FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the electronic baseball game casing showing our new design.

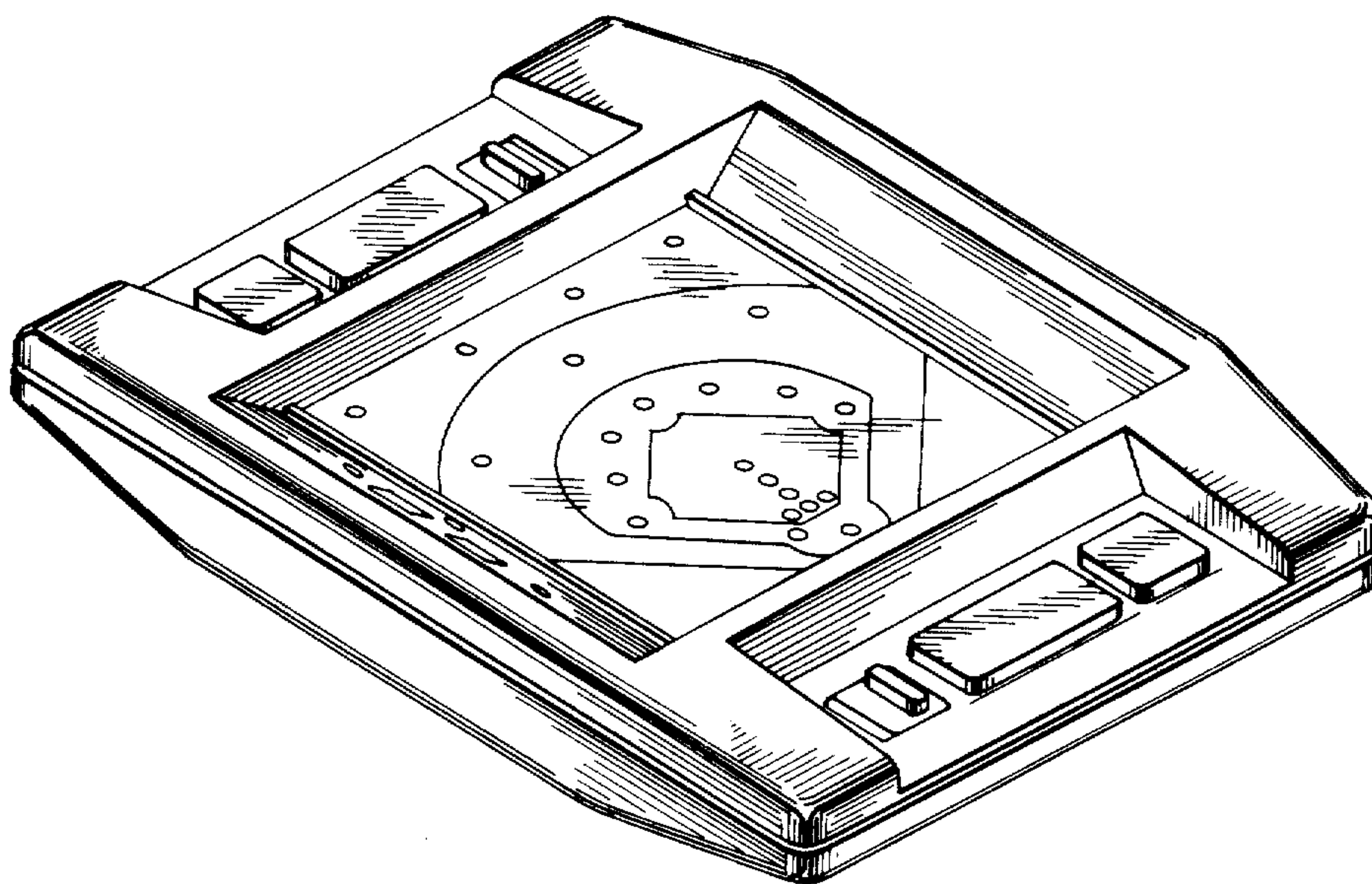
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



