[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for display stand for artificial flowers or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a display stand for artificial flowers or the like showing my new design, the rear being identical;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view of FIG. 1, the bottom being flat and unornamented;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the rear being identical;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged top plan view of FIG. 3, the bottom being flat and unornamented.

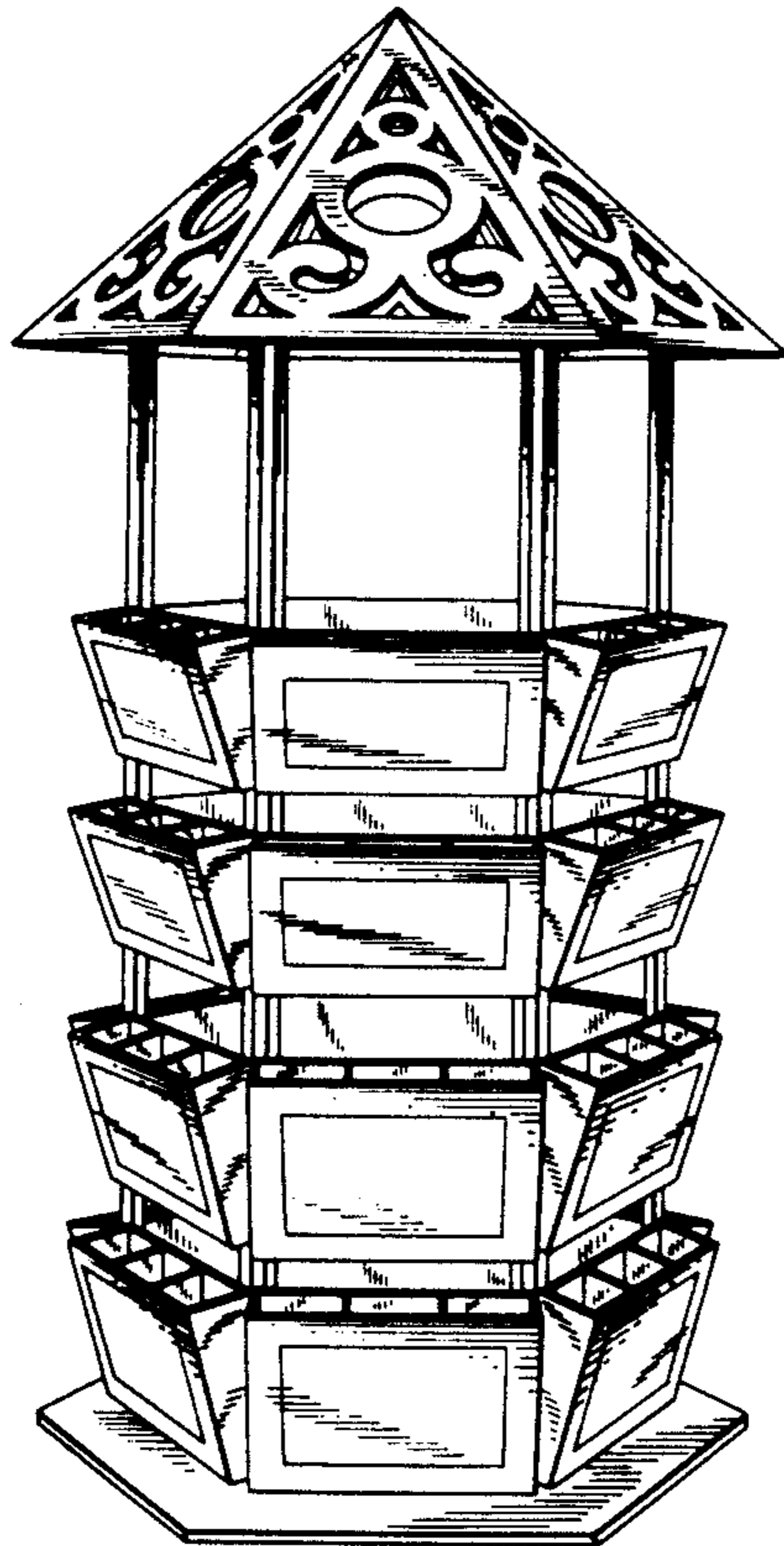

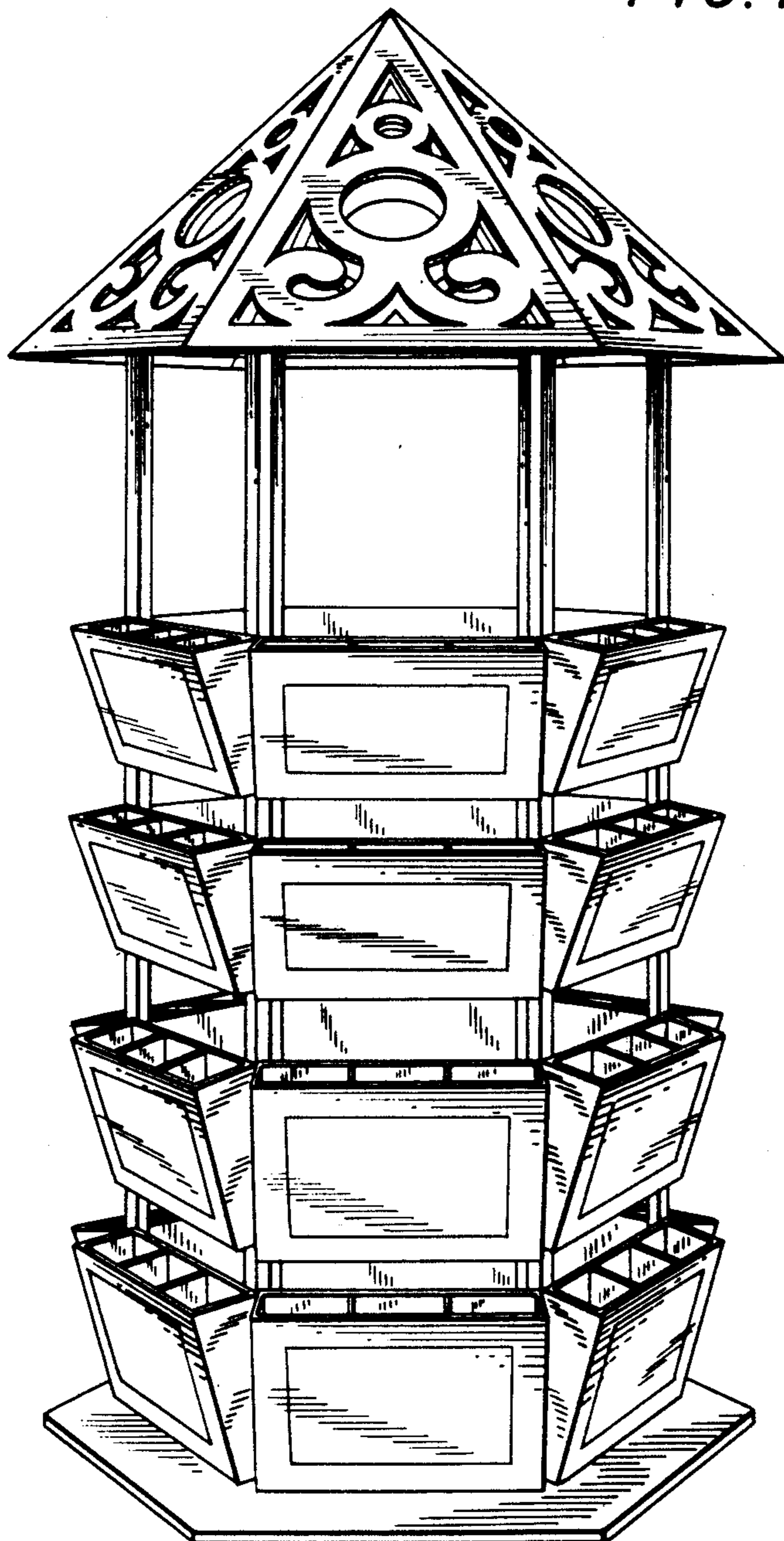
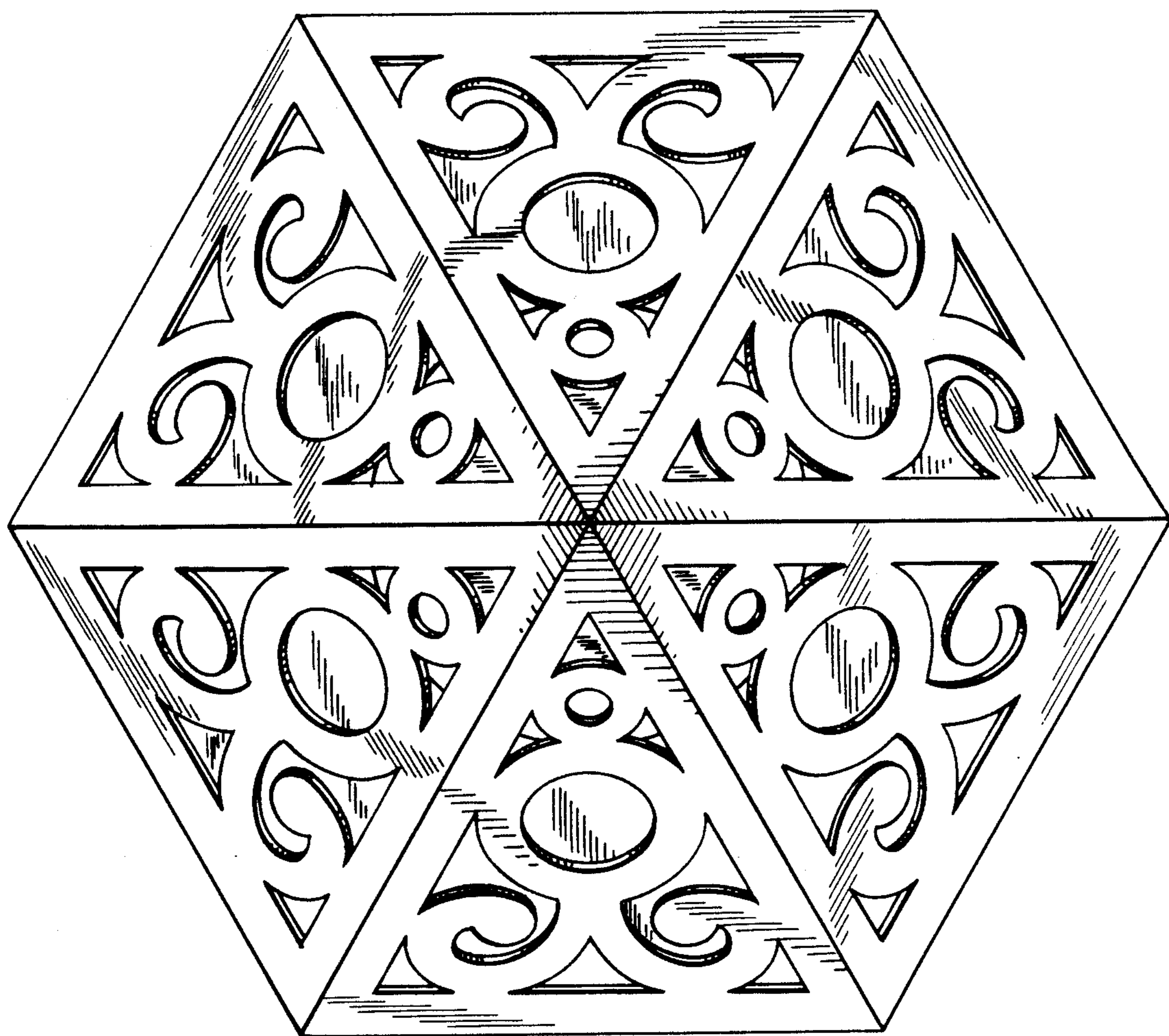

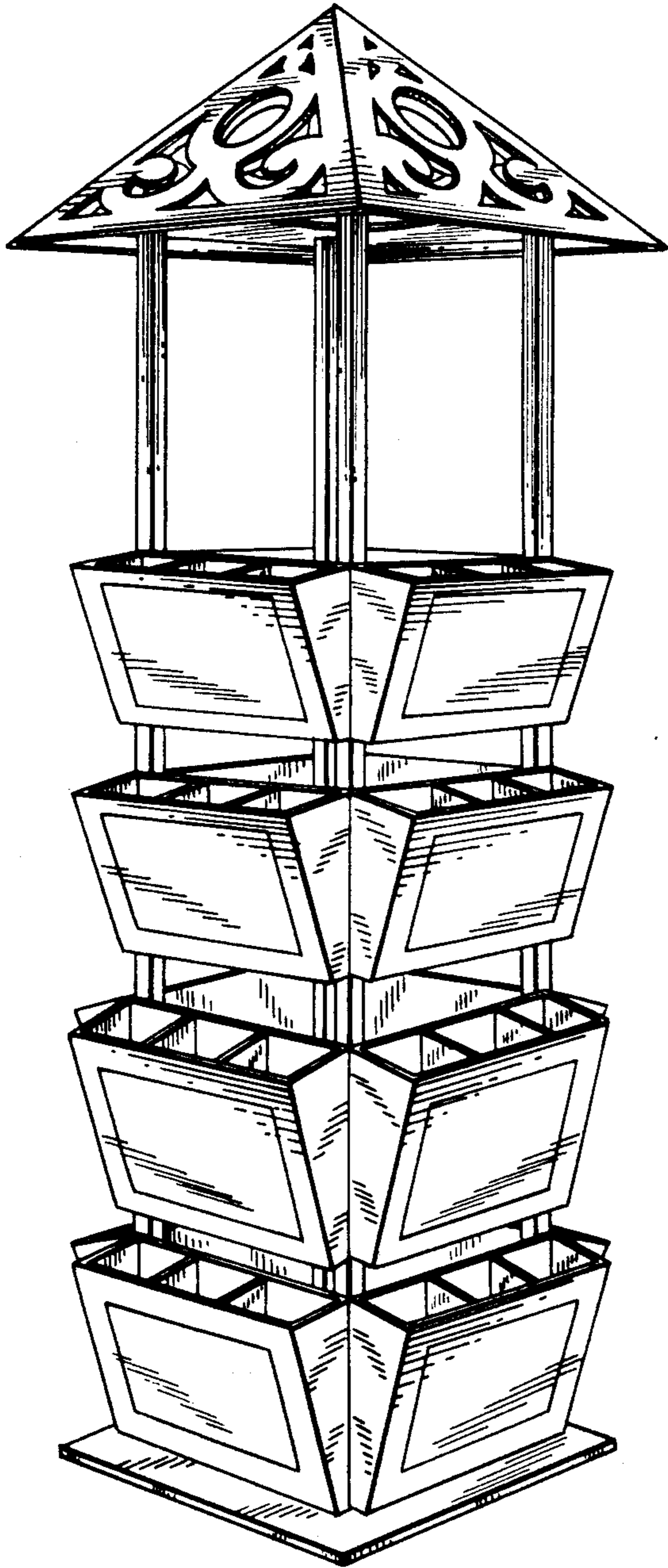
