[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sewing machine bed
cover, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sewing machine bed
cover showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite
side being substantially similar thereto;
FIG. 7 is a partial top plan view of the end portion with
the pin cushion removed for convenience of illustration;
and
FIG. 8 is a sectional view taken along lines 8—8 of FIG.
7.

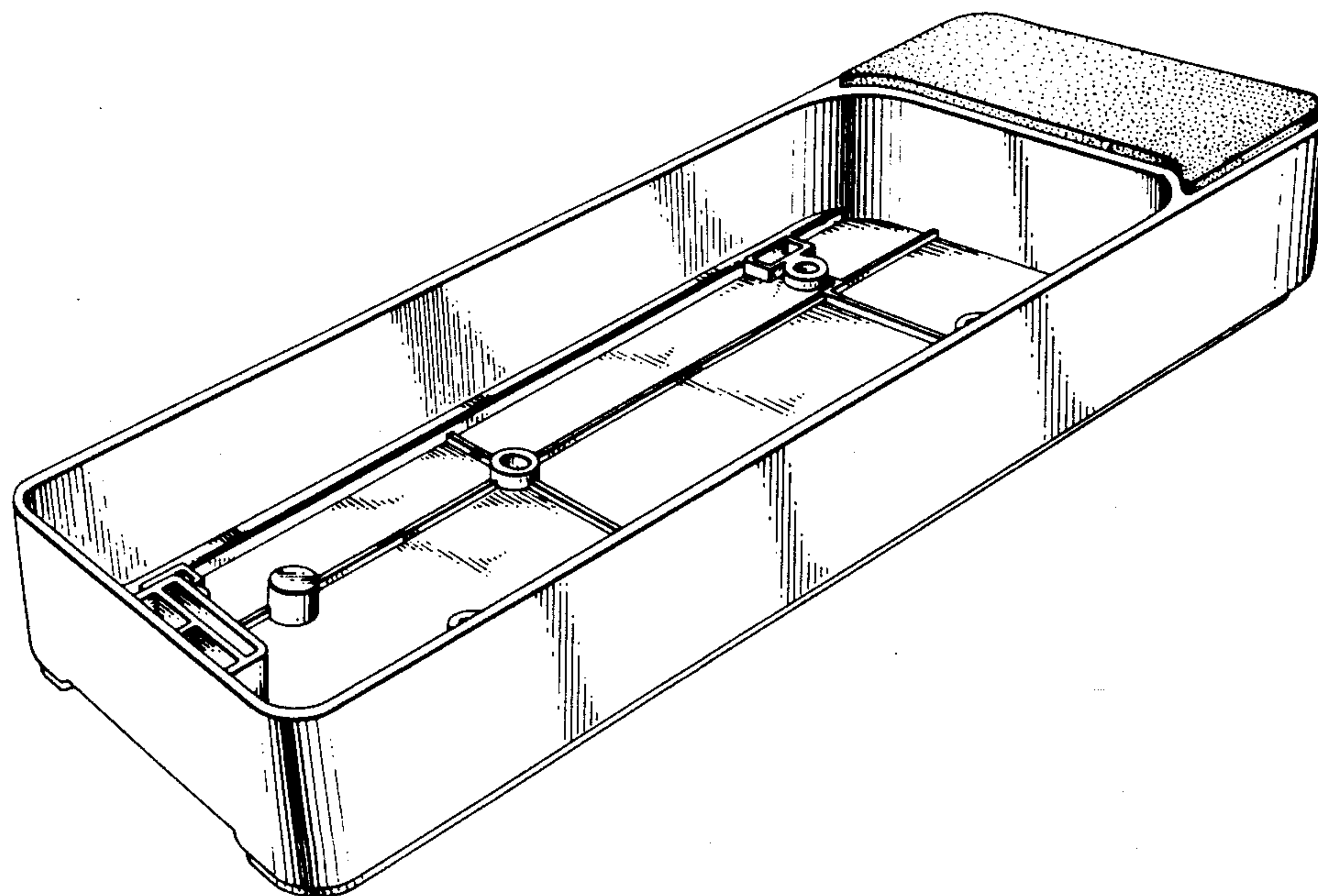

