The ornamental design for an inspection mirror for automobiles or the like, as shown and described.

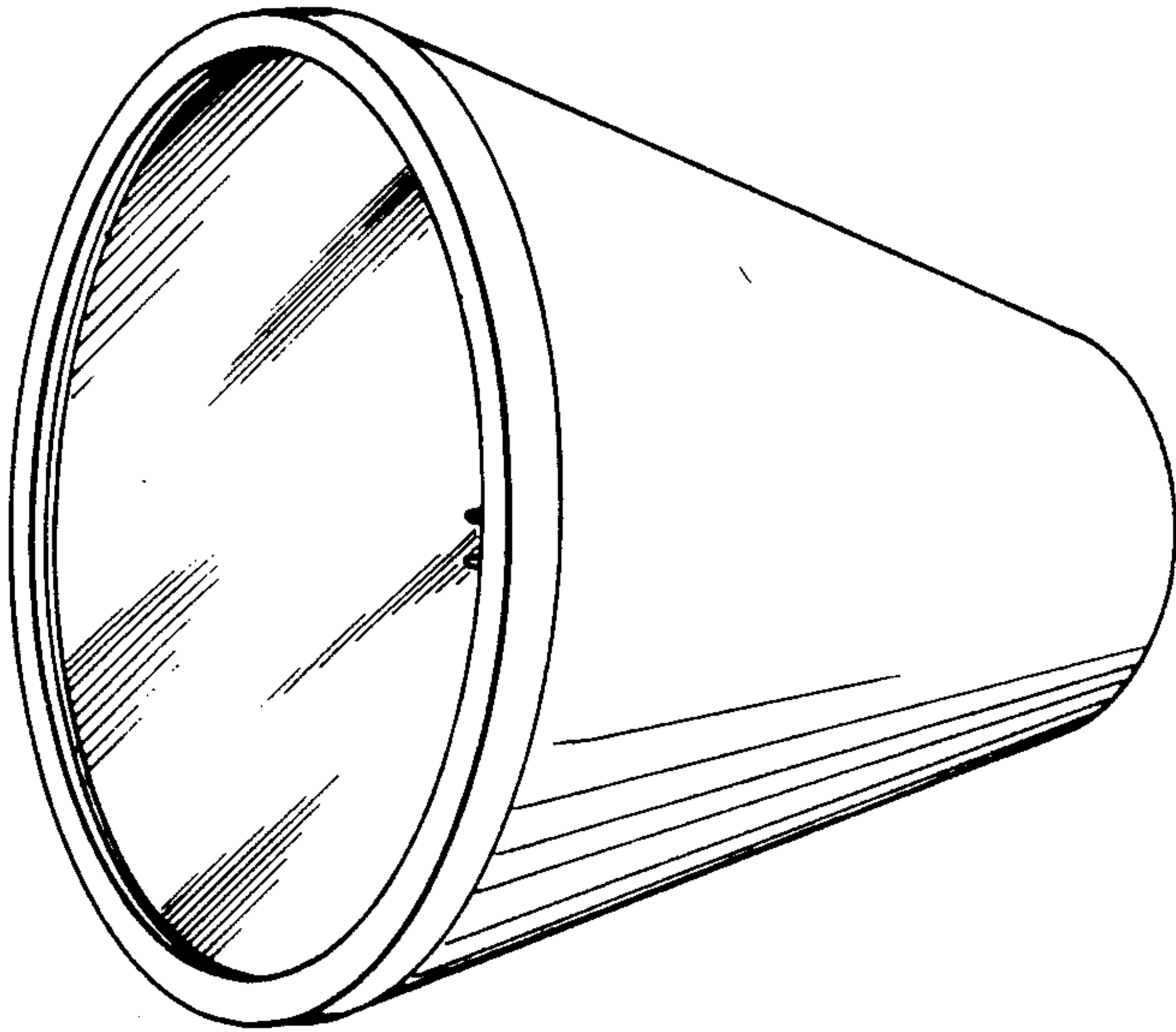
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1.



