DESCRIPTION

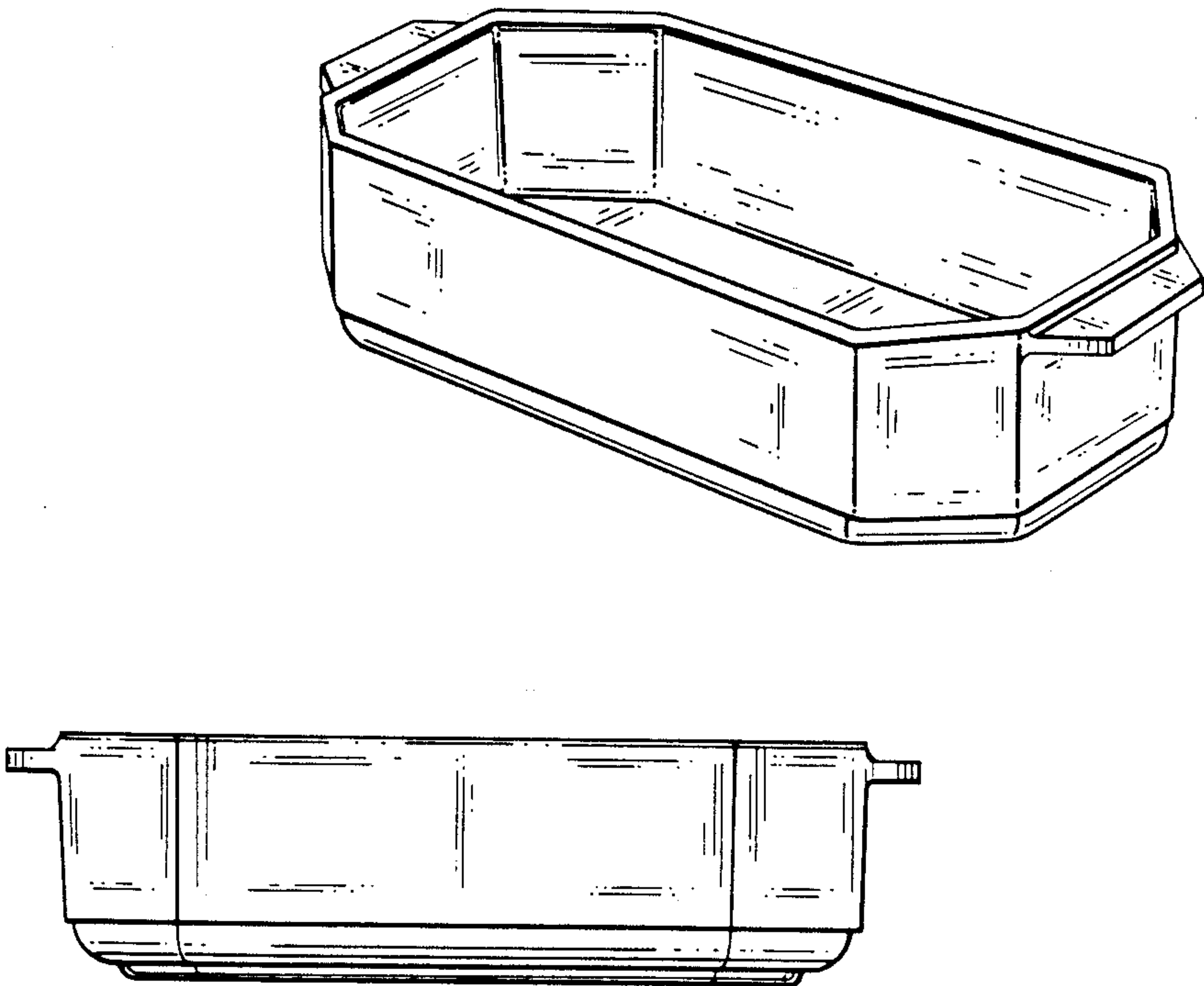
