FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

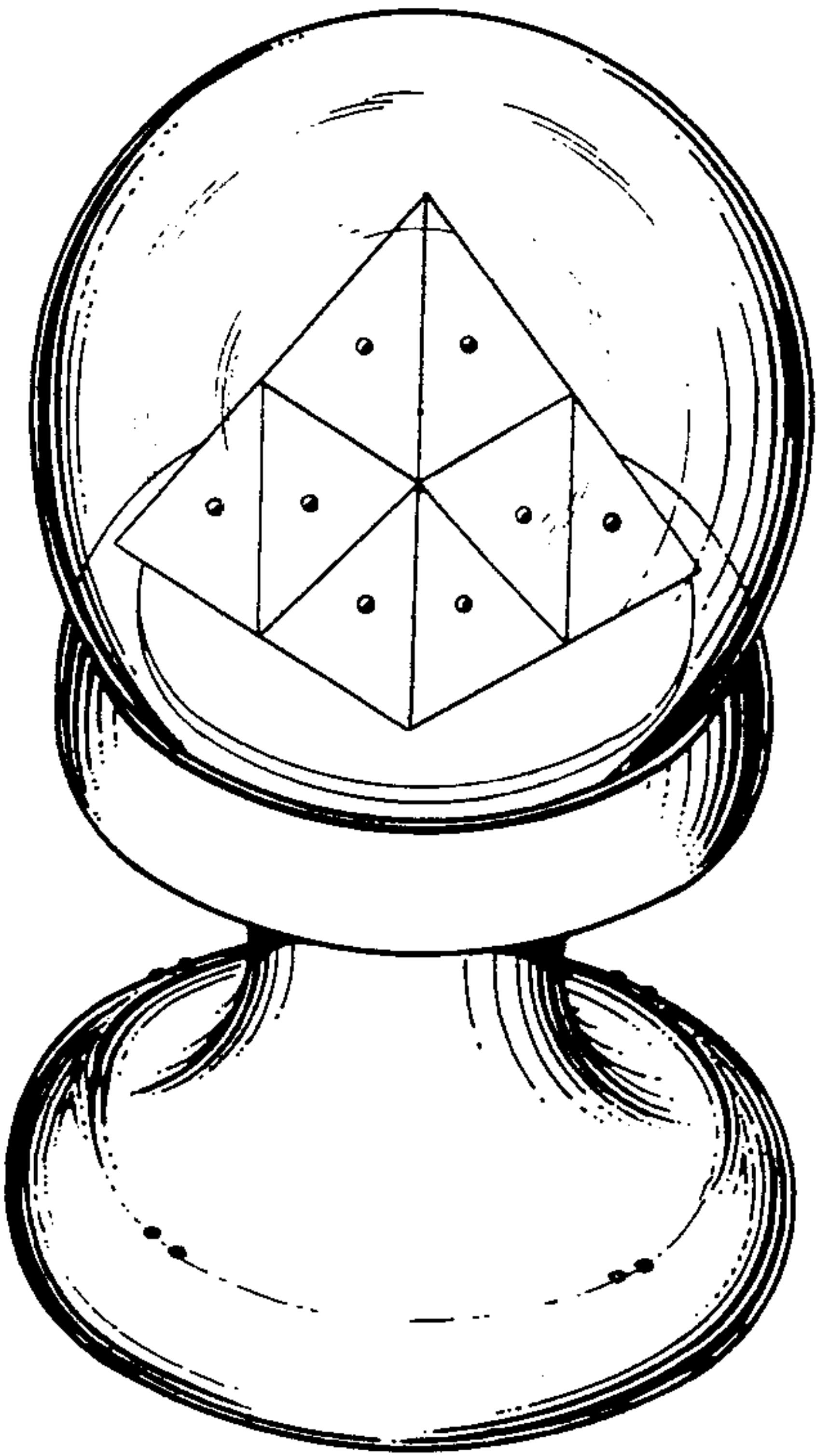

