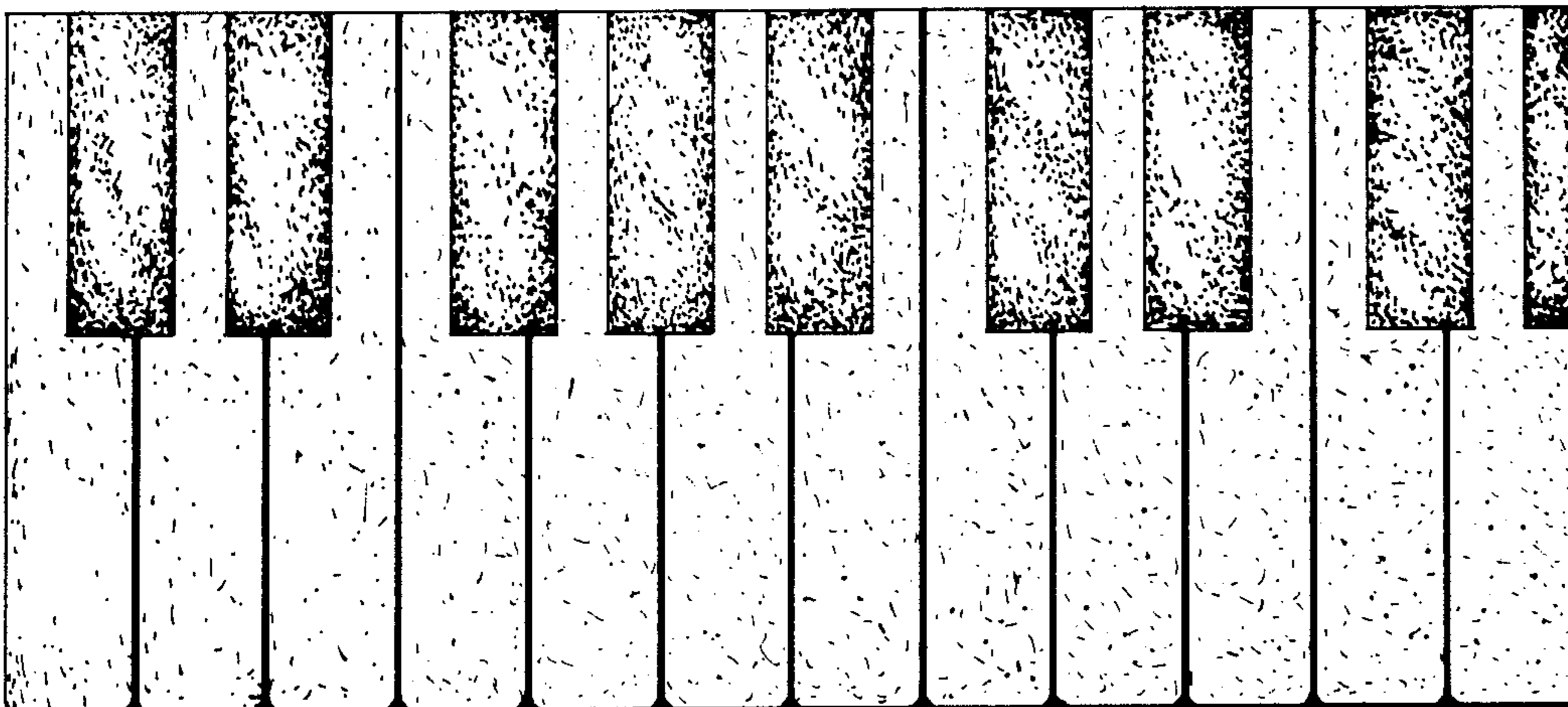
CLAIM

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.



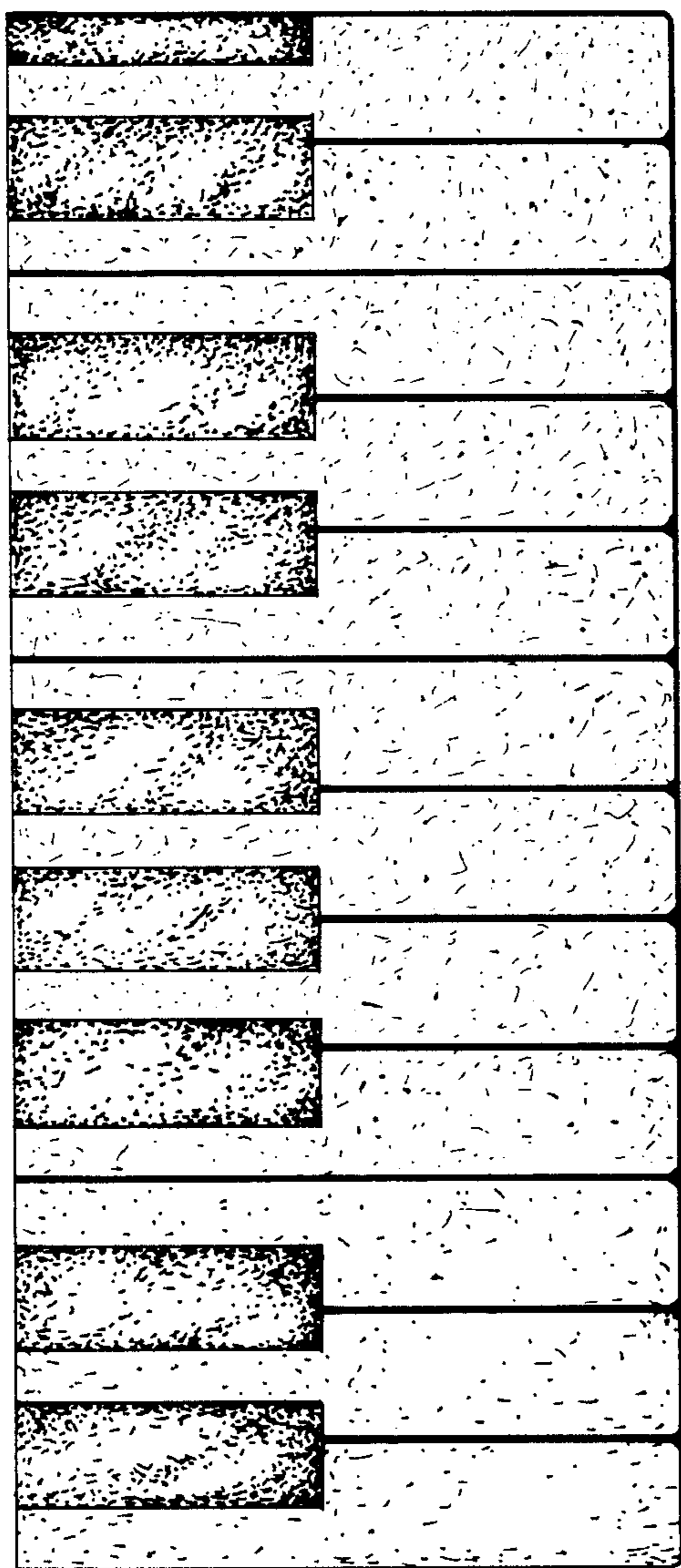
