FIG. 4 is a bottom front perspective view thereof.

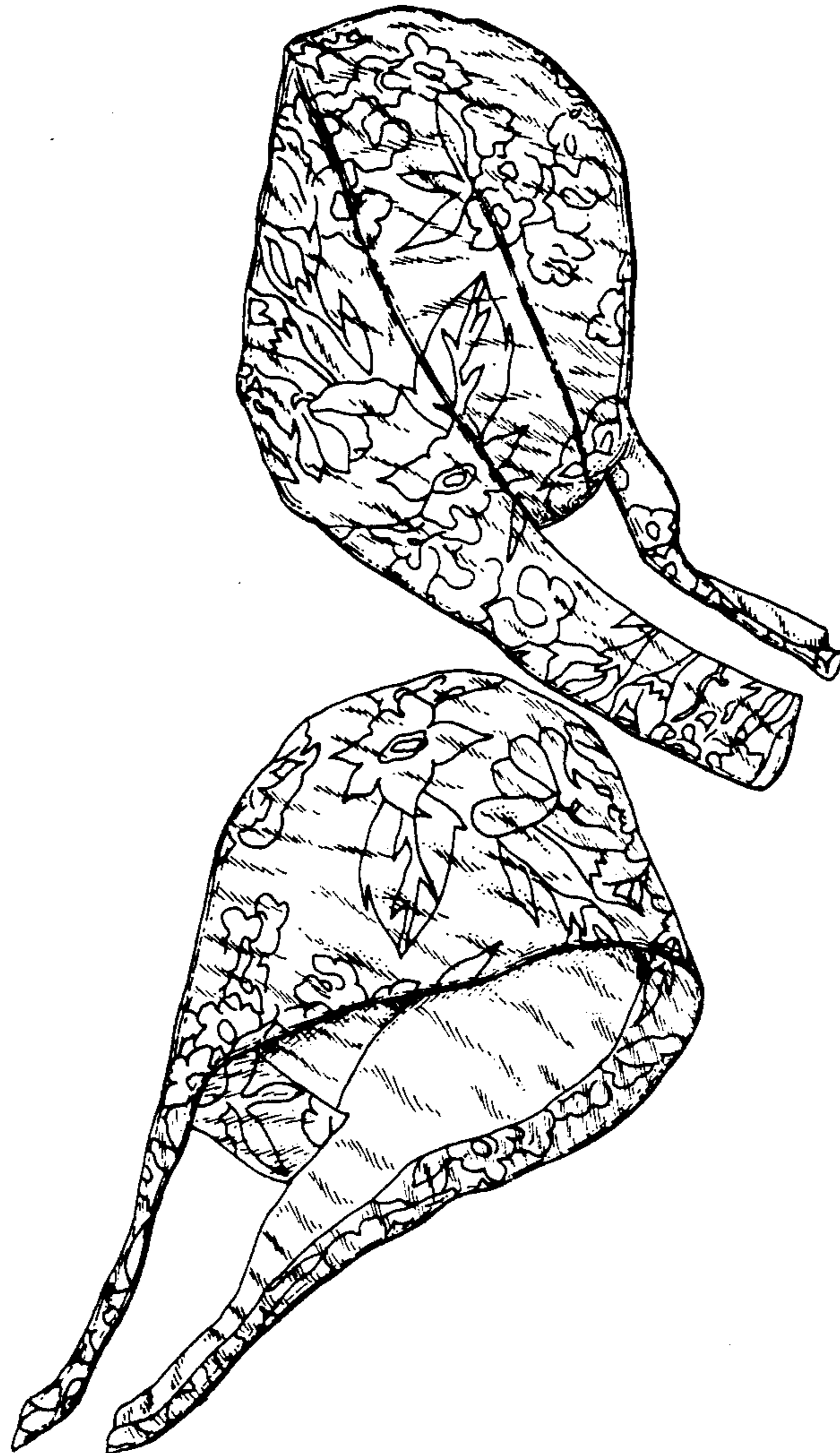