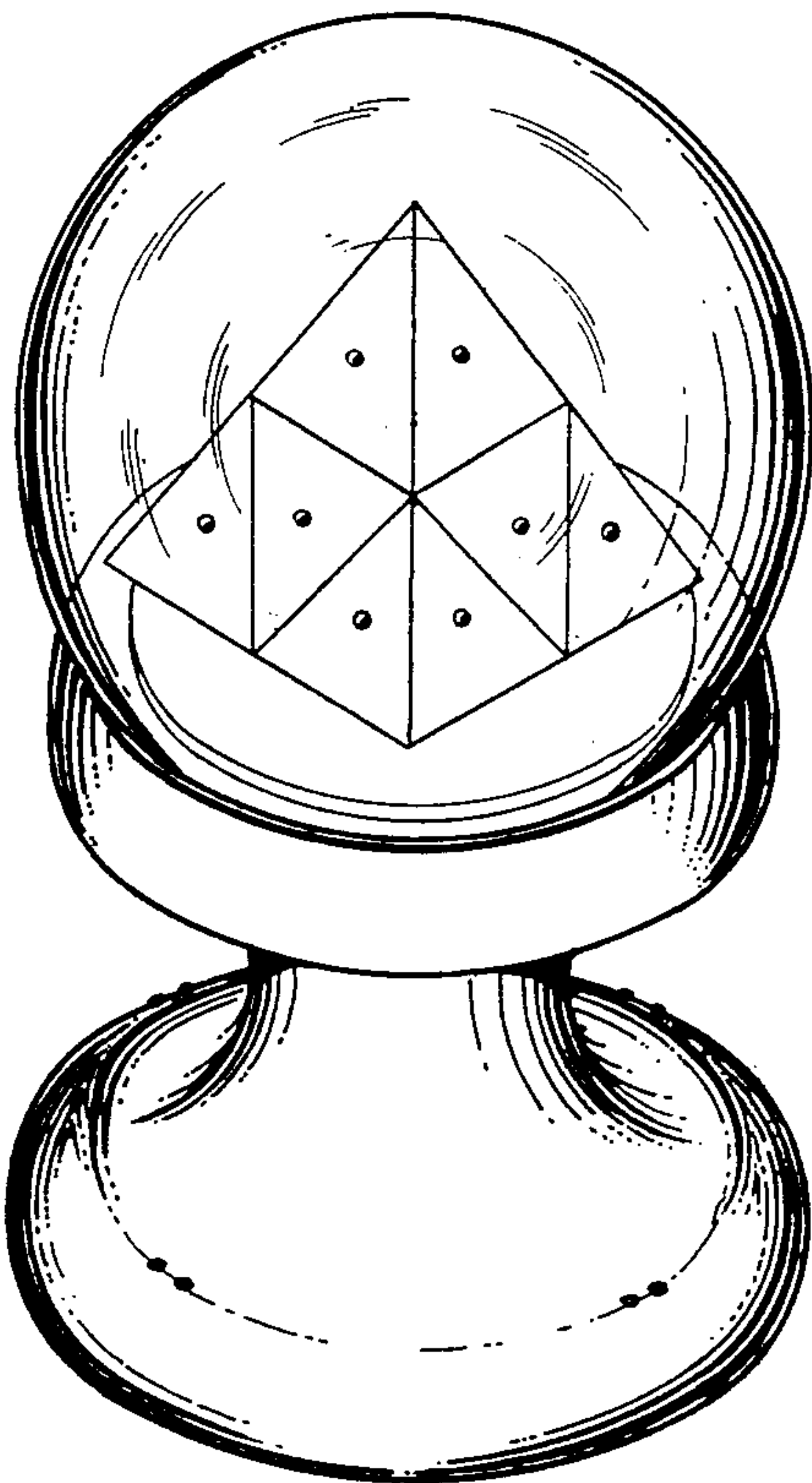
