CLAIM

The ornamental design for an alarm clock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an alarm clock showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof with the support legs in the folded position;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof with the support legs in the extended position;
FIG. 5 is a partial cross-sectional view taken from line V—V of FIG. 1.

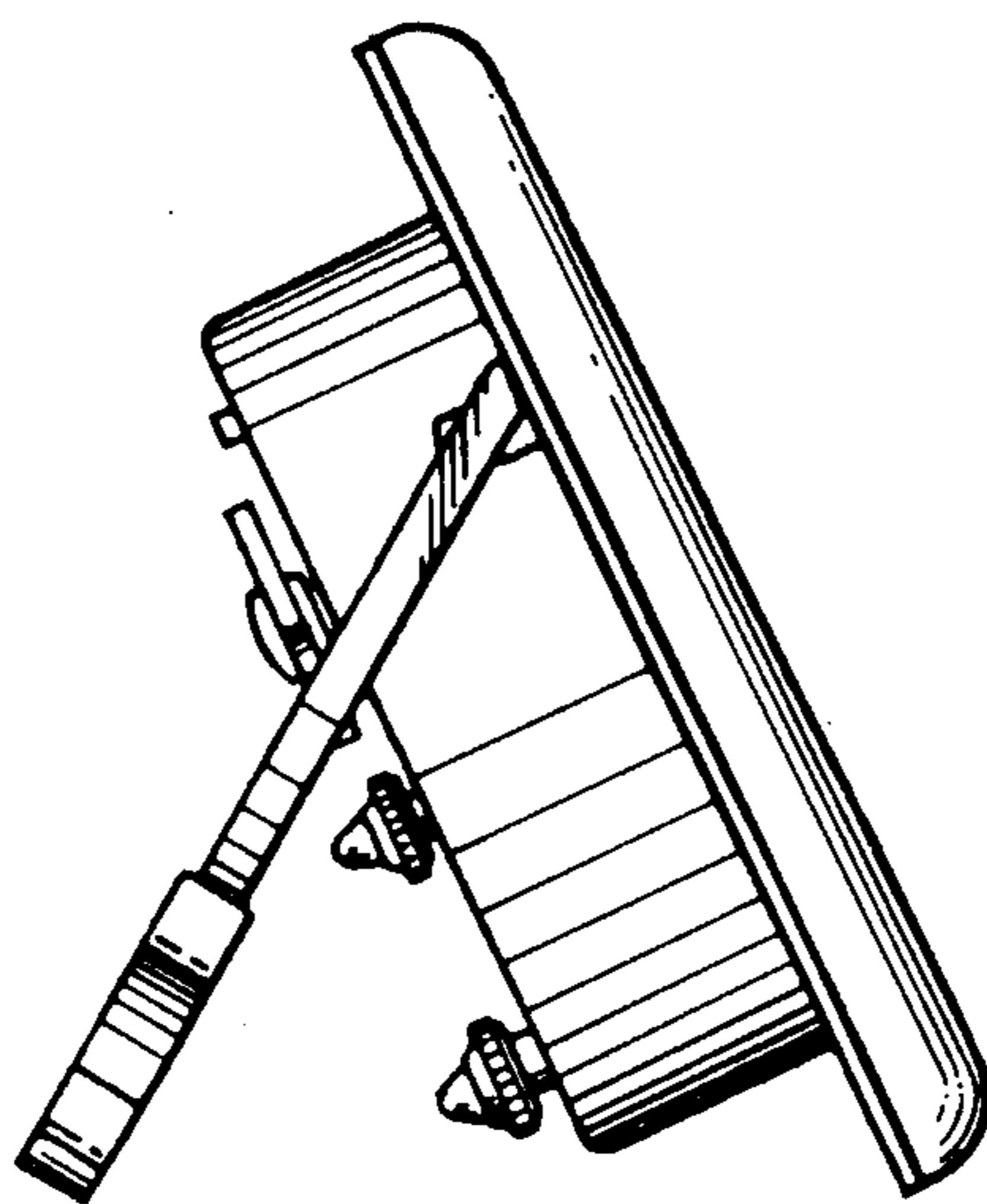

