[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a resilient shock absorber for boat docking lines or the like, substantially as shown and described herein.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a resilient shock absorber for boat docking lines or the like, showing my new design, the boat line being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof on an enlarged scale.
