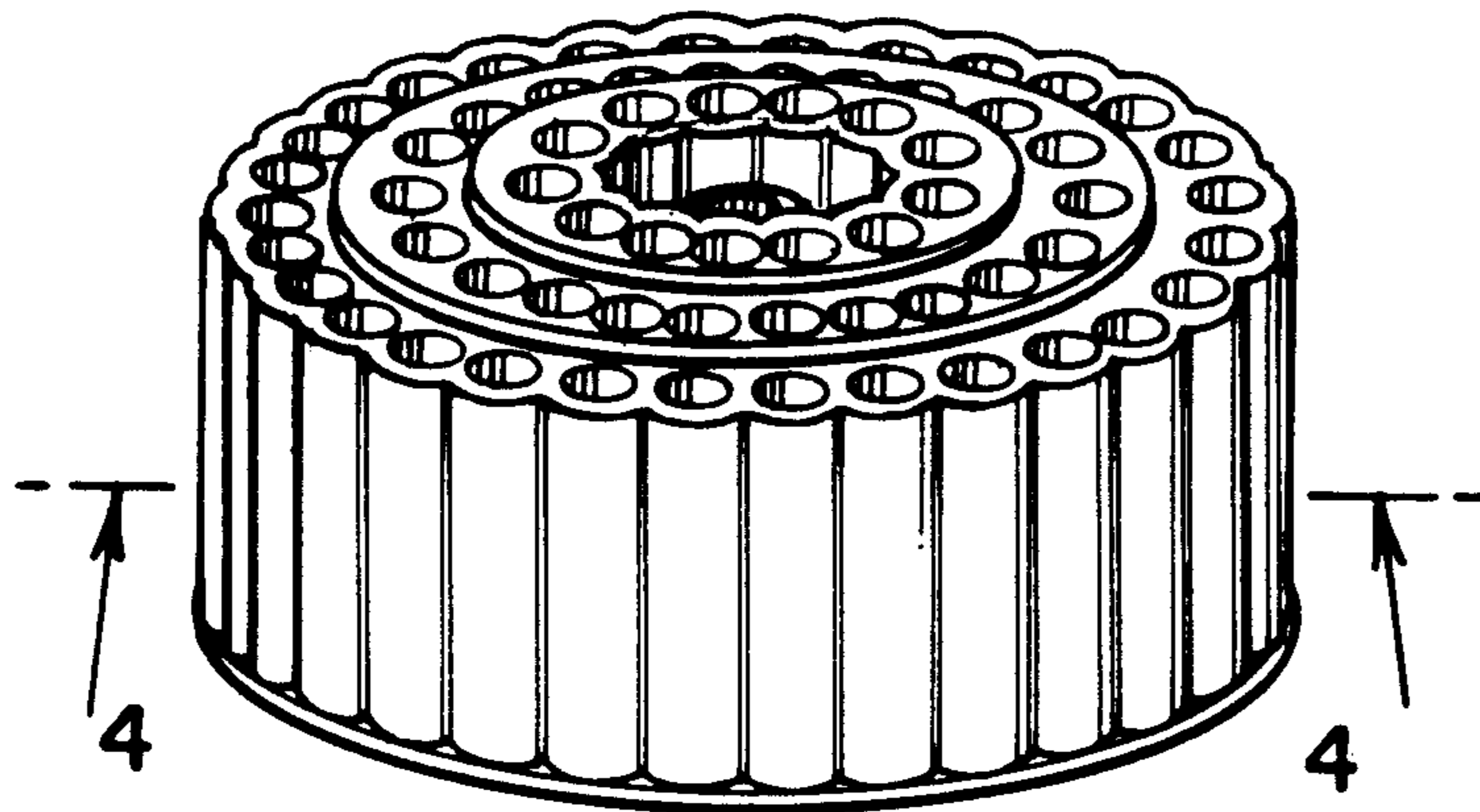

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a test tube