[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electronic pinball game housing, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an electronic pinball game housing showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side perspective view showing the bottom thereof; the left side being a mirror image of the right side;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view showing the bottom thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

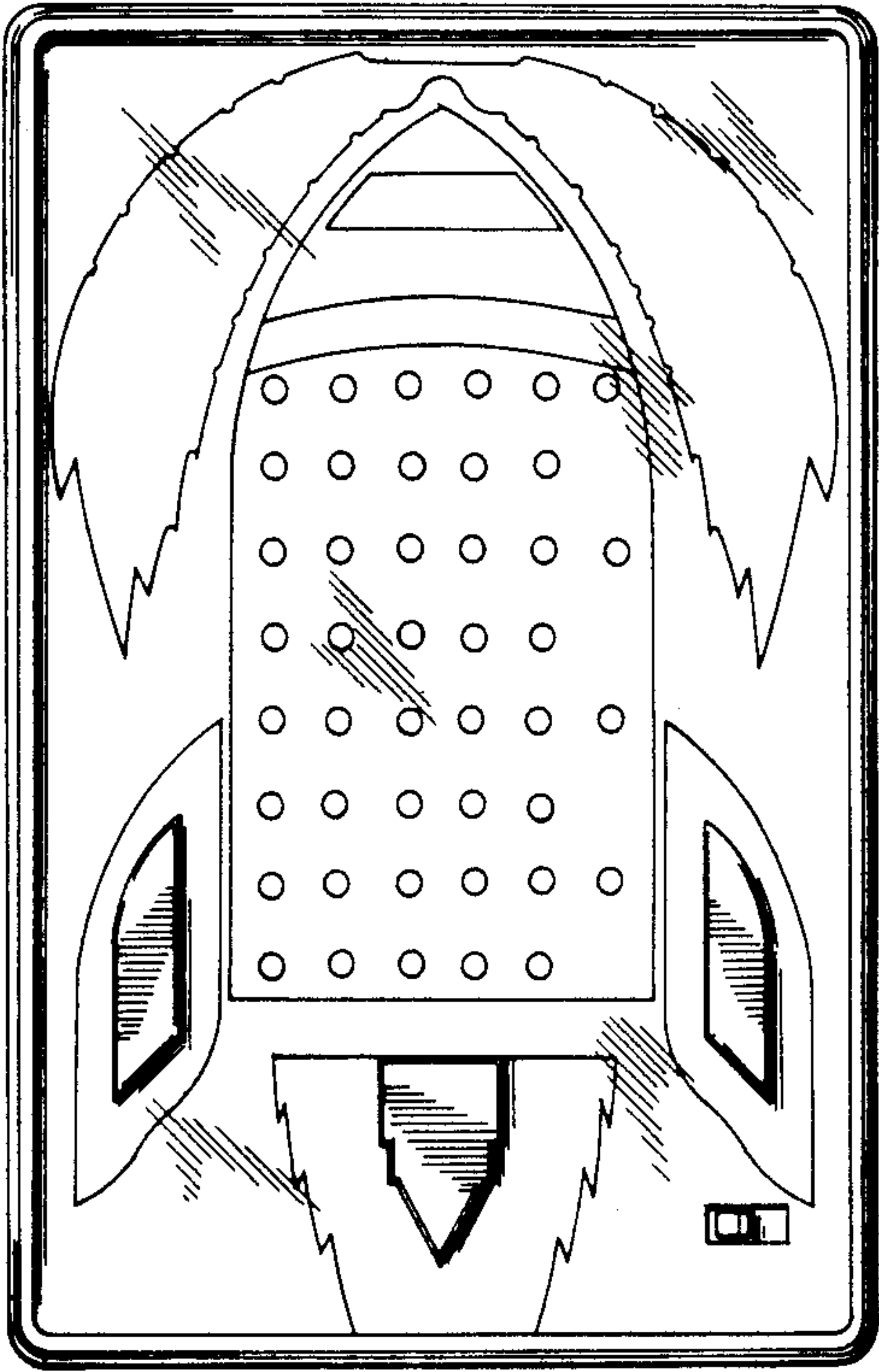

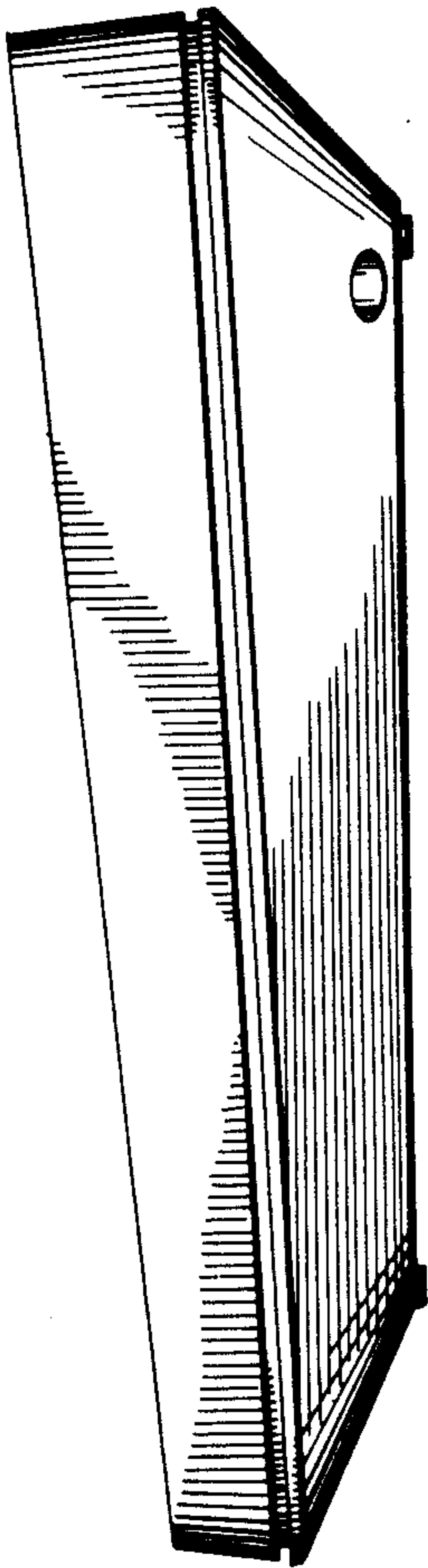
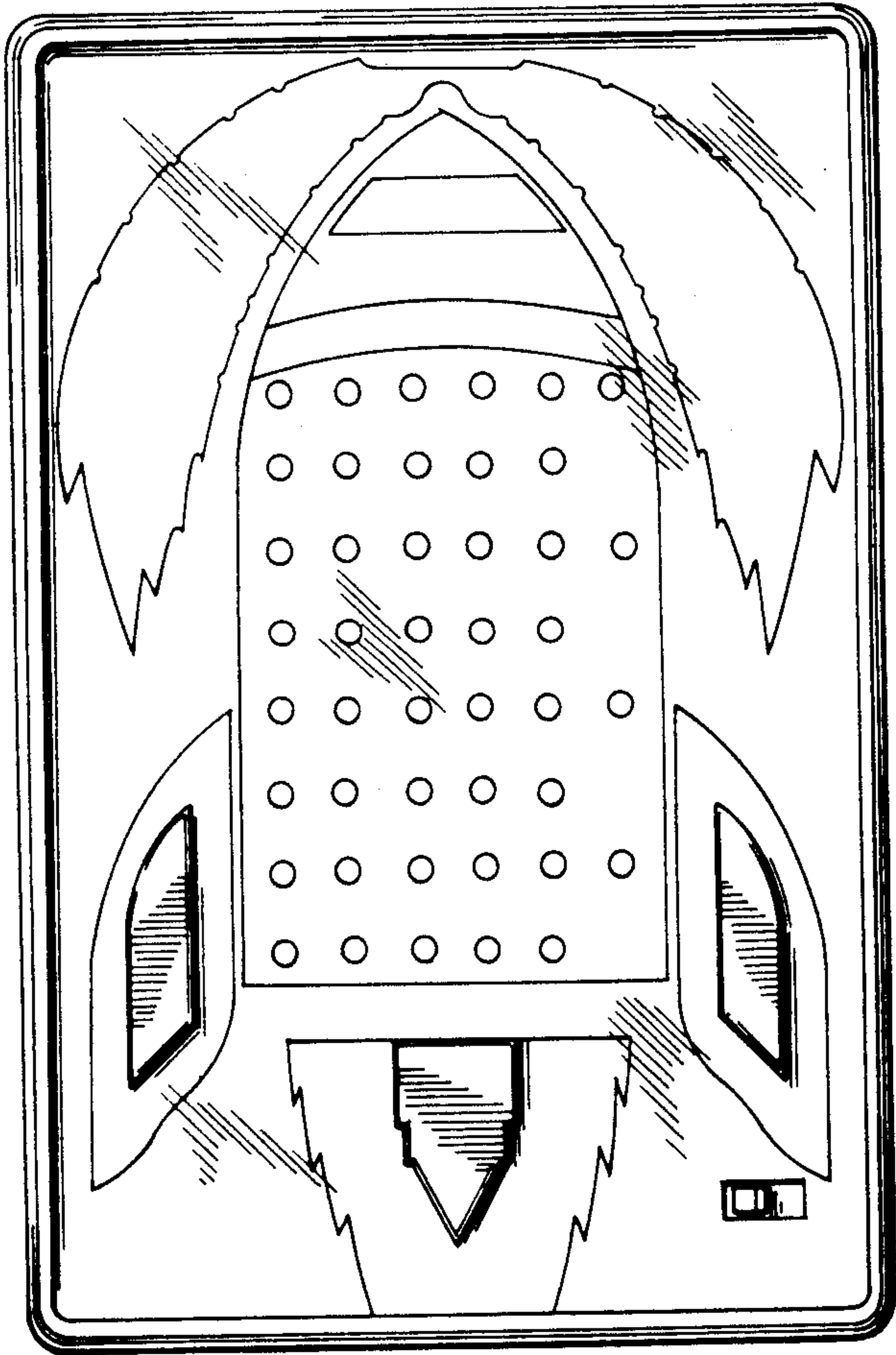