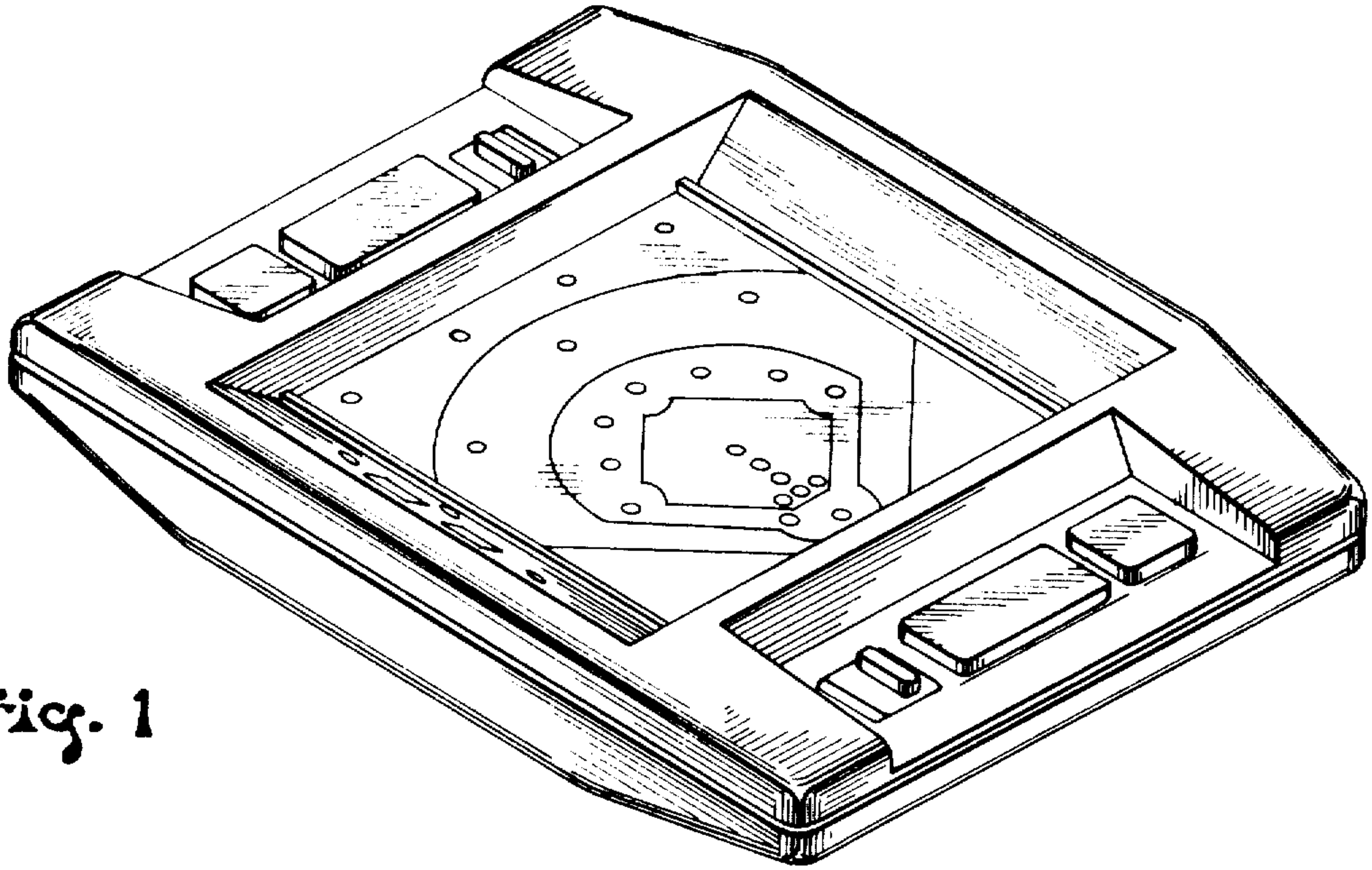

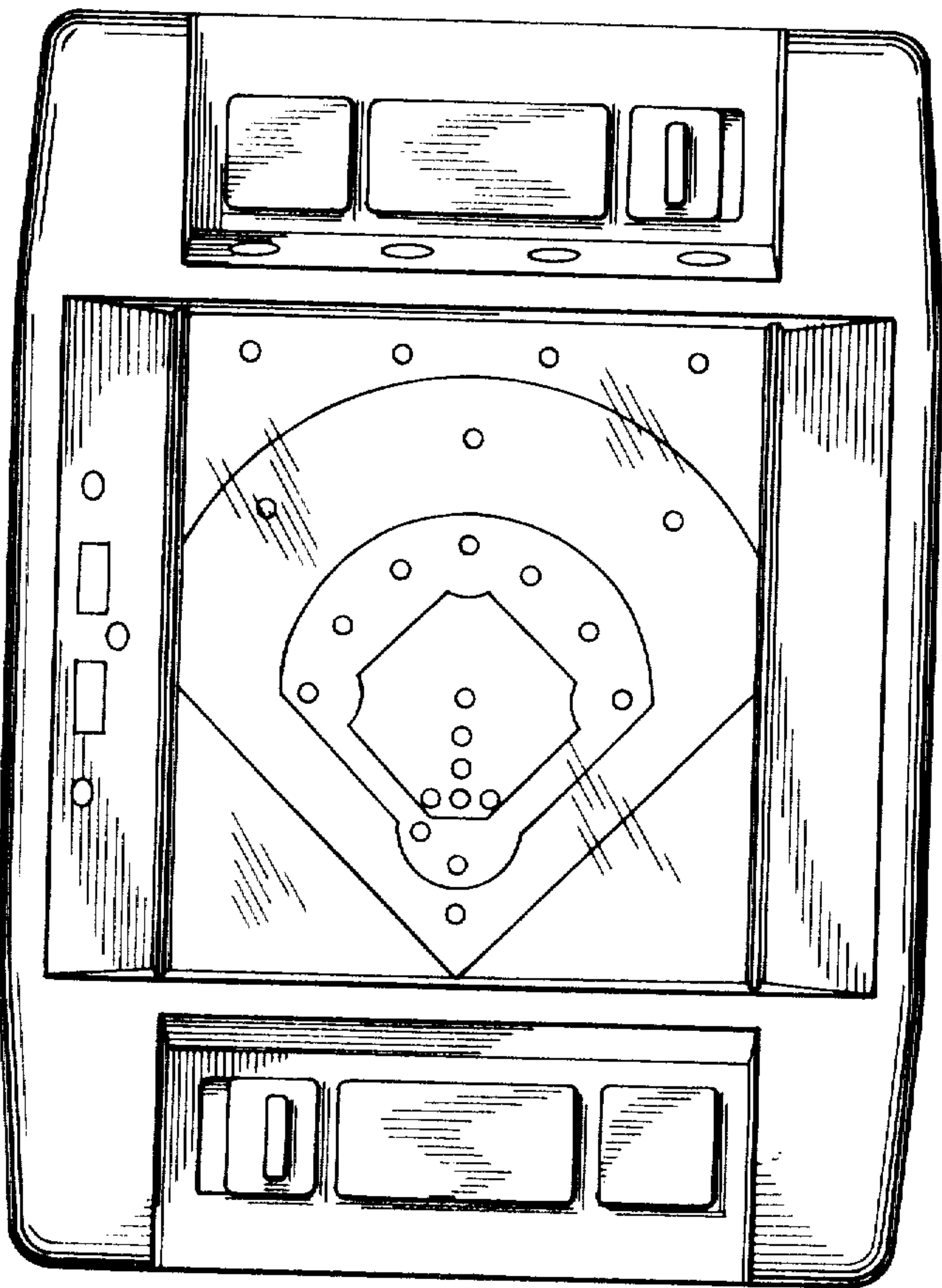