holder, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of a test tube holder showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the elements of FIG. 1 in assembled relationship; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a cross section looking in the direction of the arrows 4-4 of FIG. 2 thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



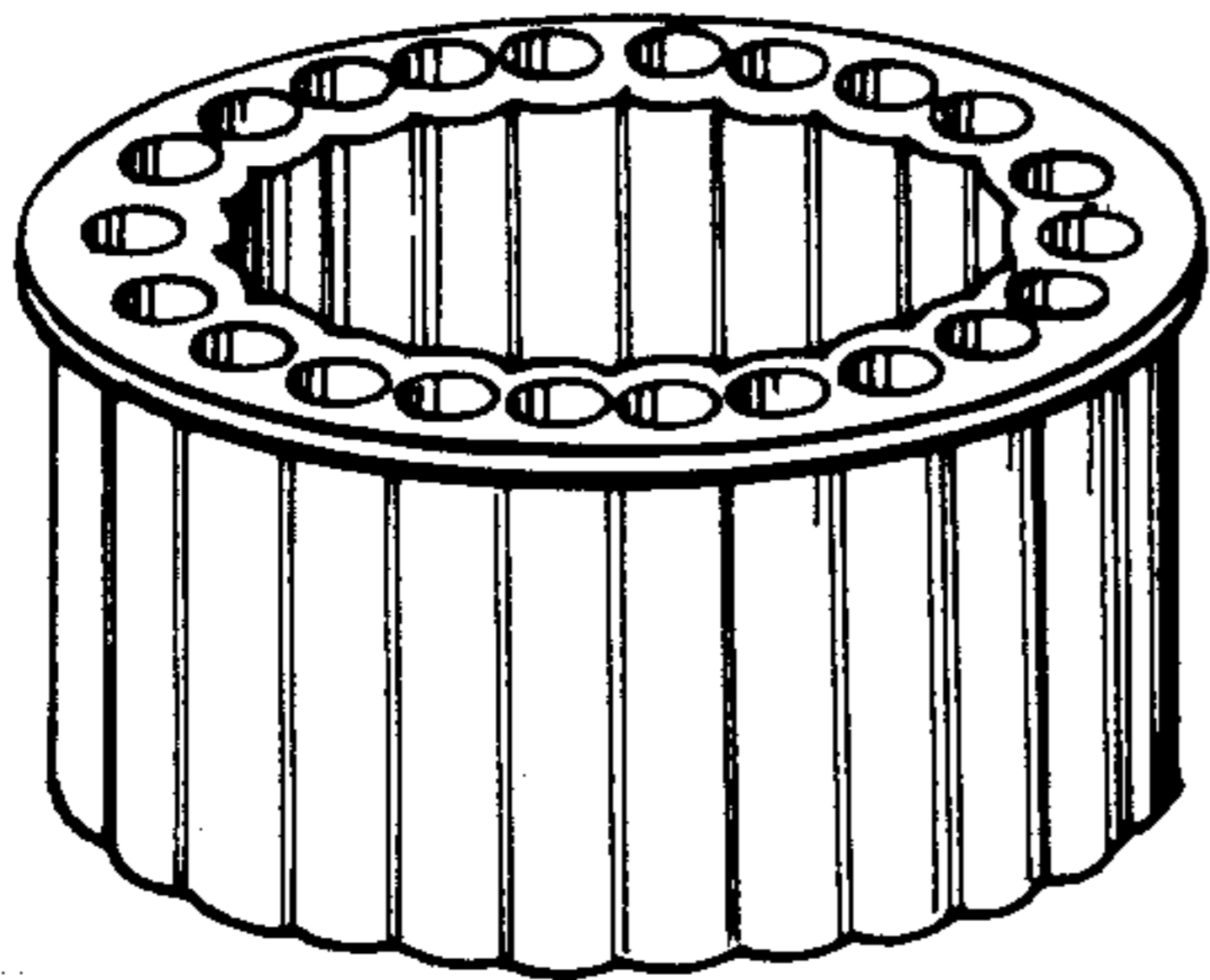
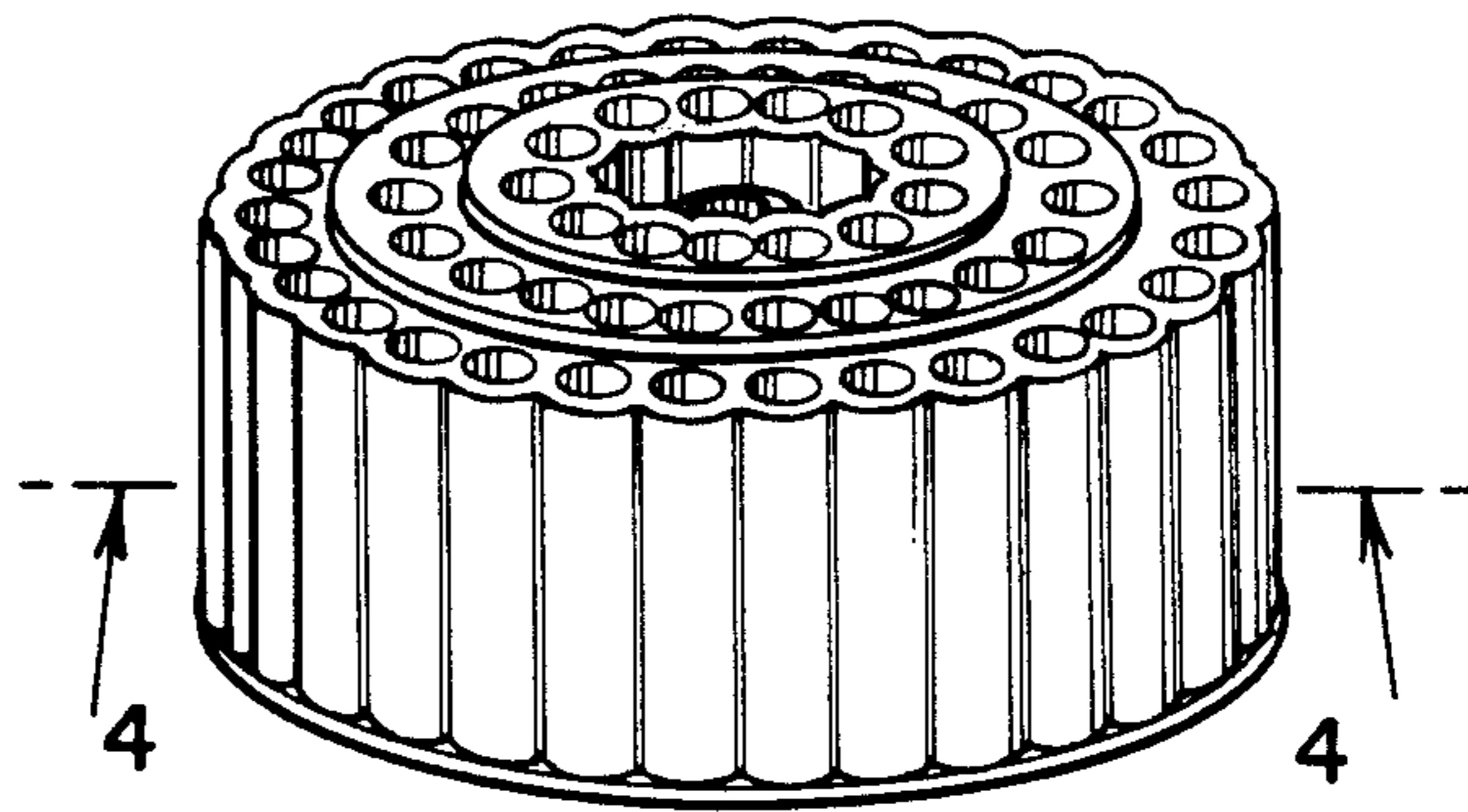
