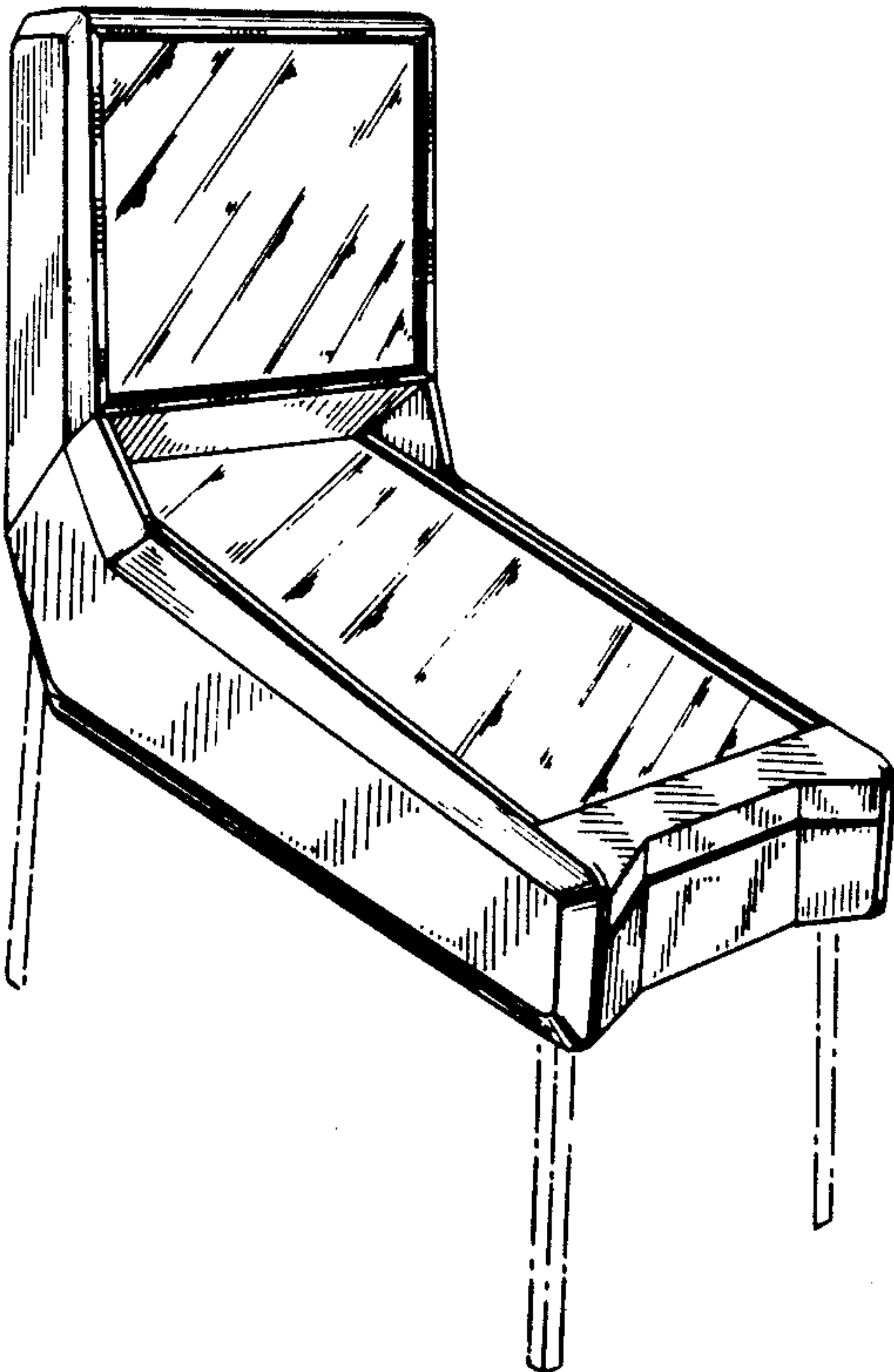

[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a pinball game cabinet, sub-
stantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pinball game cabinet
embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the cabinet shown in FIG.
