CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pinball game cabinet, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pinball game cabinet embodying my new design;


FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the cabinet shown in FIG. 1;
