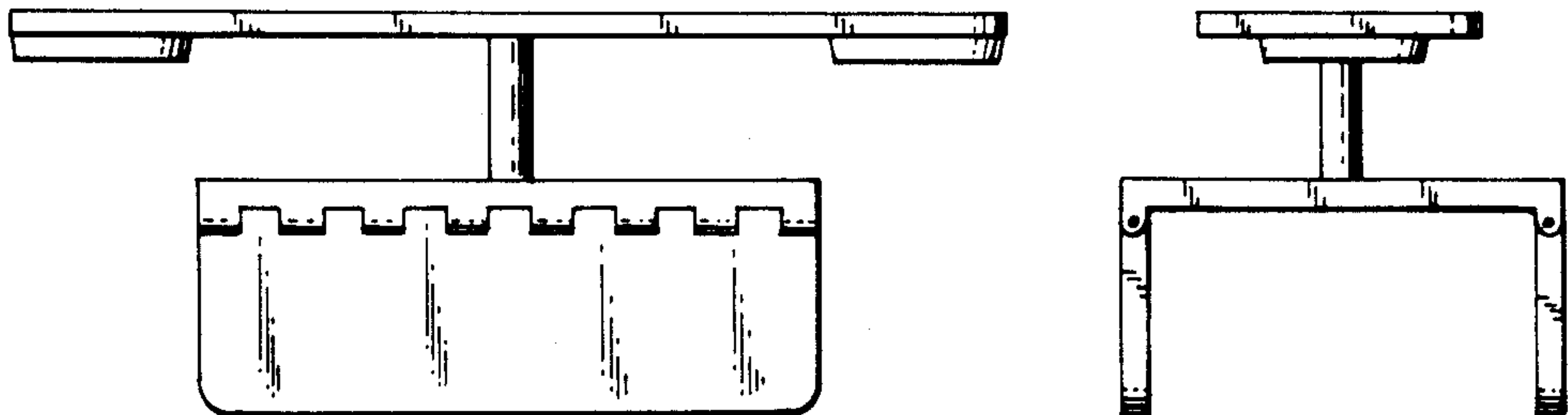

The ornamental design for a portable glass holder for
attachment to a furniture arm, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a