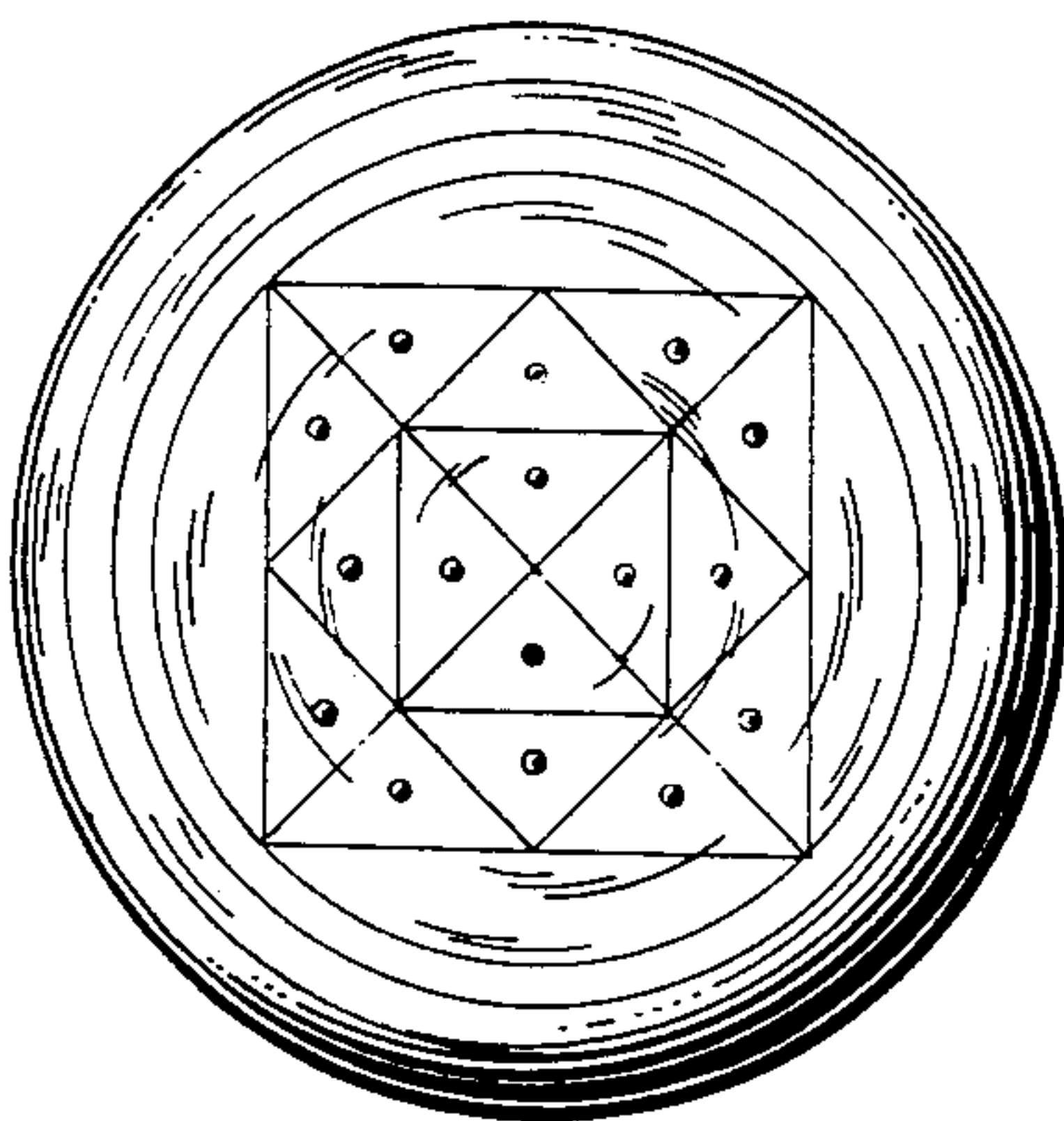

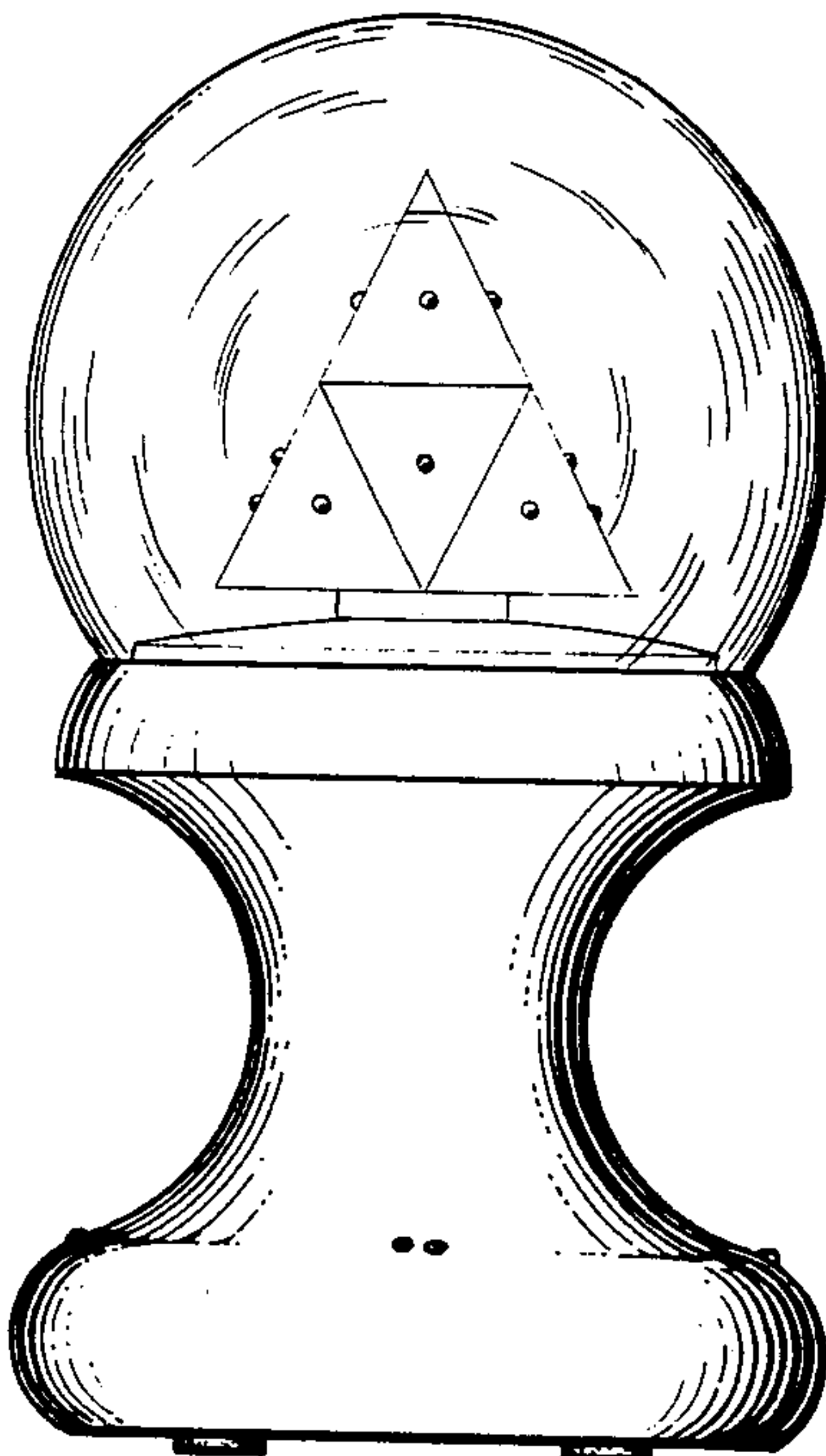

