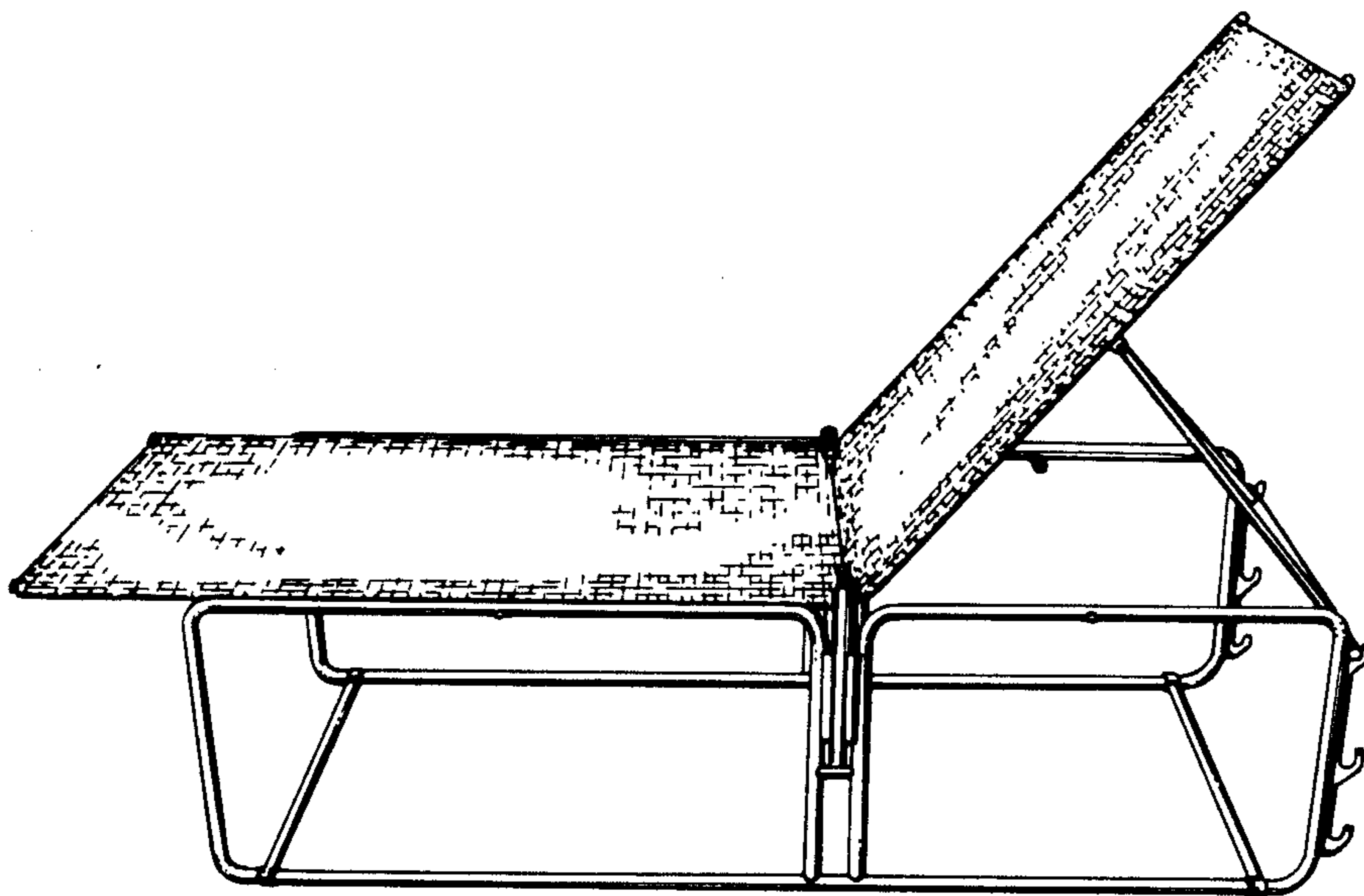

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation of the sun bench.