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pan showing our new

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



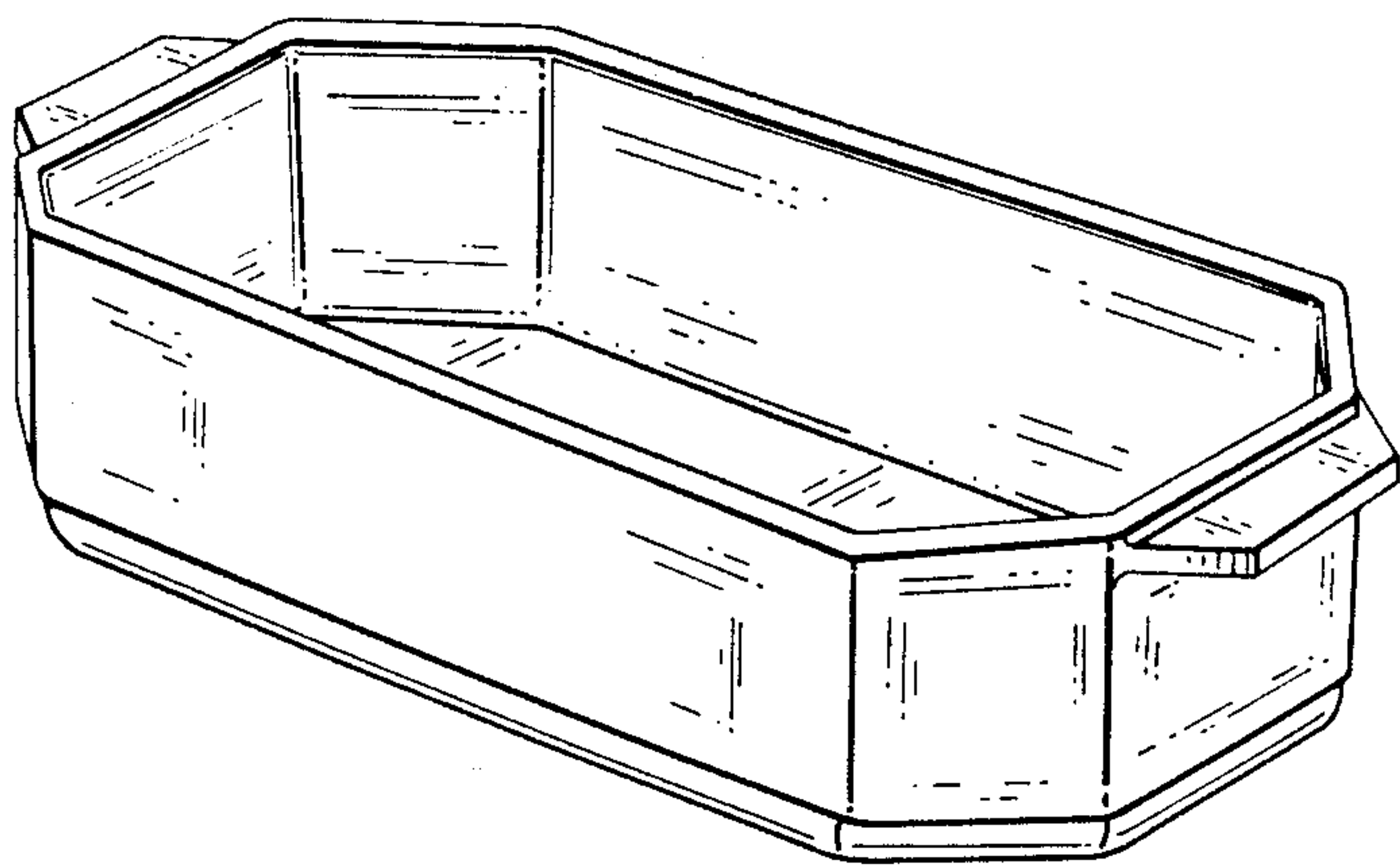

