FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 2.

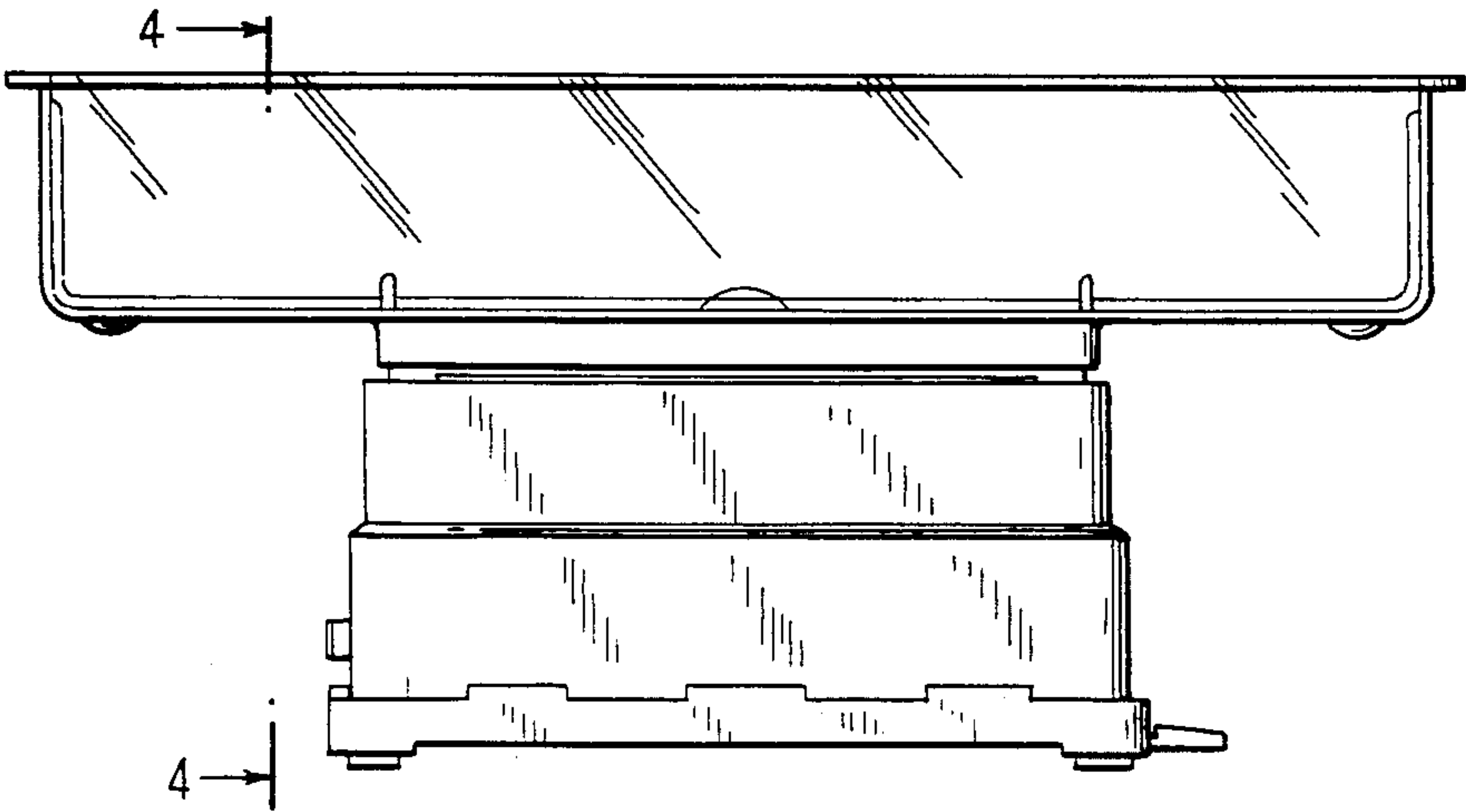

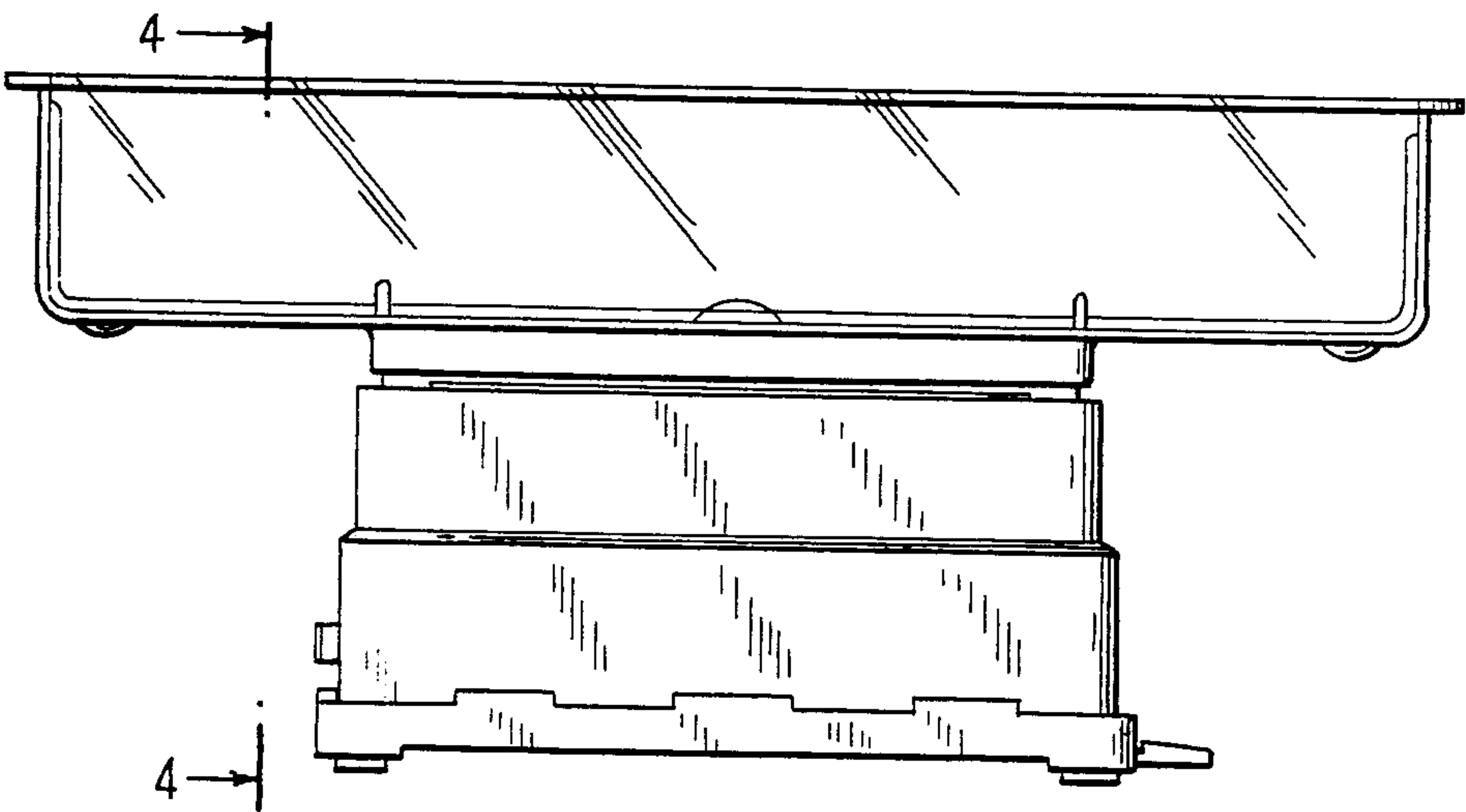
