The ornamental design for a shelf, as shown and described.

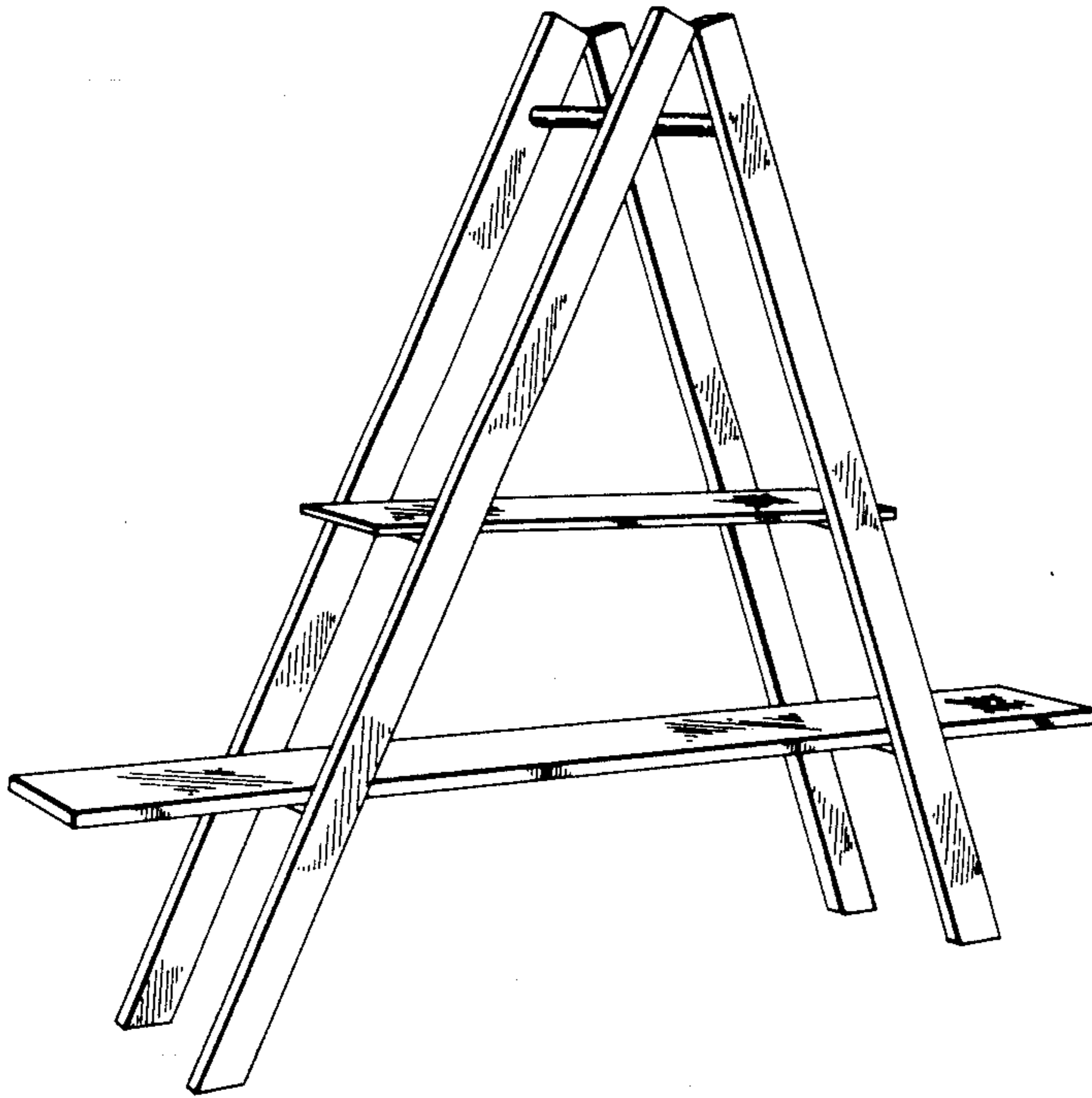
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shelf showing my new design.

