[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a beverage container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a beverage container showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;  
 FIG. 4 is a fragmentary rear view looking in the direction of the line 4-4 of FIG. 2;  
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
 FIG. 6 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken along lines 6-6 of FIG. 5.  
 The rear elevations of the containers mirror images of the front elevations.

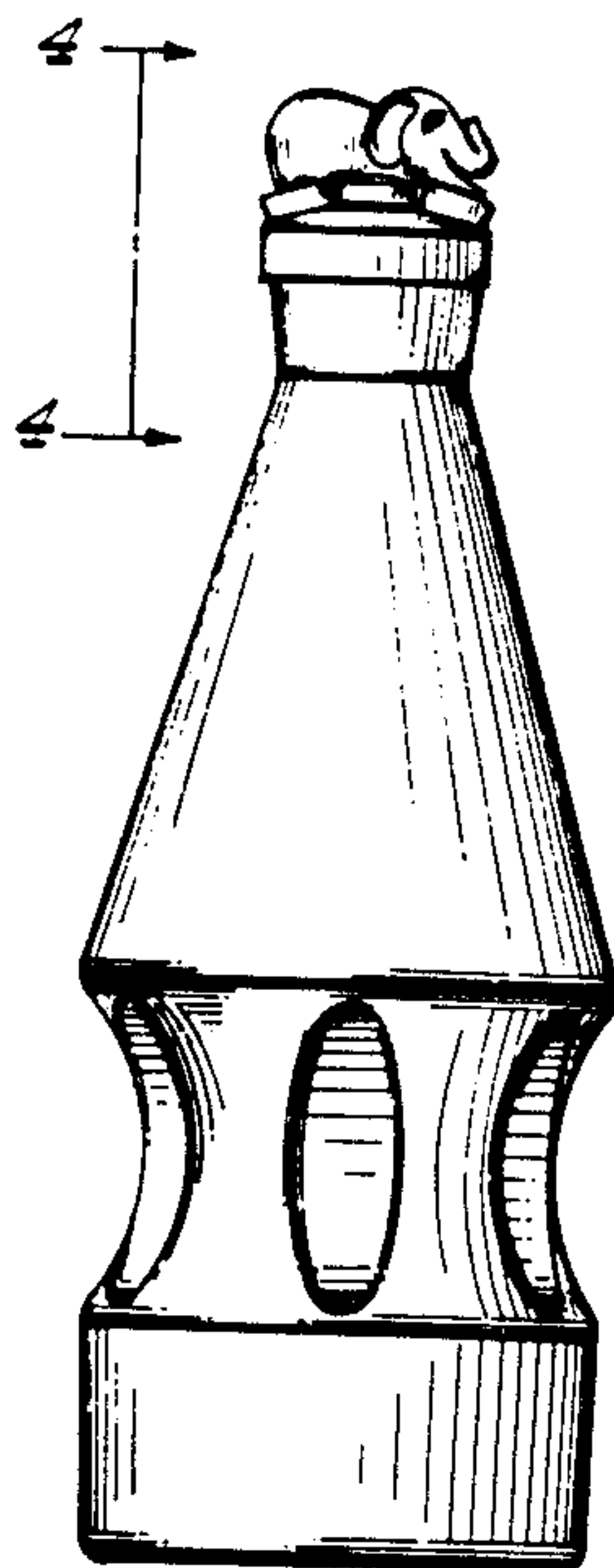

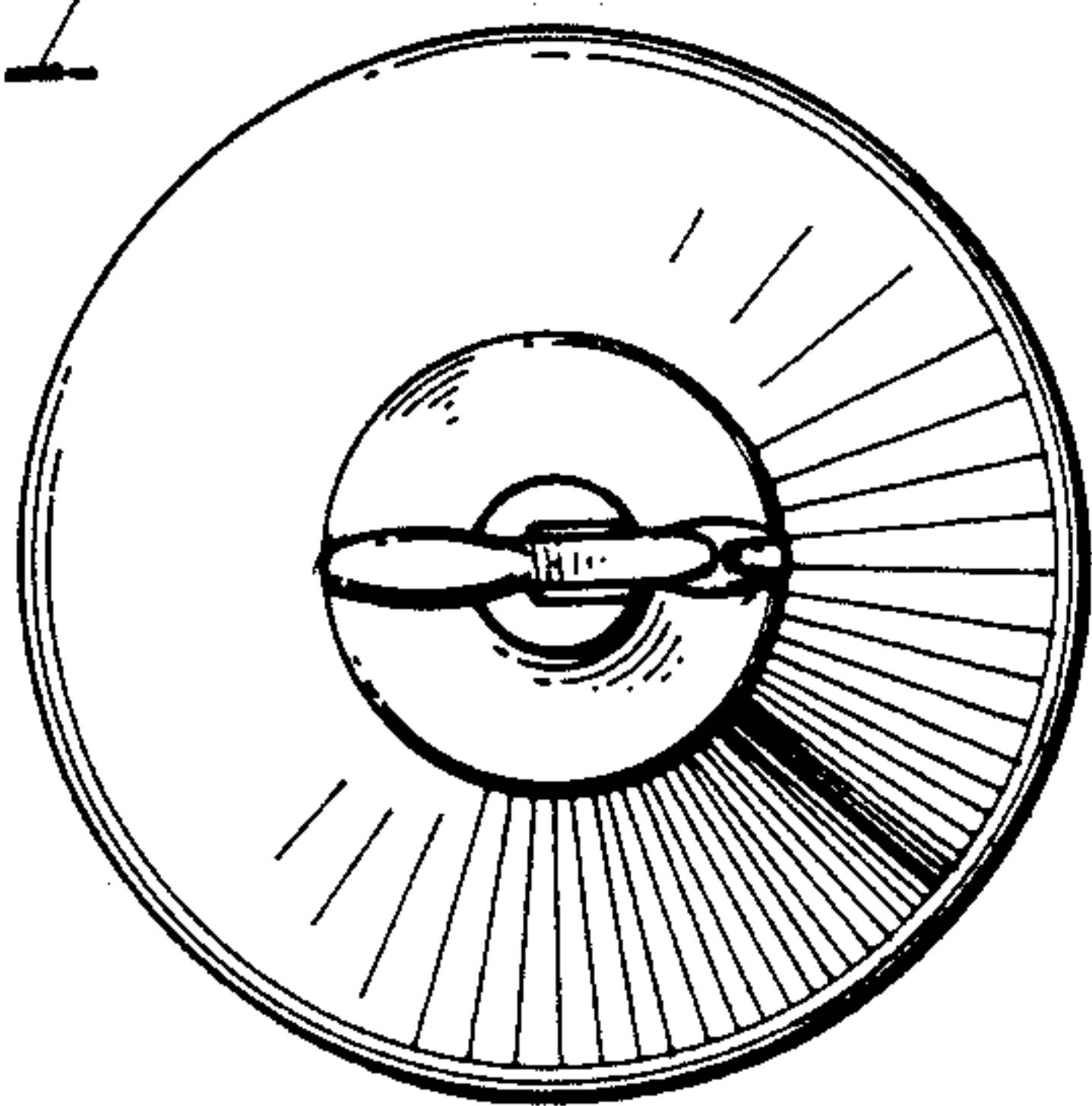

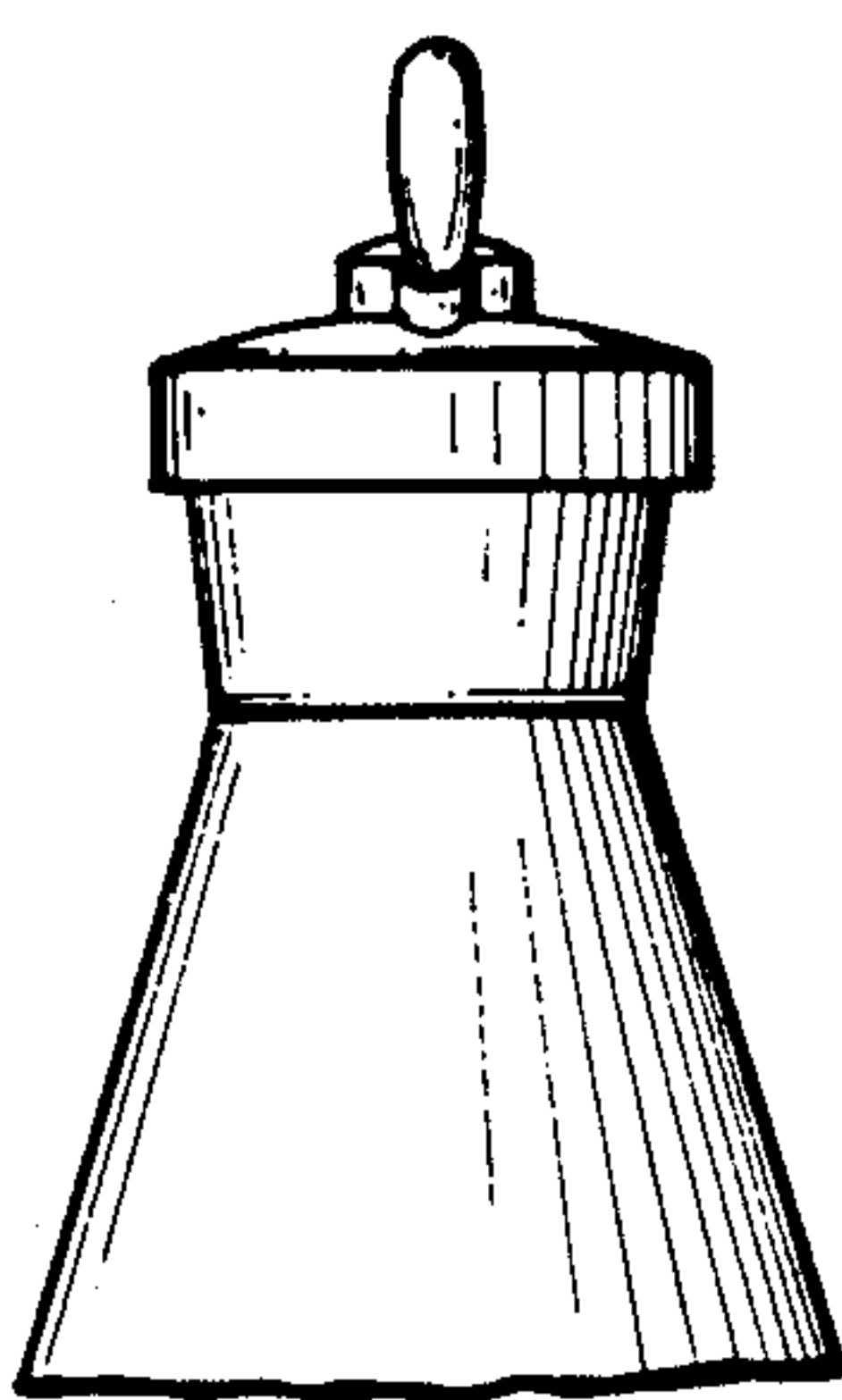
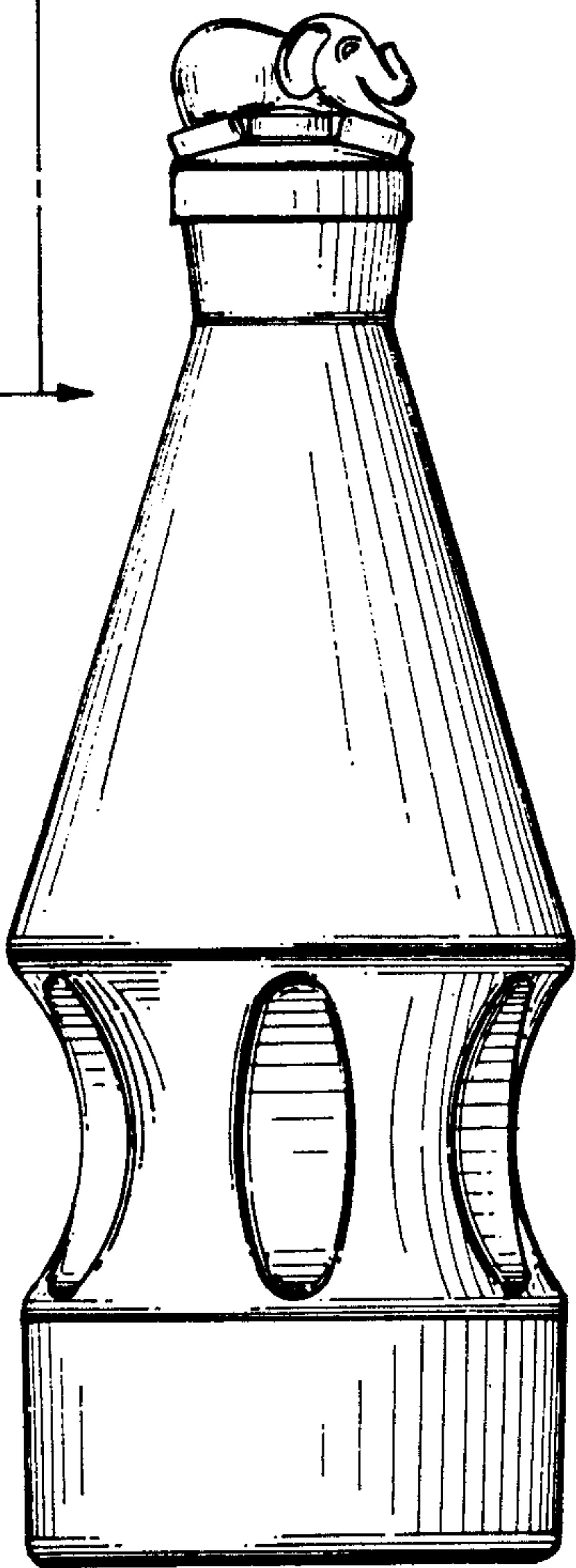