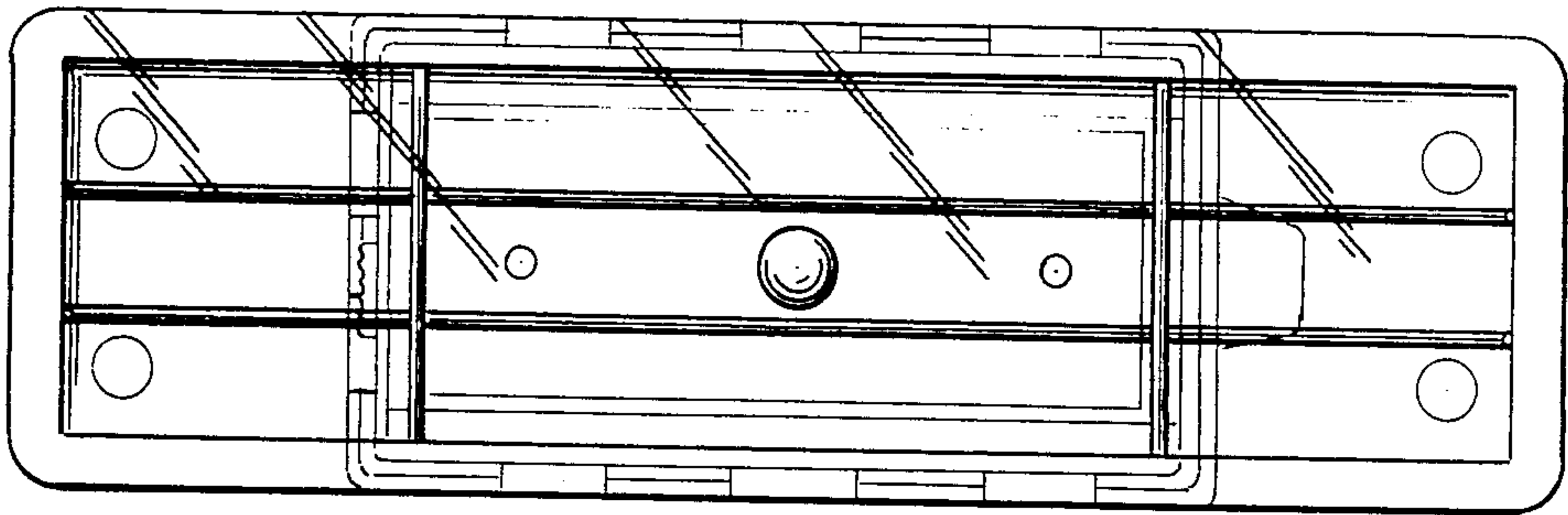