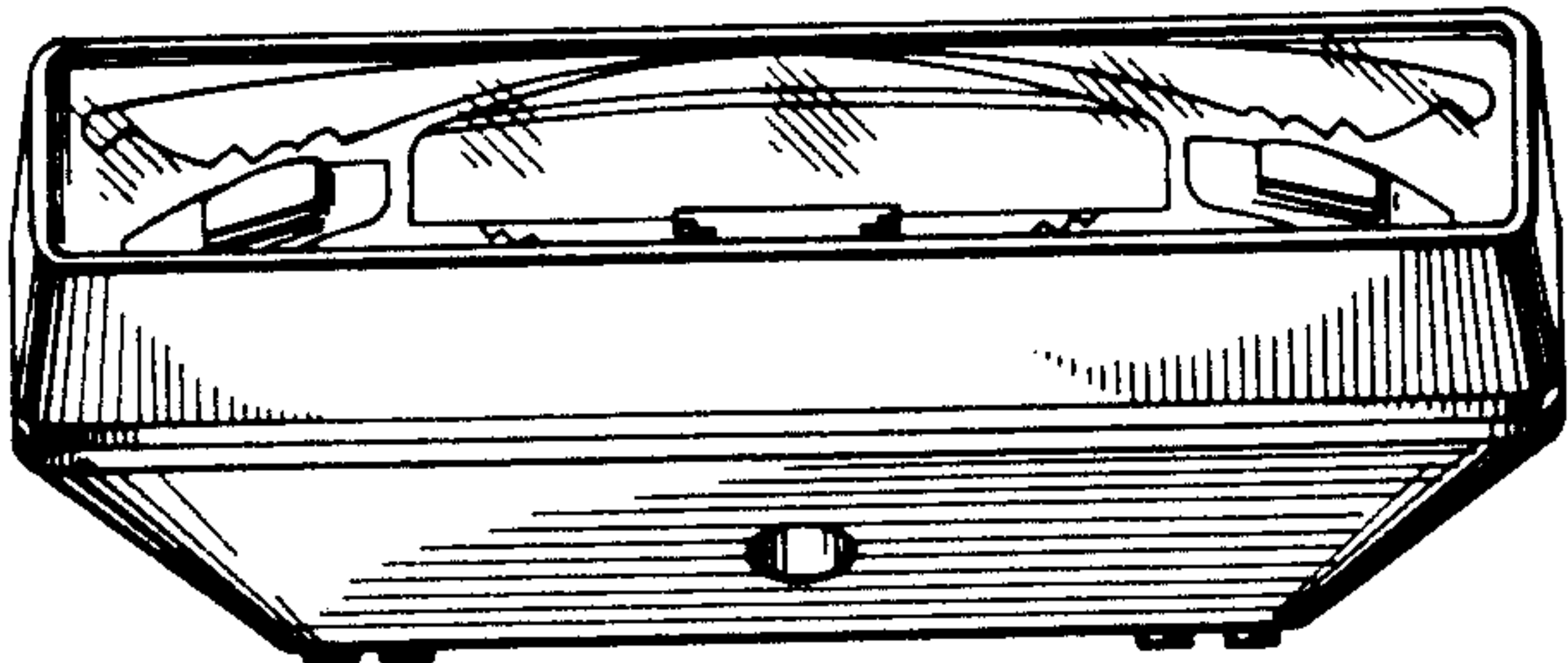

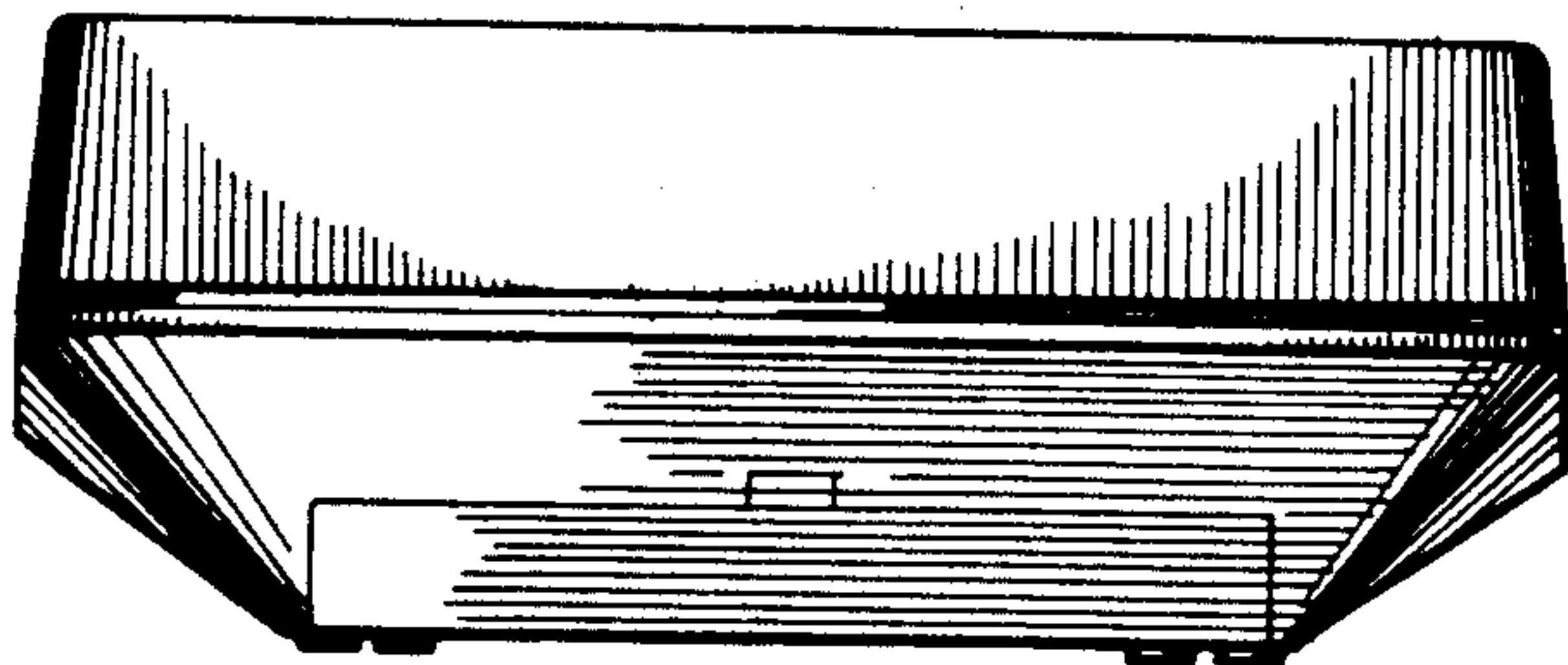

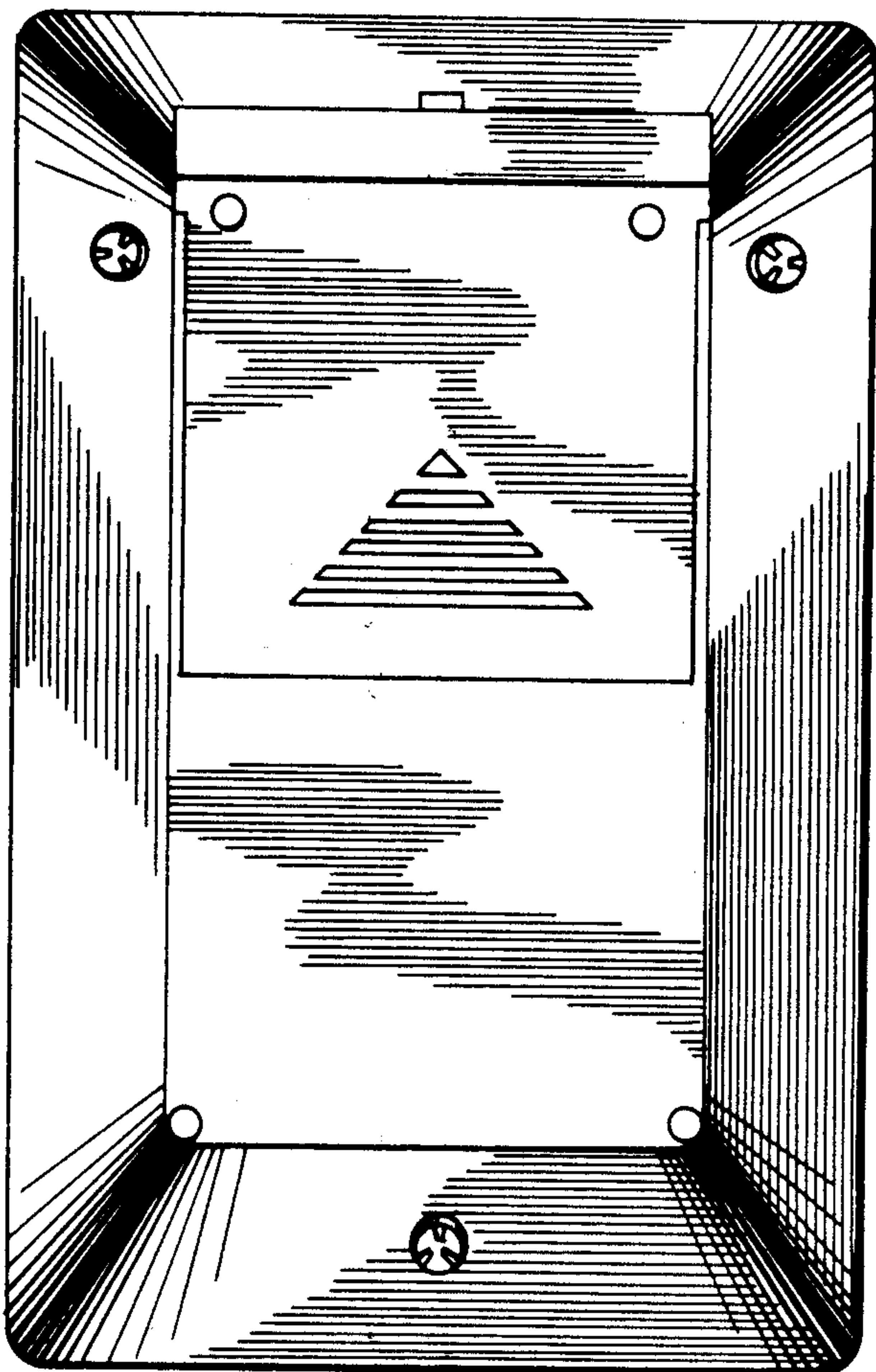