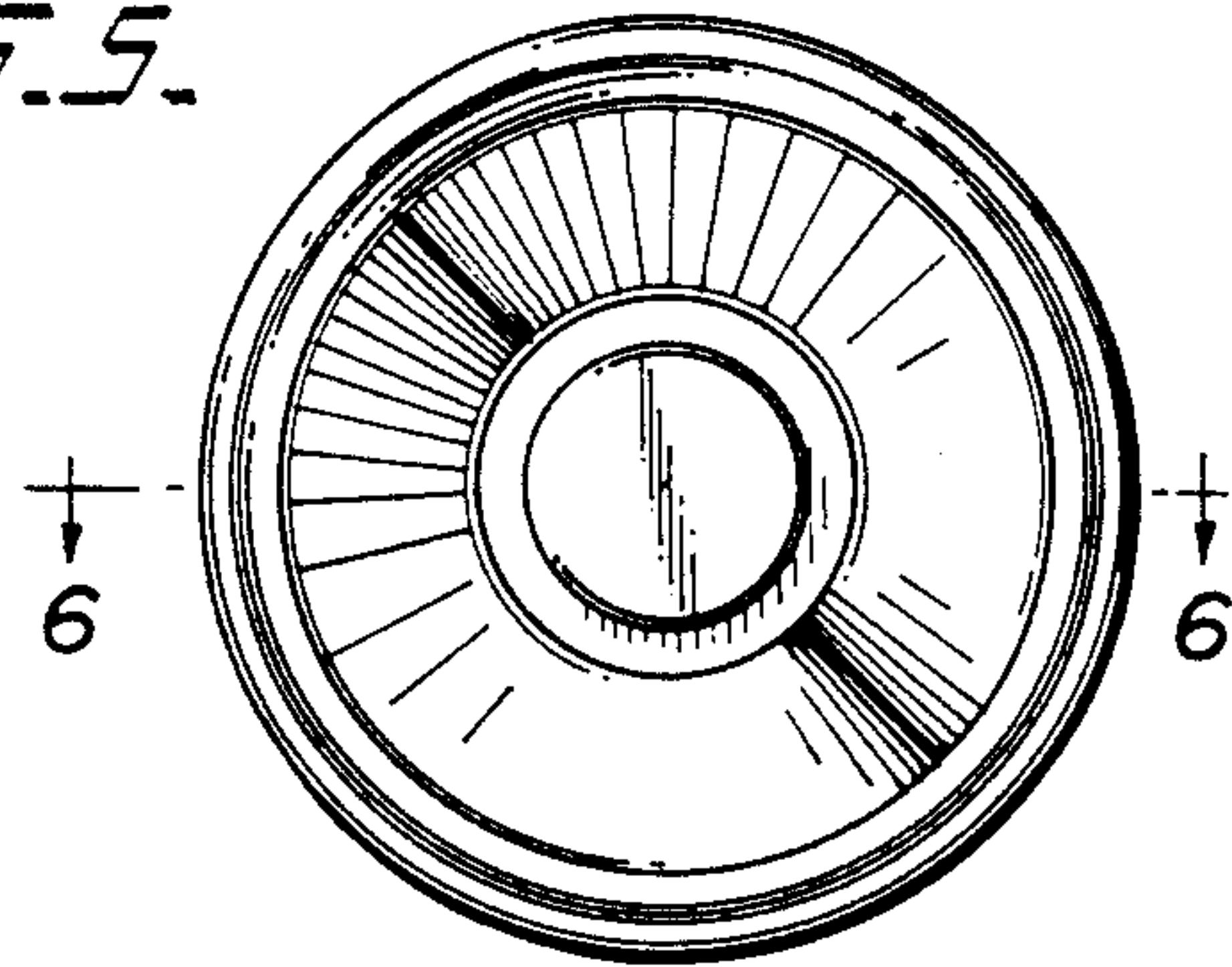

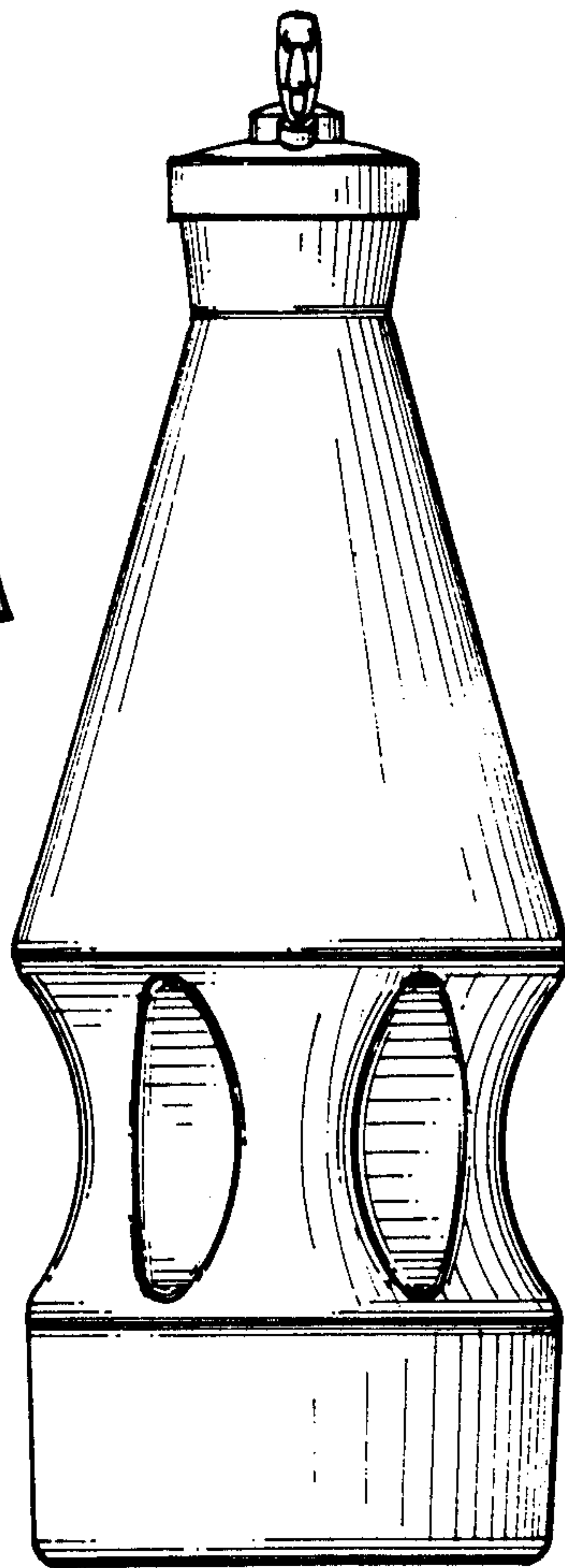
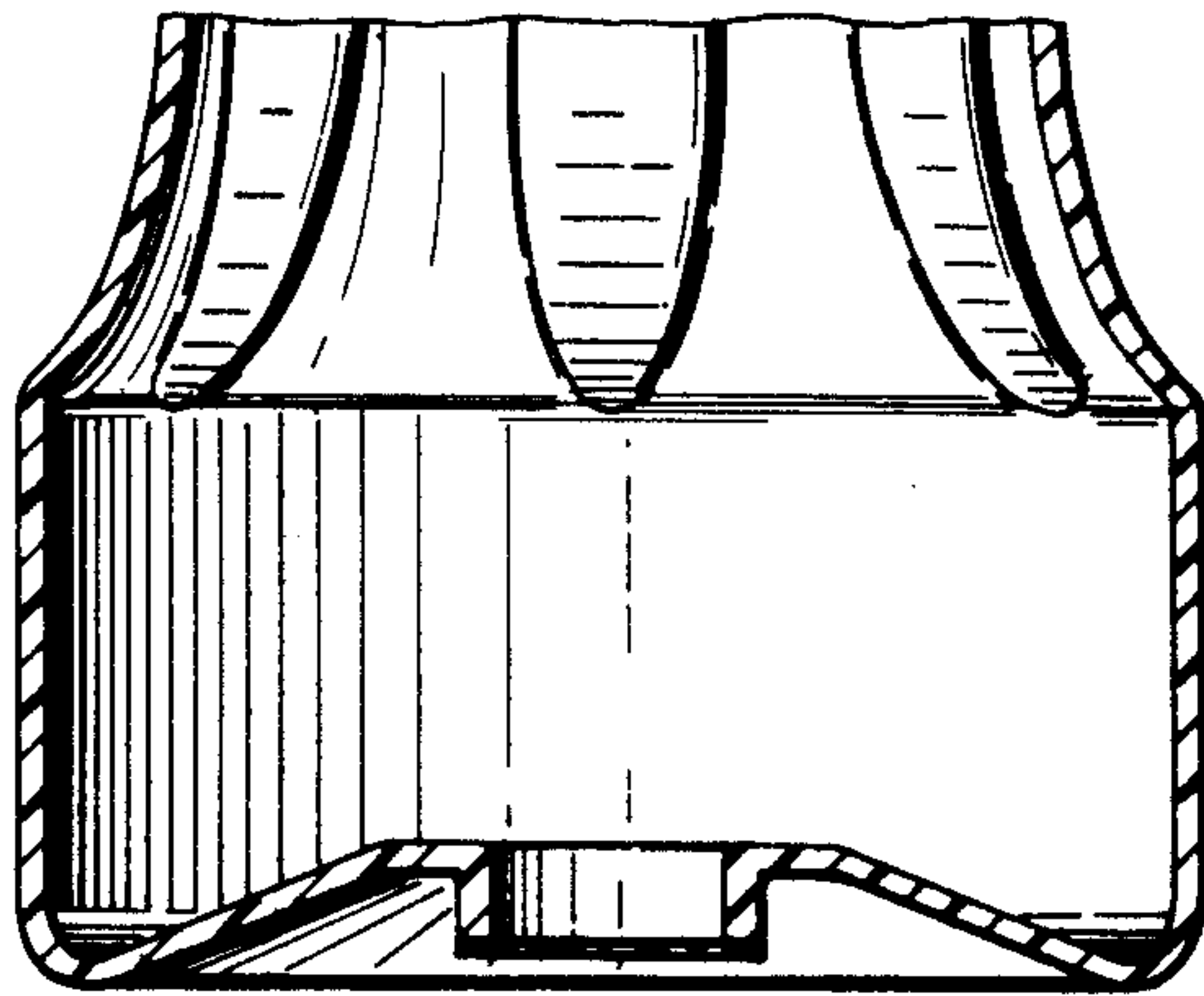