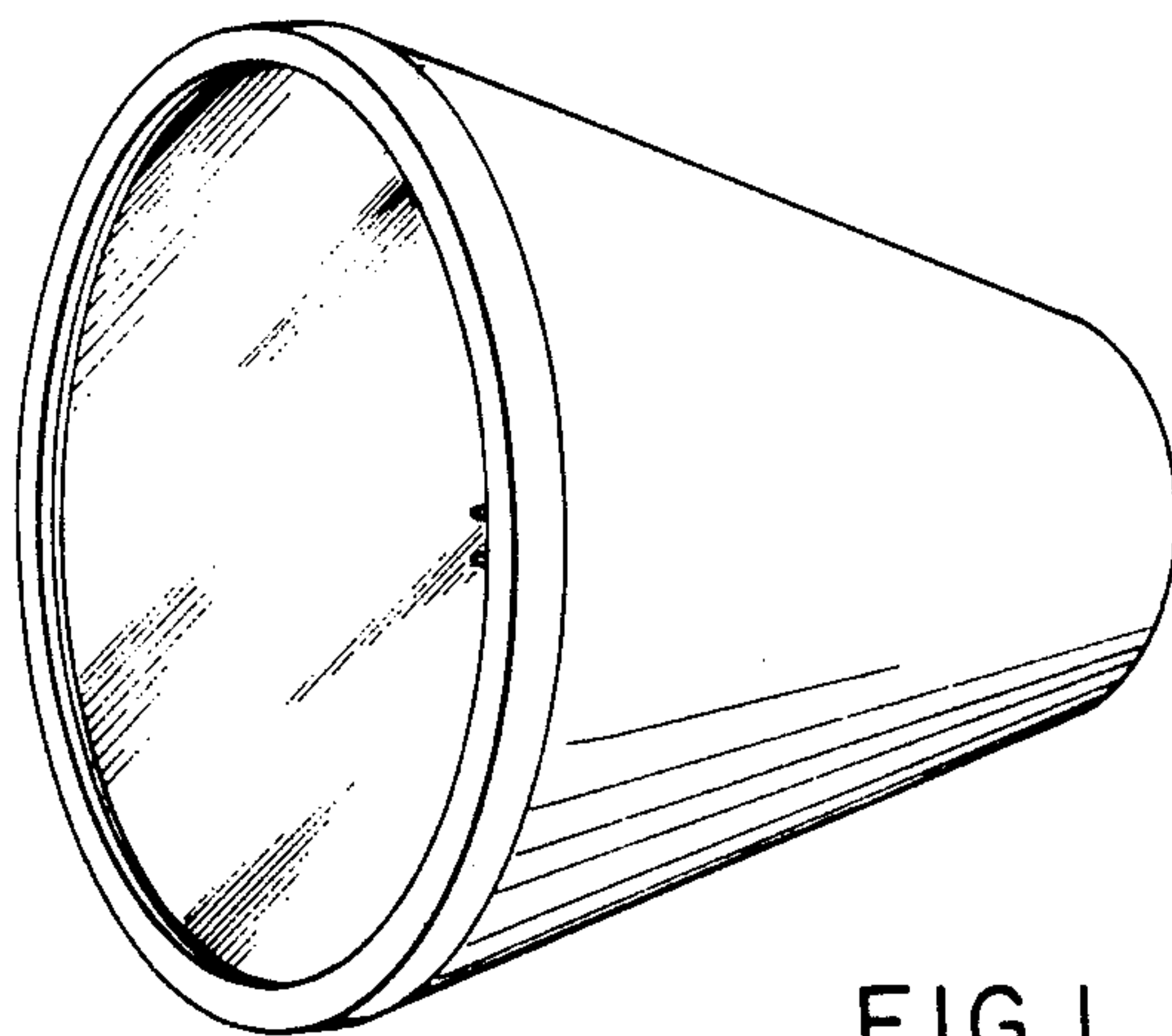

