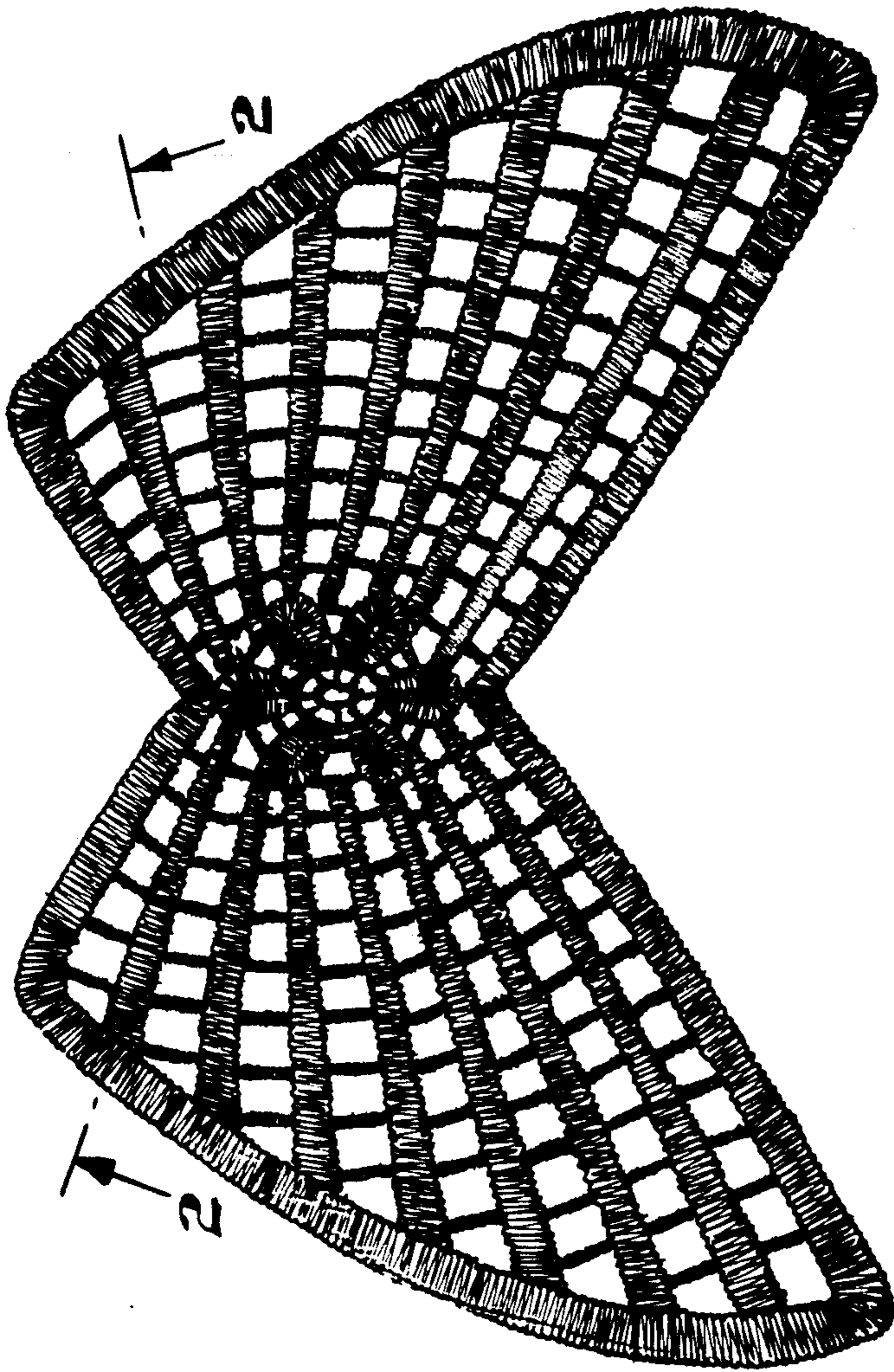