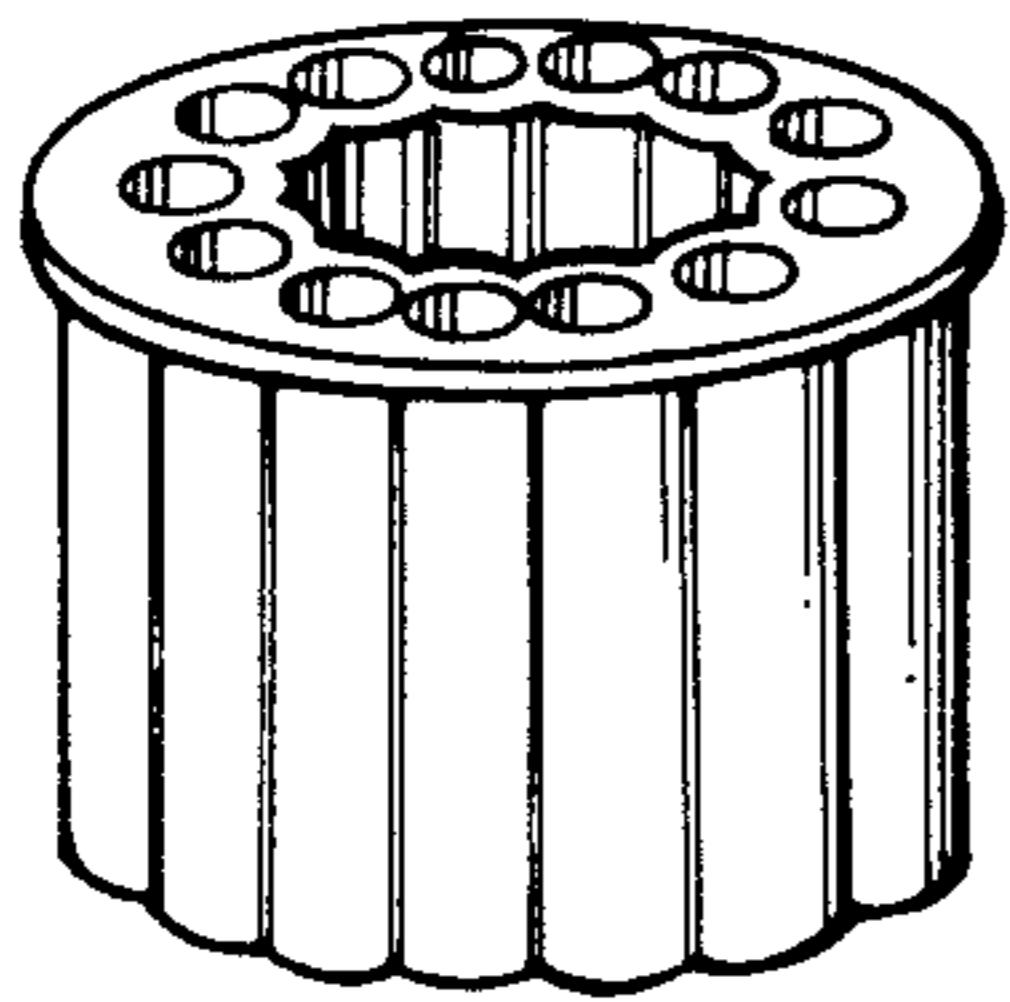

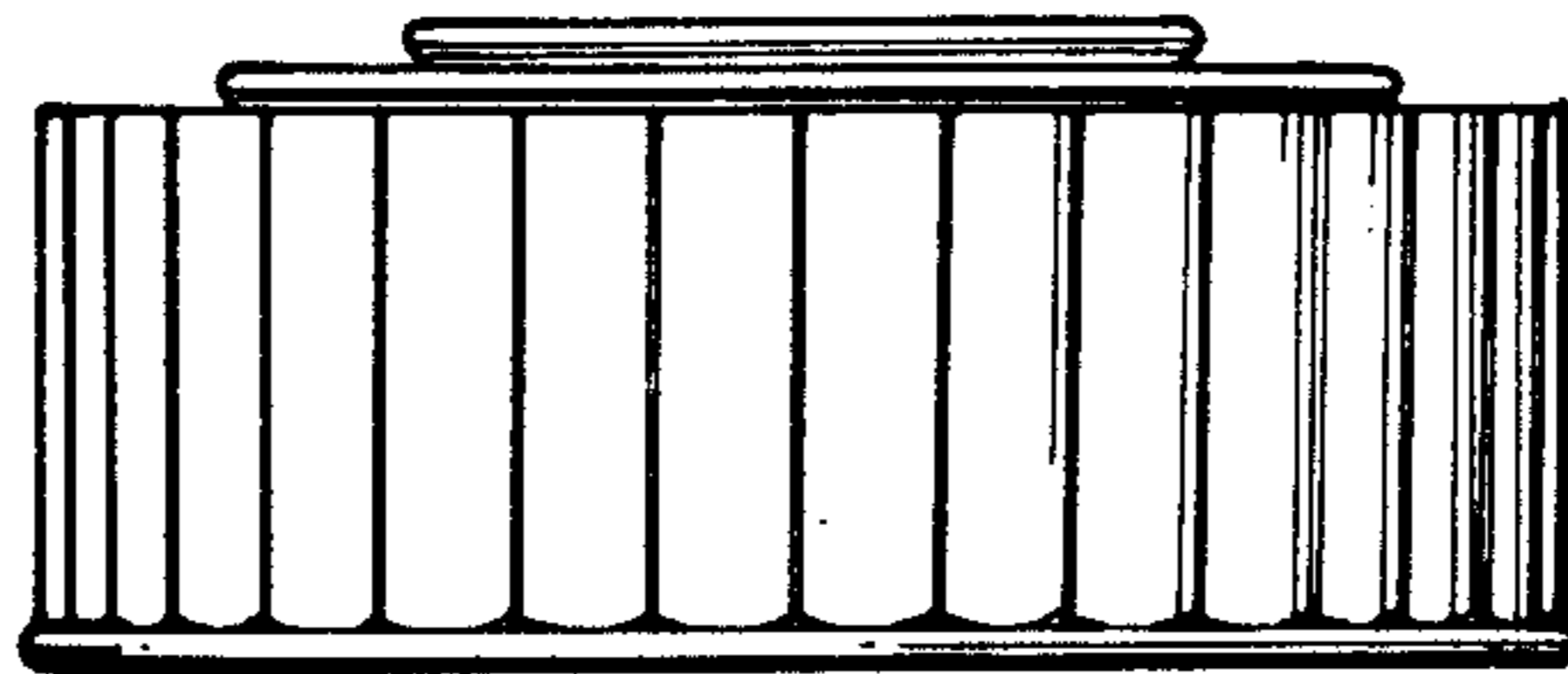