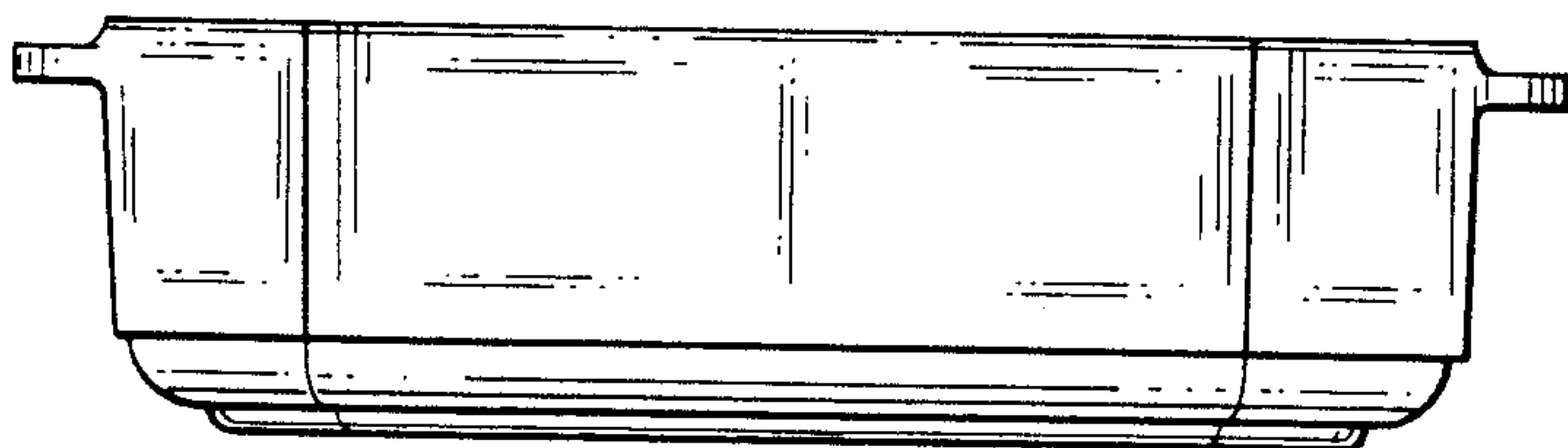

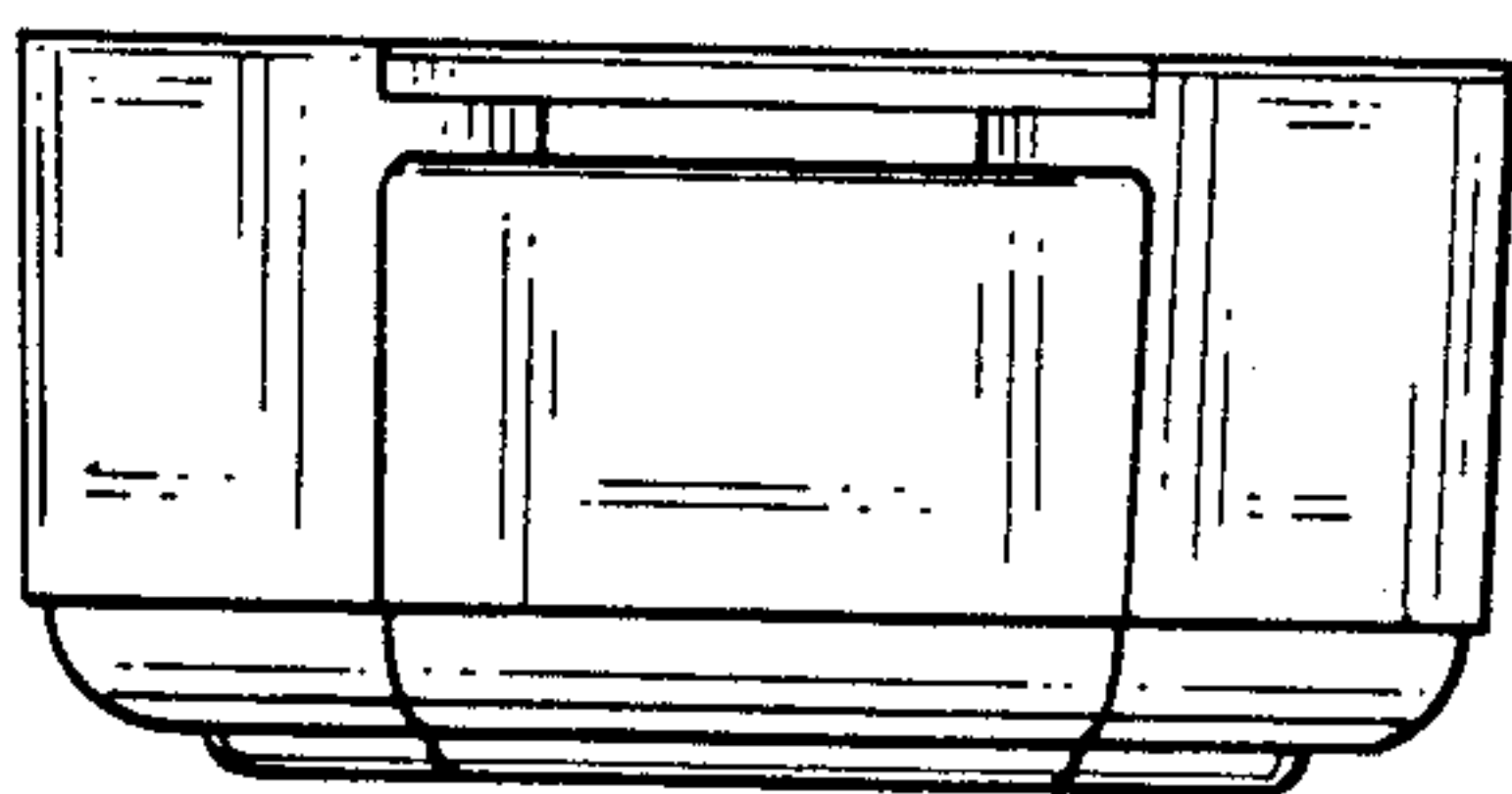

