DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a security telephone showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top front perspective view with the handset removed for clarity of illustration.

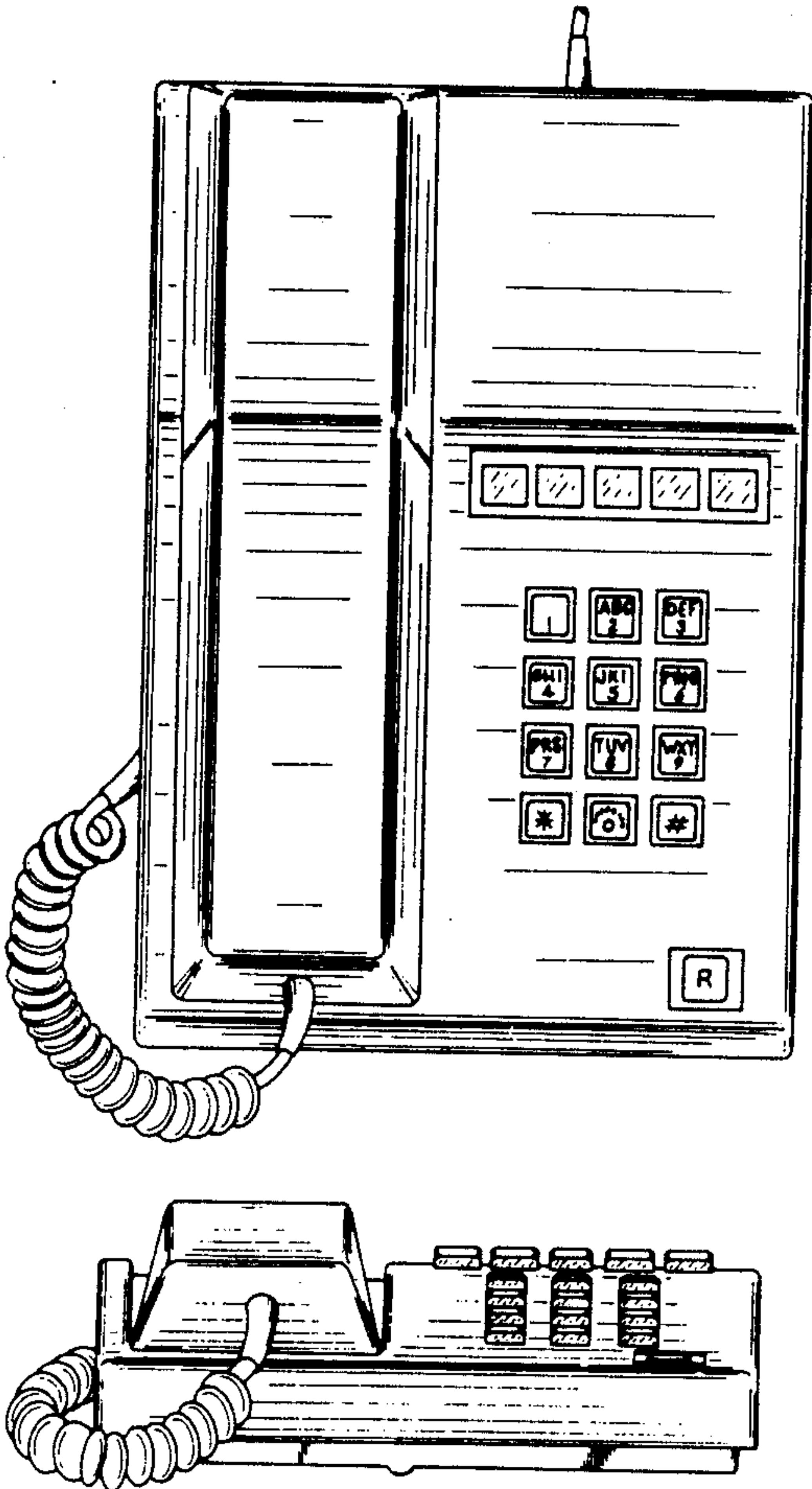

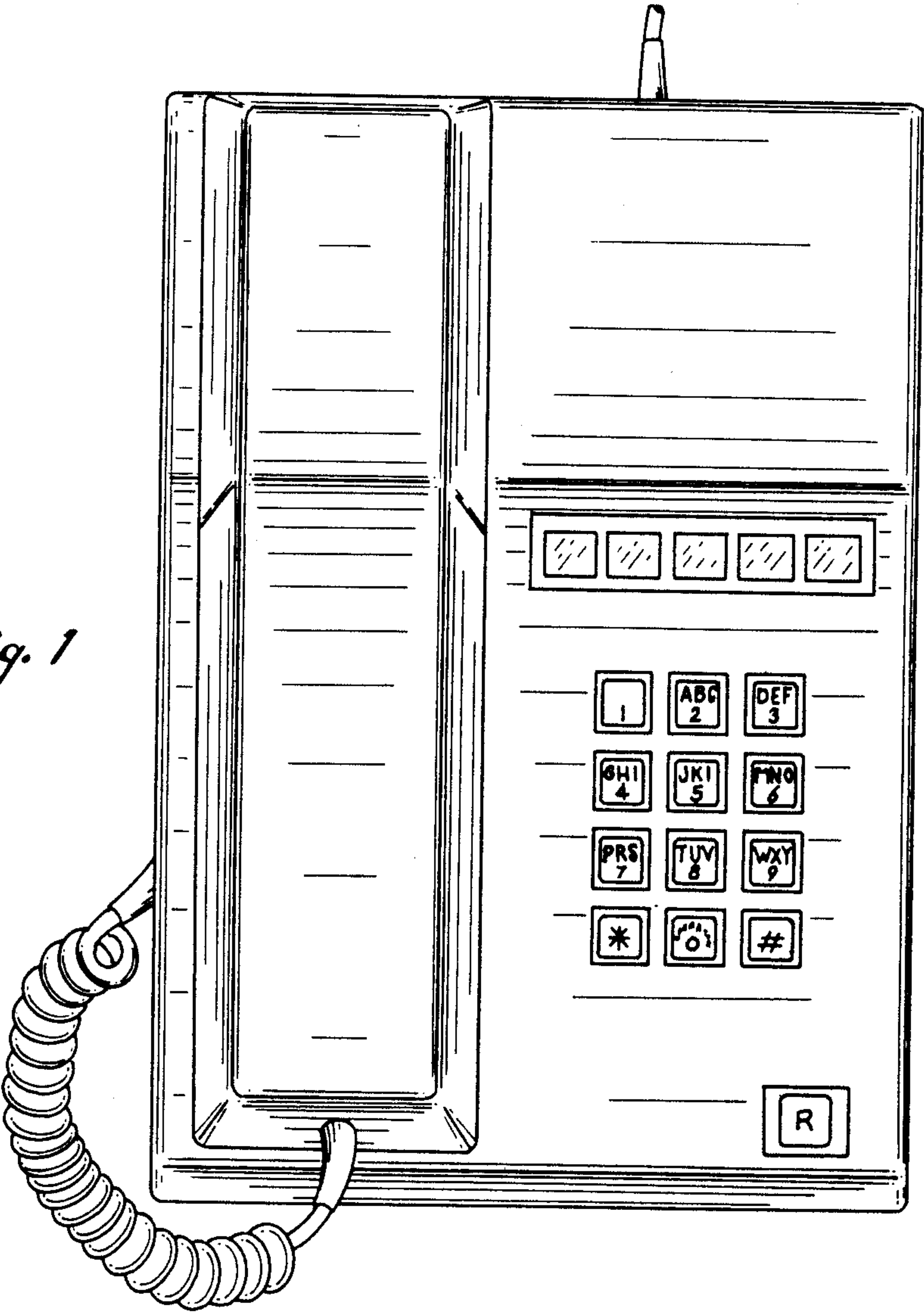