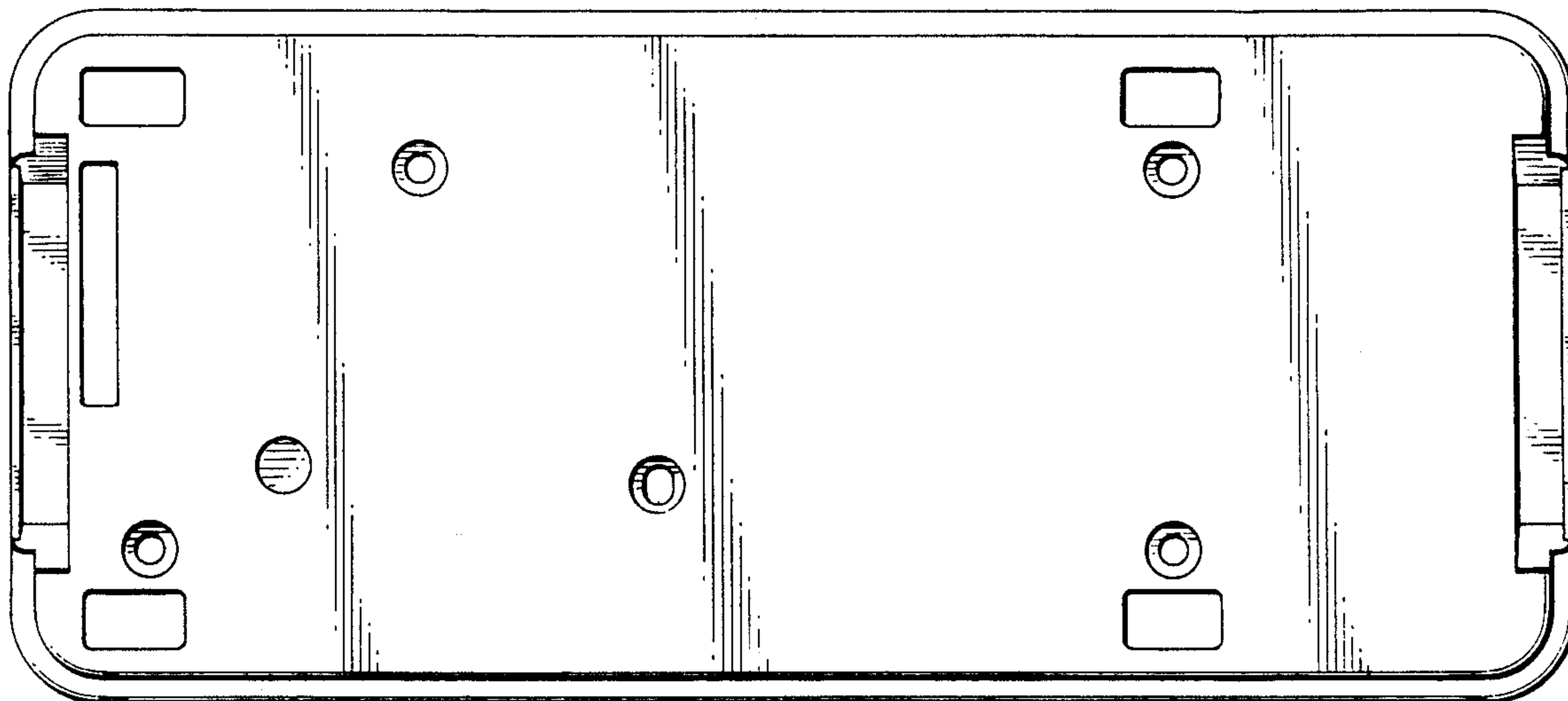
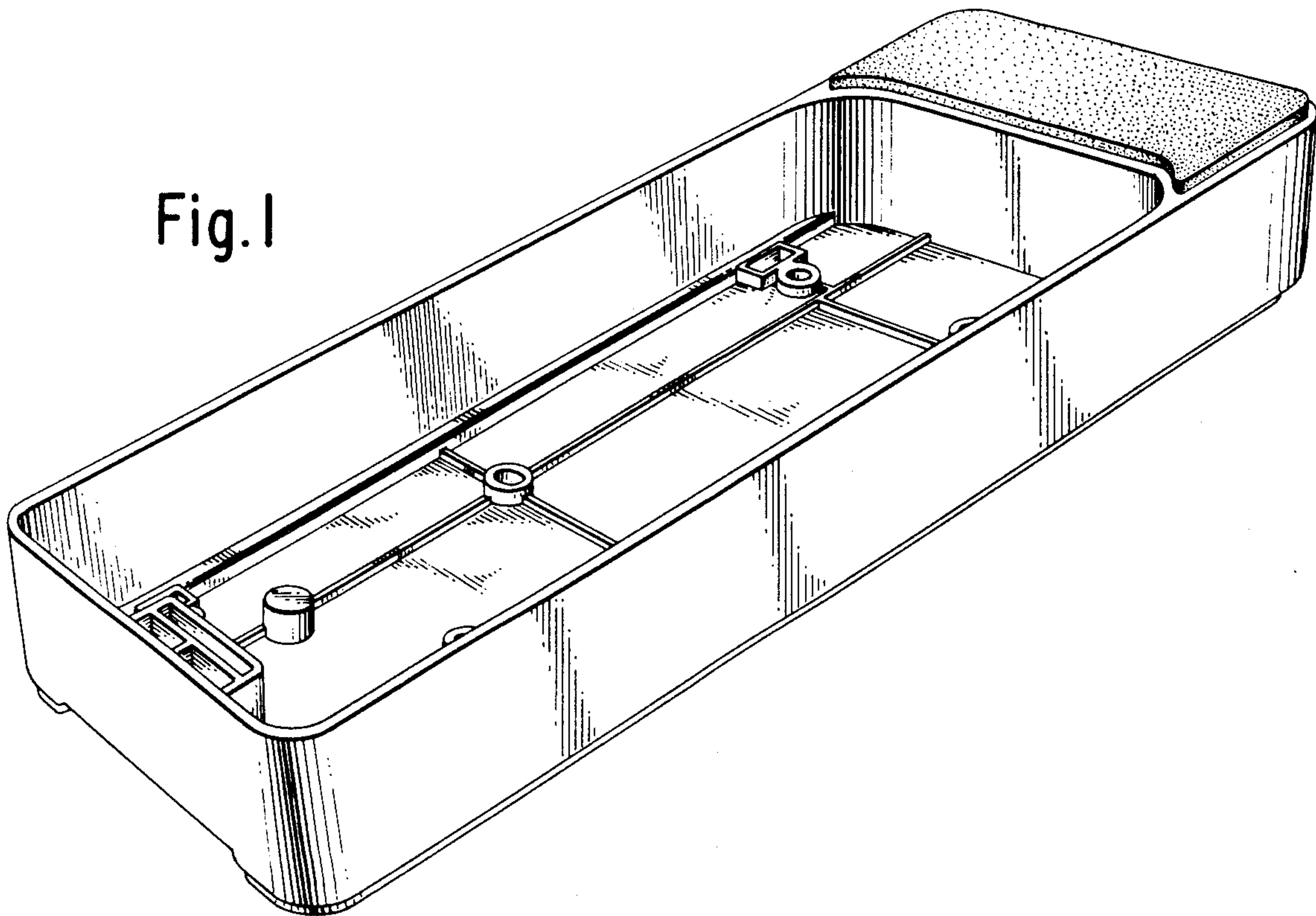

