The bottom surface is plain and unornamented.

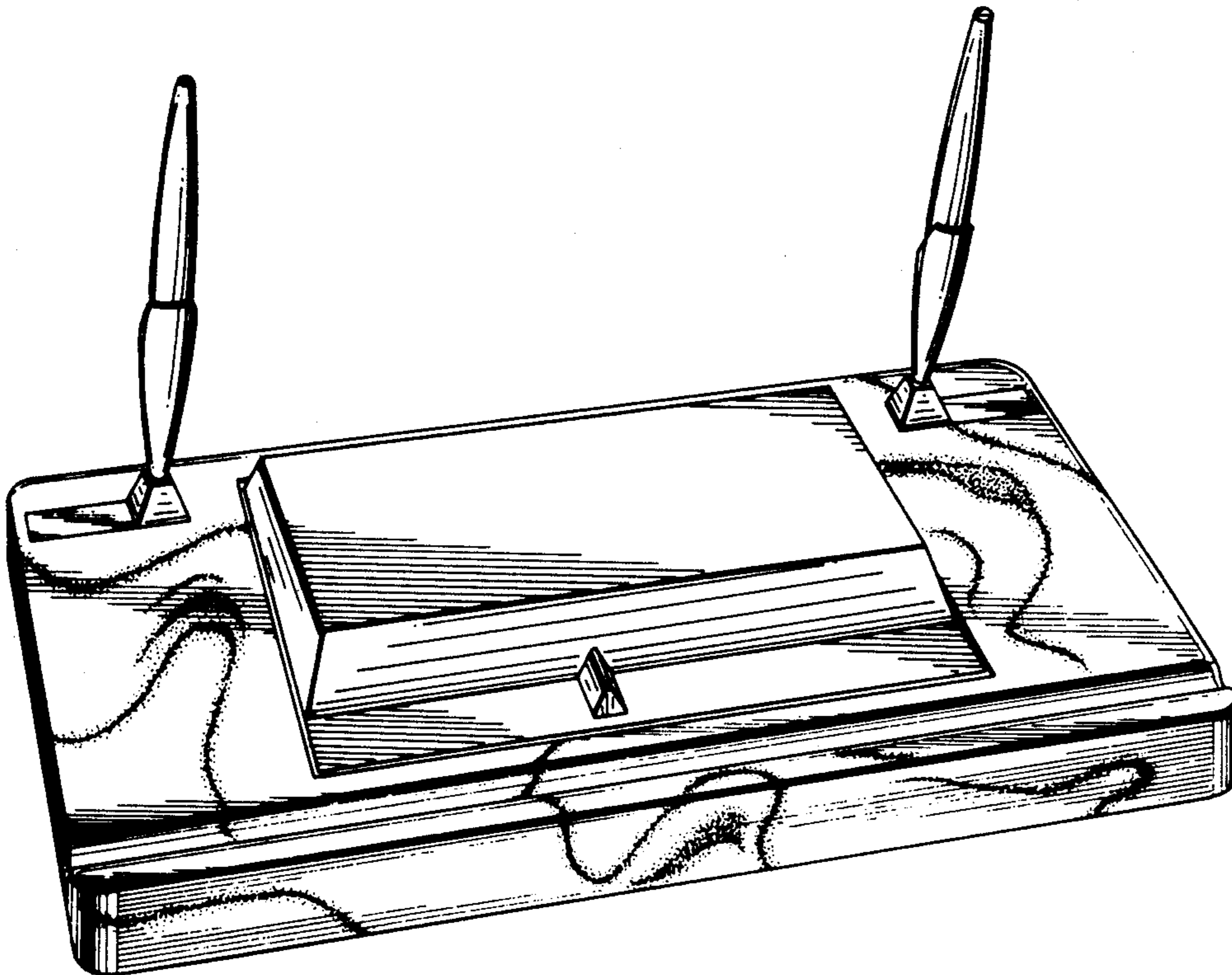

