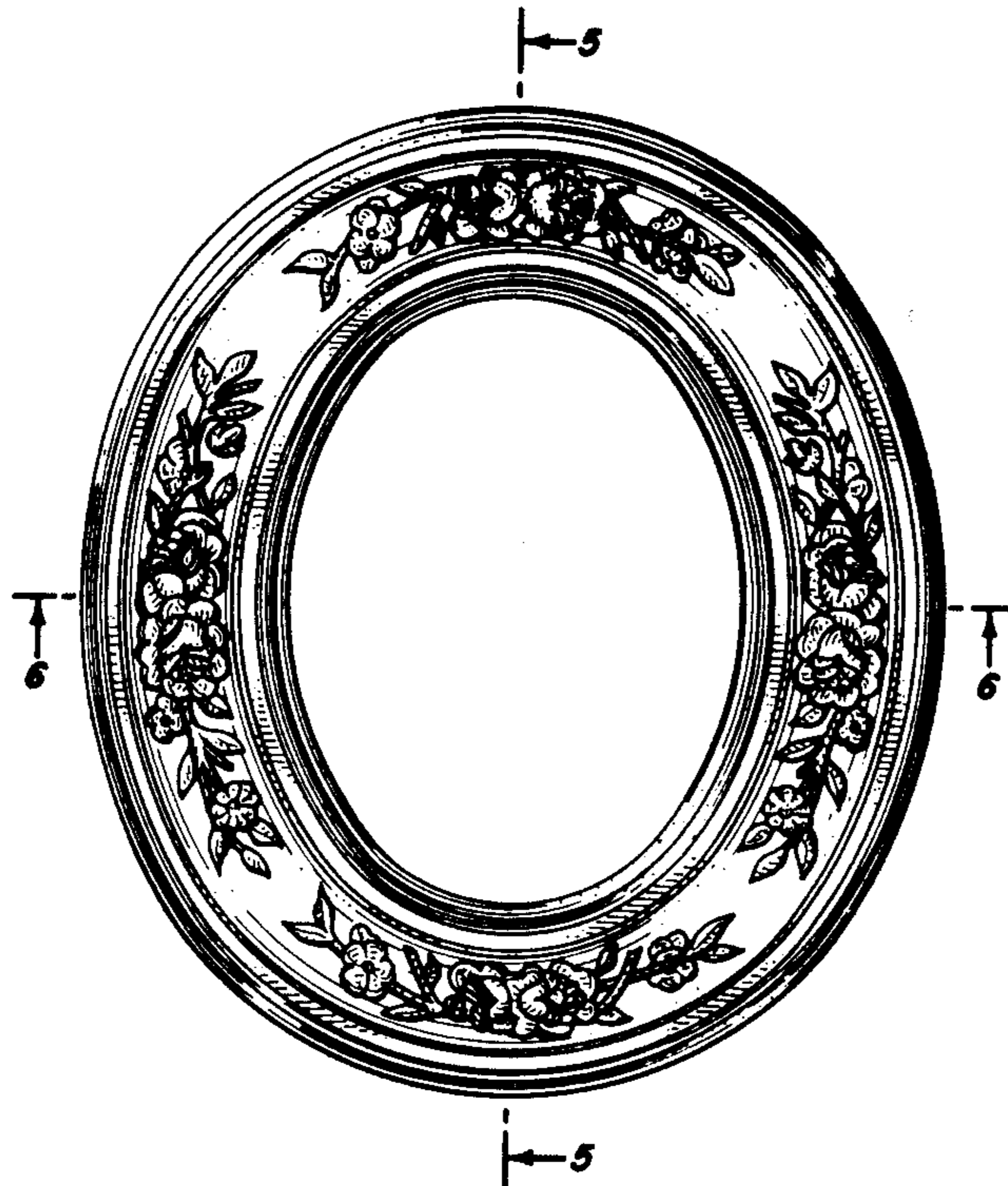

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an oval picture frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an oval picture frame showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof, the top plan view being substantially a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 5-5 in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 6-6 in FIG. 1.