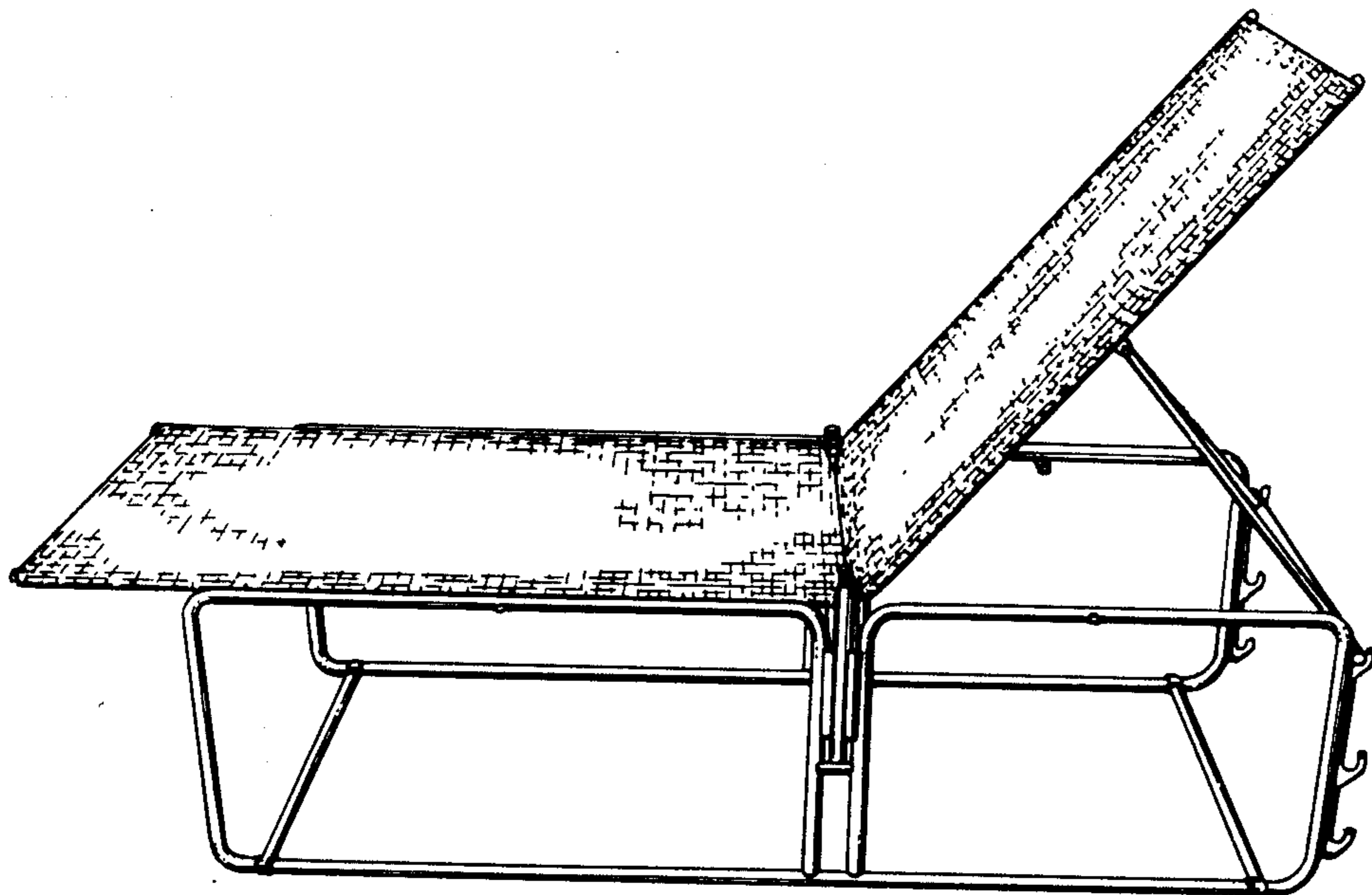