portable glass holder for
attachment to a furniture arm showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a side plan view;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along the line 5—5 of
FIG. 1.
The side and end not shown in FIGS. 2 and 3 are mirror
images of the respective side and end shown.



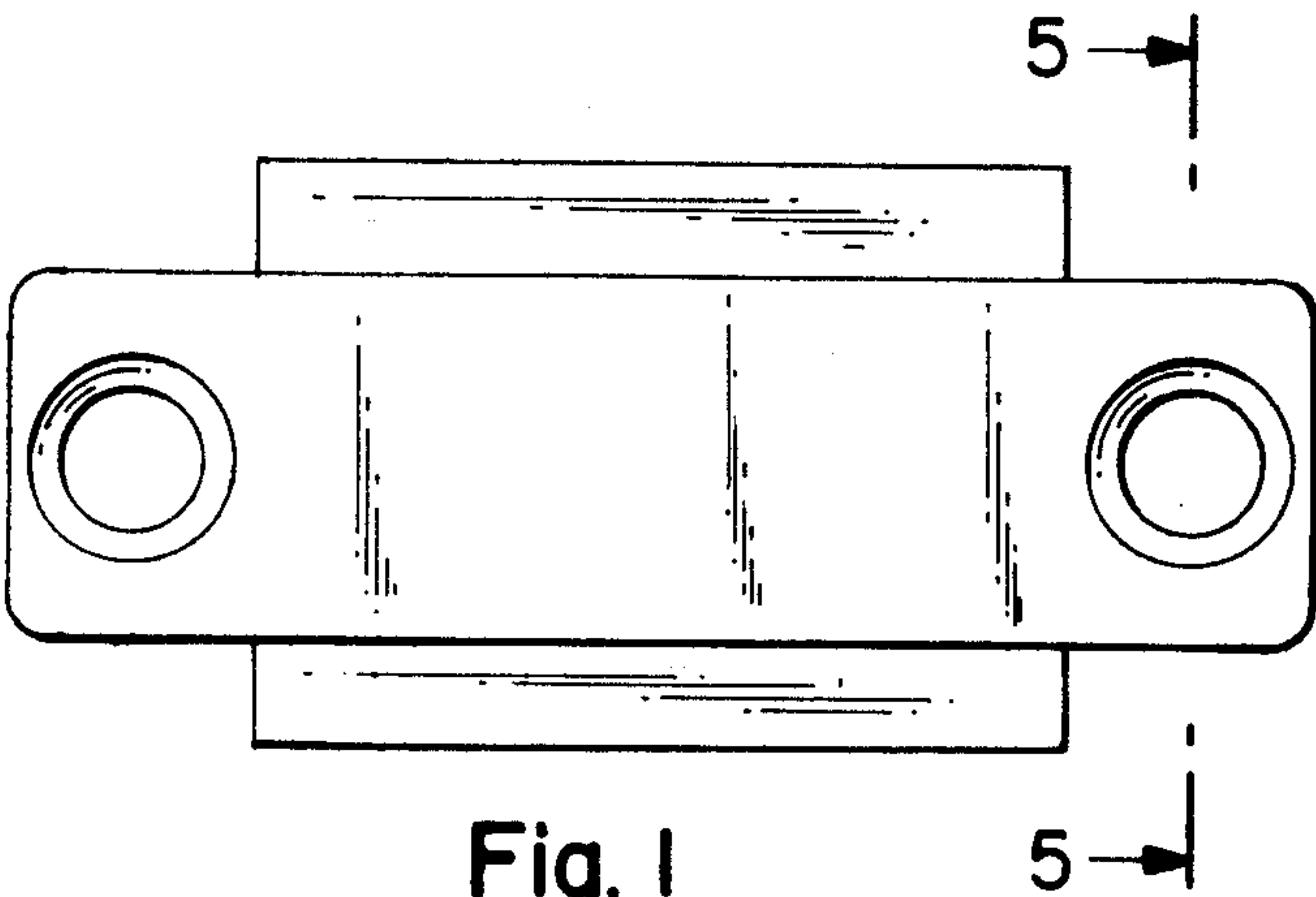

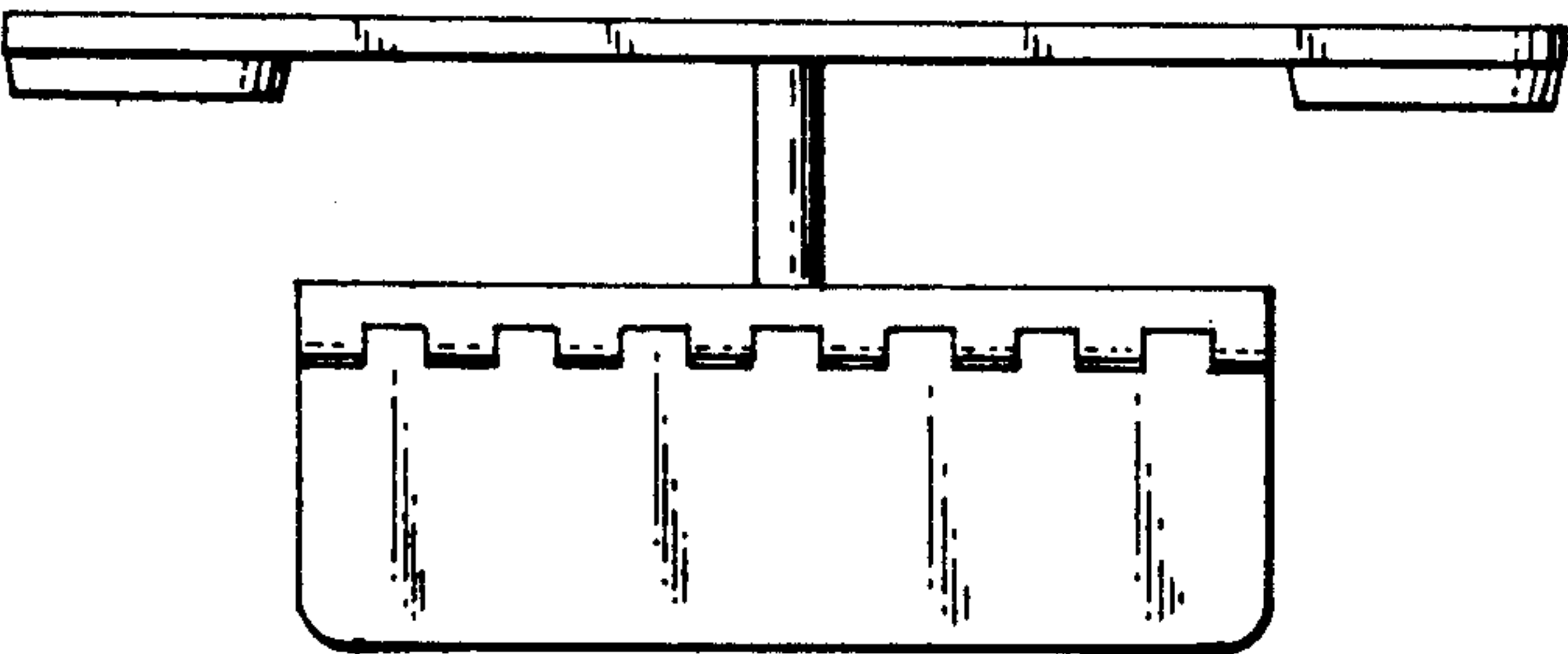

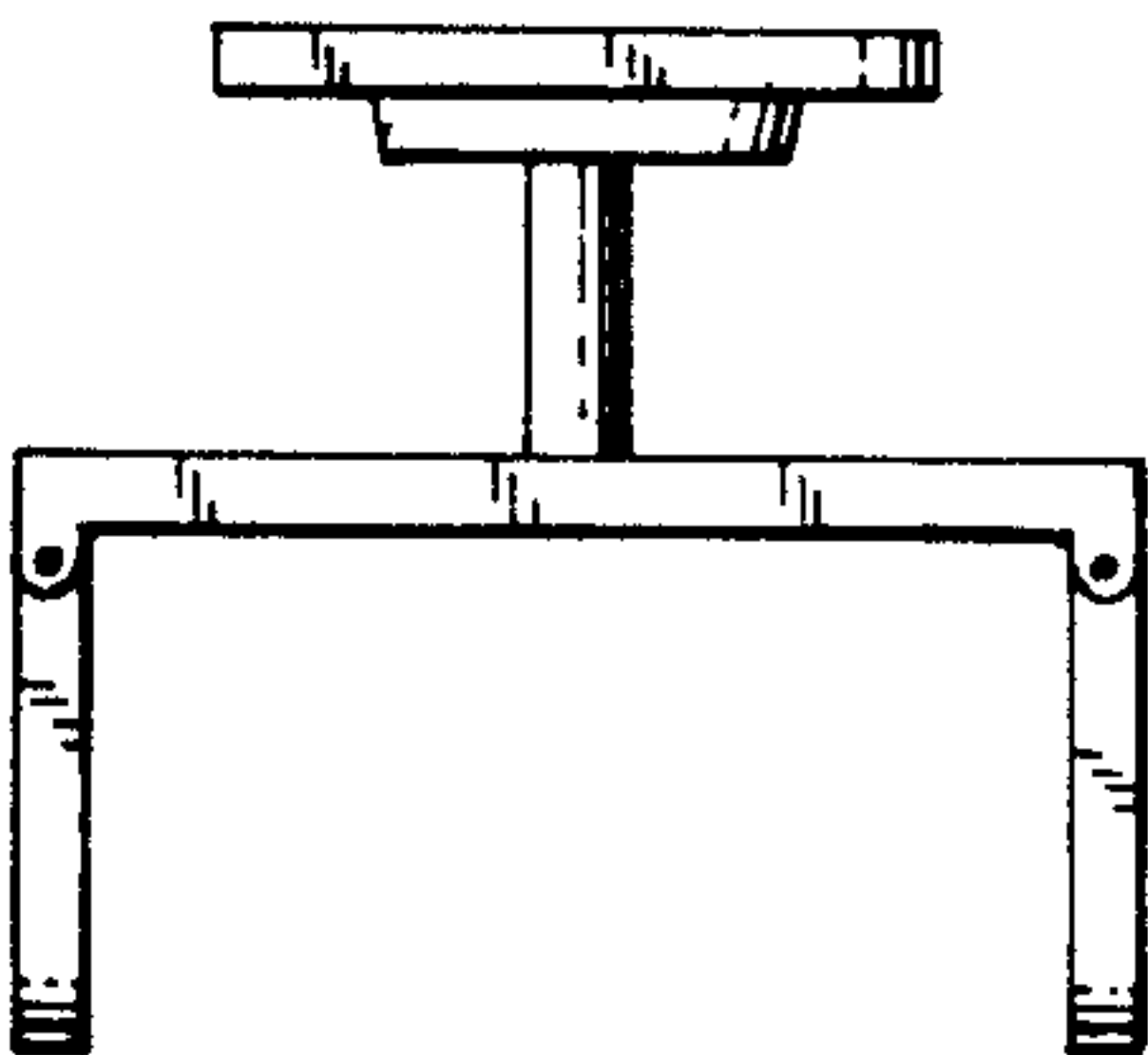

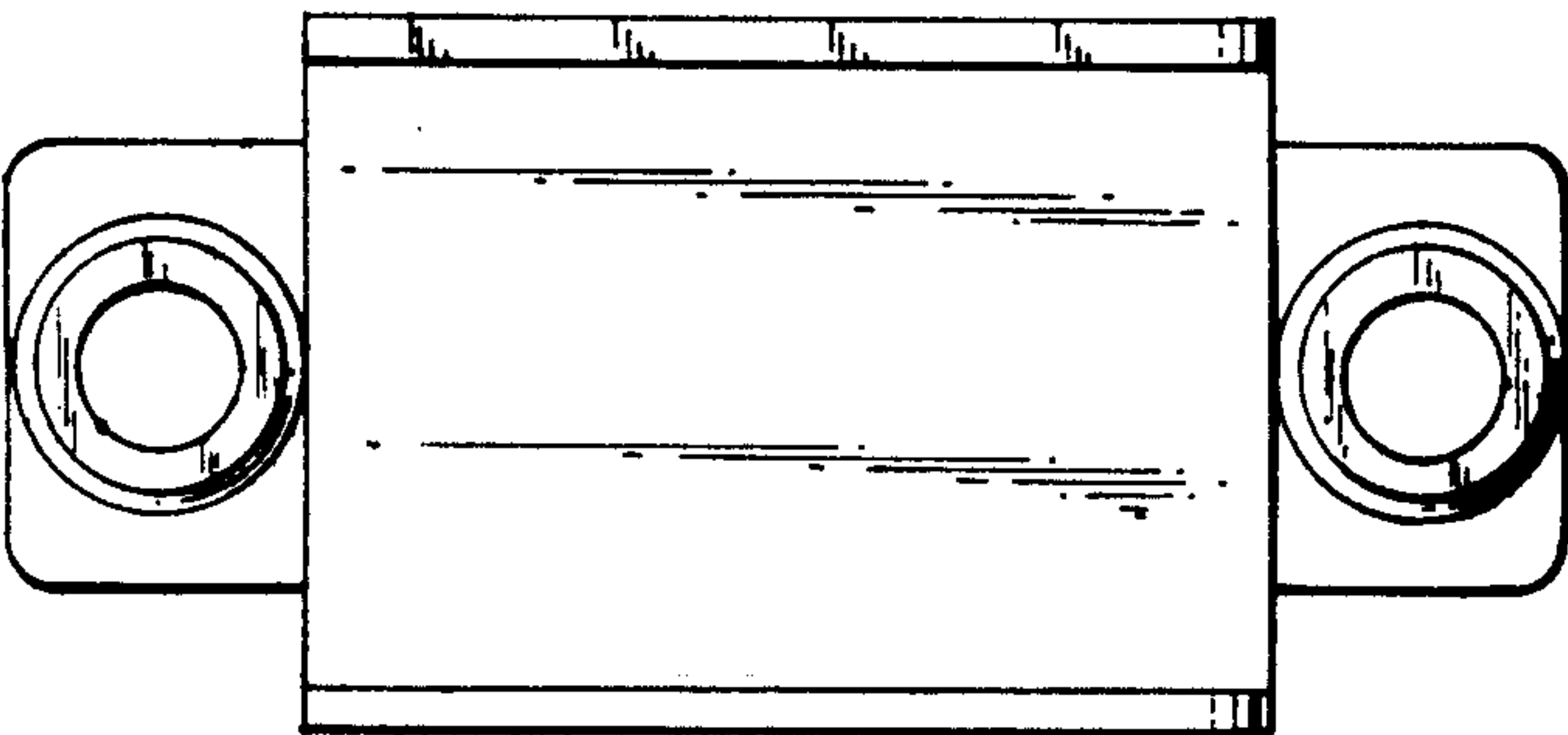
