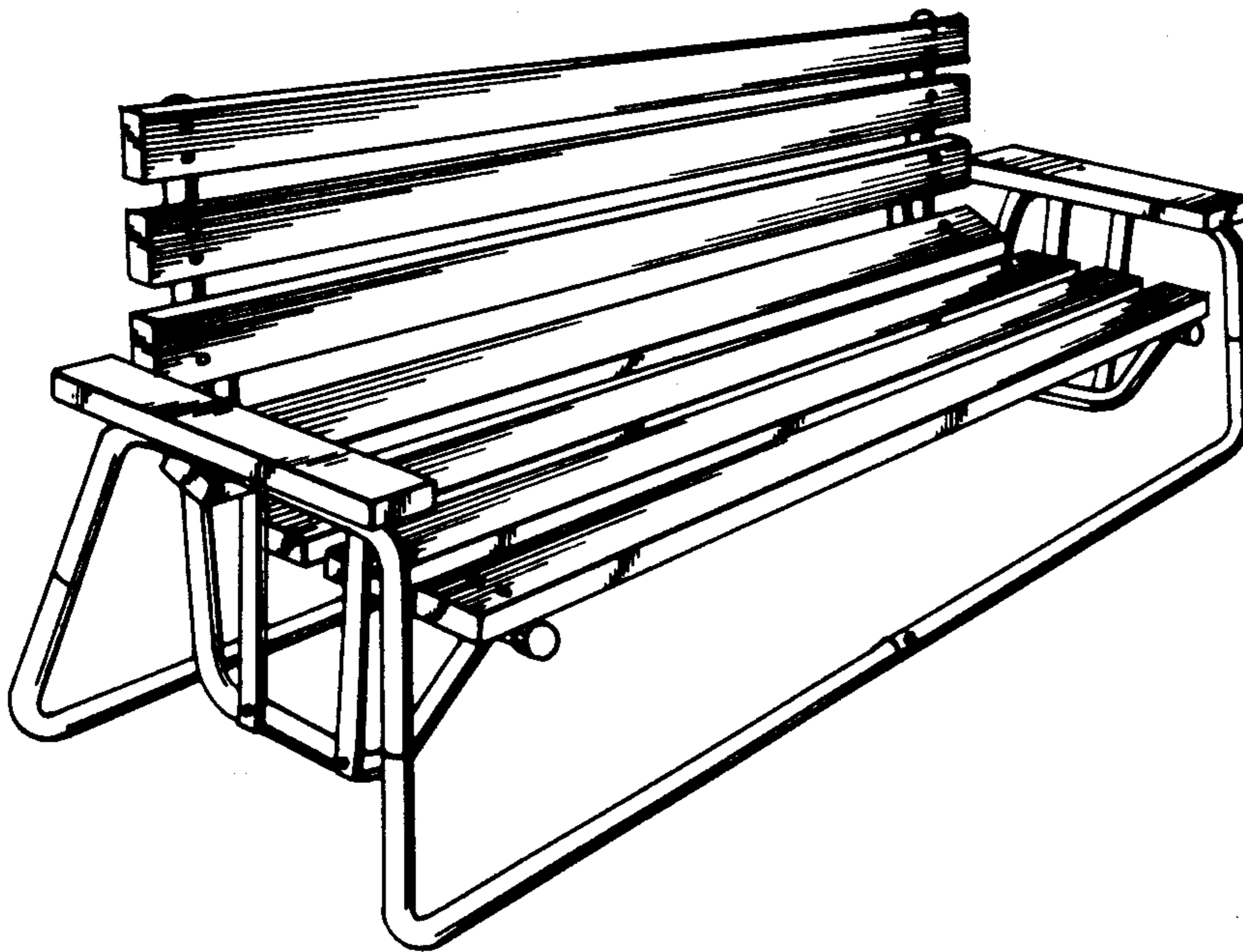

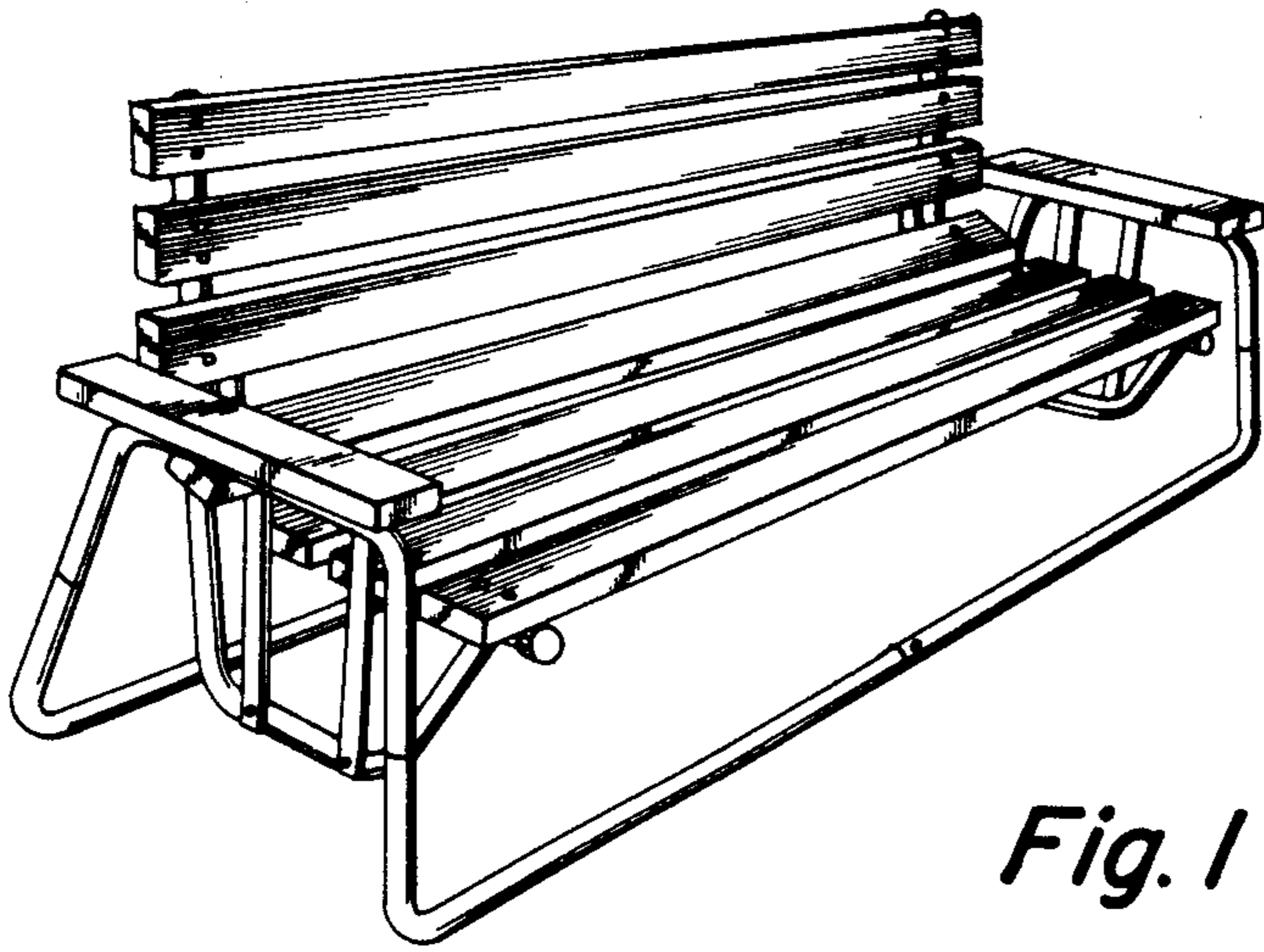
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a glider, substantially as shown.

