FIG. 3 is a top plan view.

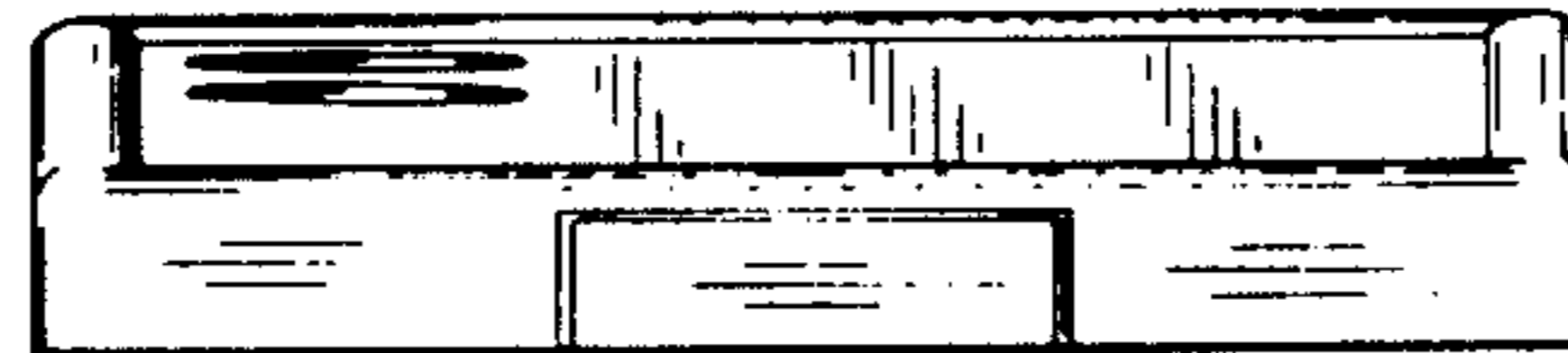
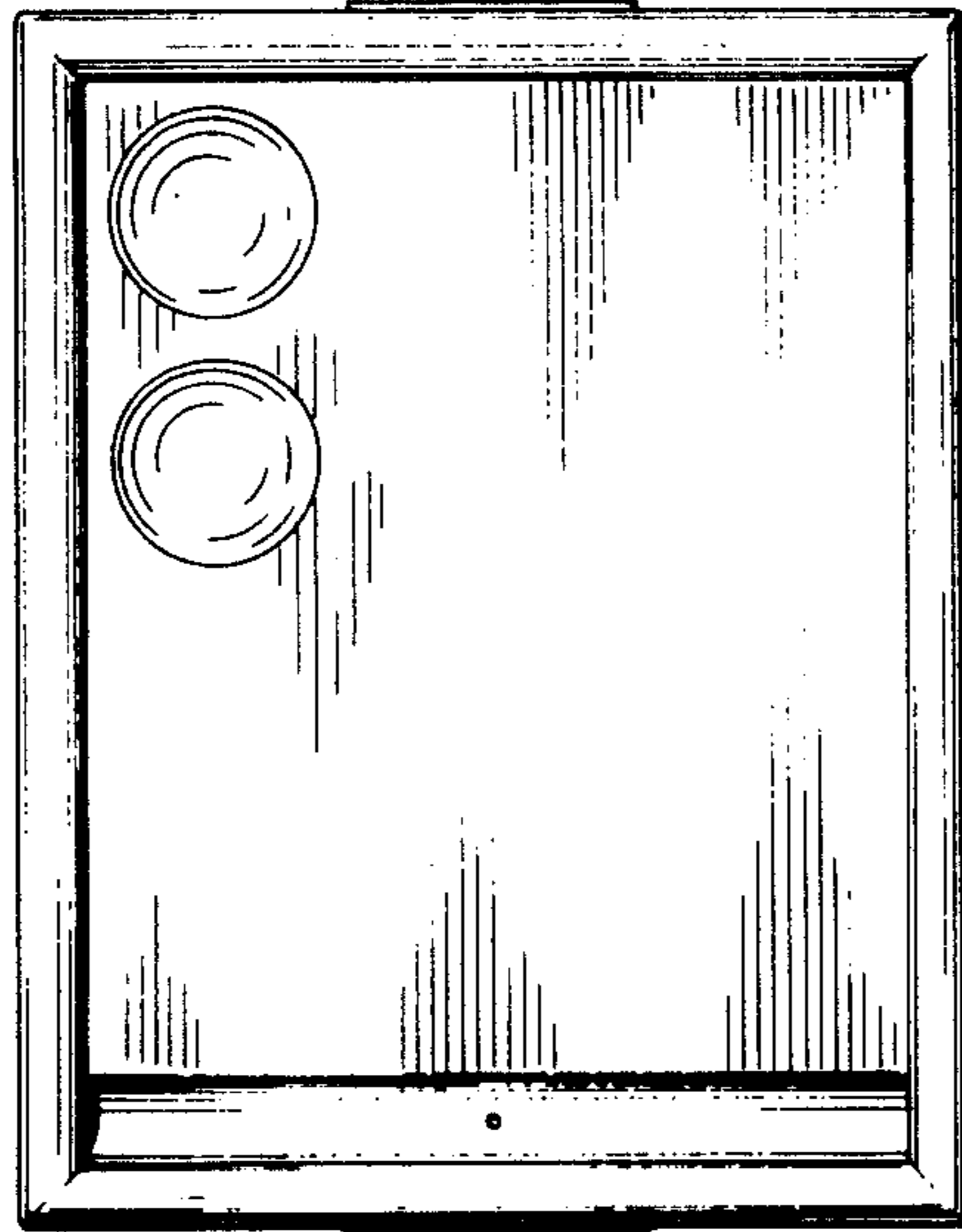
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view.