1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the cabinet shown in
FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the cabinet shown
in FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is a back elevational view of the cabinet shown
in FIG. 1.

for illustrative purposes only.



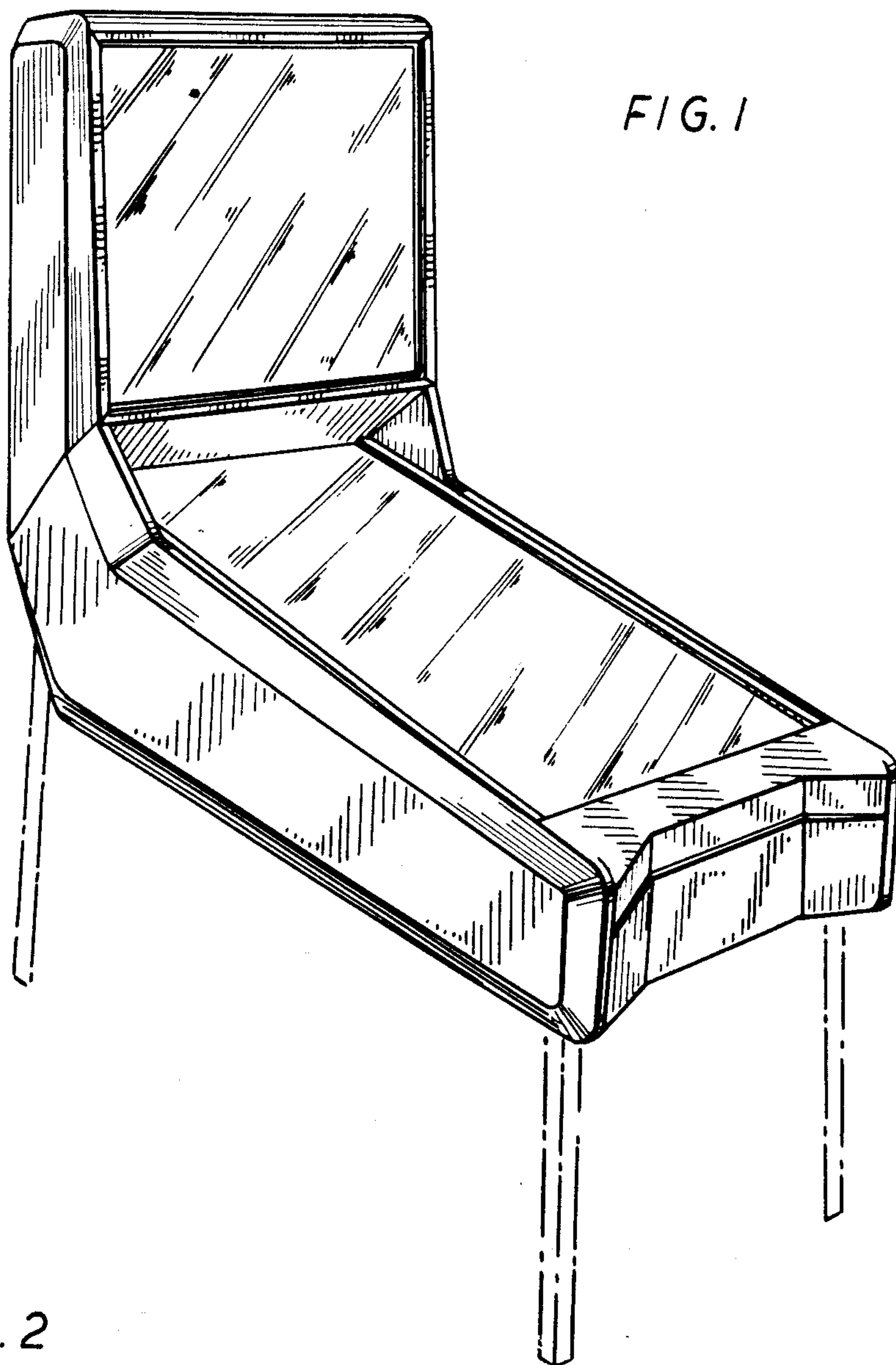