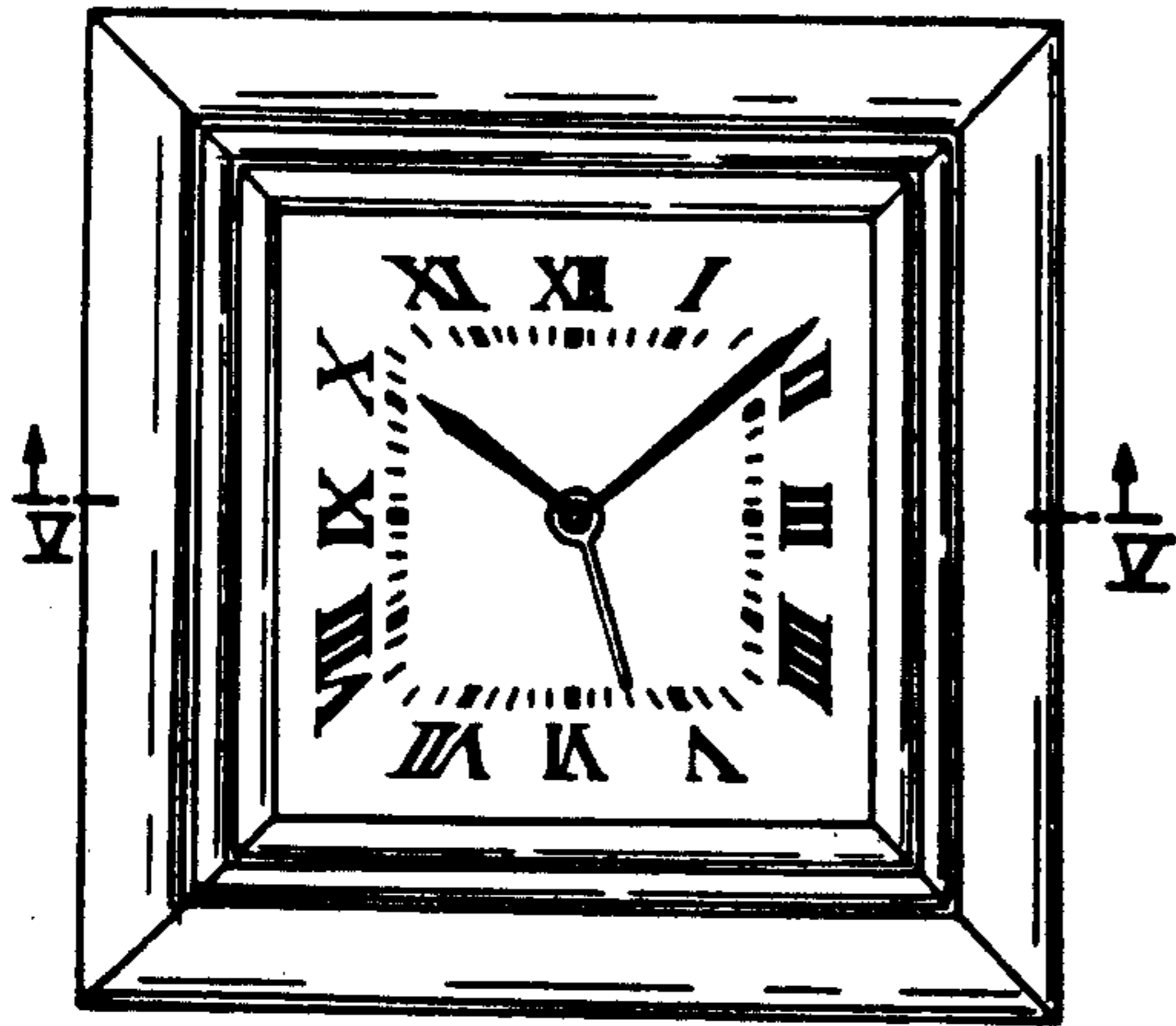

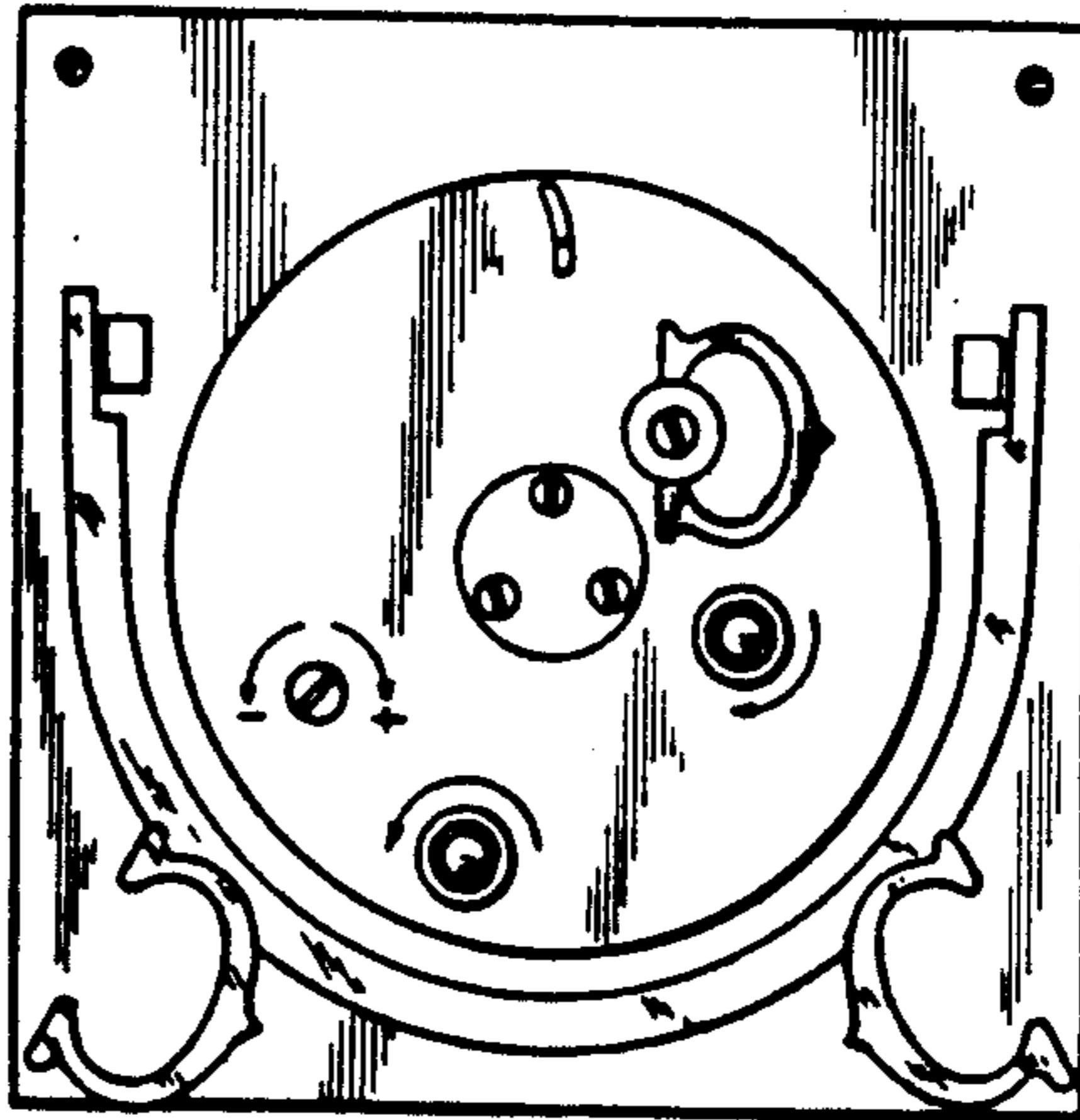

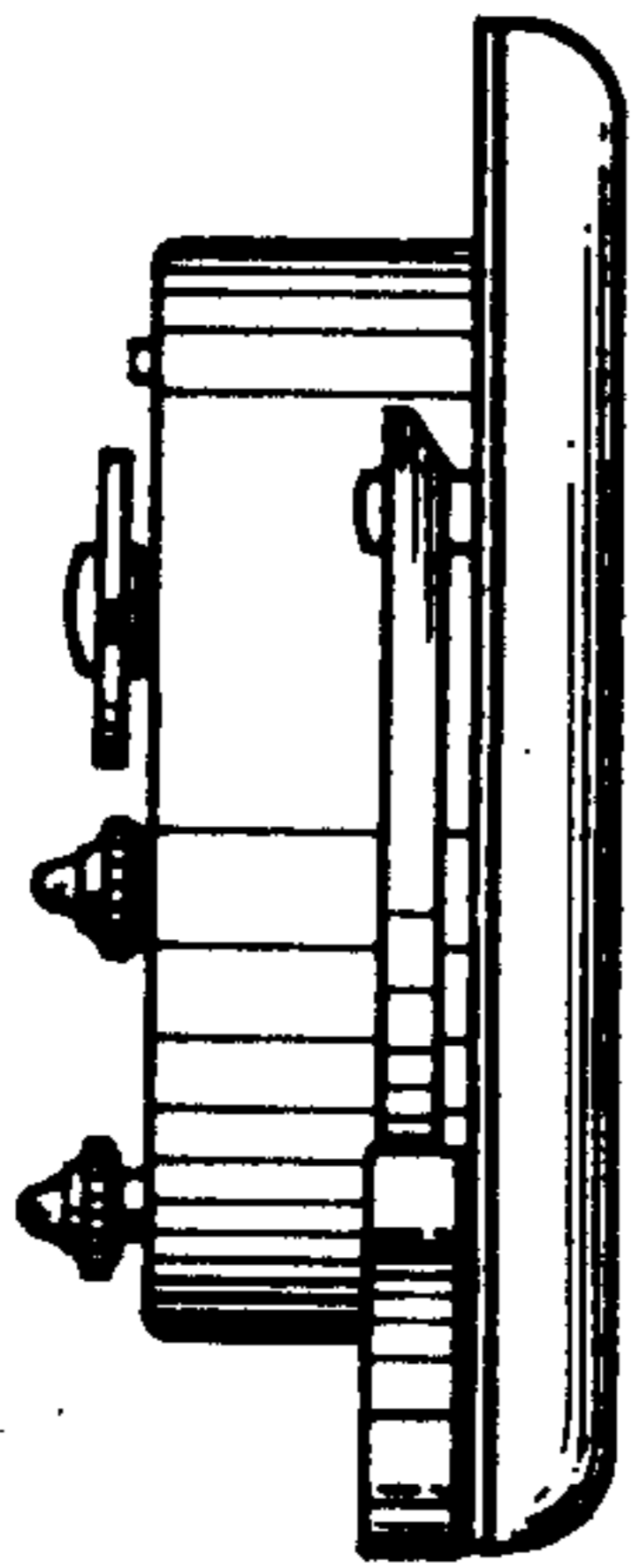

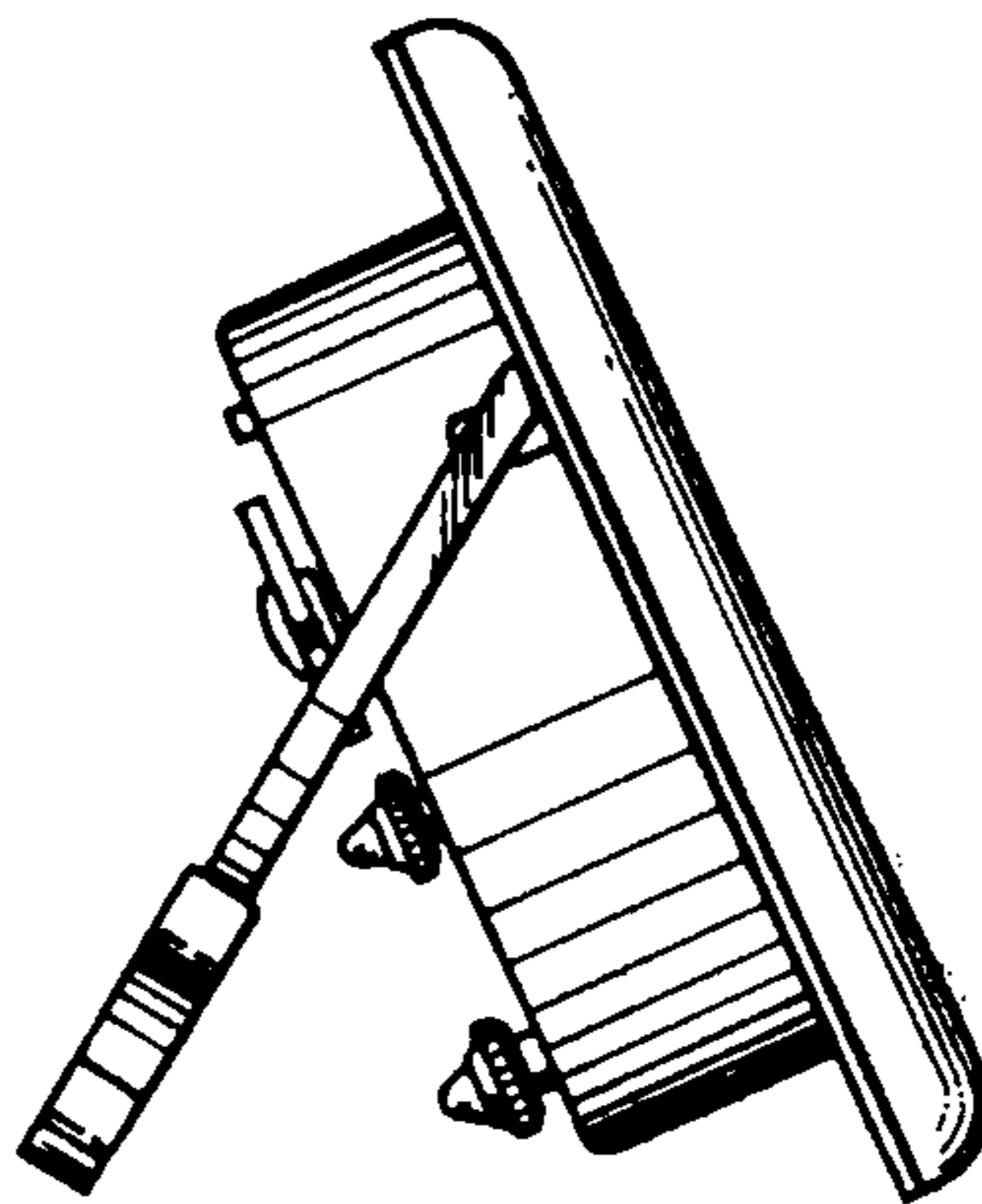