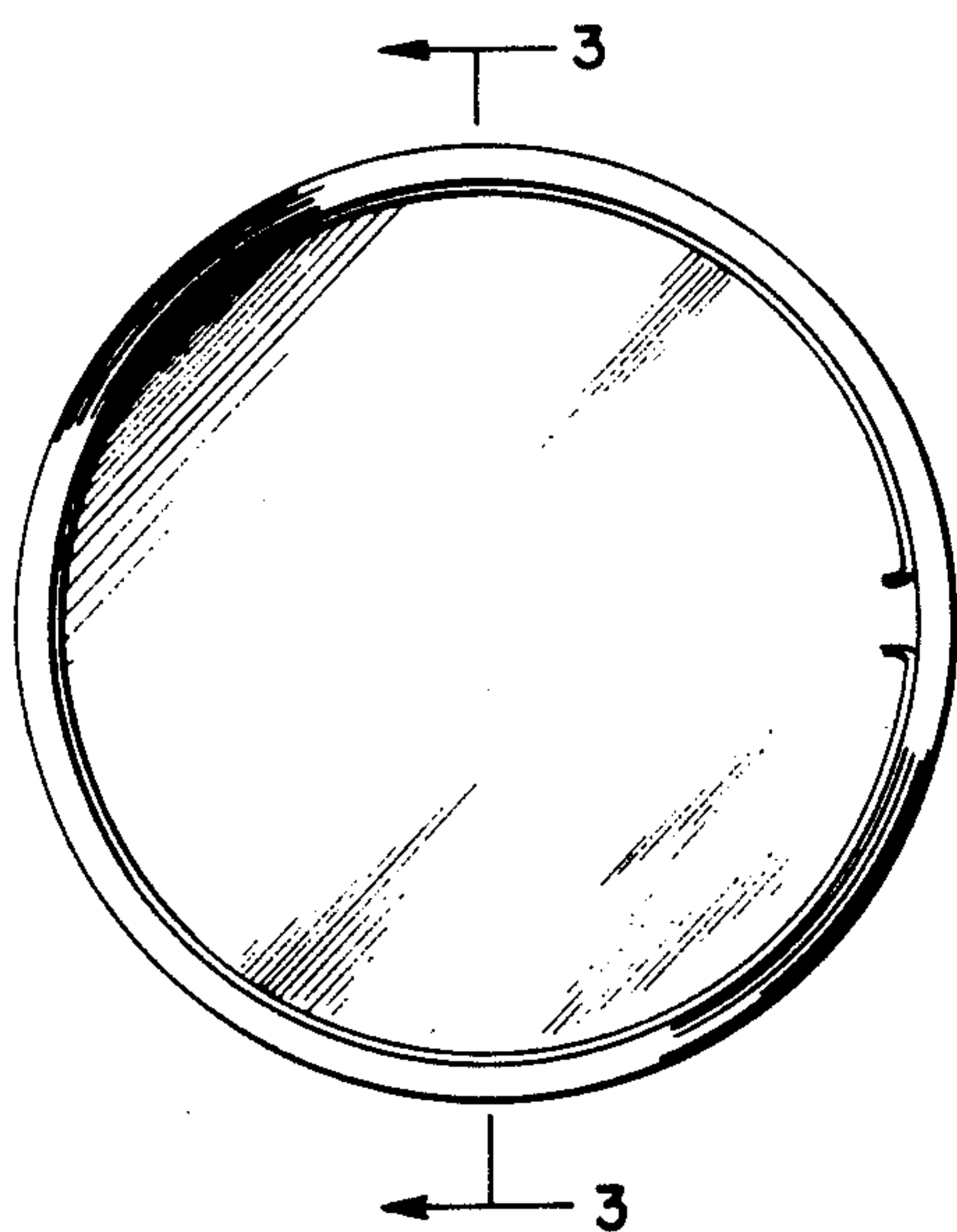