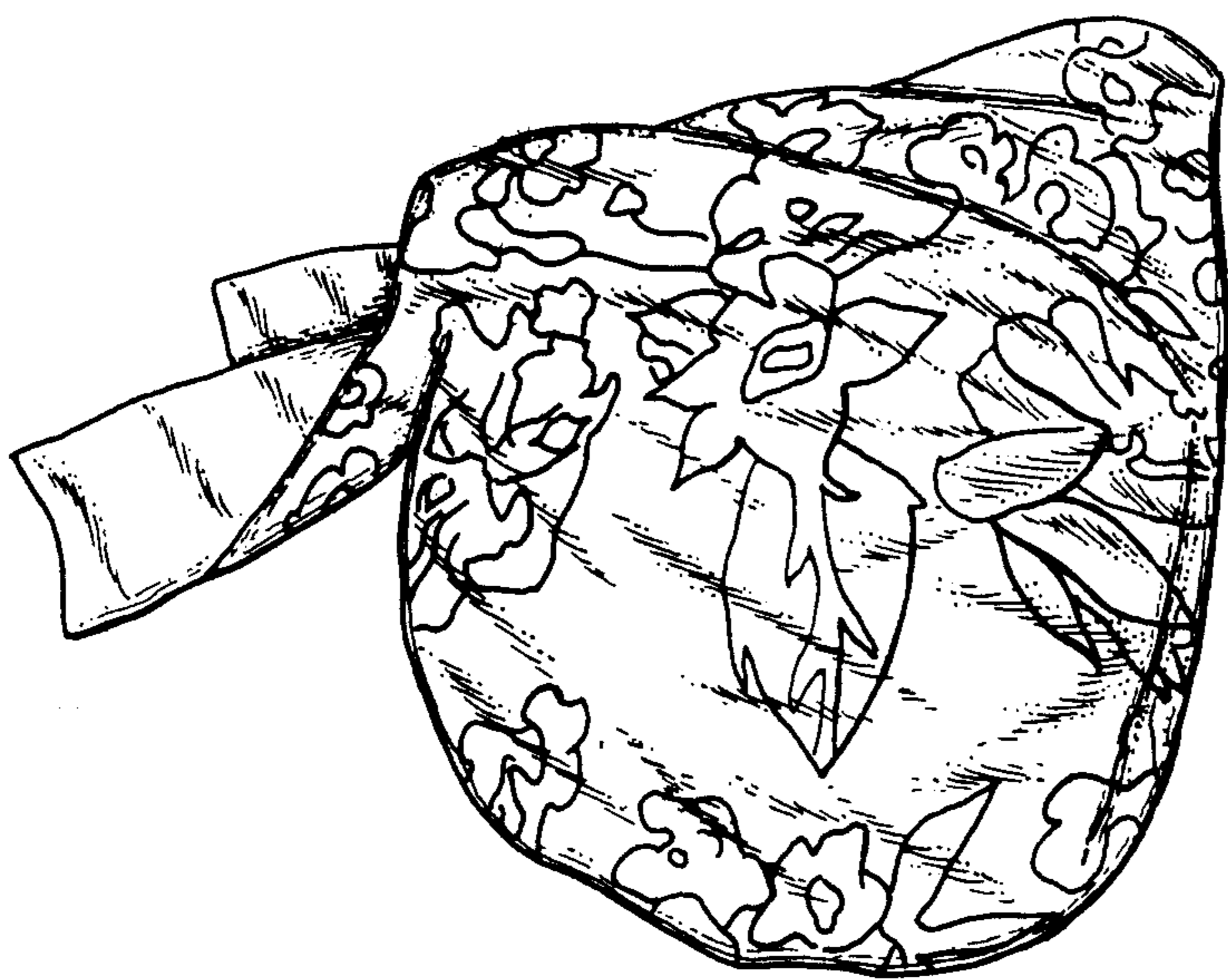