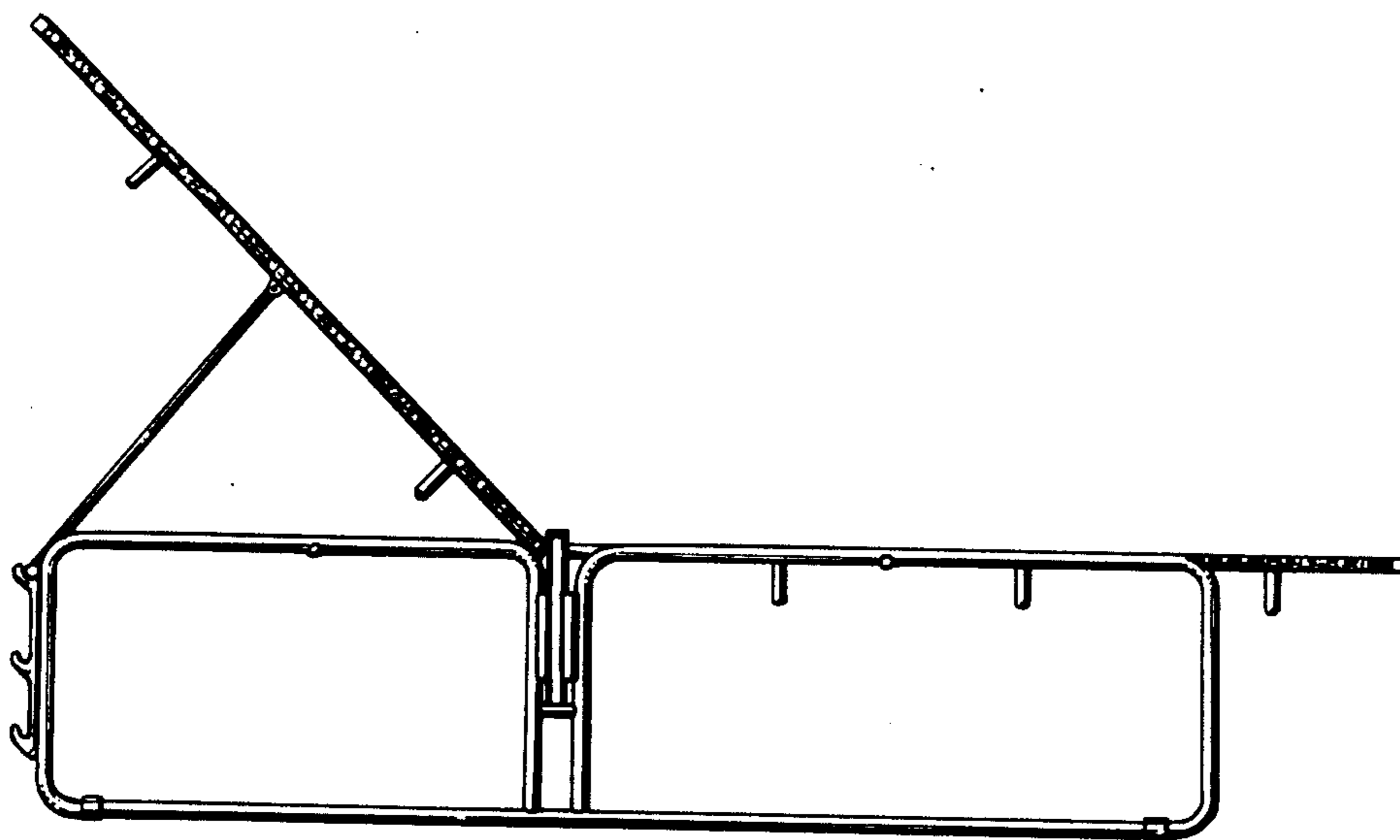