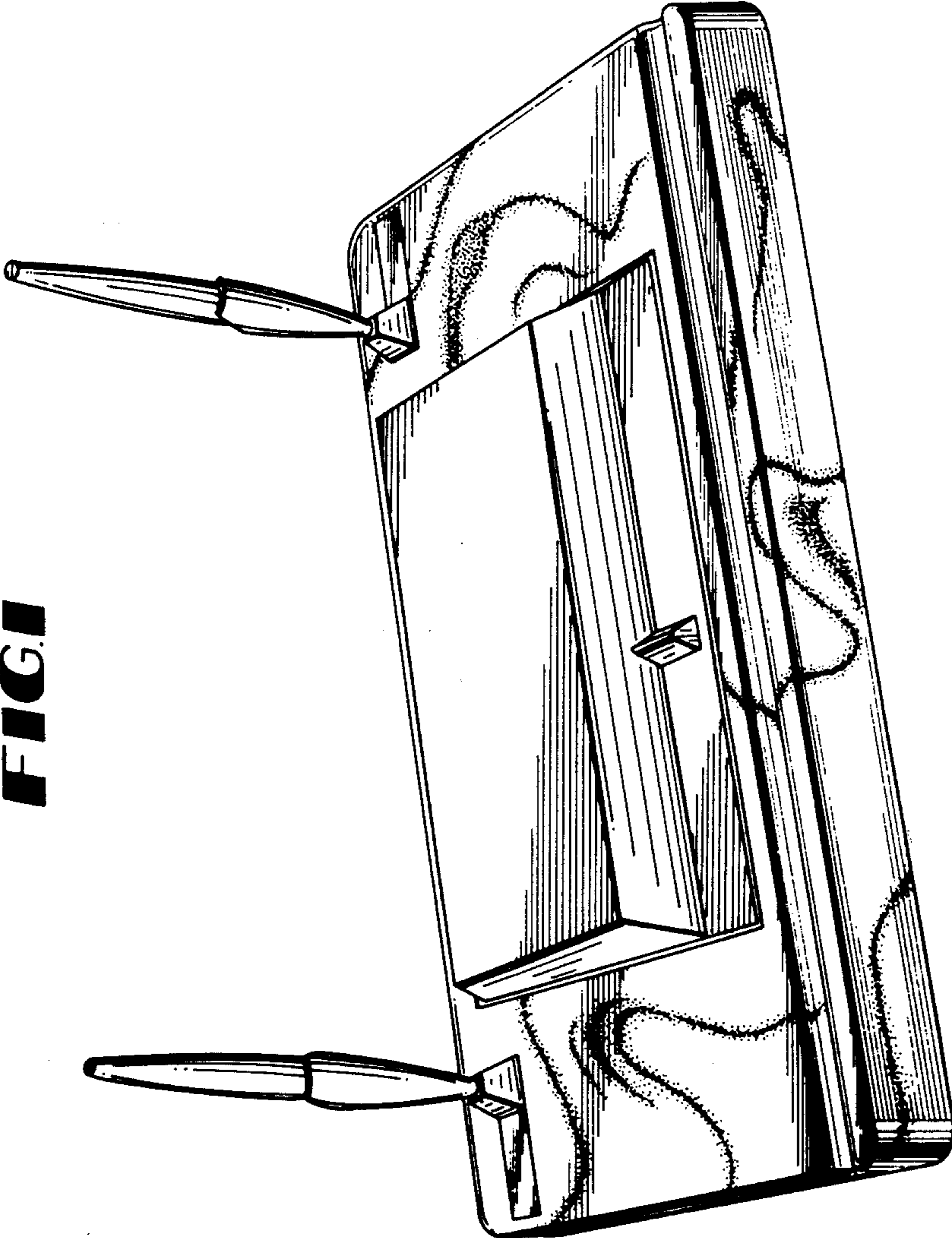

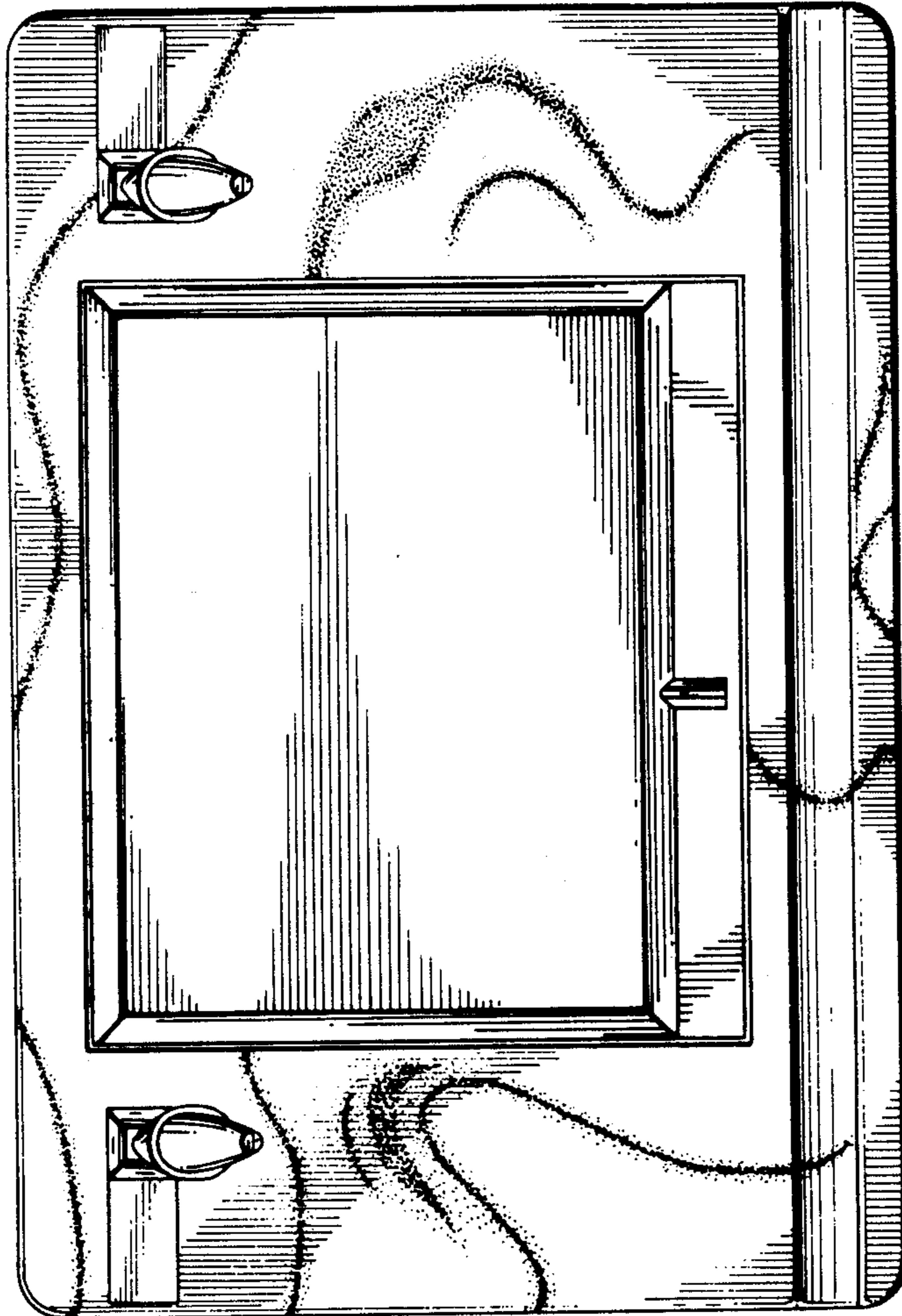