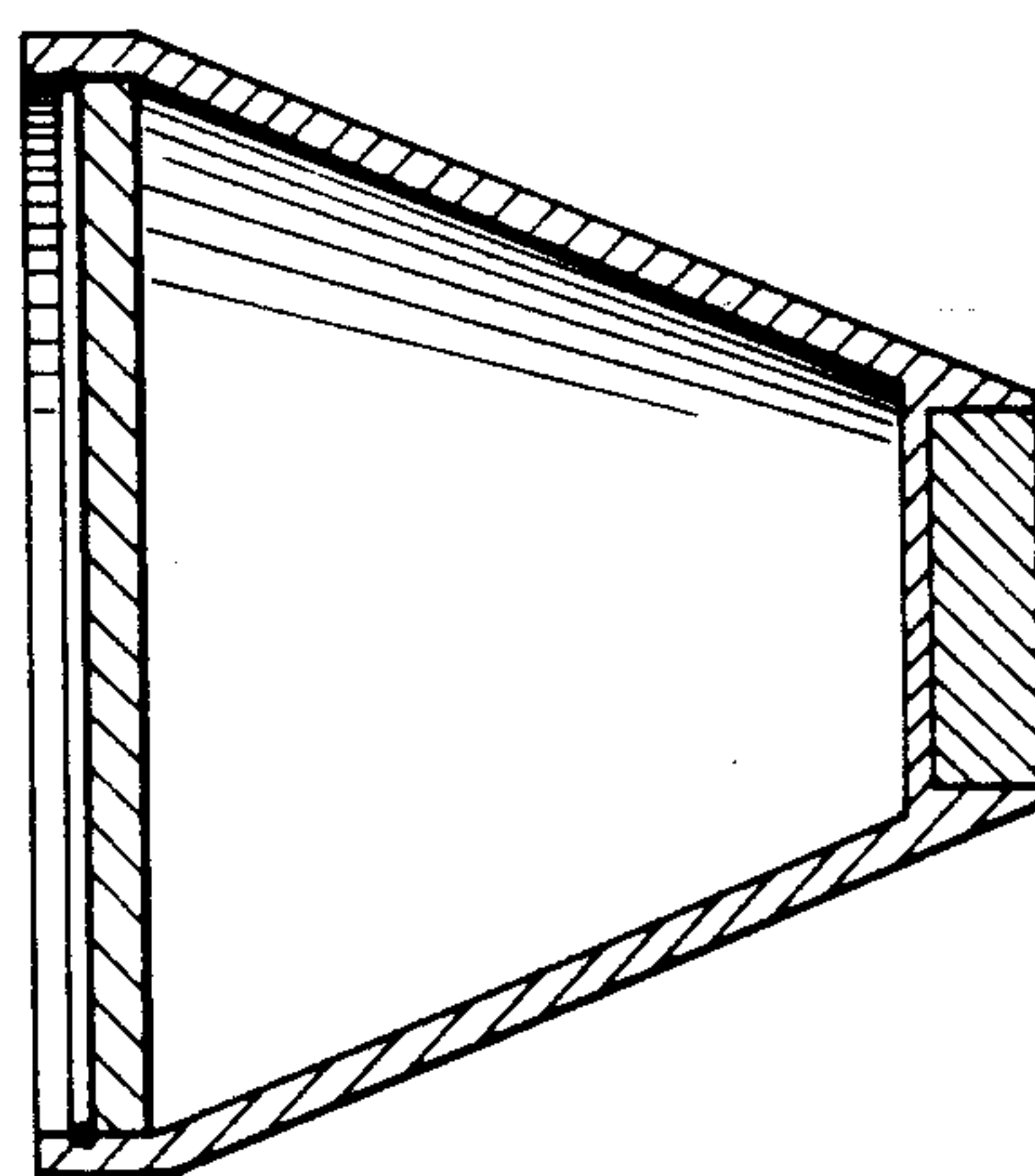