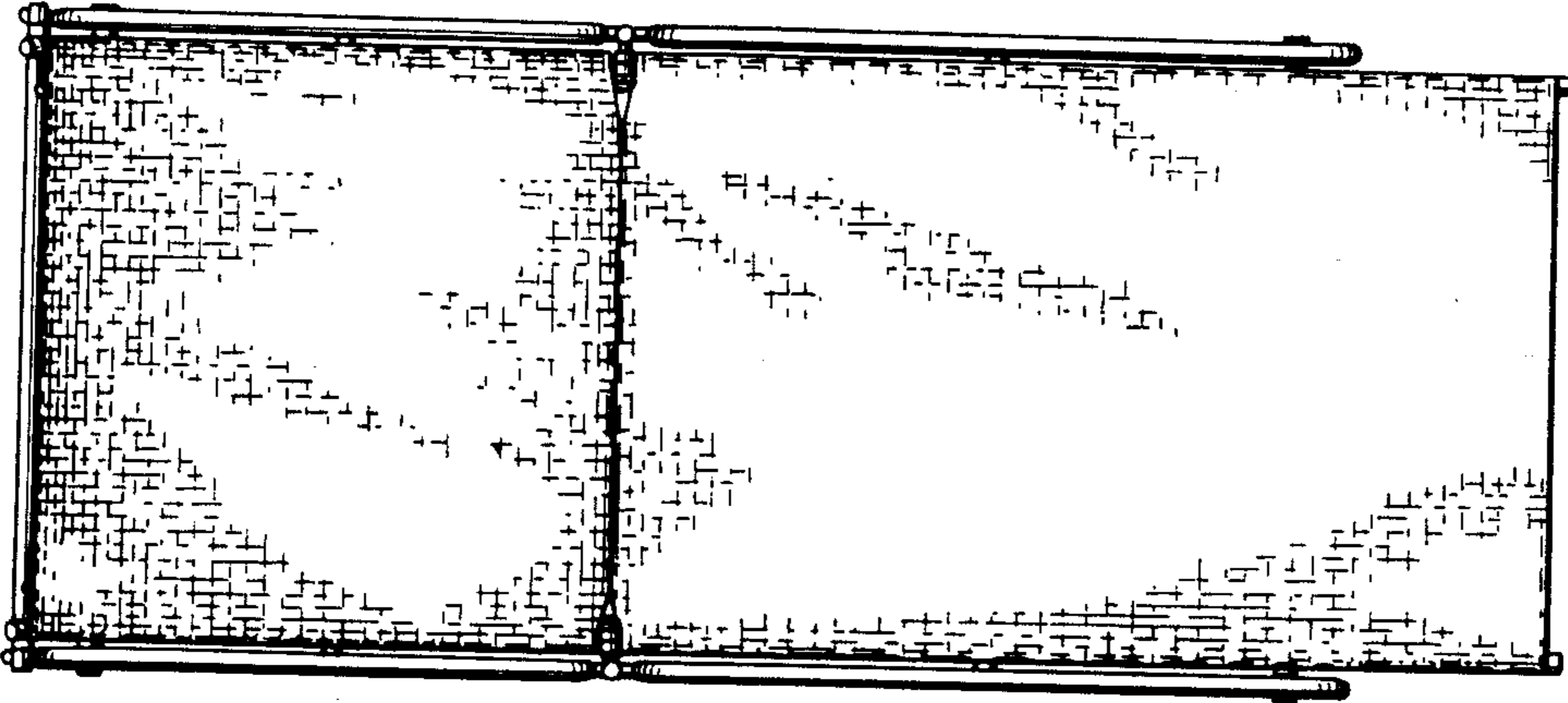