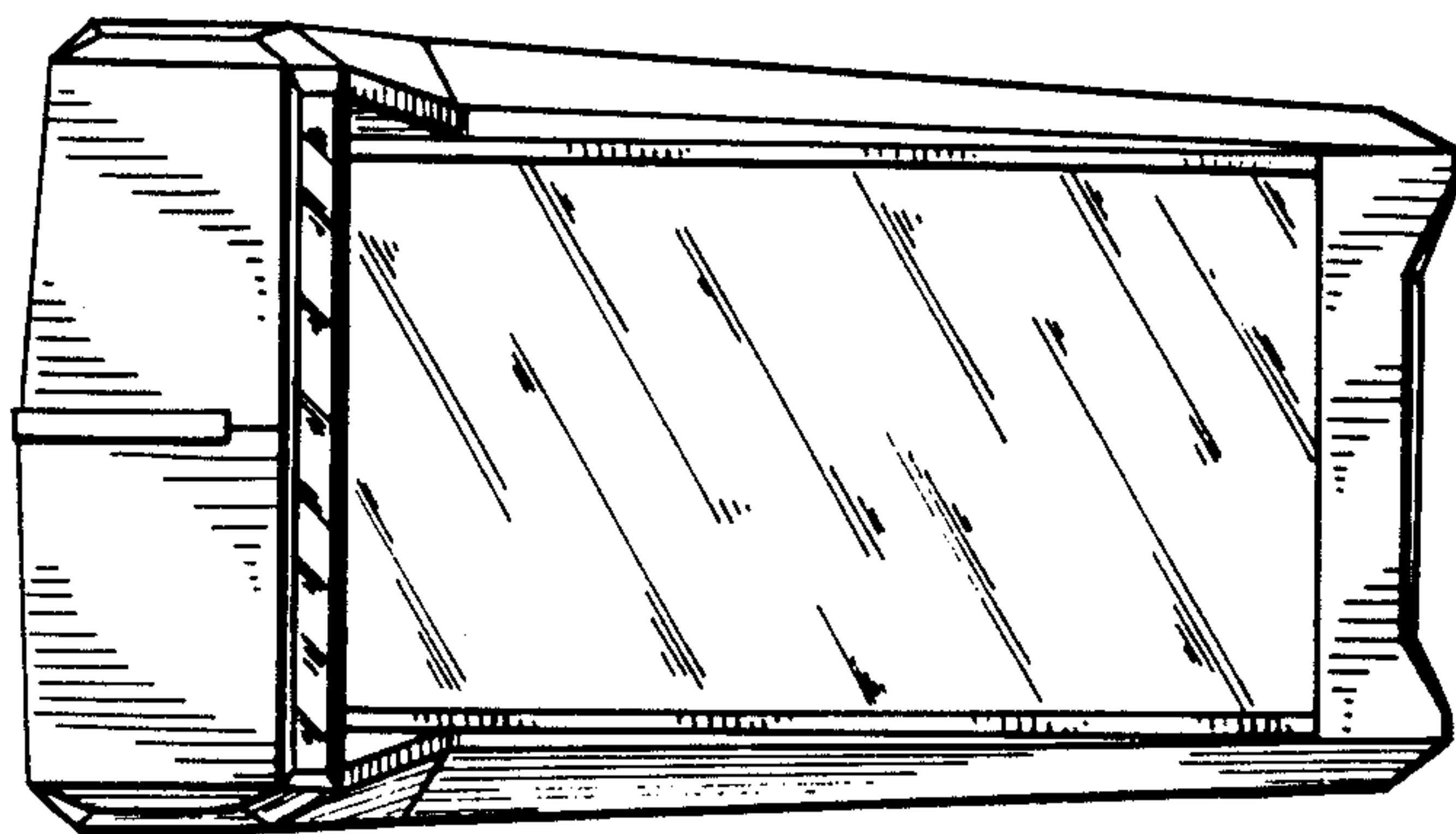

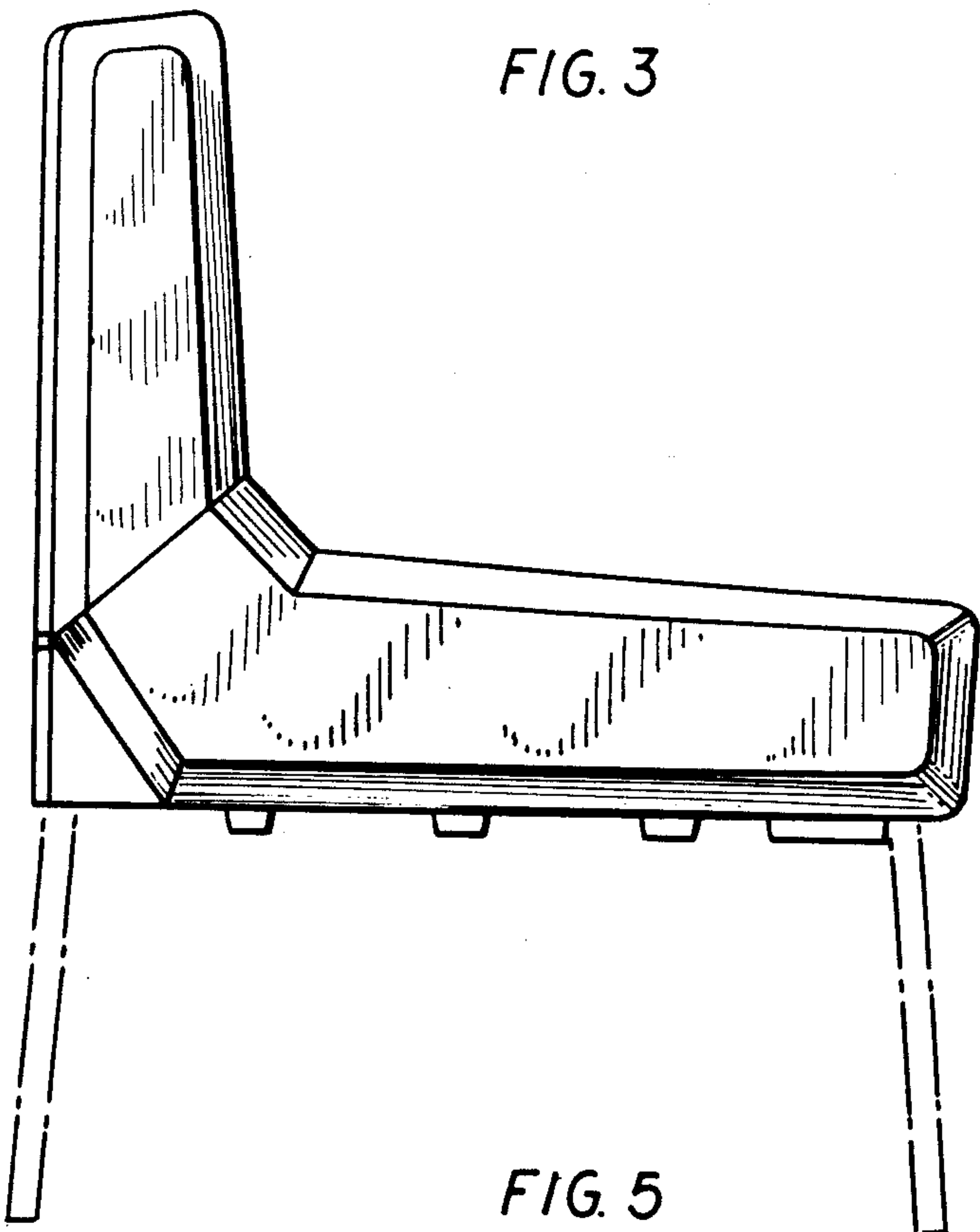

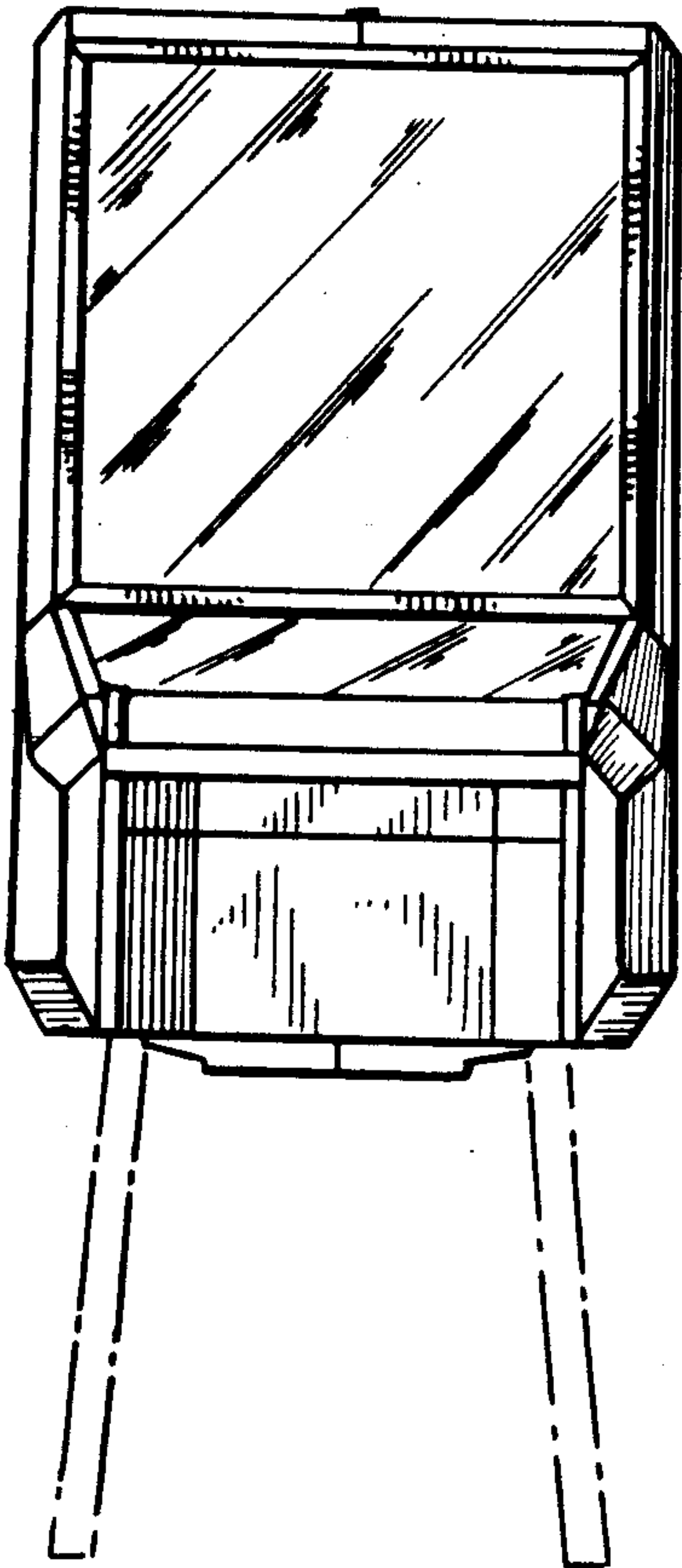
