FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a rosette iron showing my new design, the rear elevational view thereof being the same;

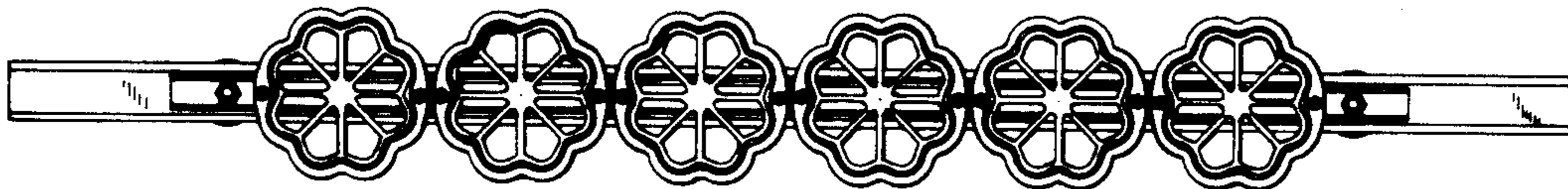
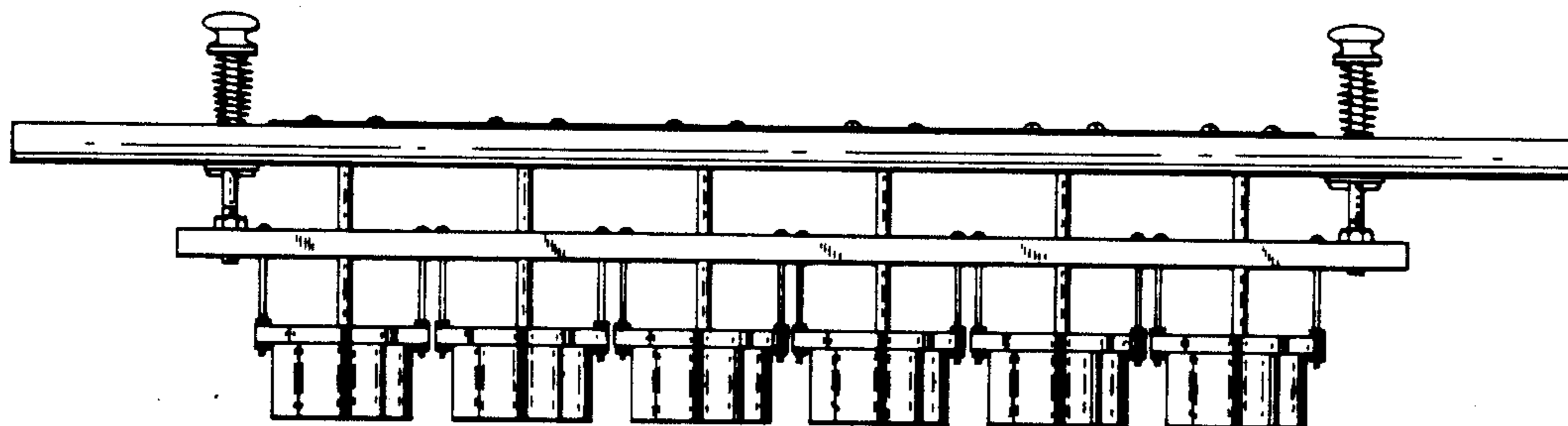