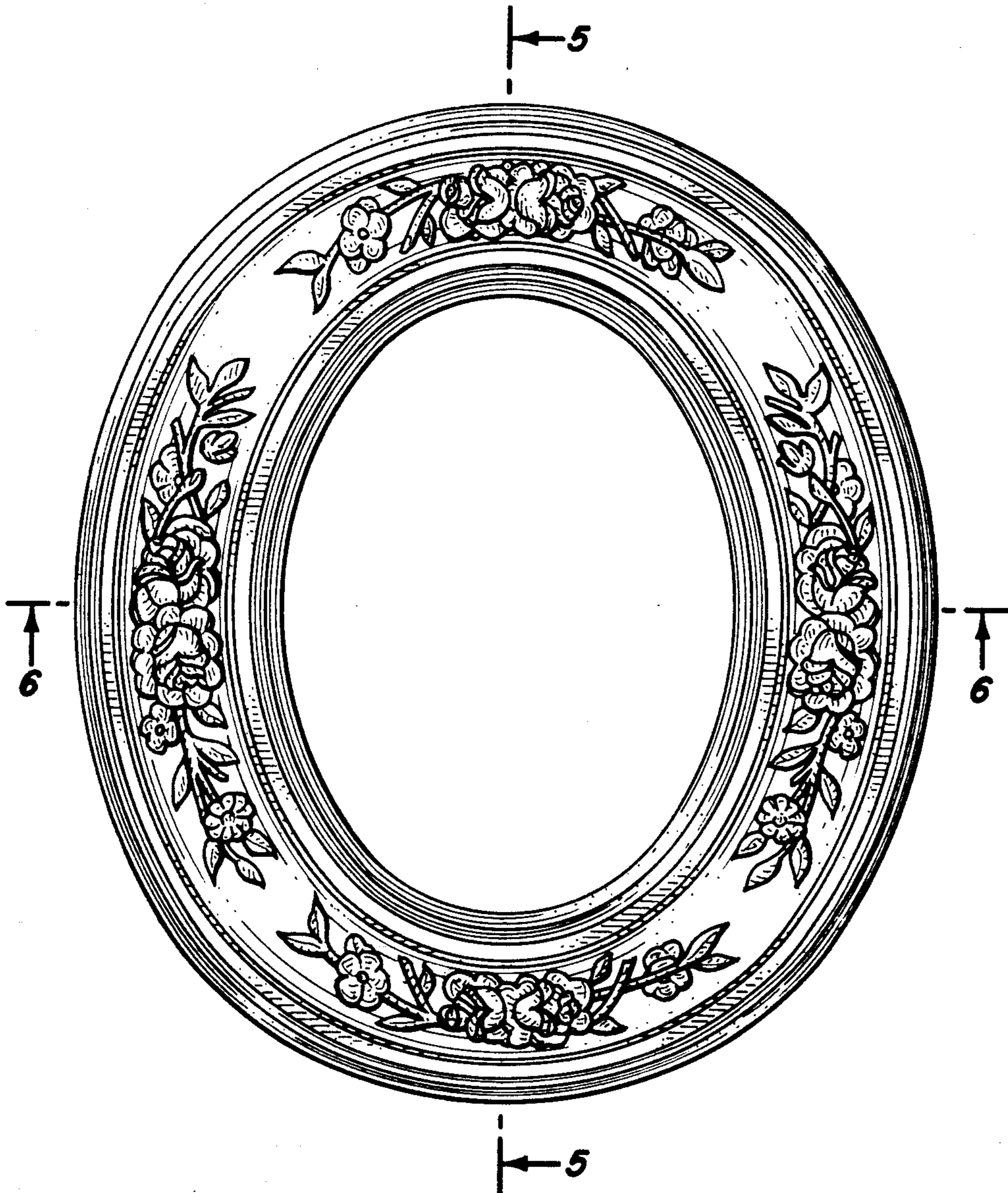

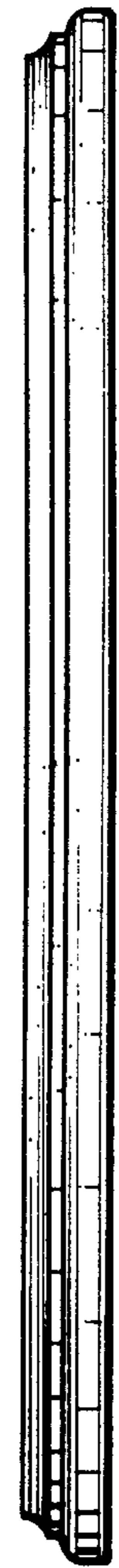

