[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a vial suitable for pharmaceuticals, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a vial suitable for pharmaceuticals showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of one embodiment of the vial suitable for pharmaceuticals shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the vial suitable for pharmaceuticals; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment of the vial suitable for pharmaceuticals shown in FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of another embodiment of the vial suitable for pharmaceuticals shown in FIG. 1; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment of the vial suitable for pharmaceuticals shown in FIG. 5.