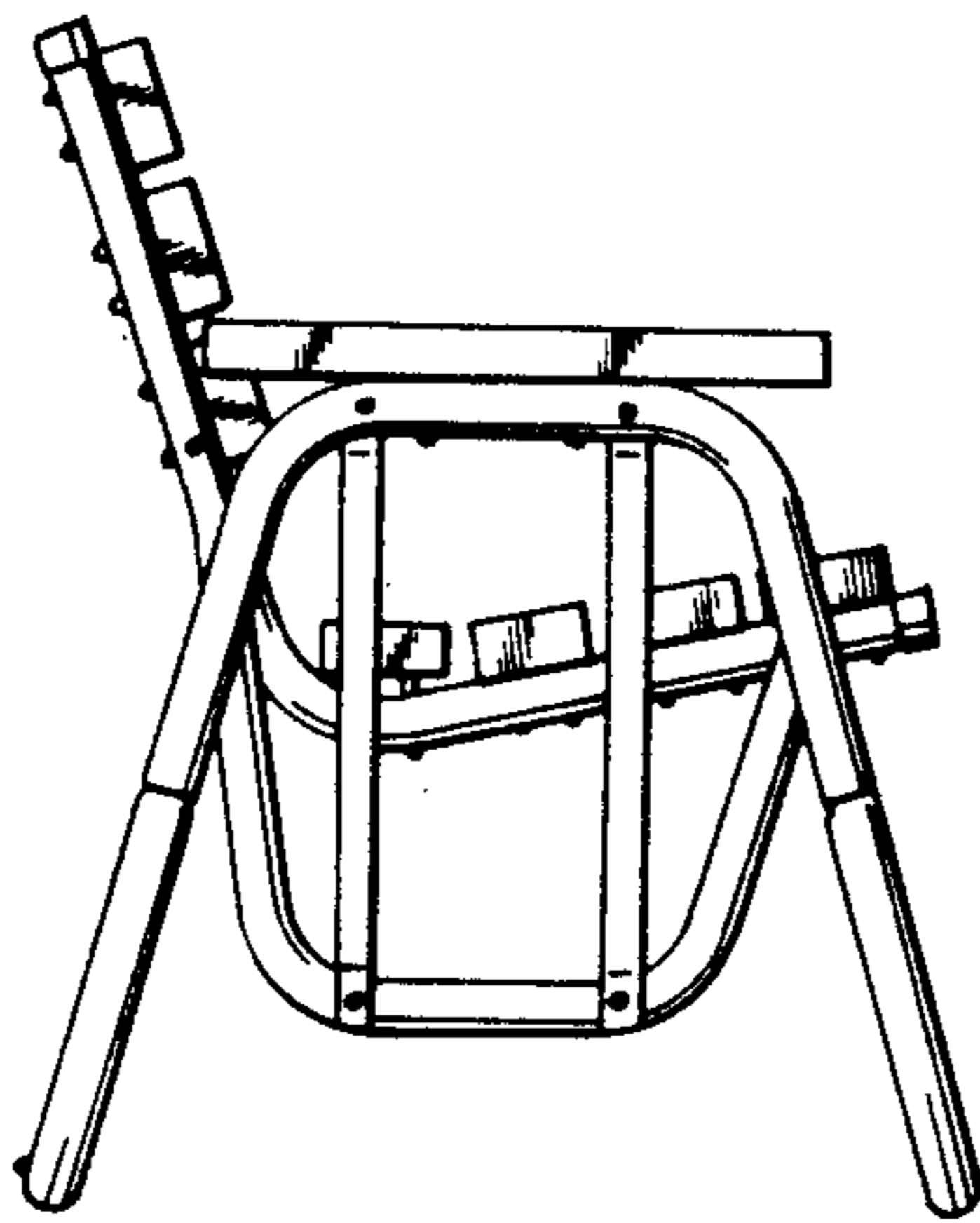
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