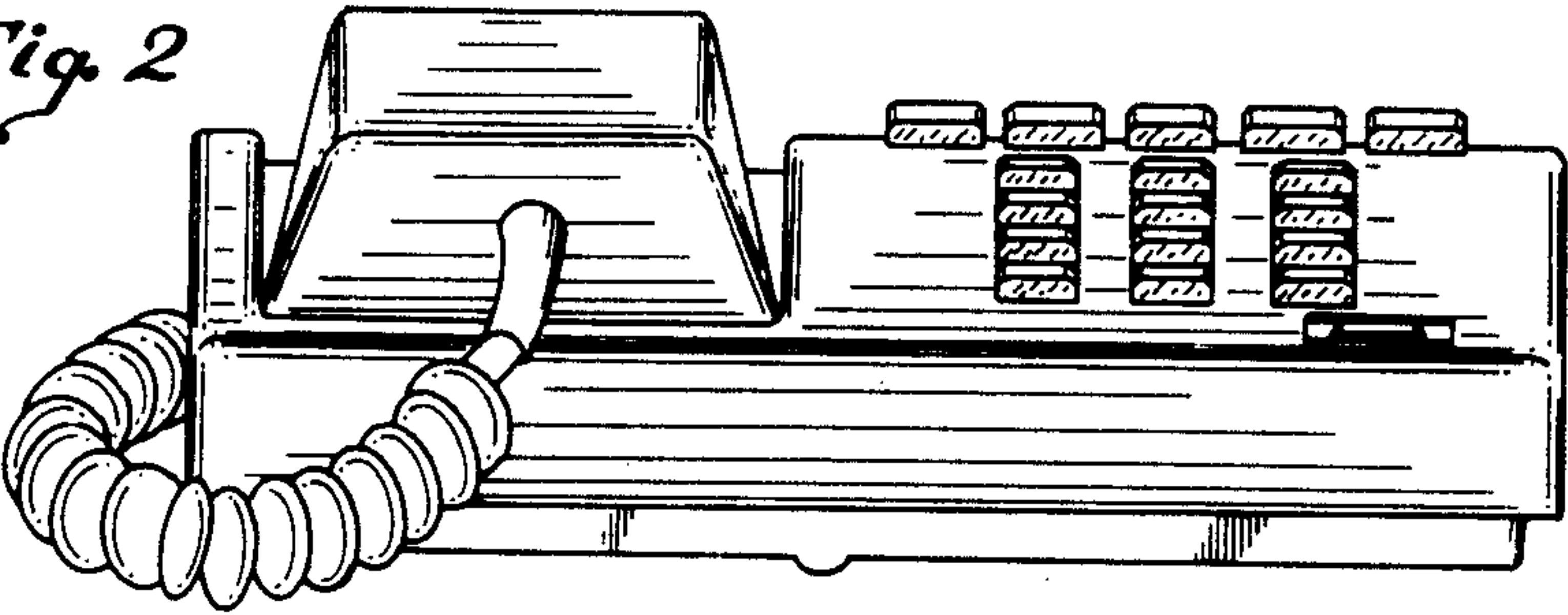

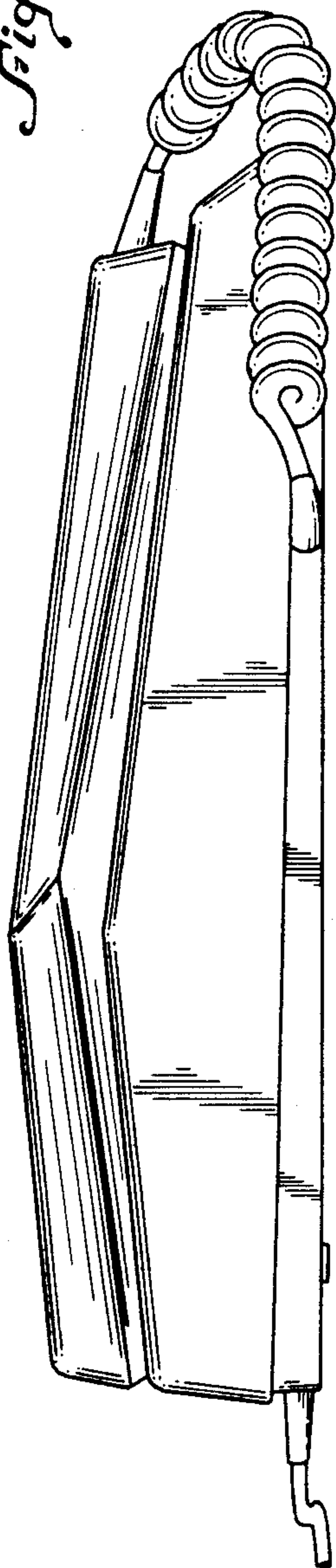

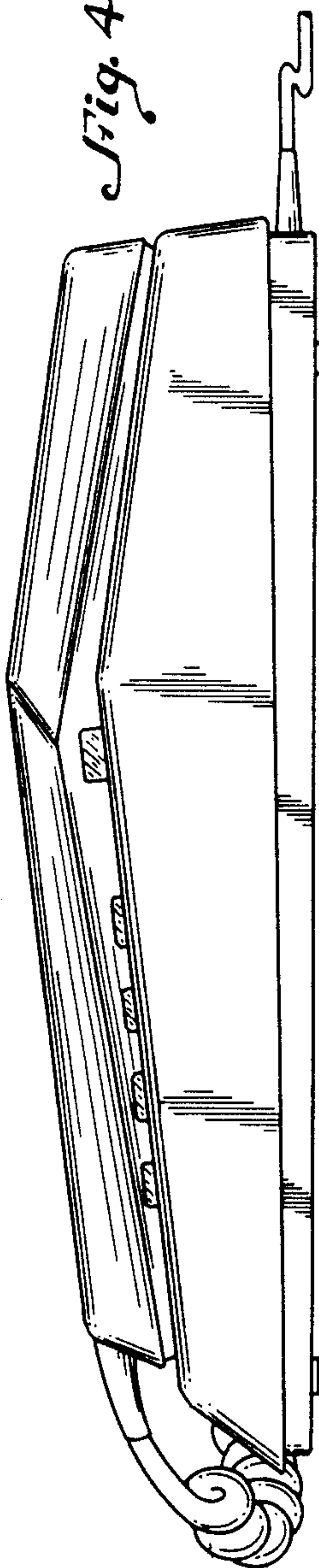