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



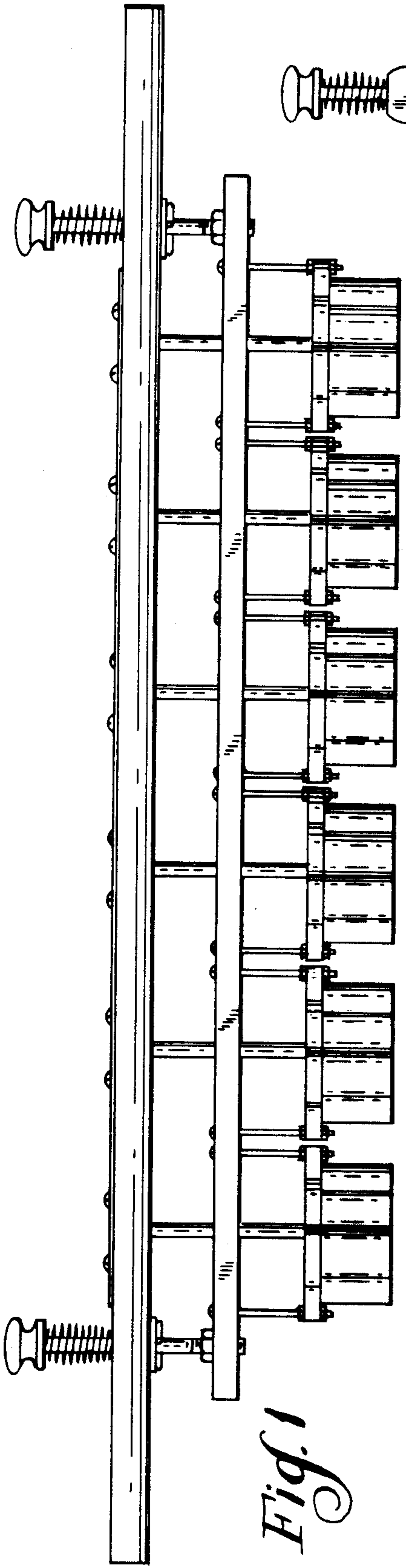

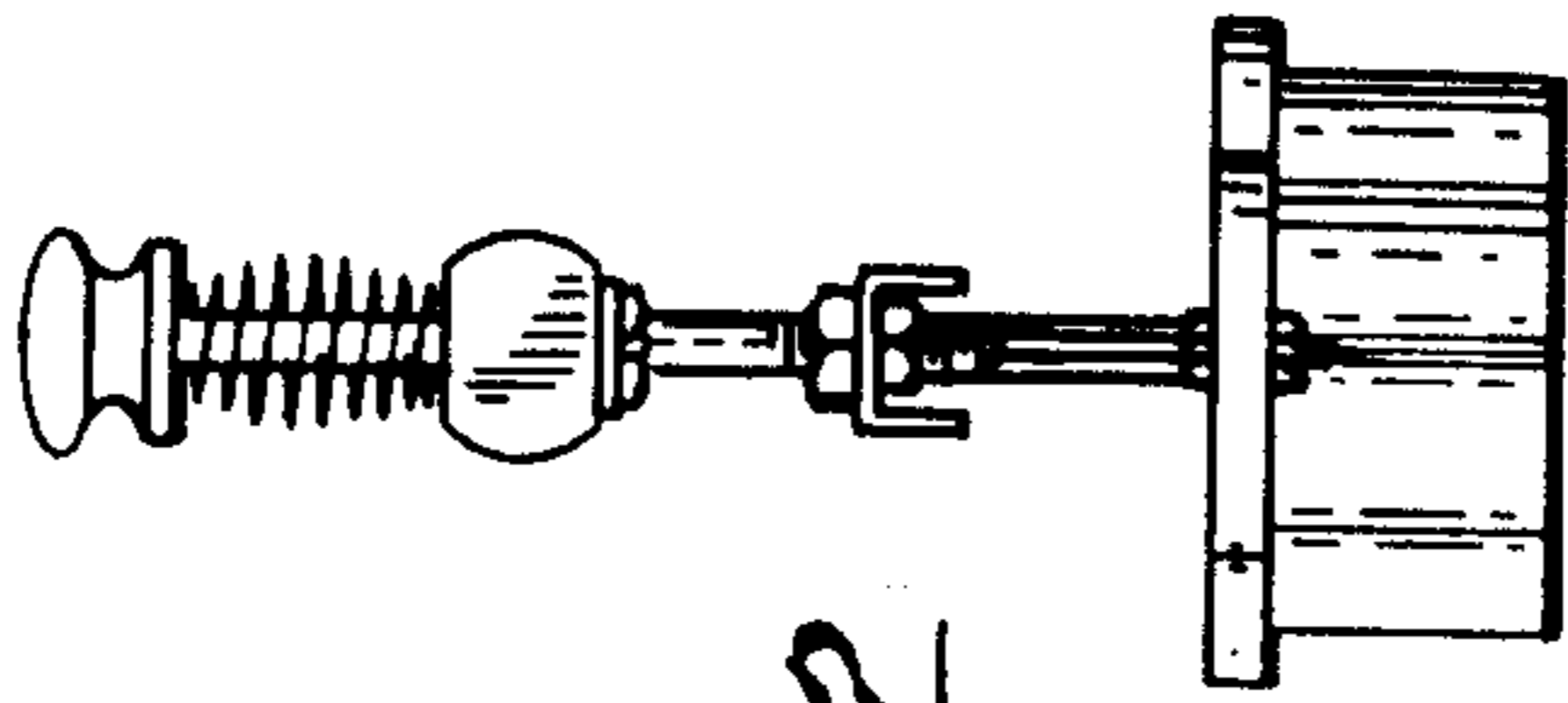

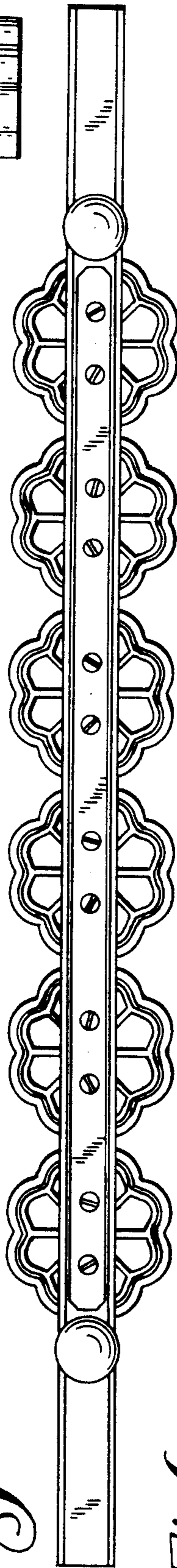

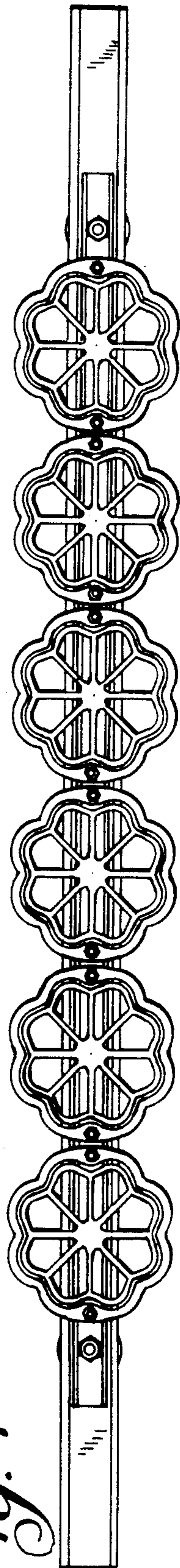