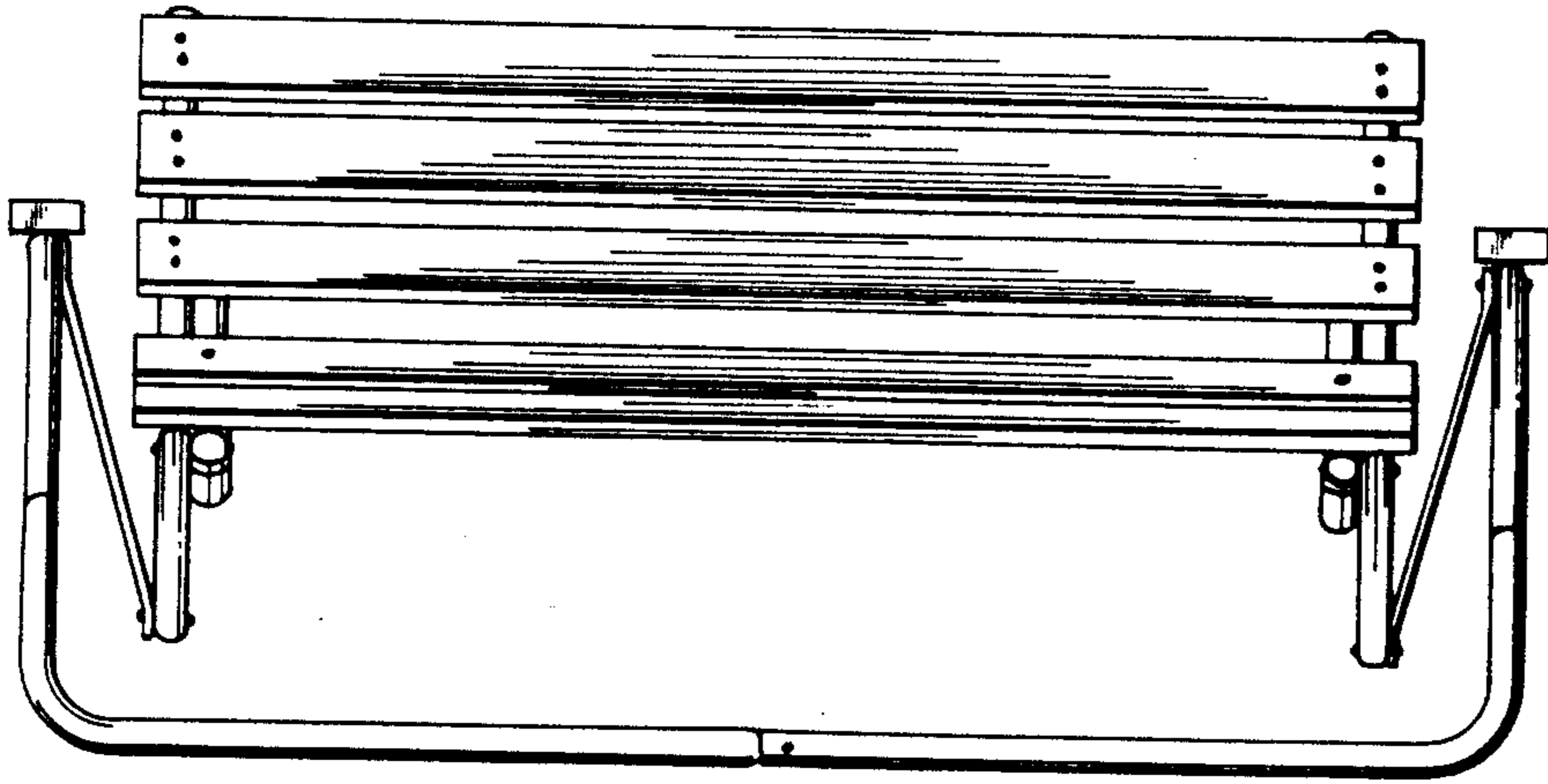