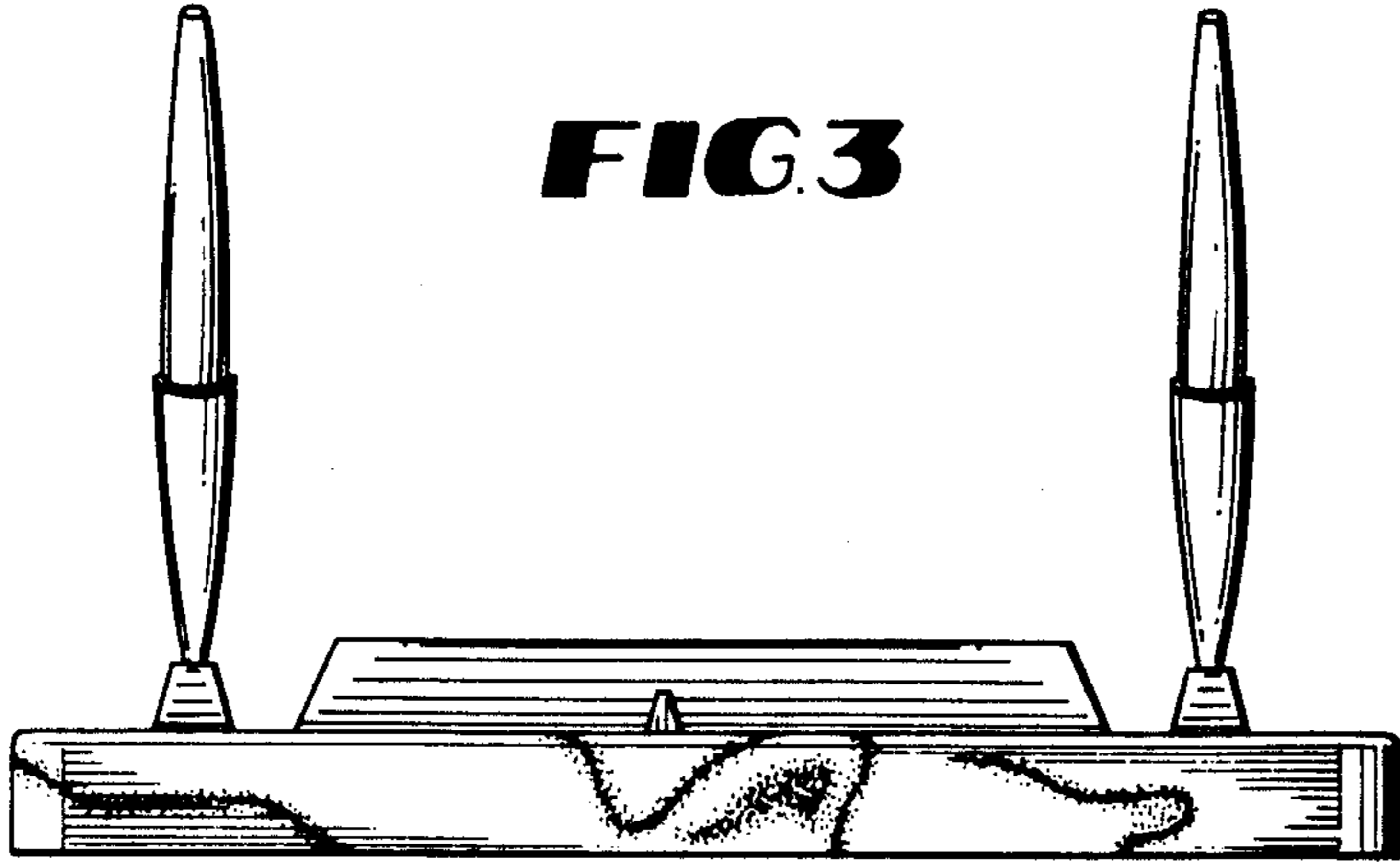