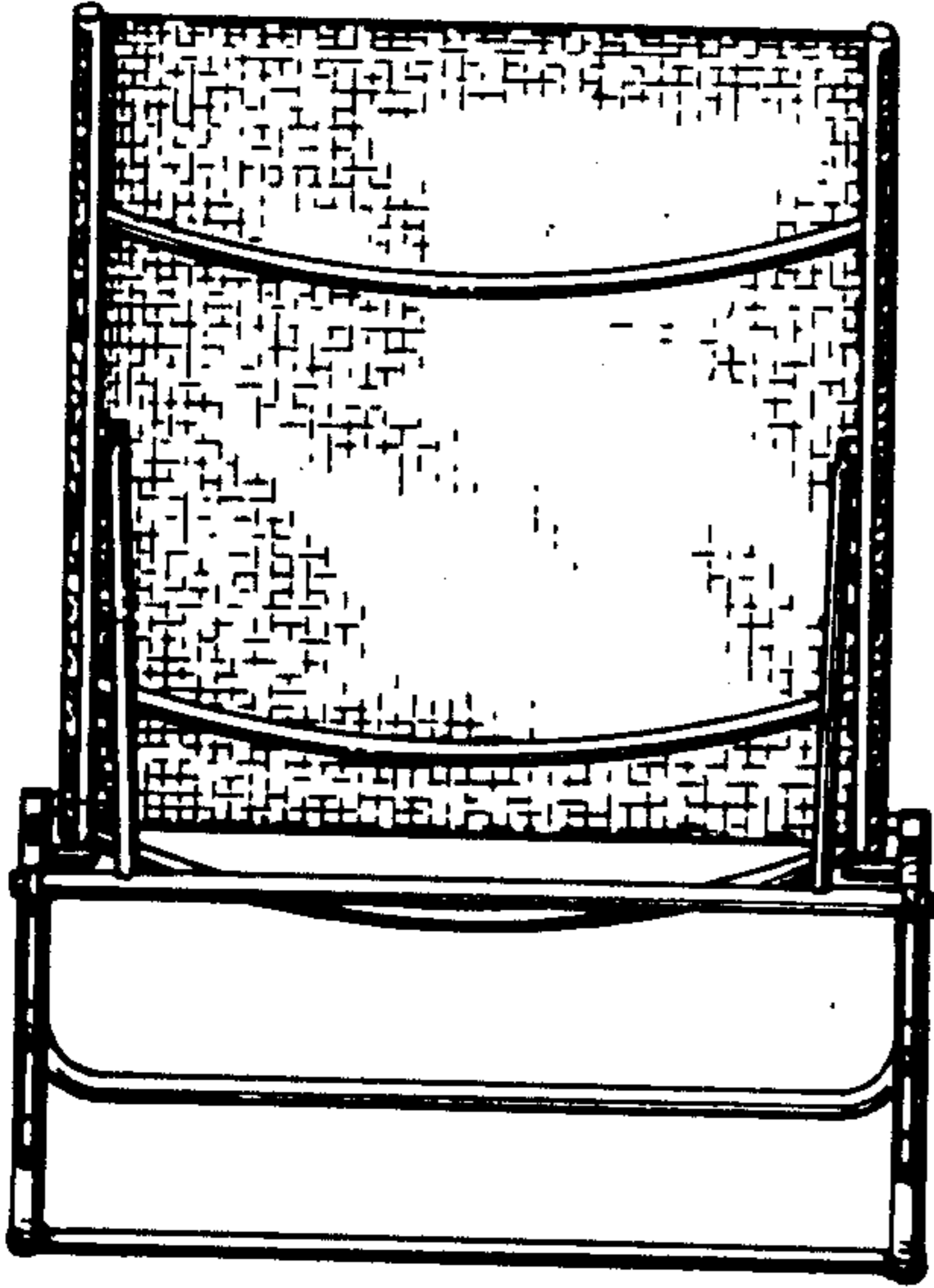