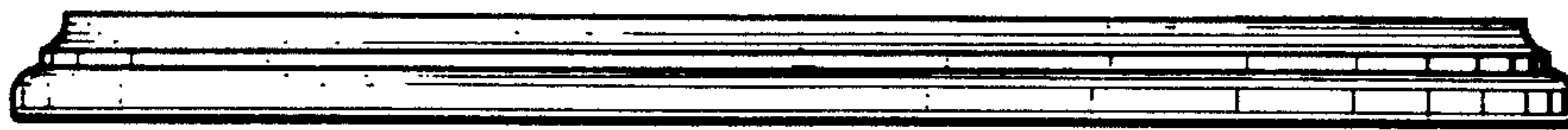

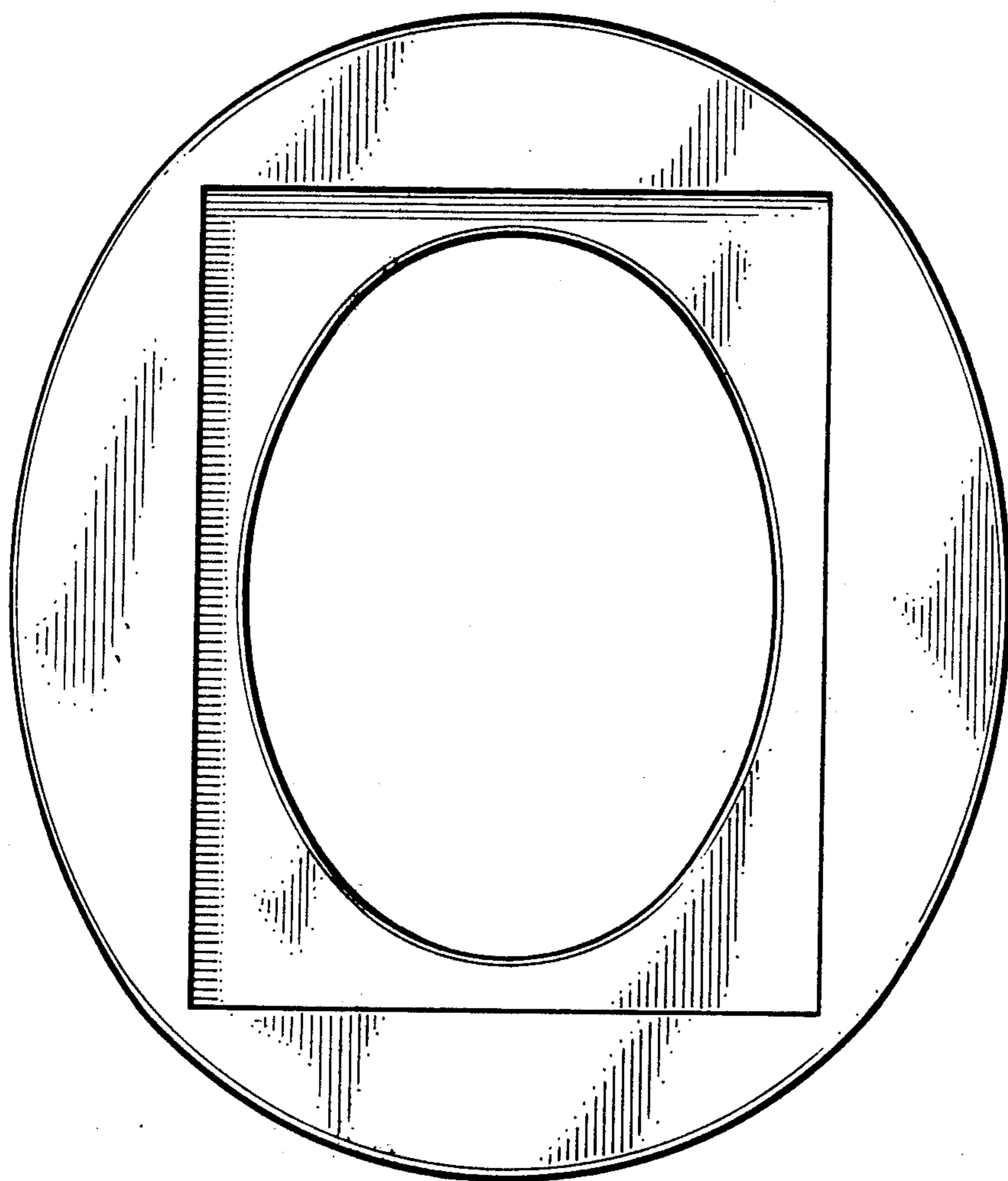

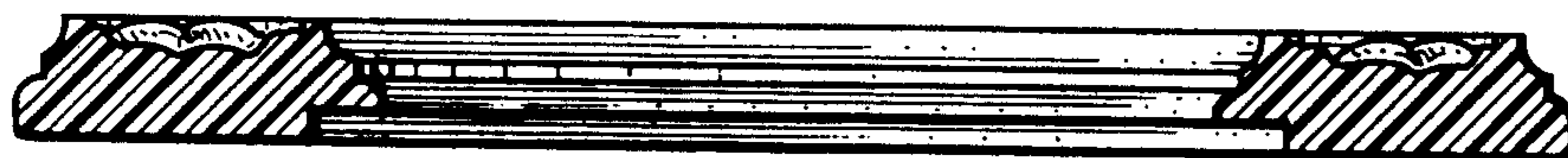