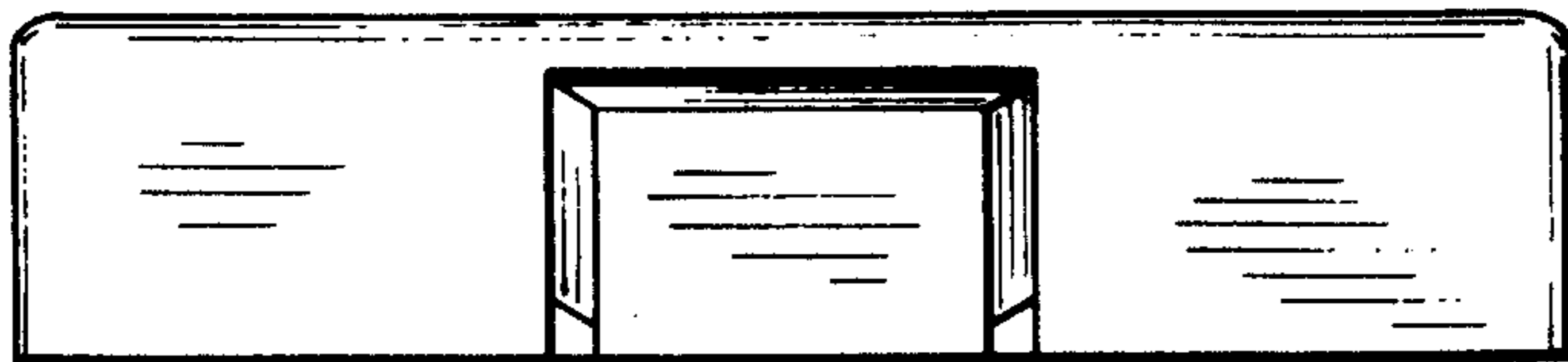

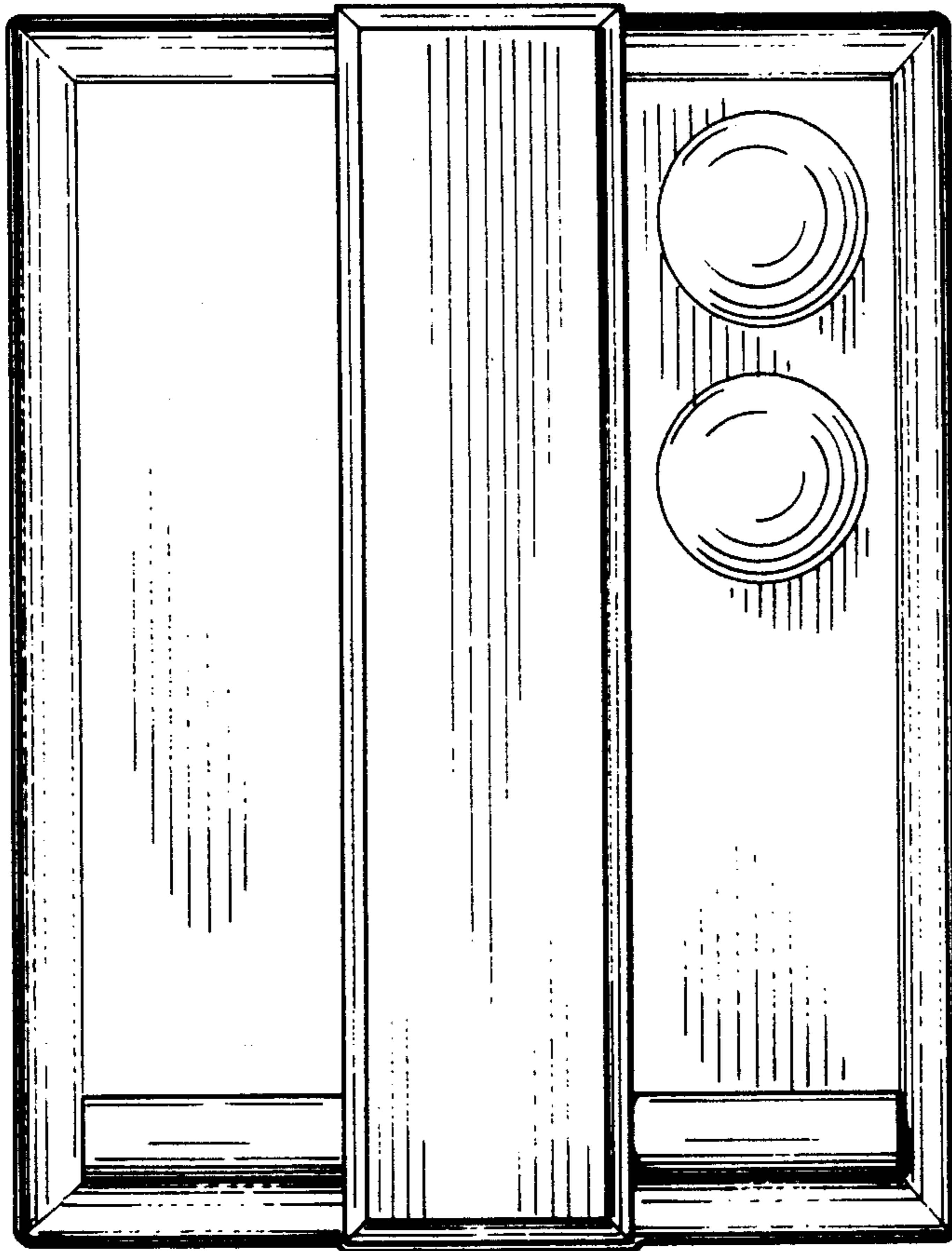