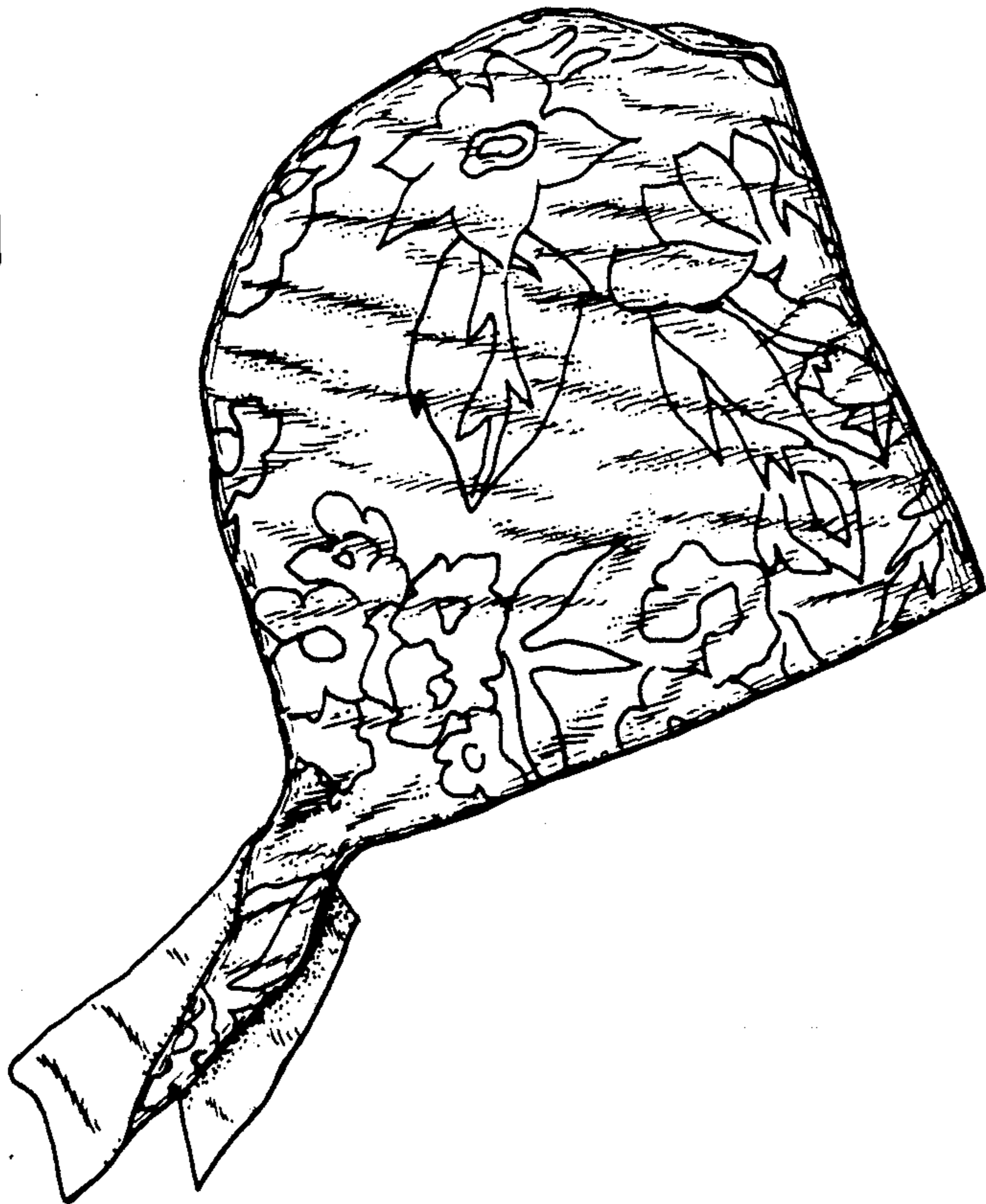

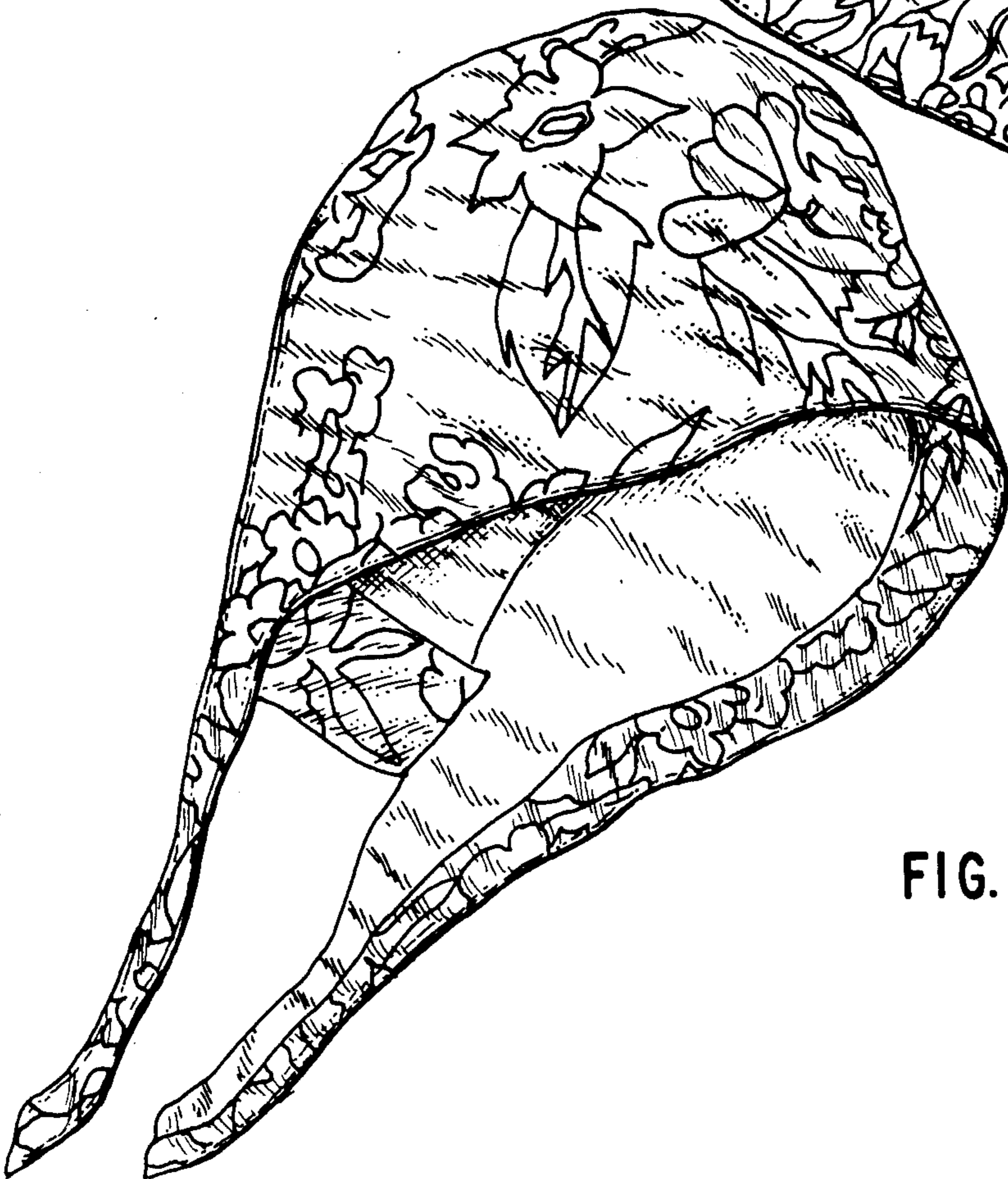