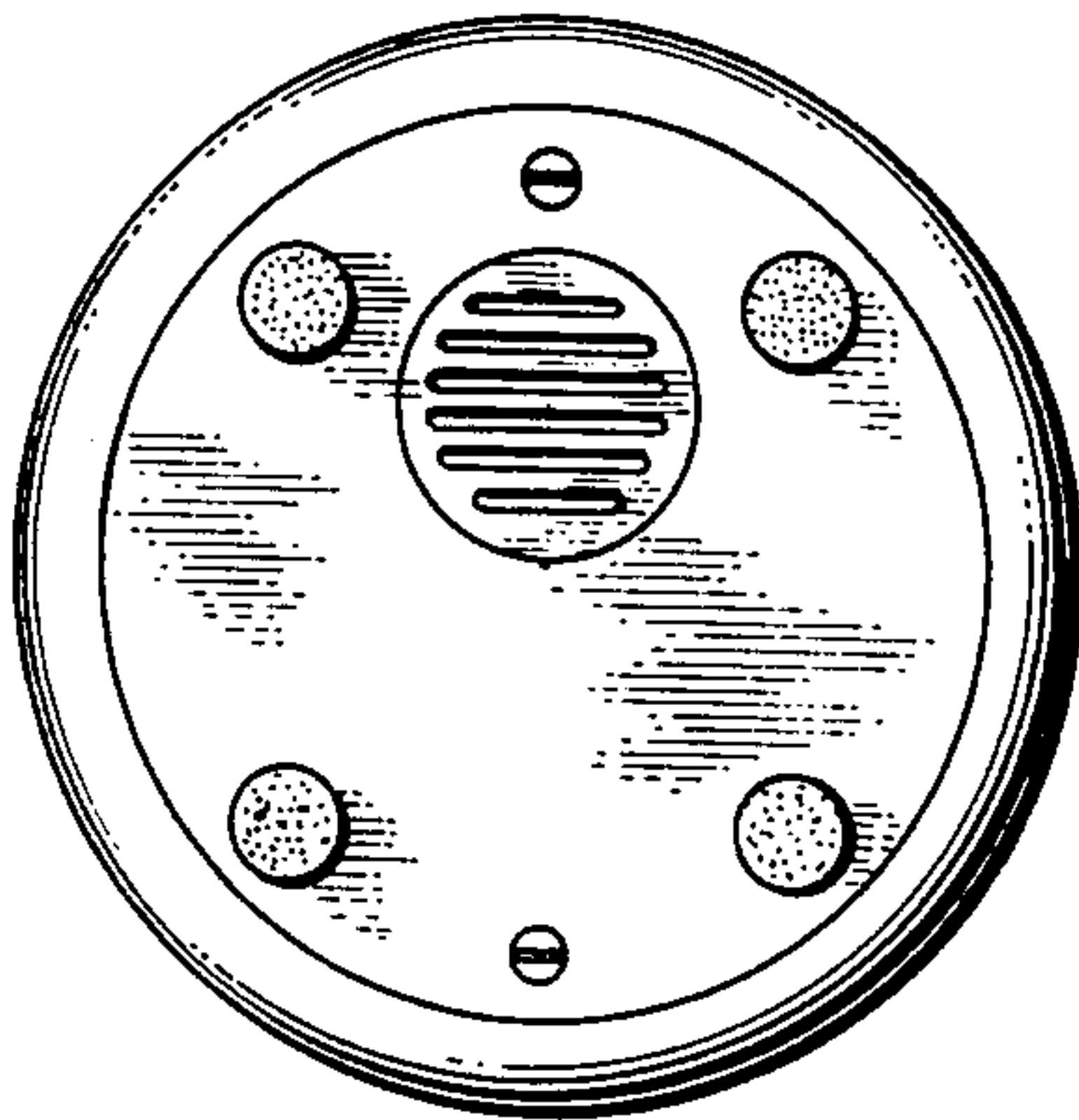