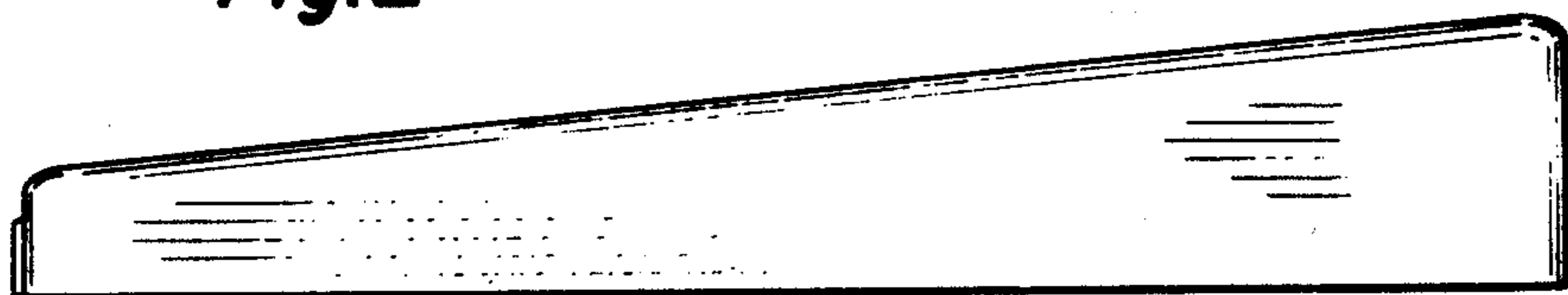