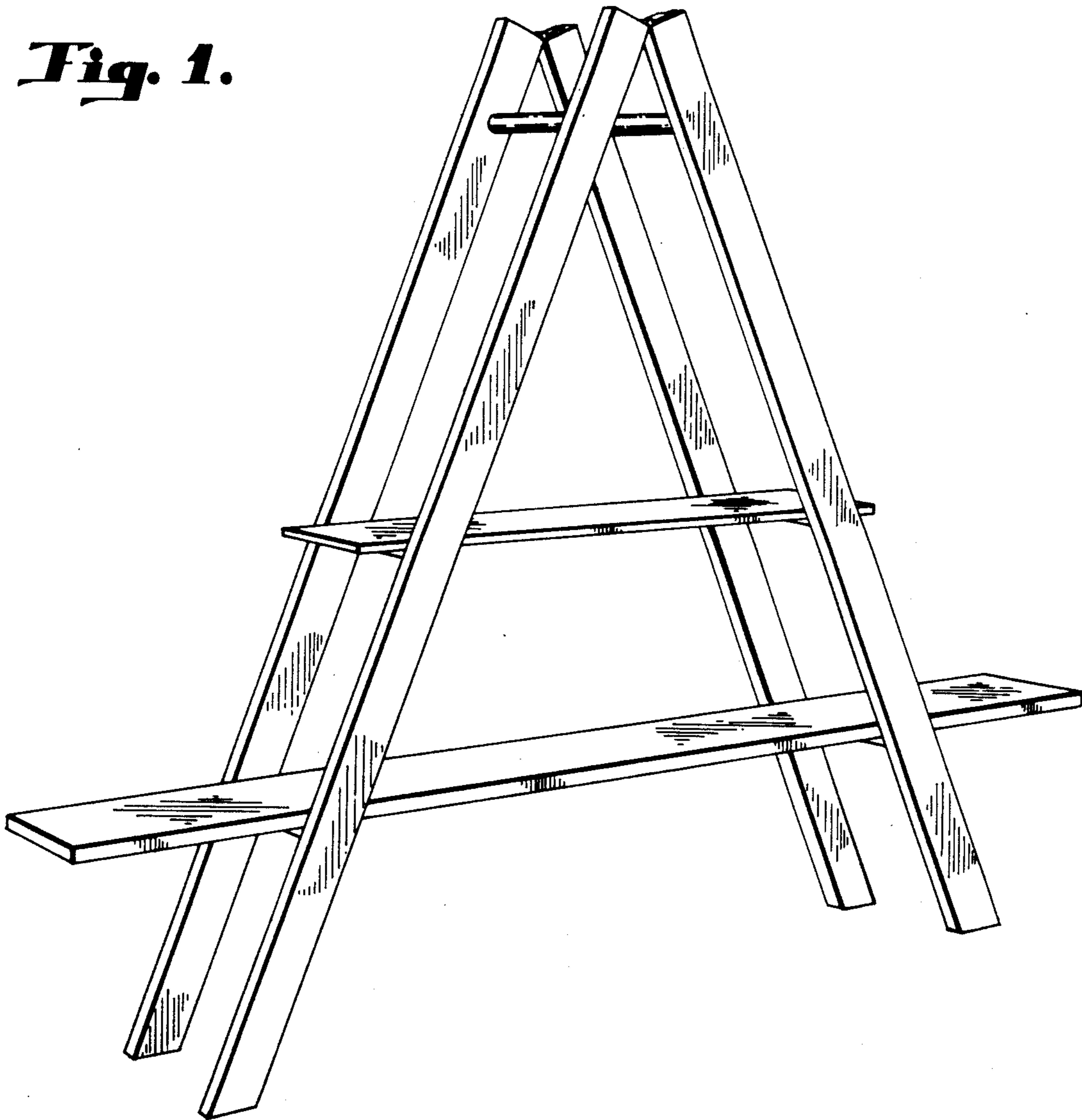
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image thereof; and