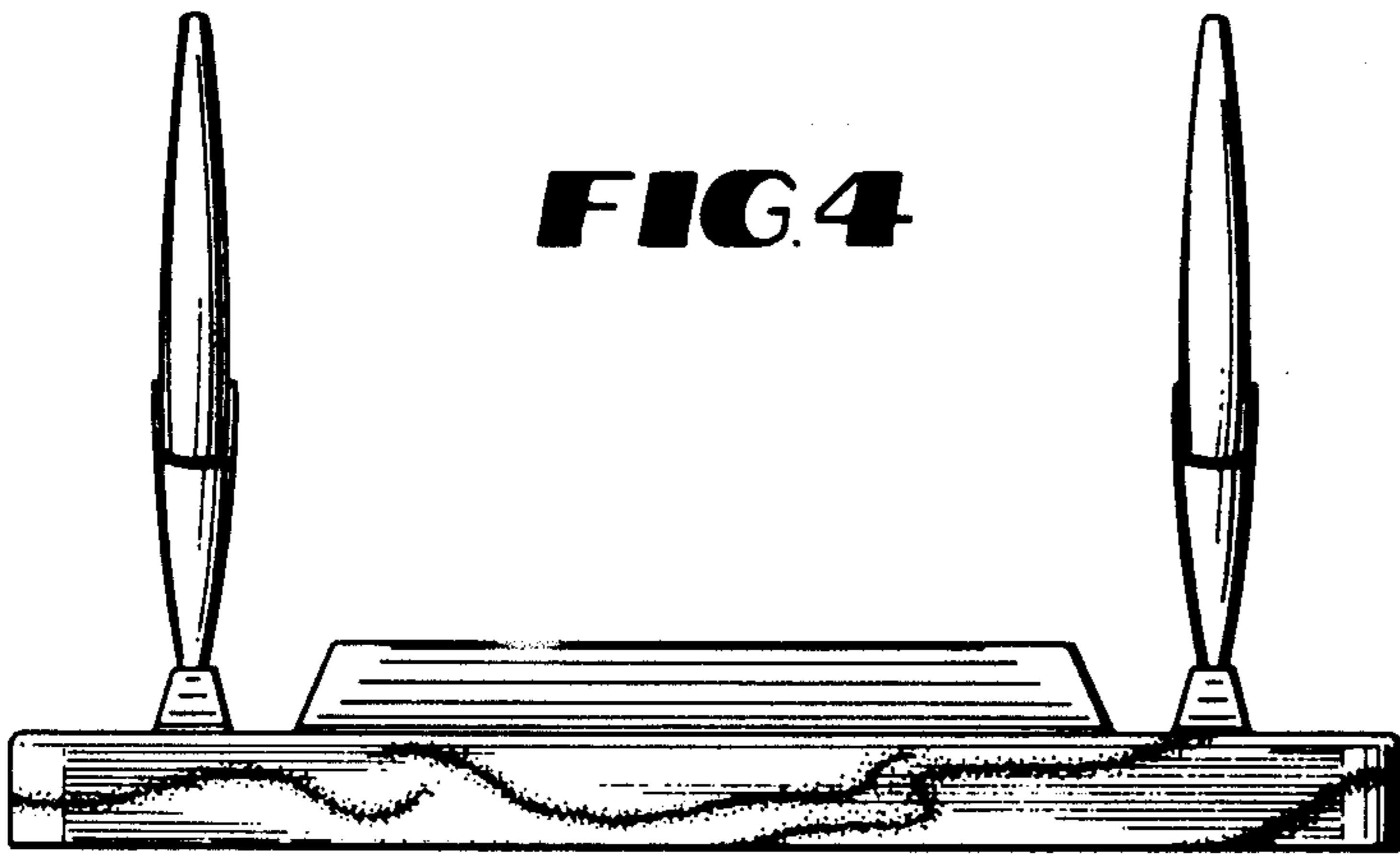
