FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view taken from FIG. 3.

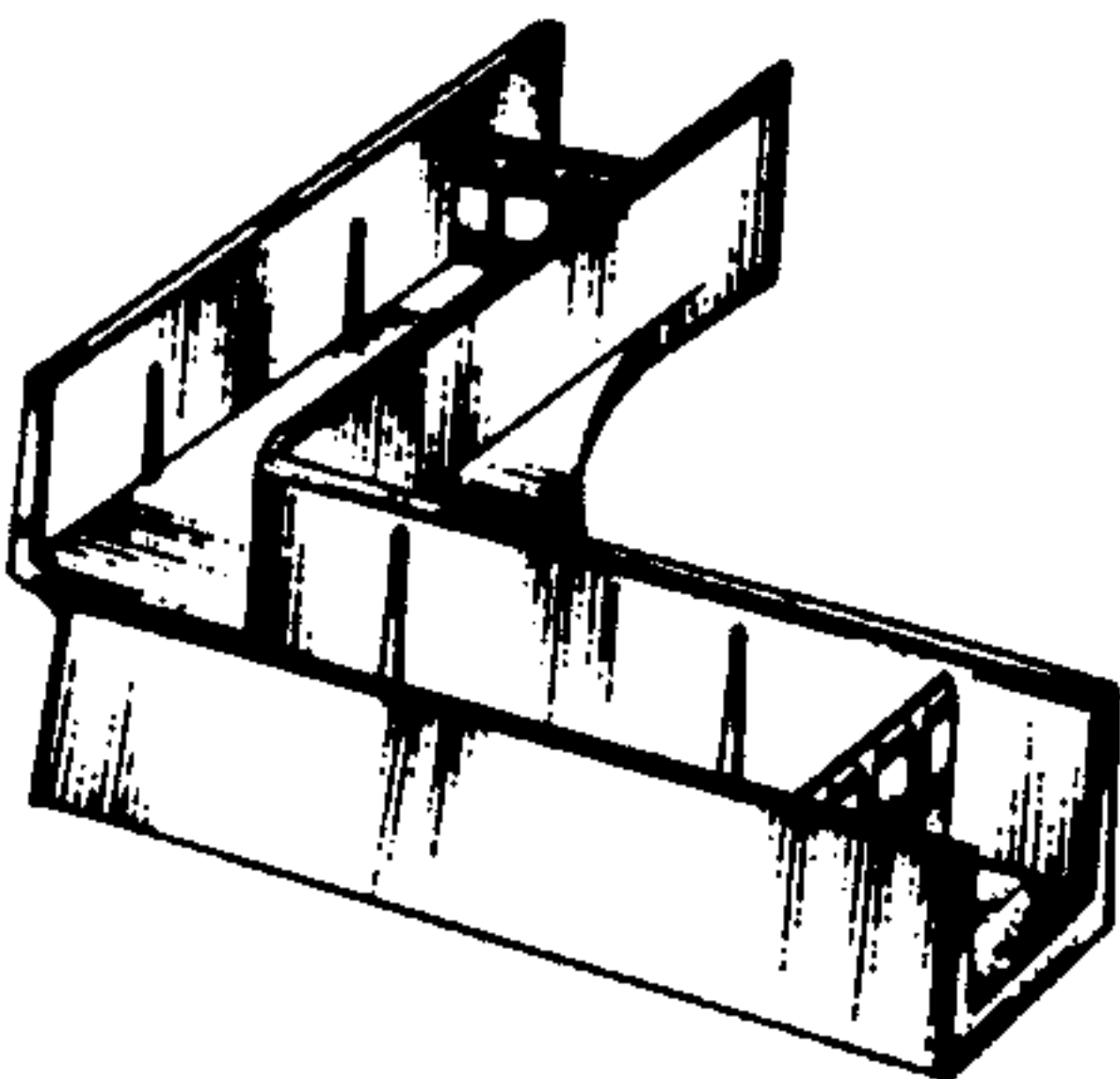