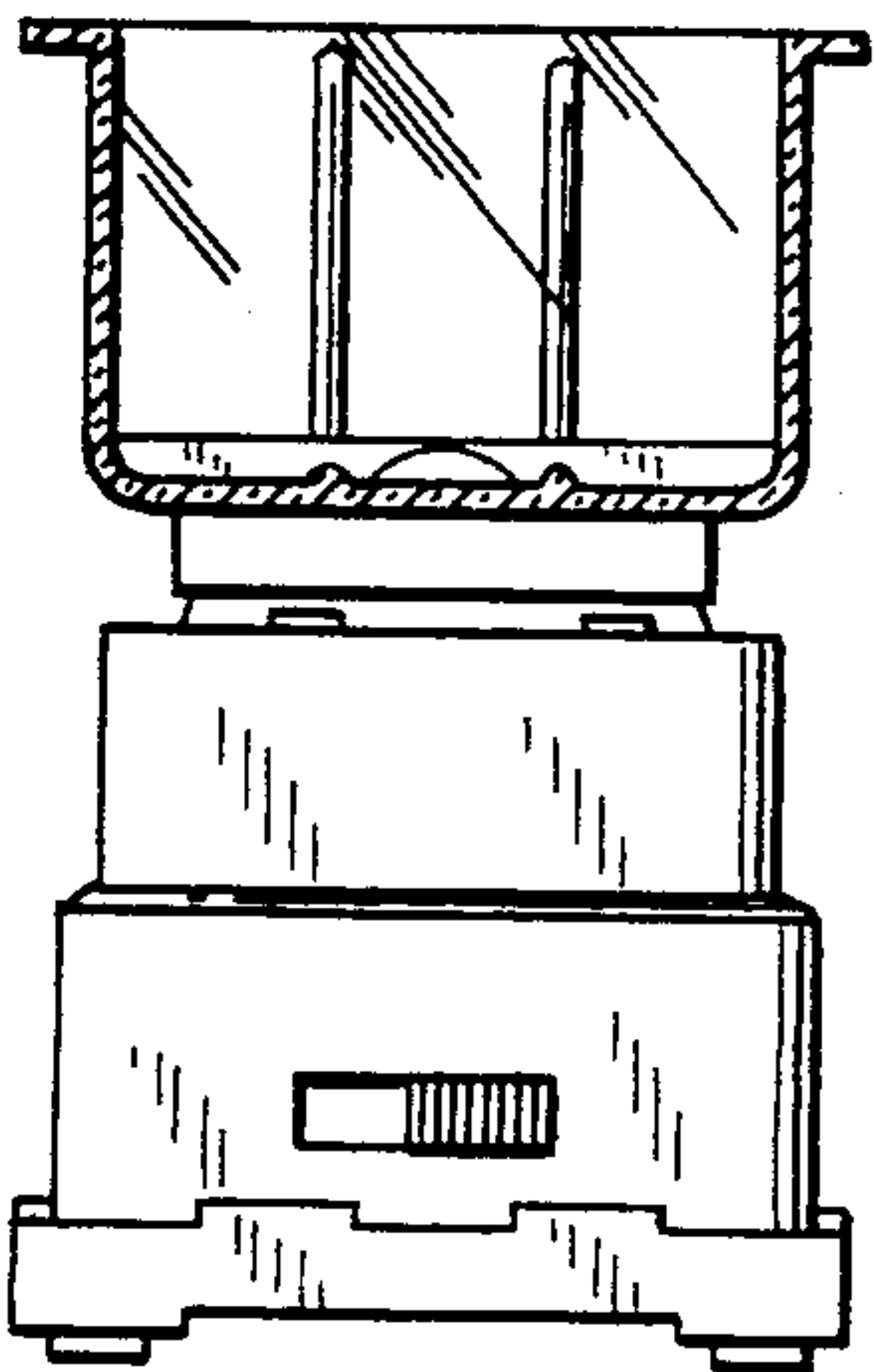

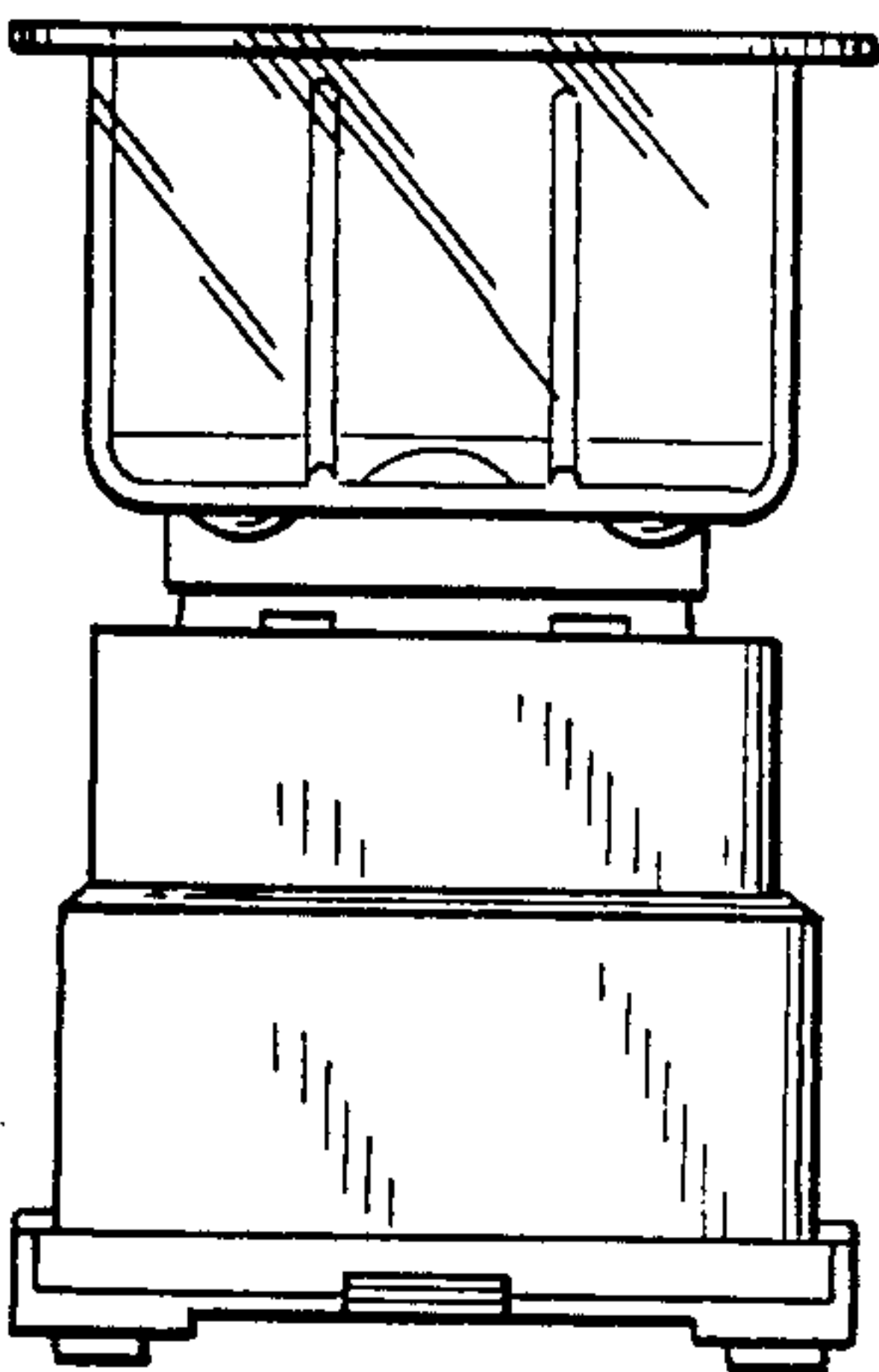