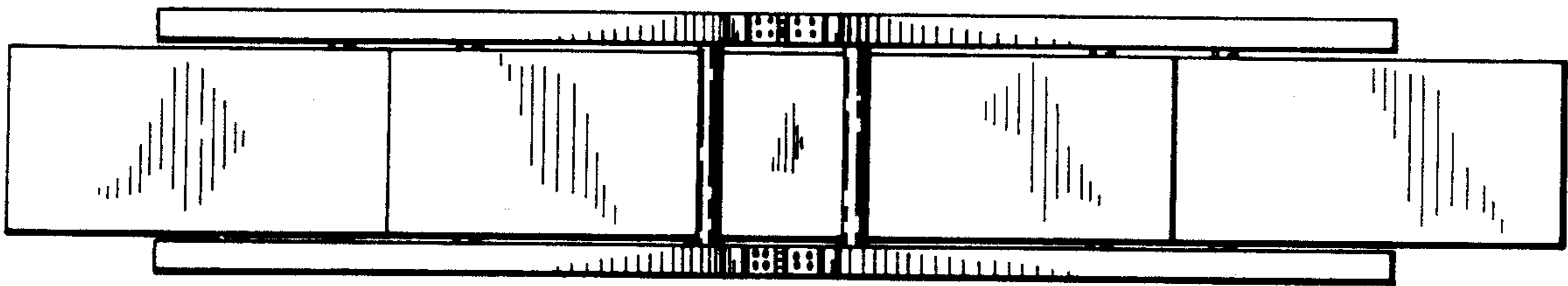
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end view being a mirror image thereof.