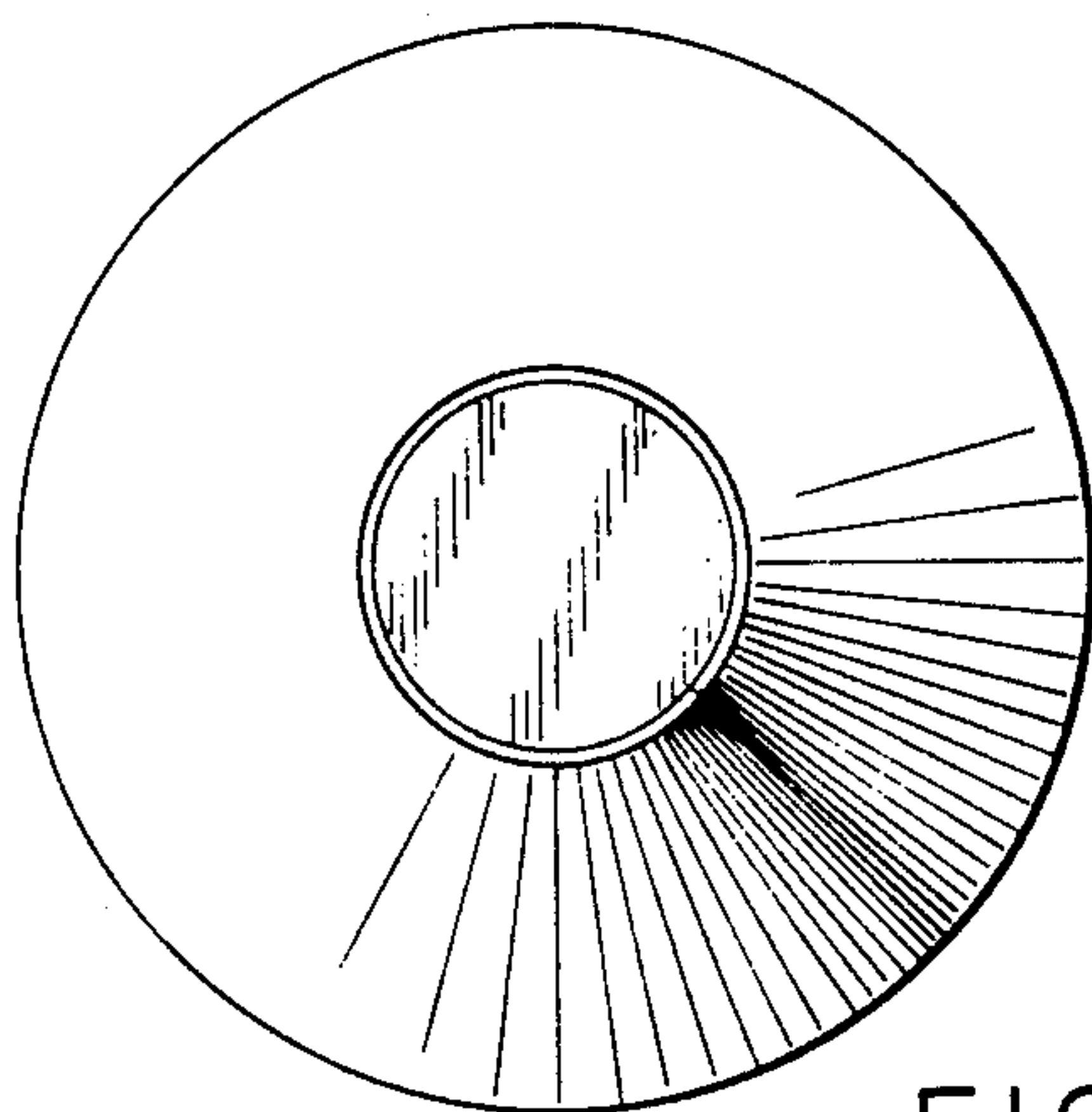