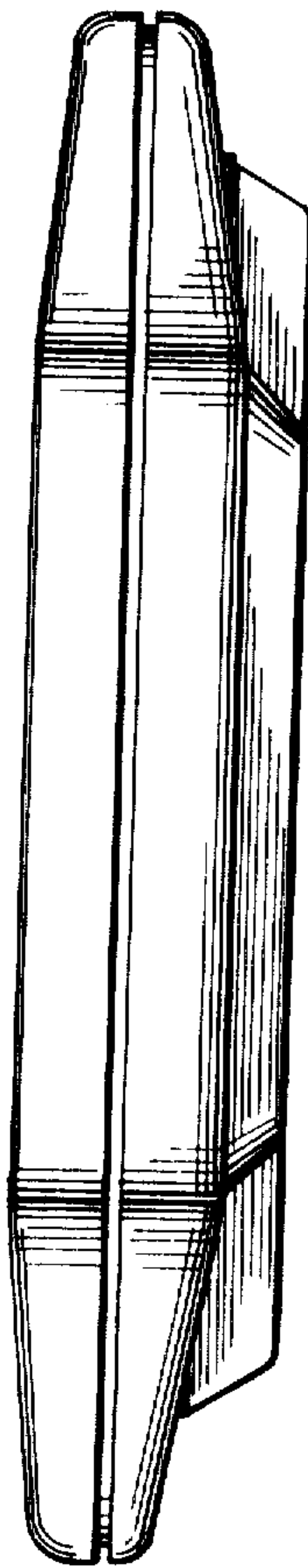

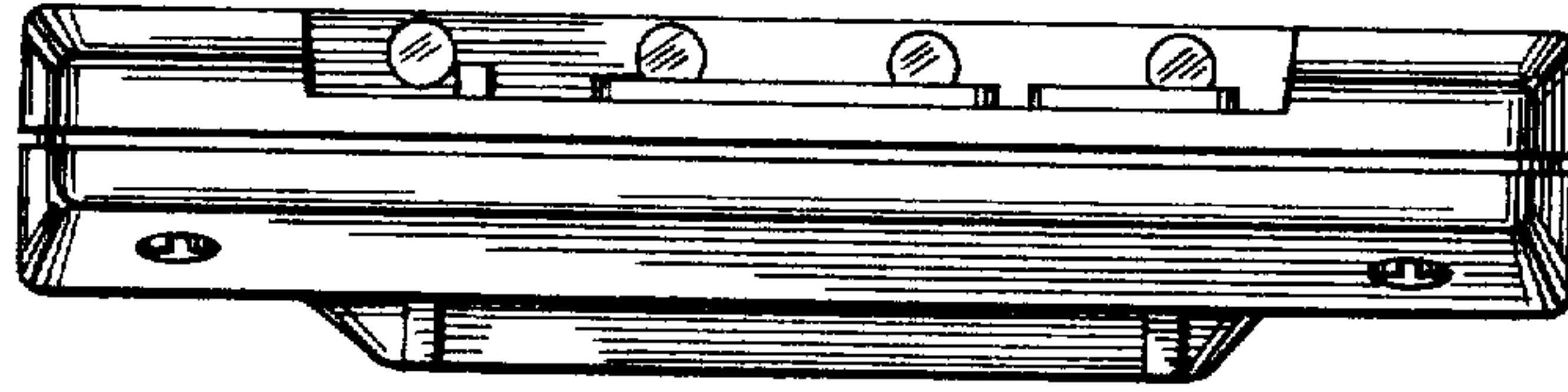