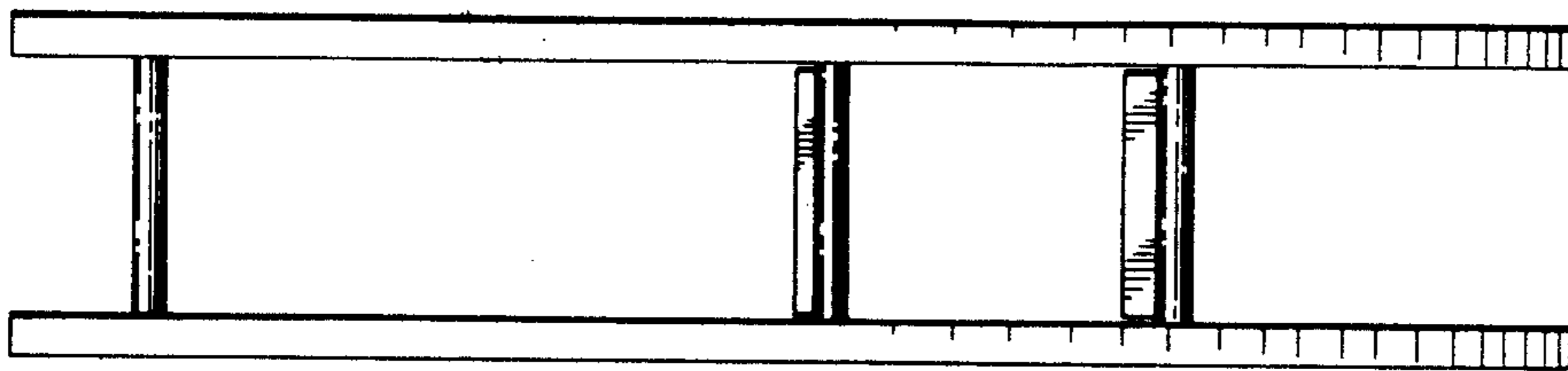


***Fig. 1.***

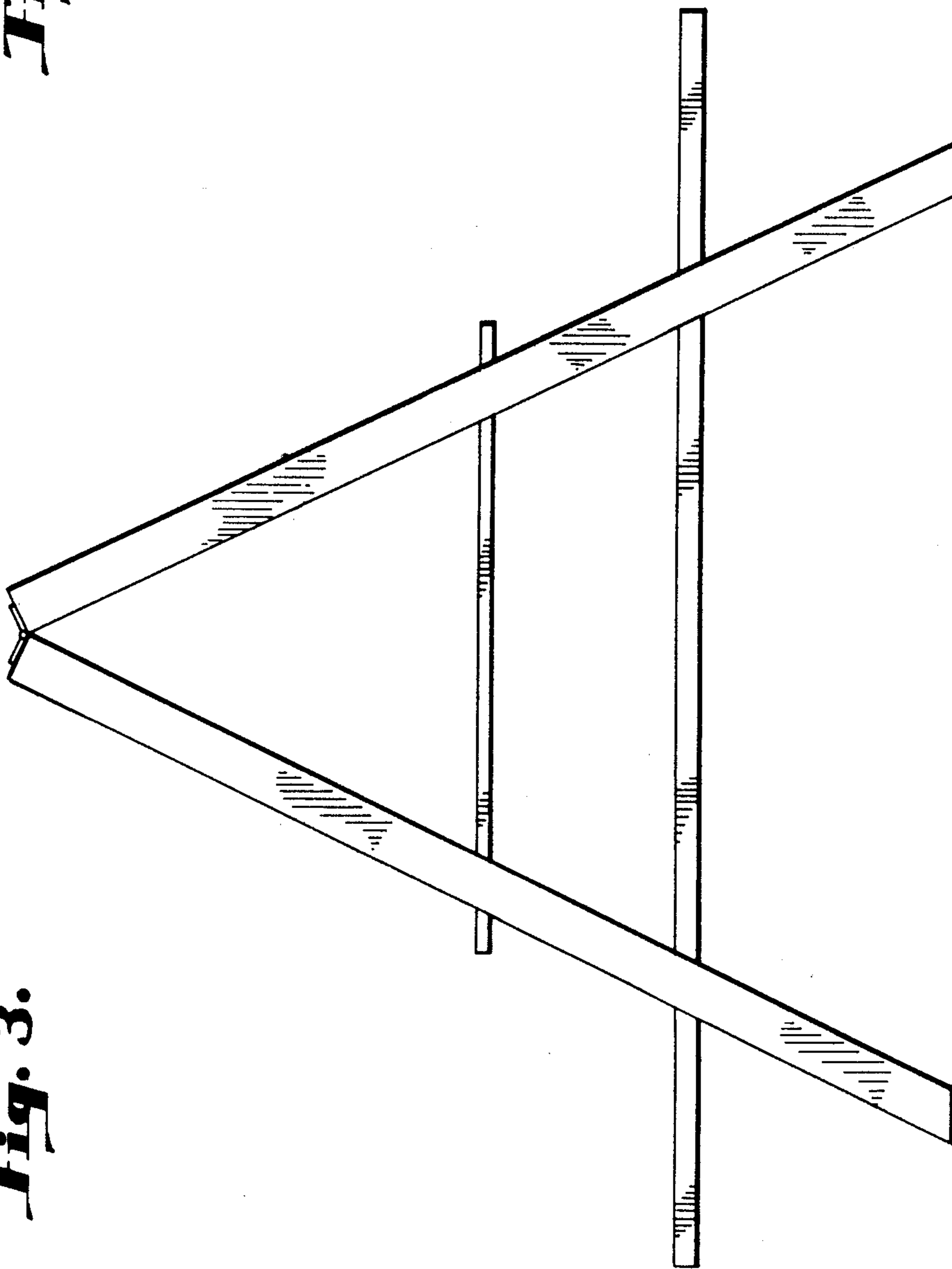


***Fig. 2.***