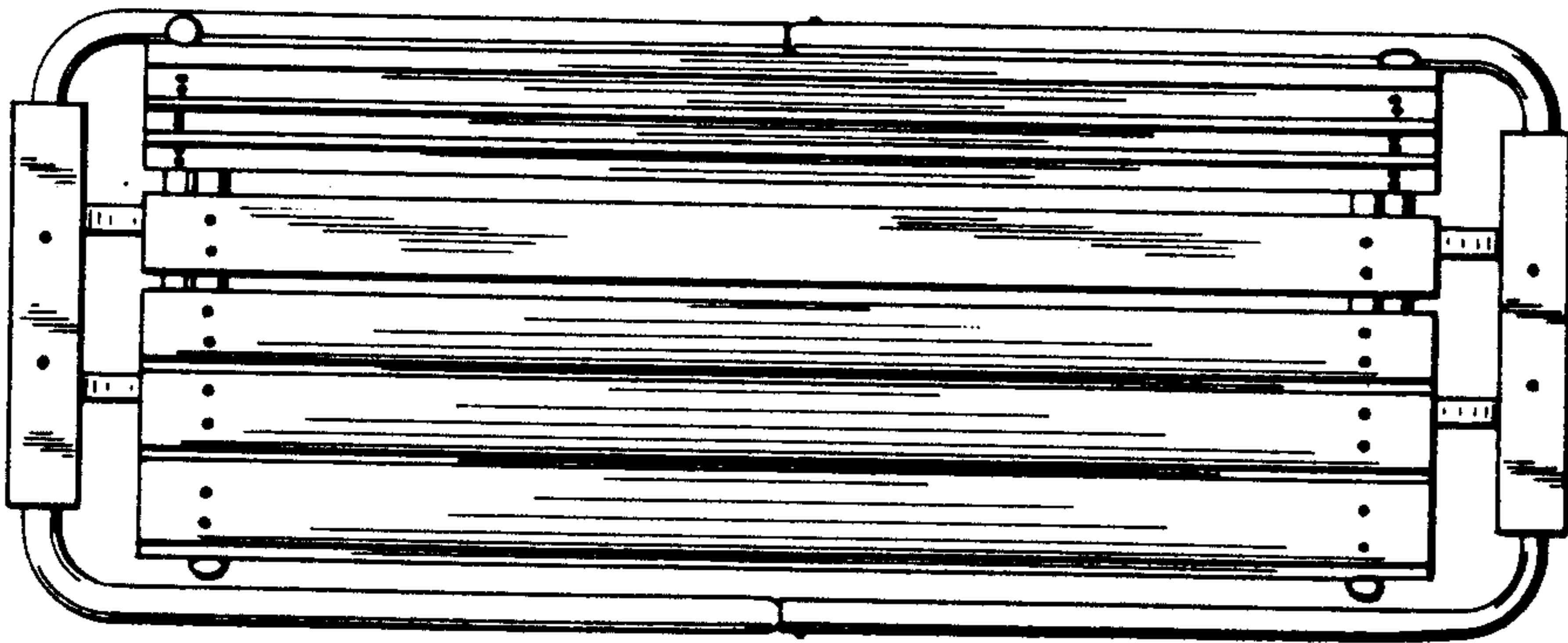

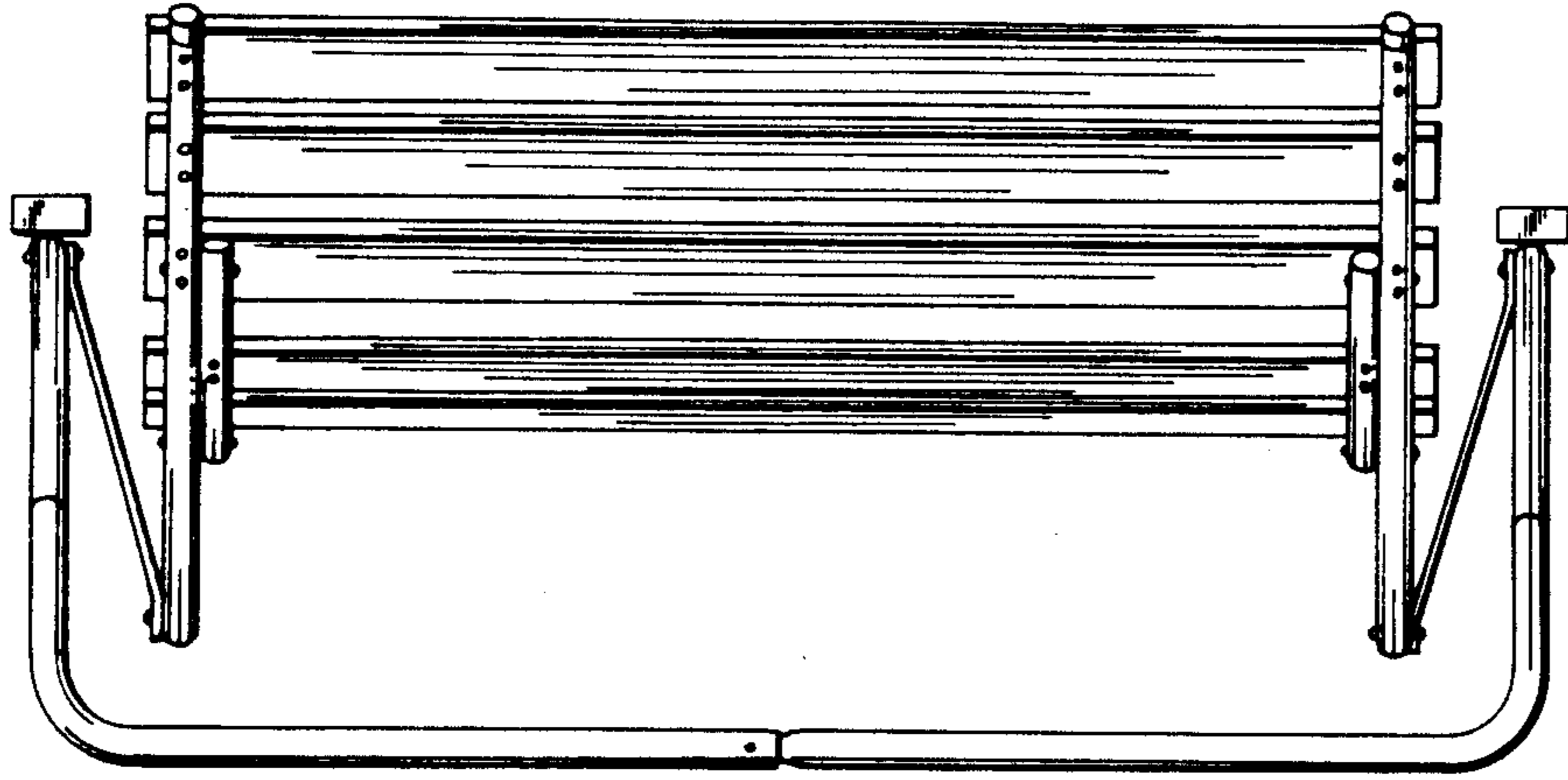