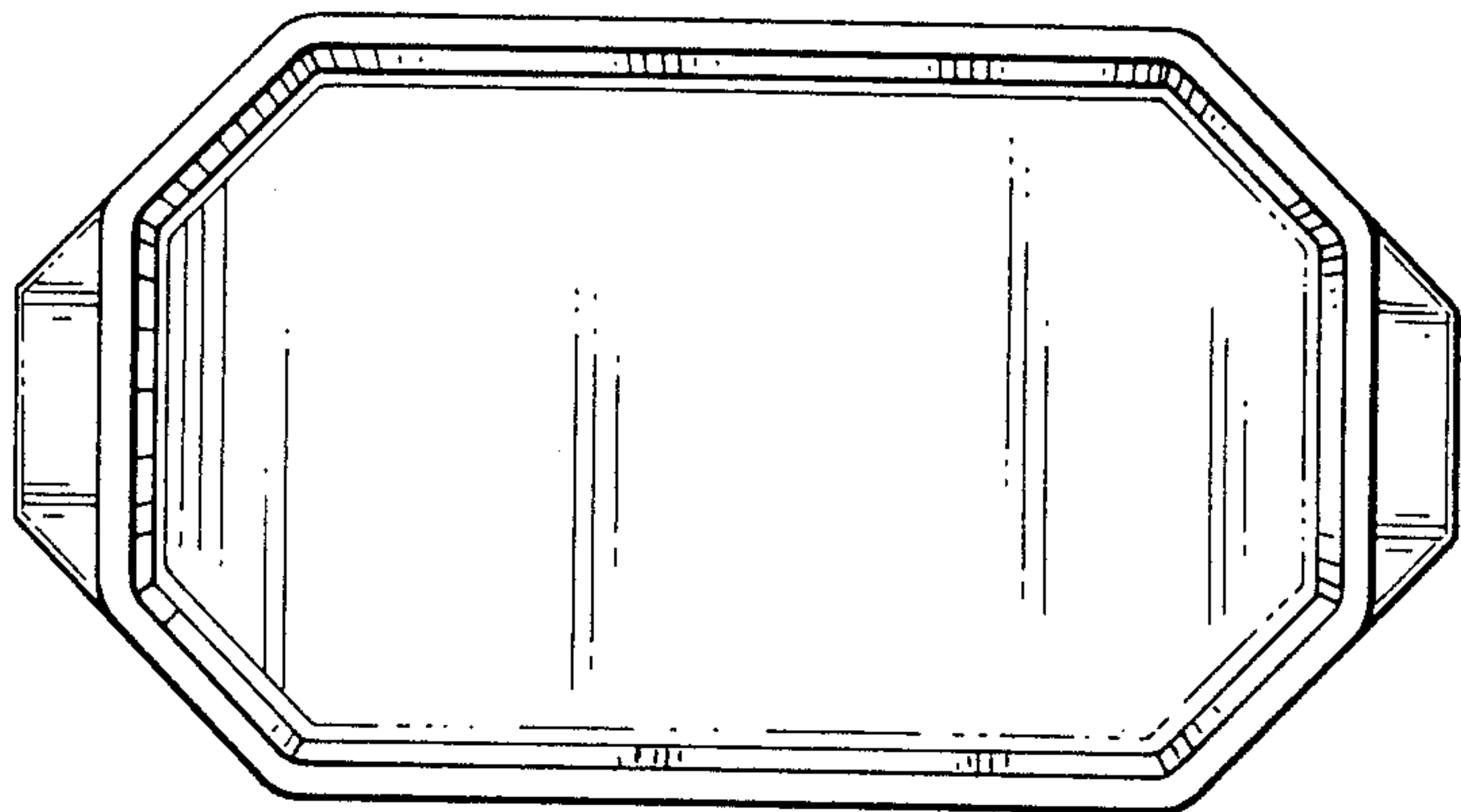

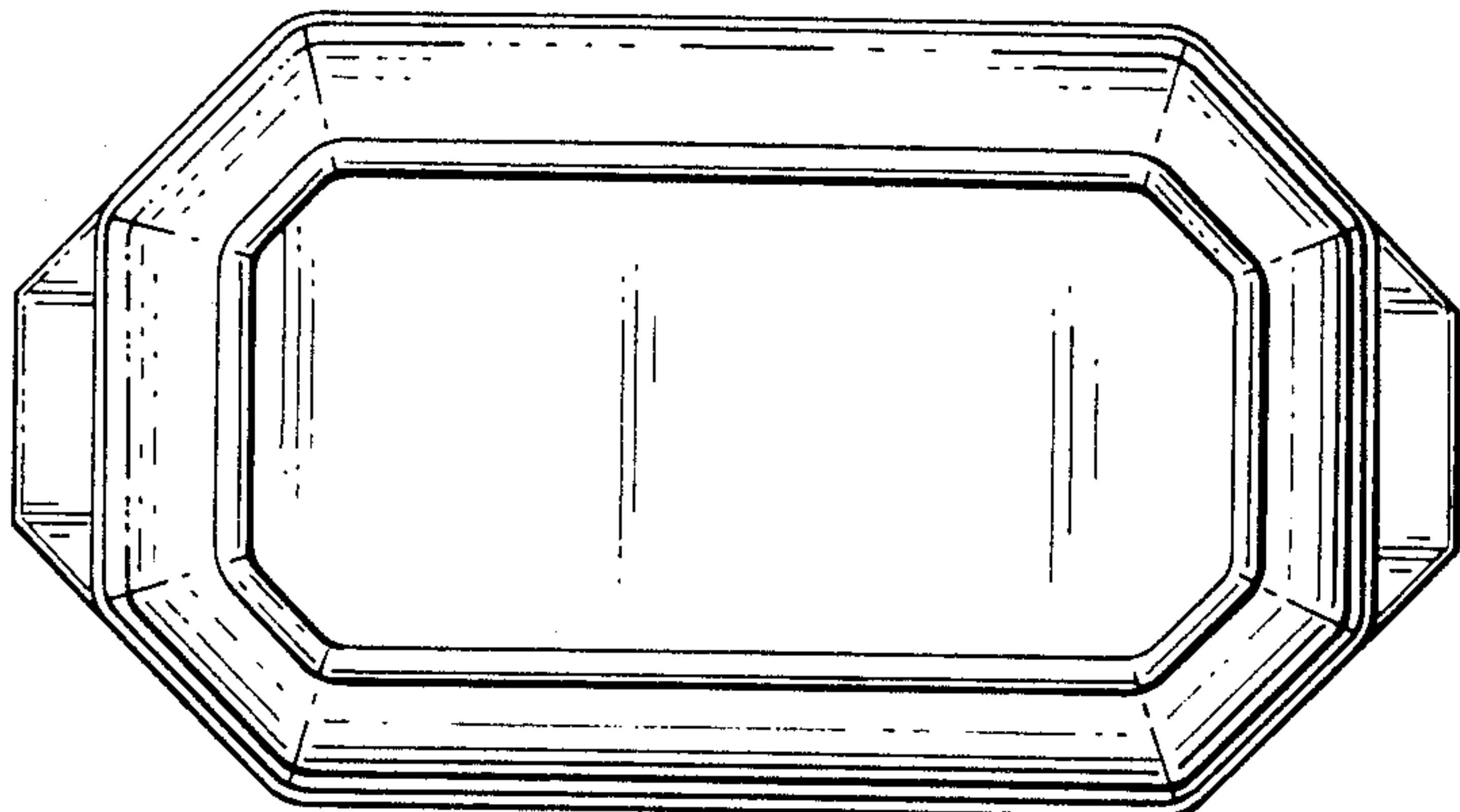