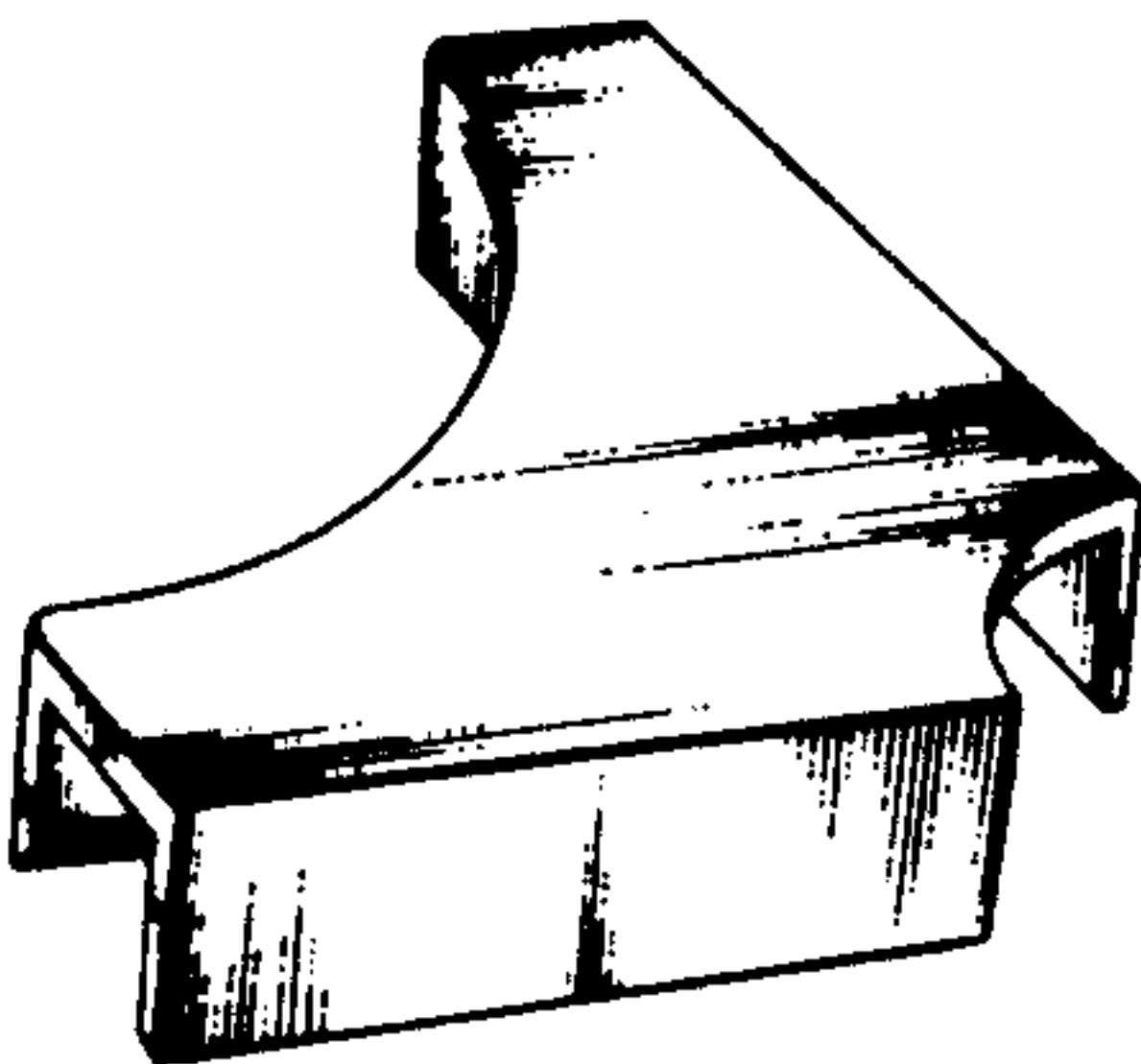