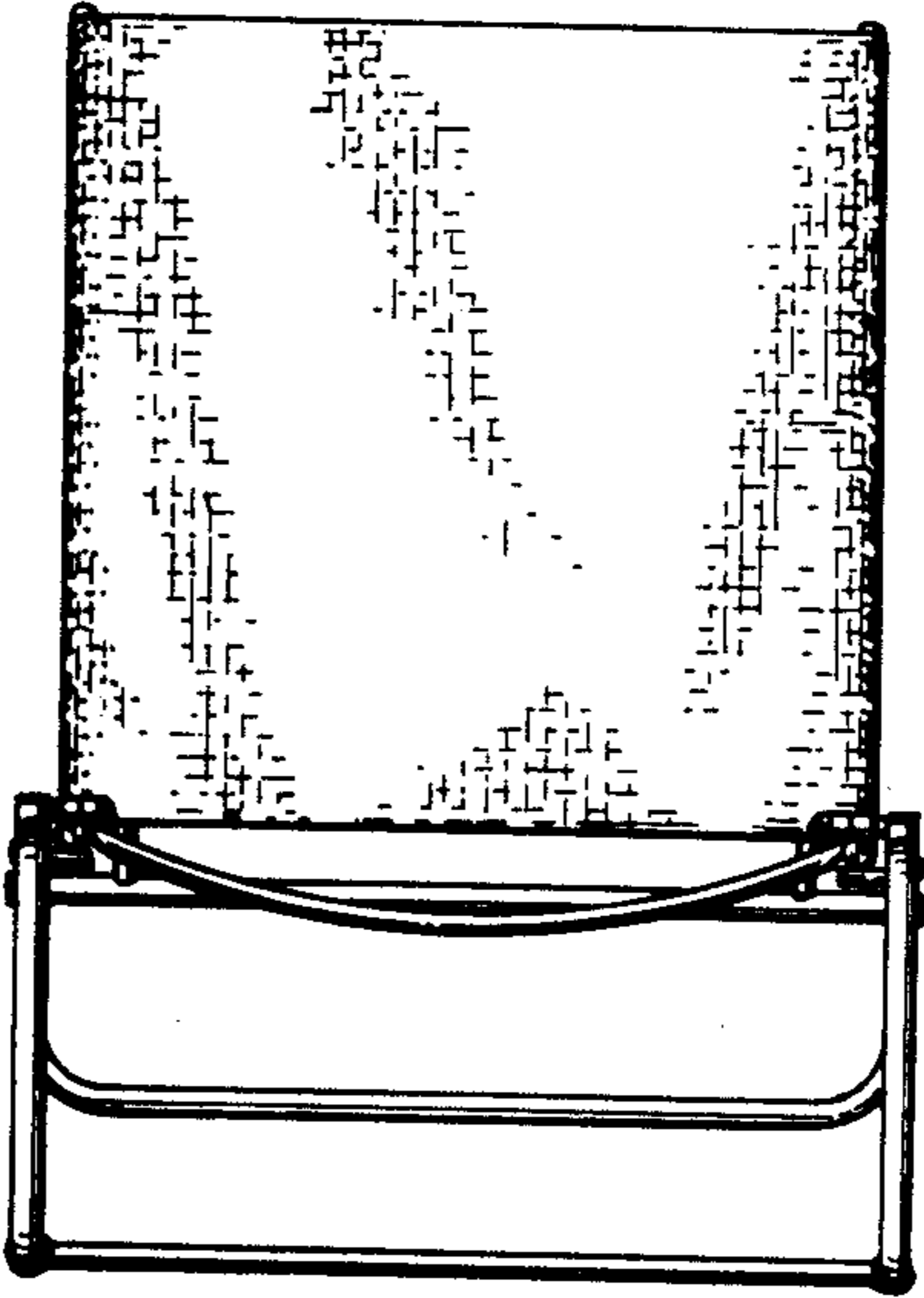