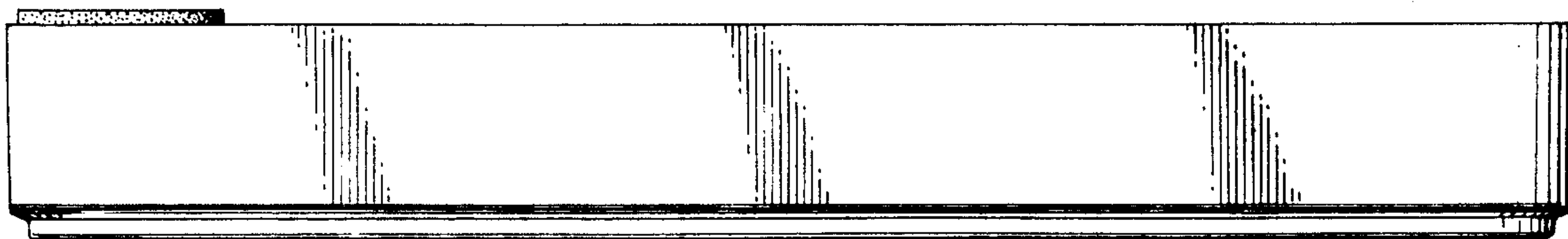

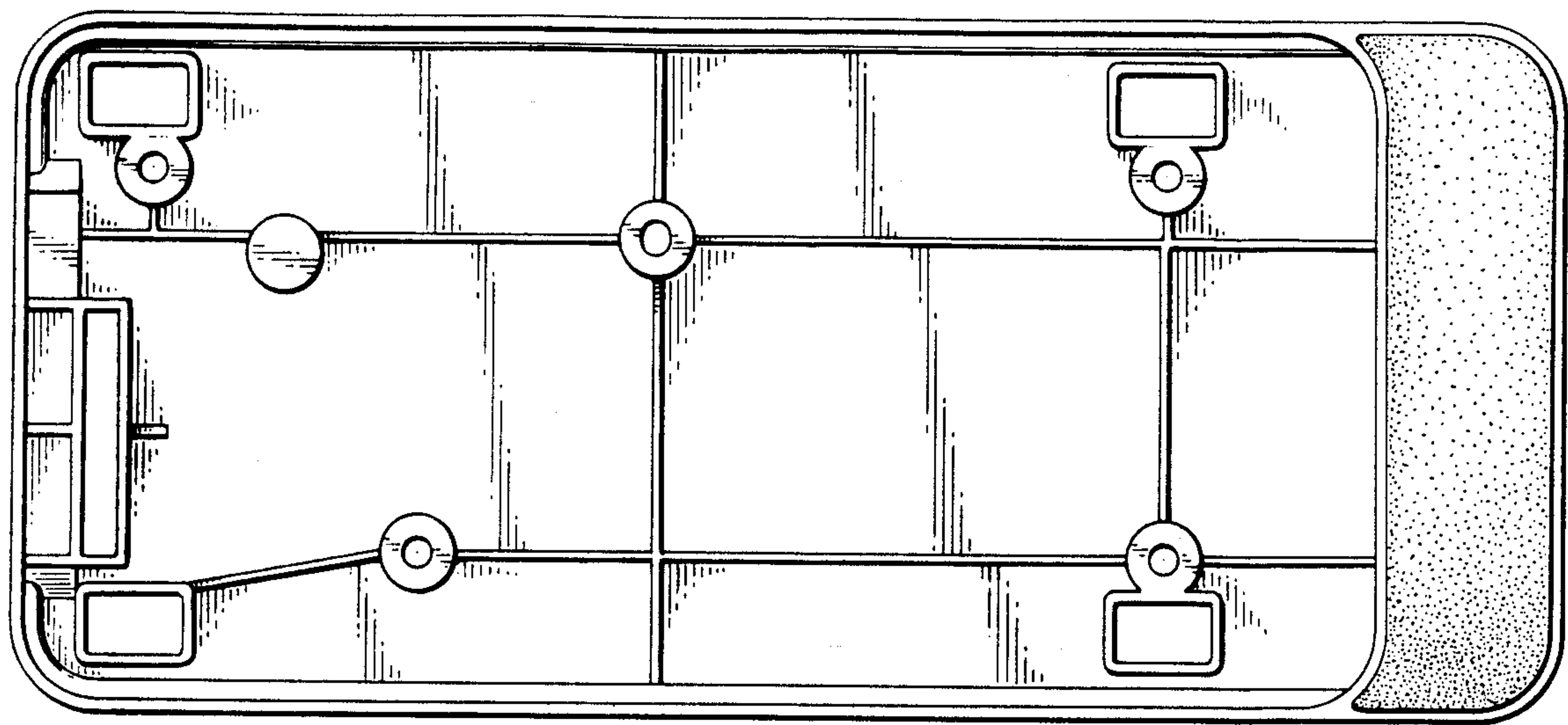

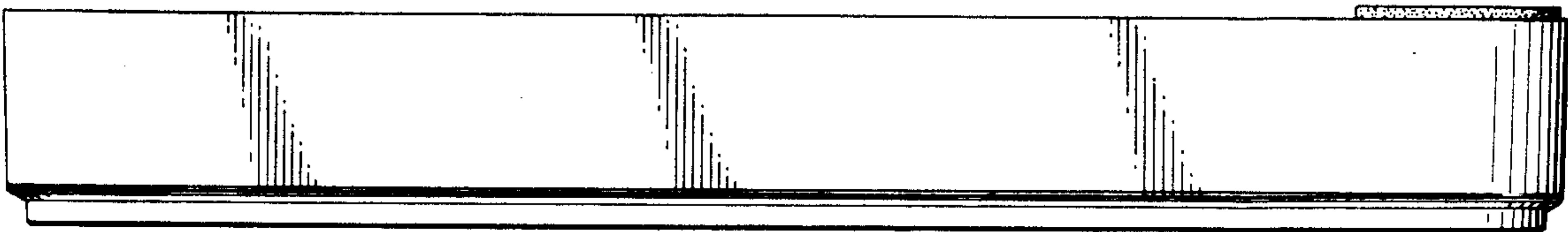