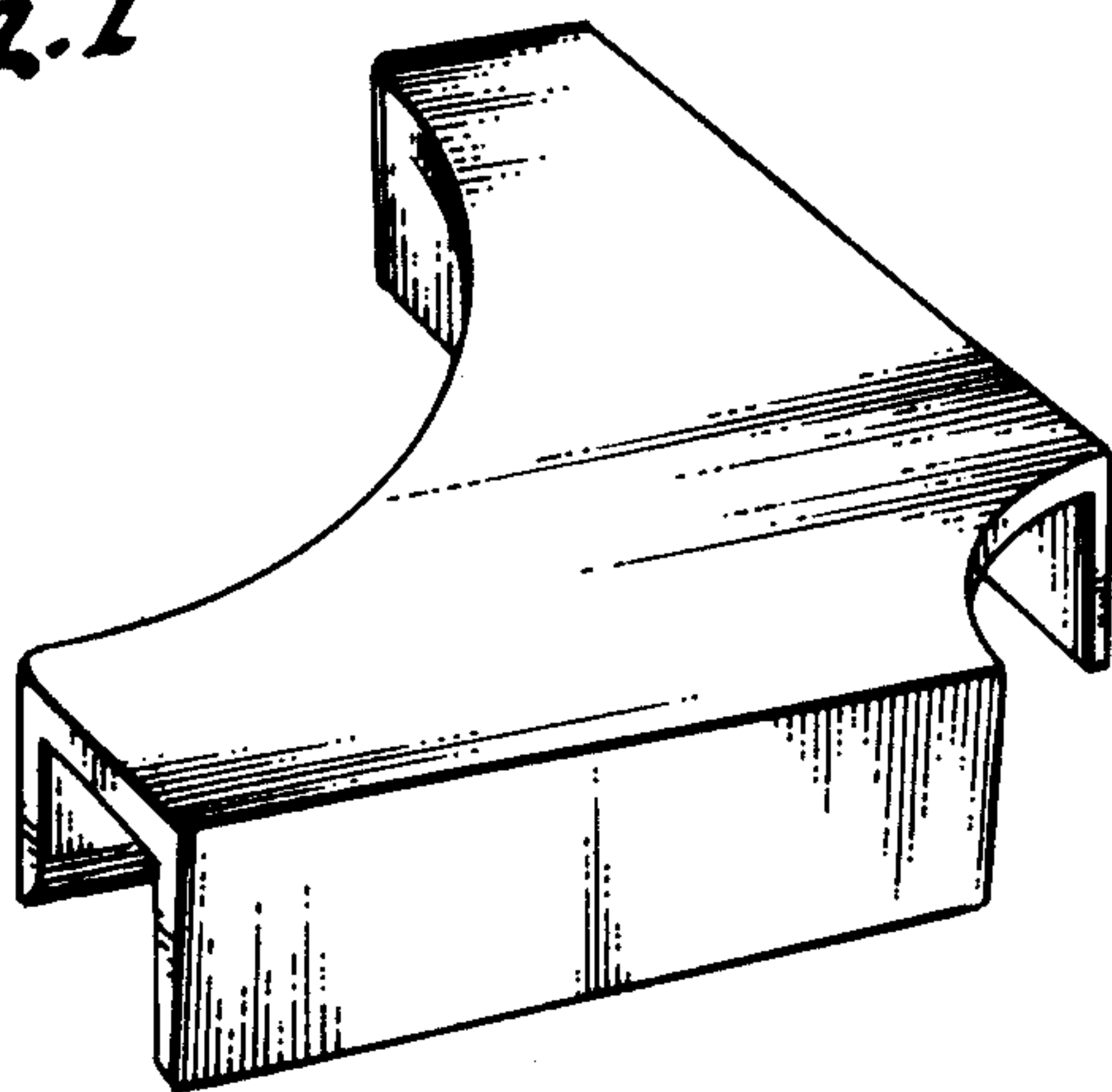

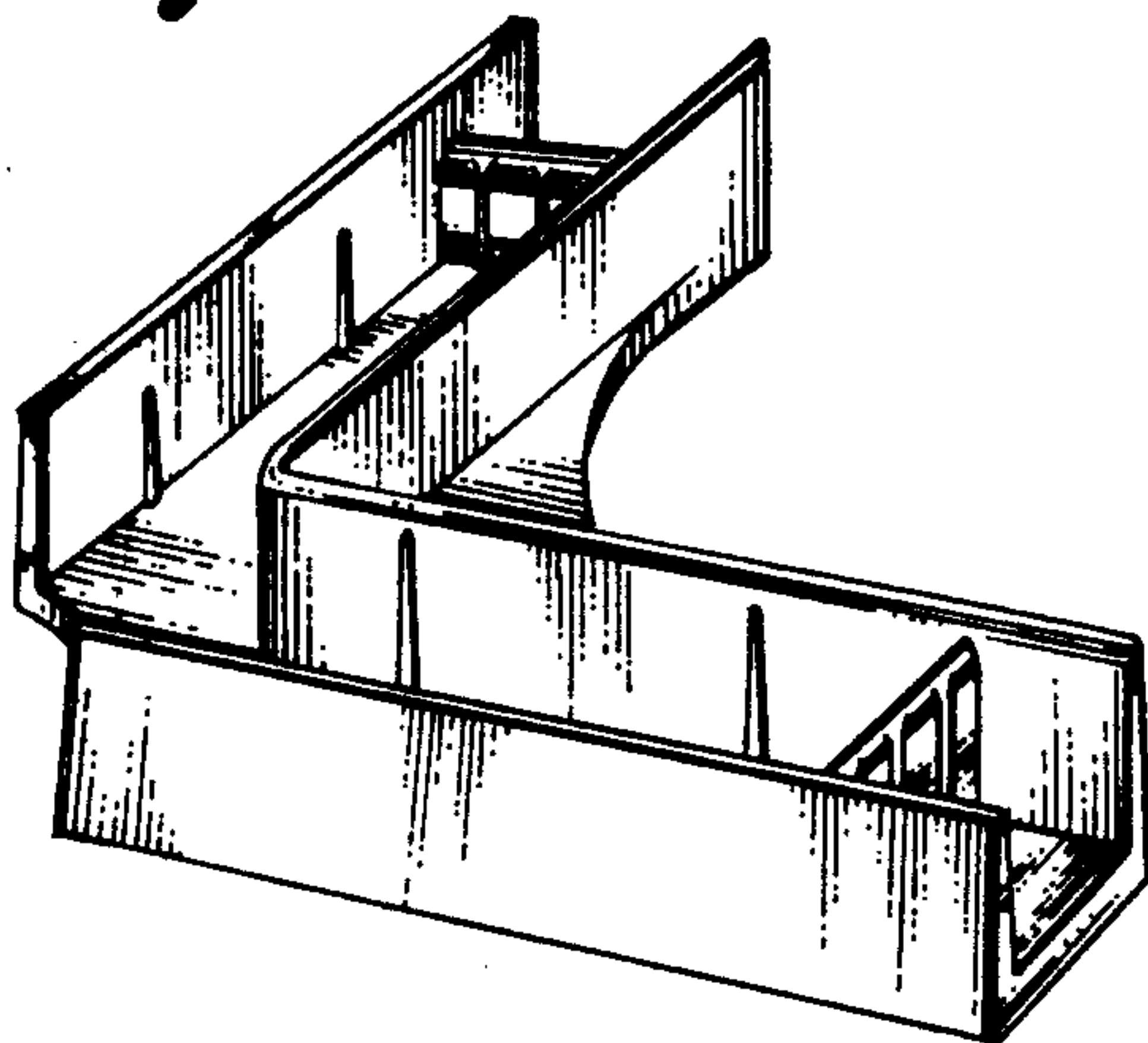