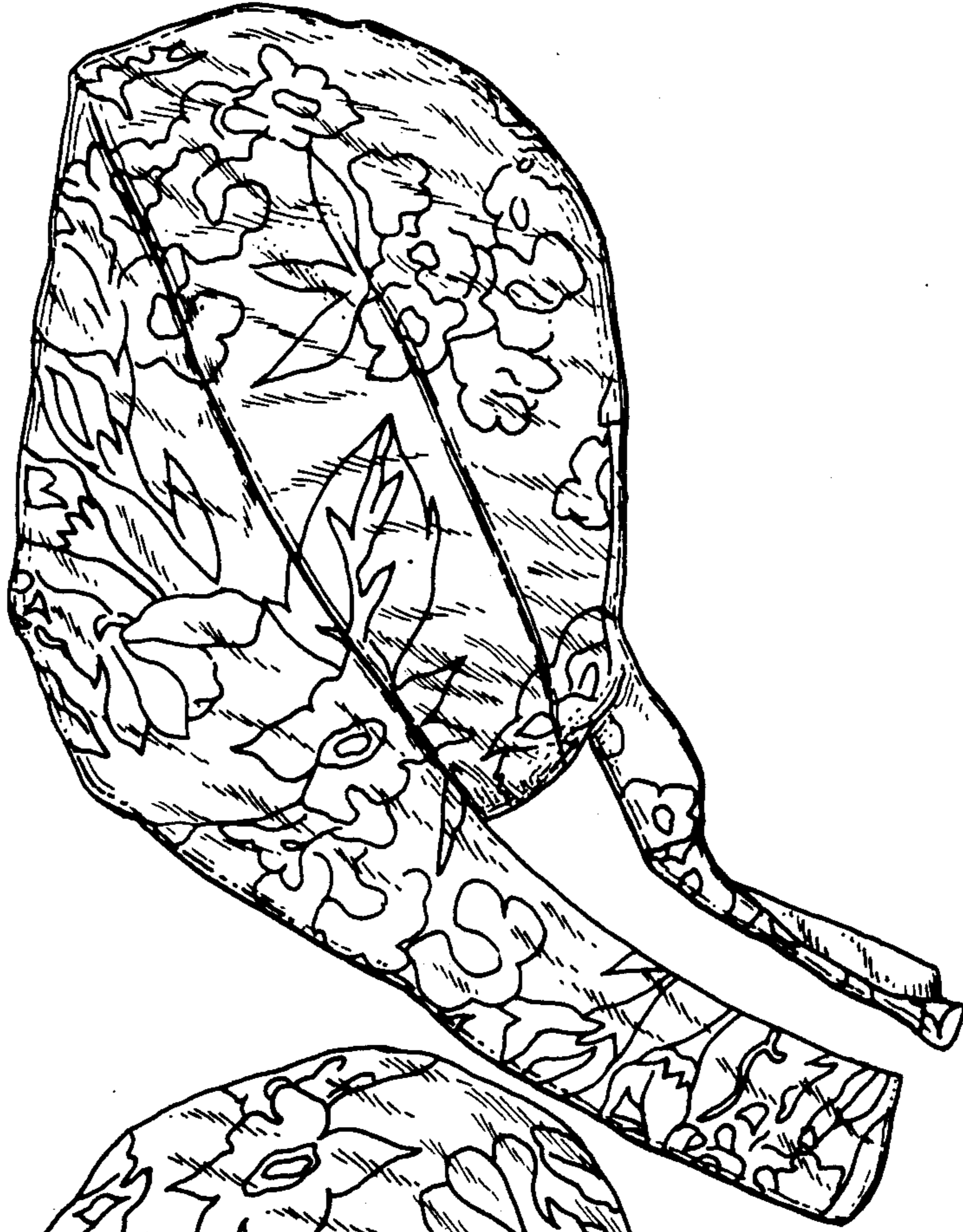