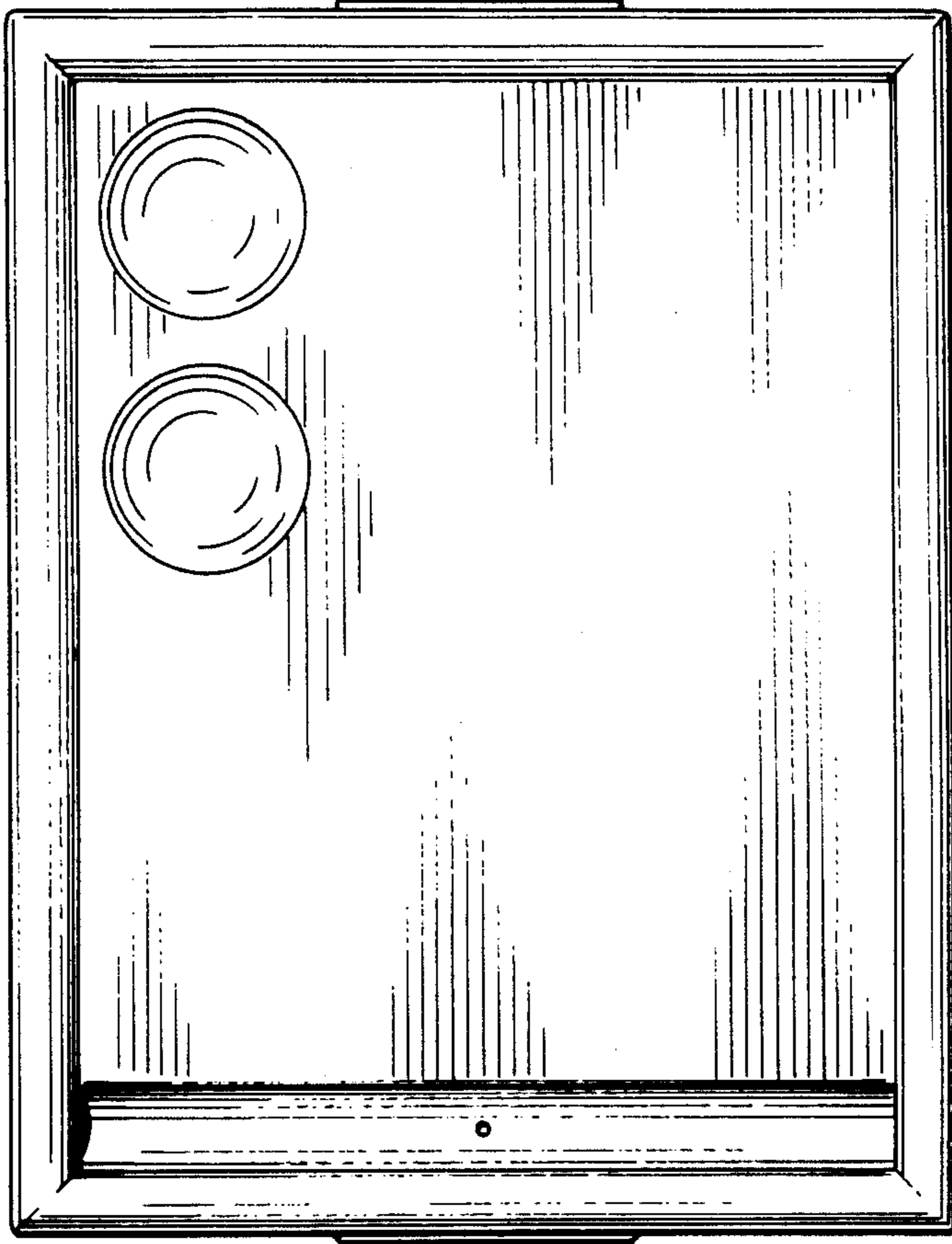

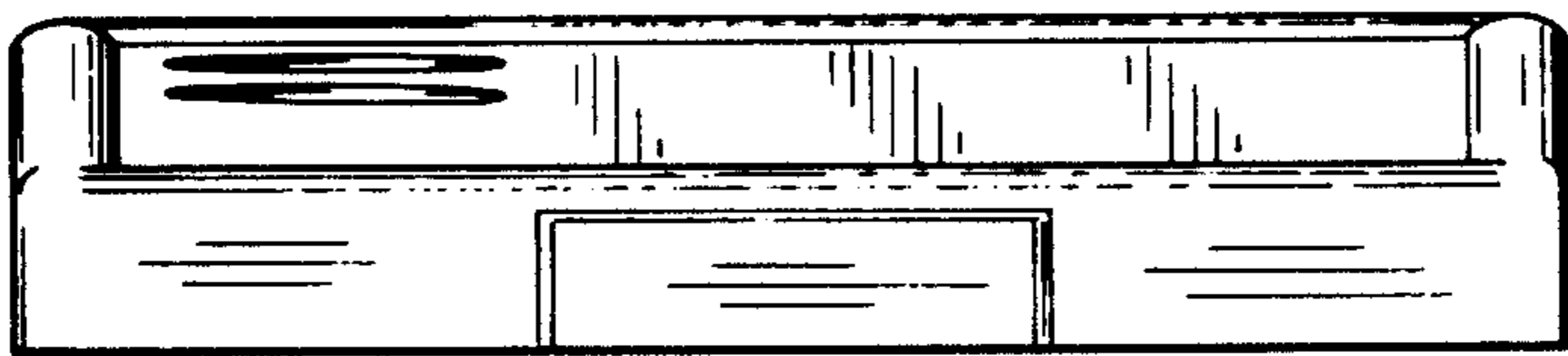