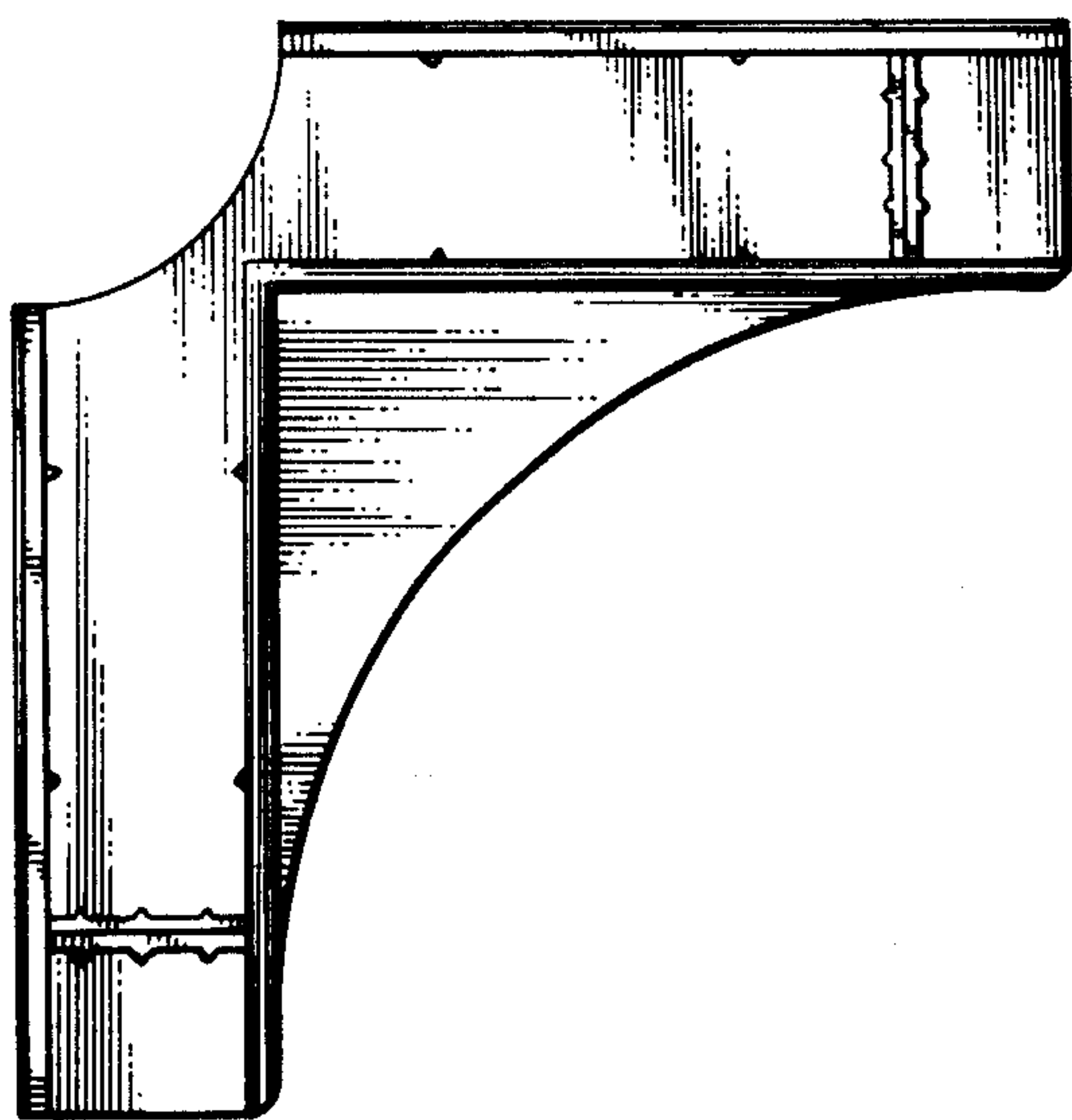