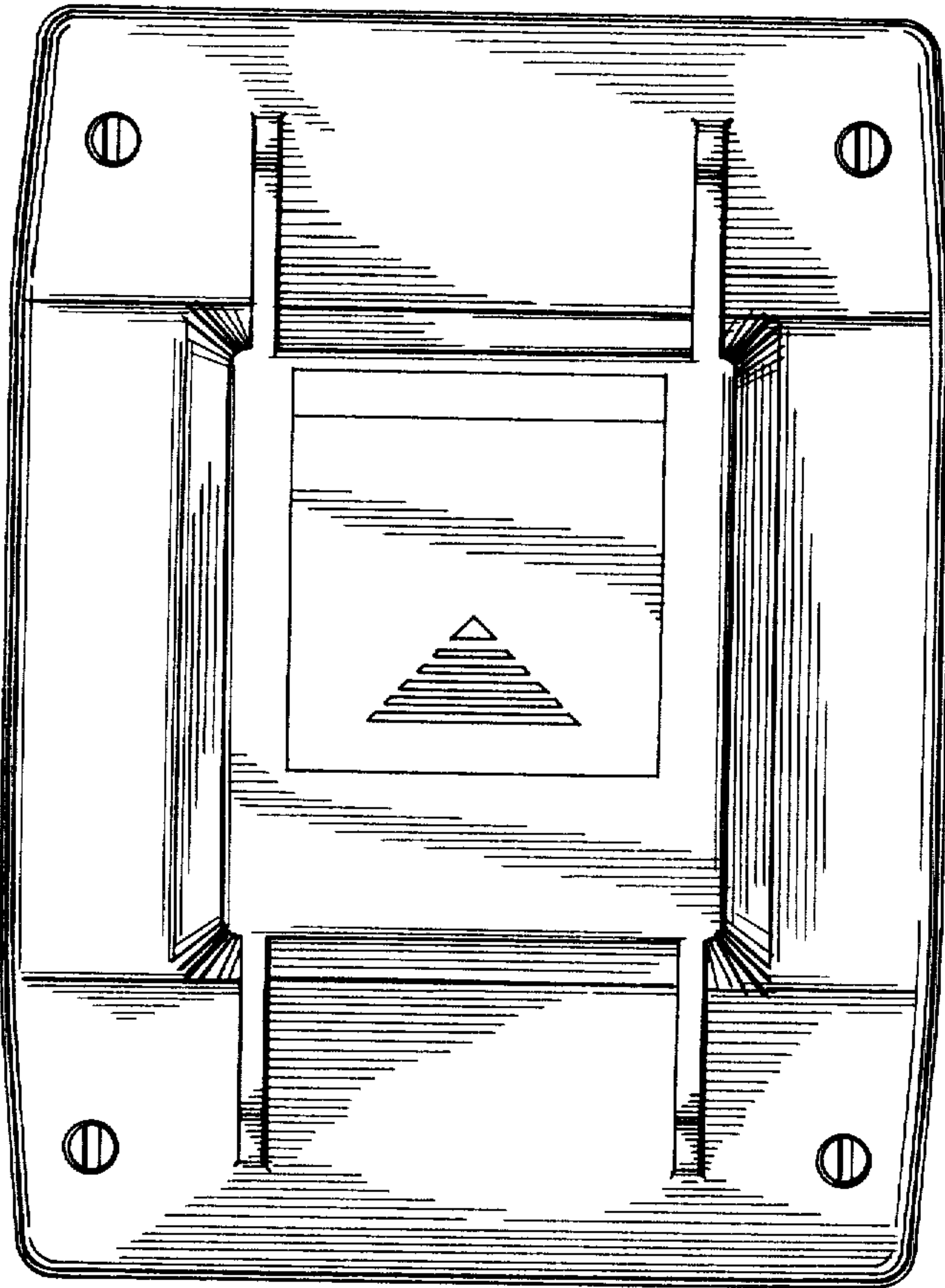

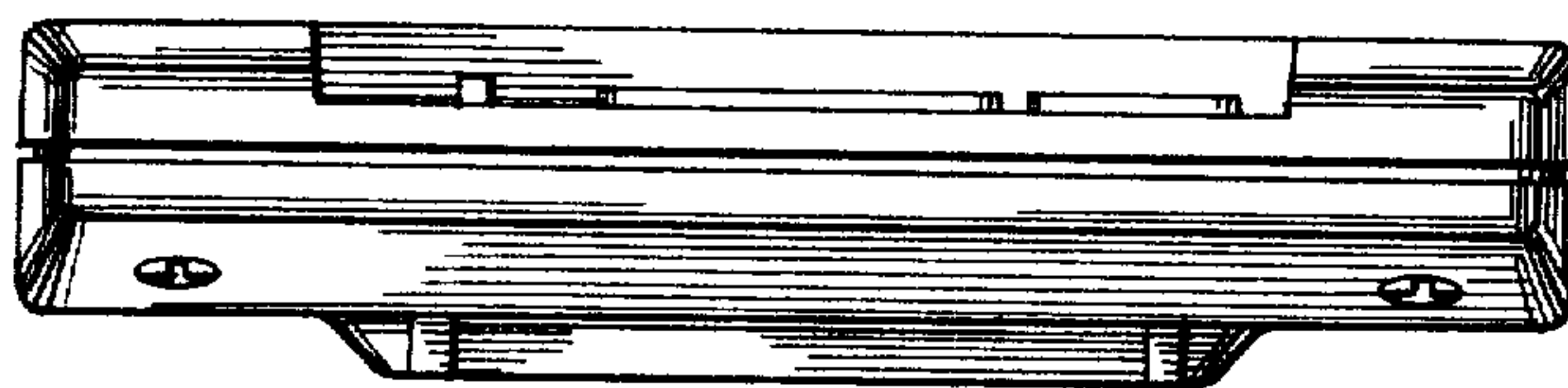