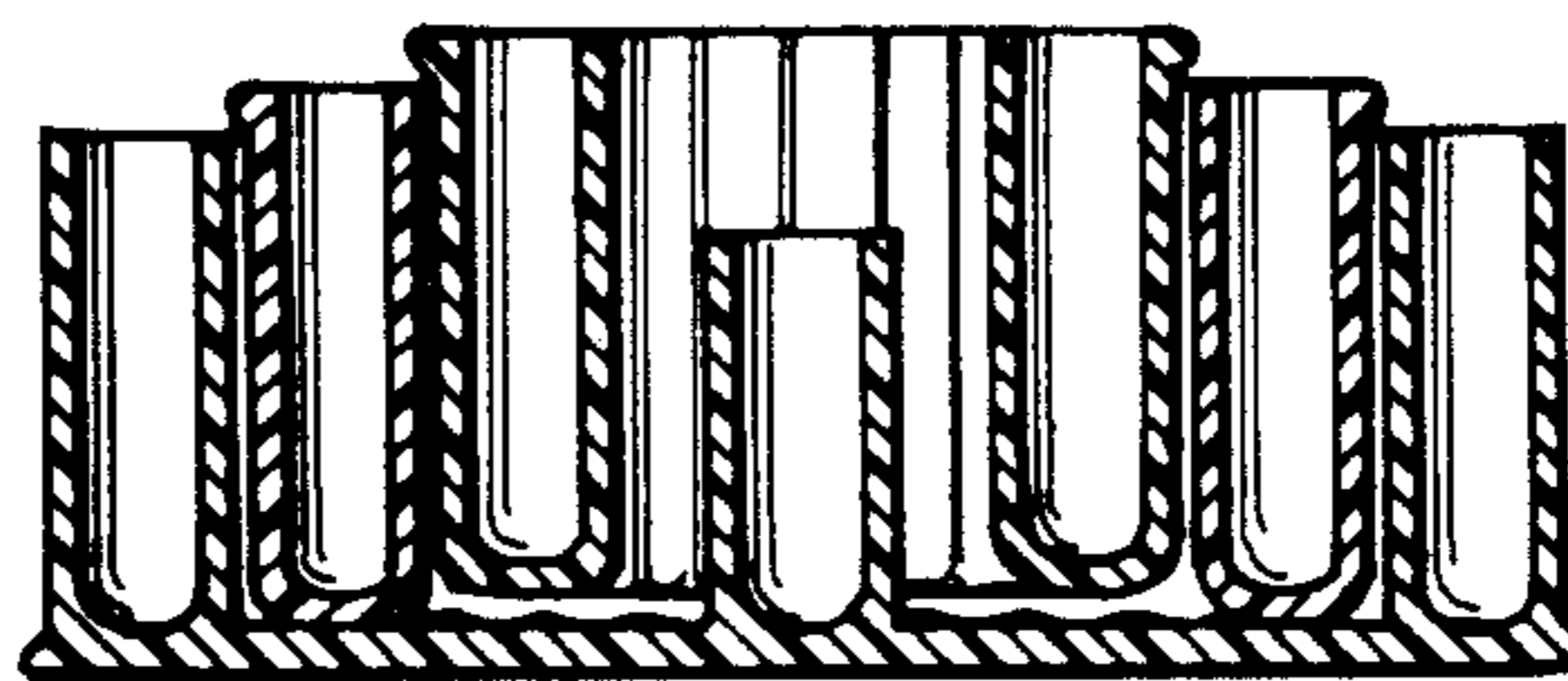

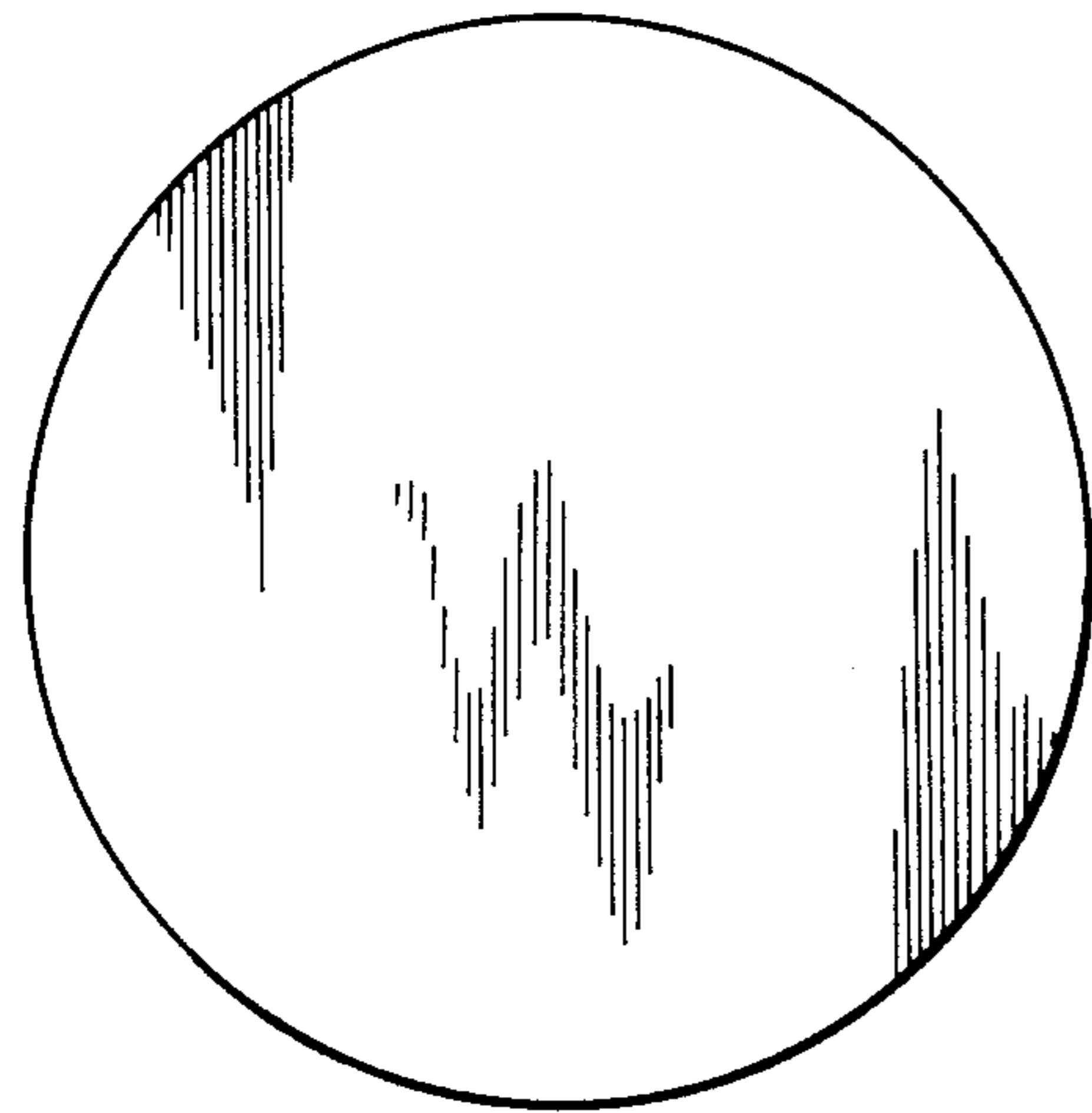

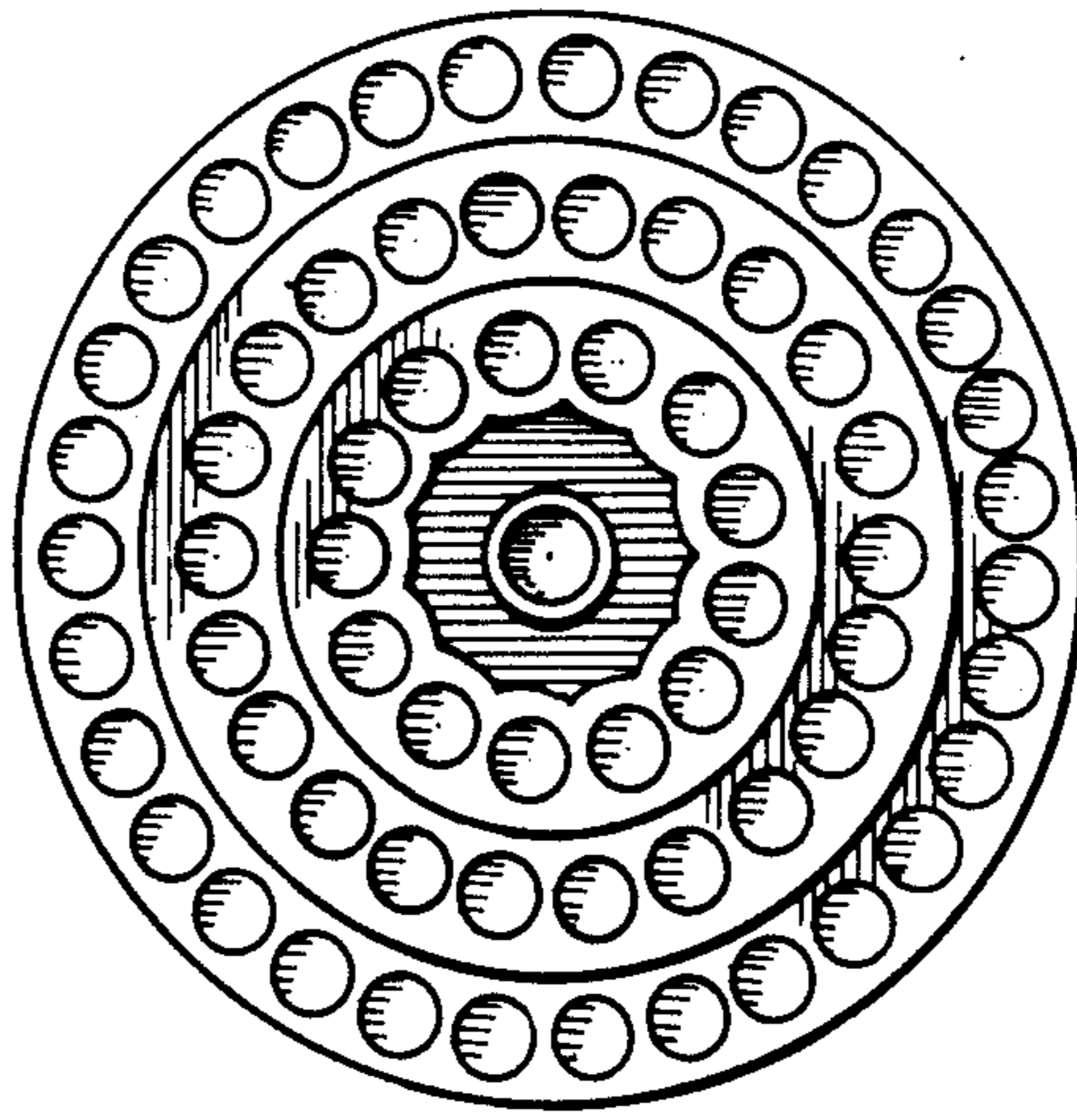