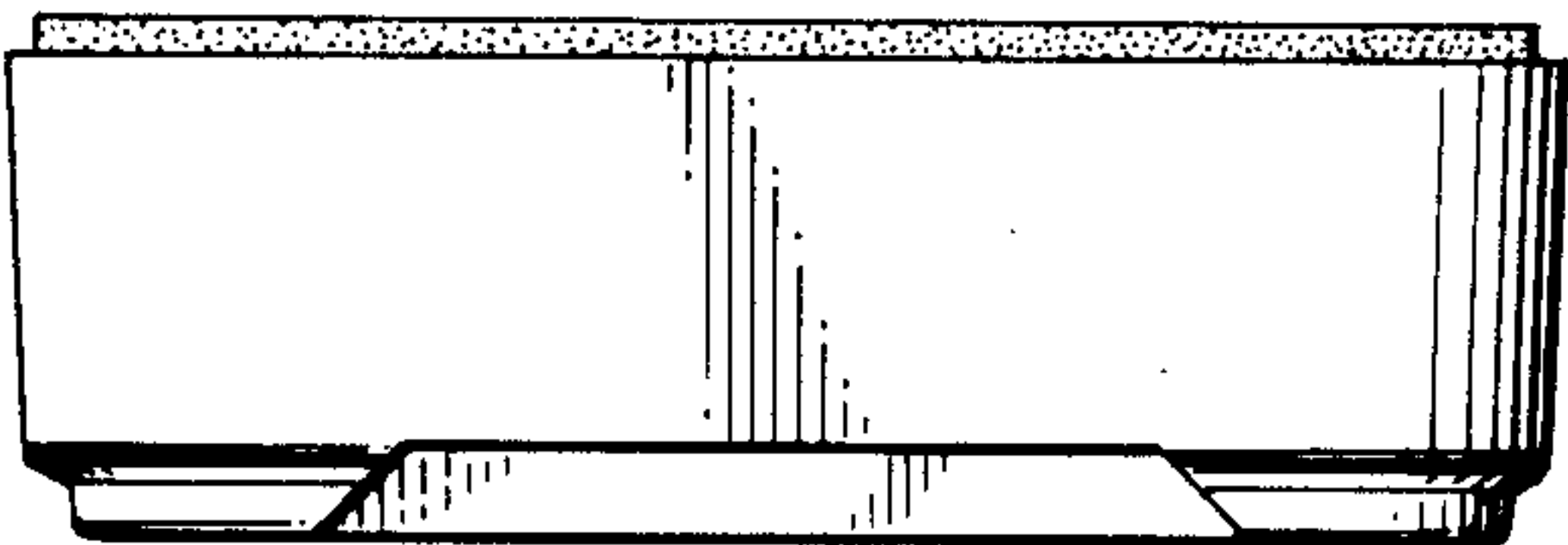

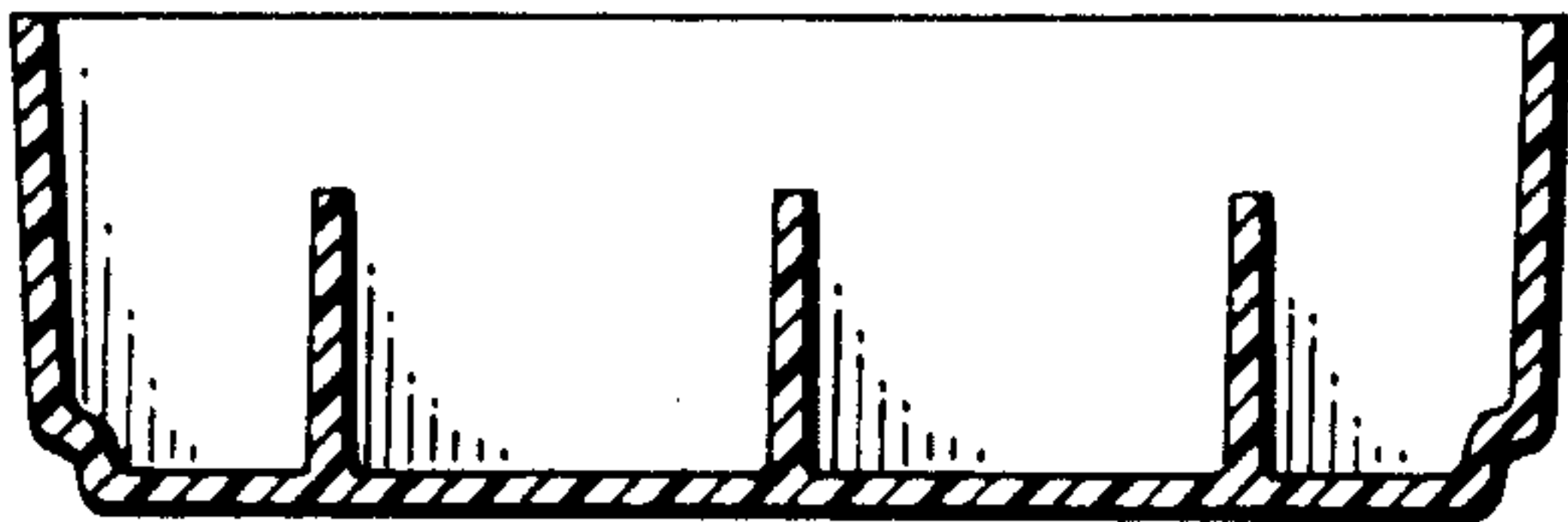

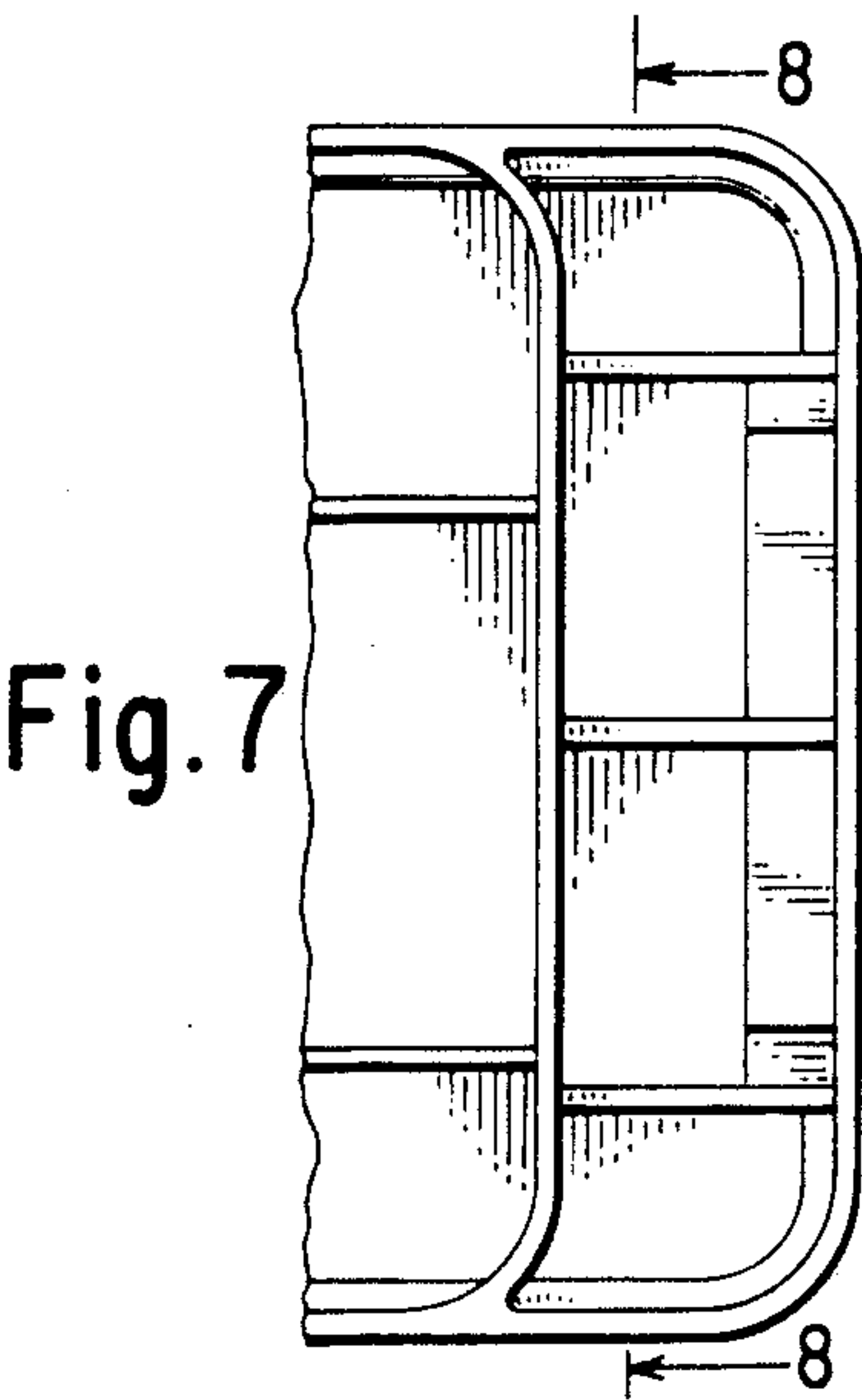
