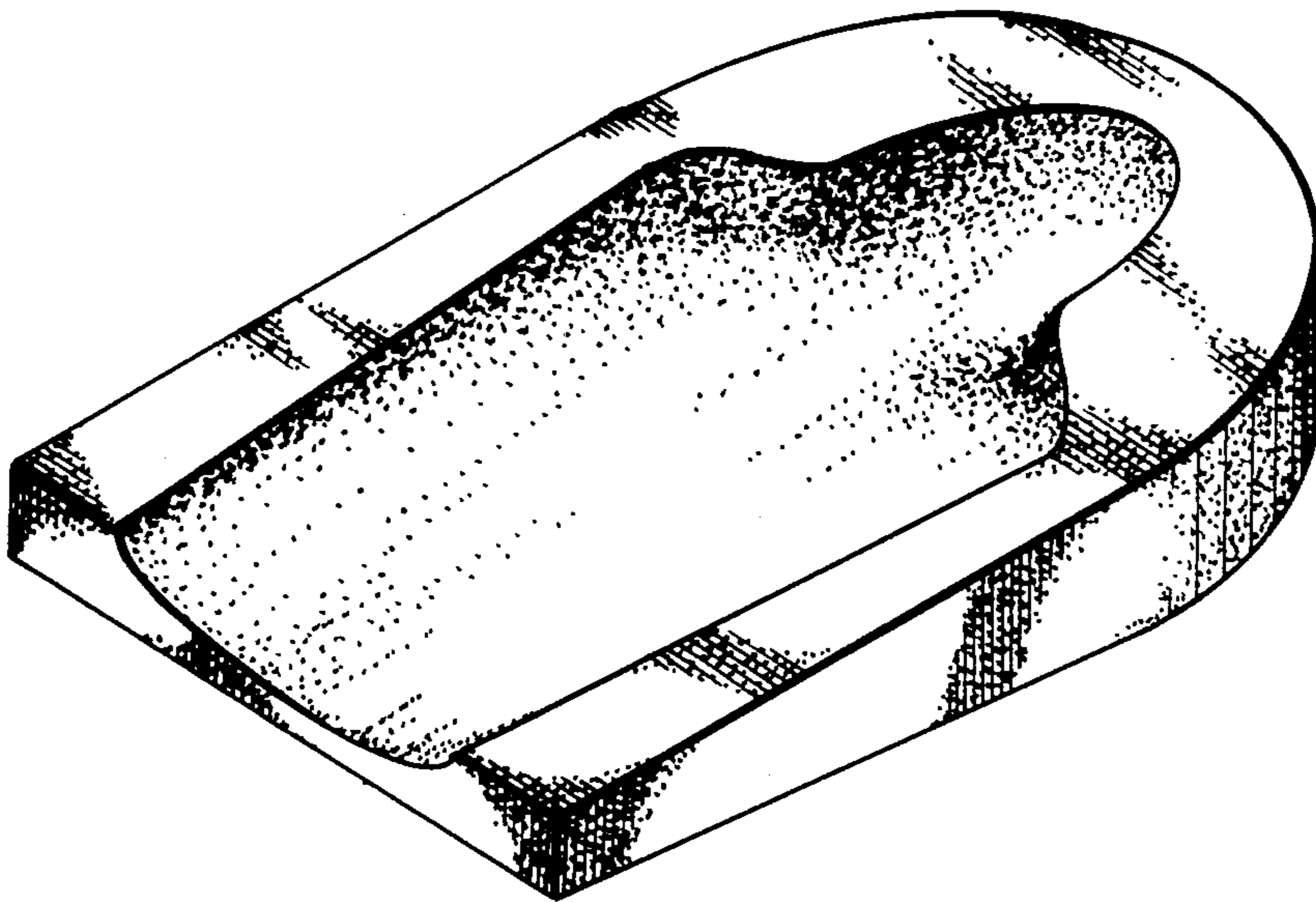
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a view of the other end.

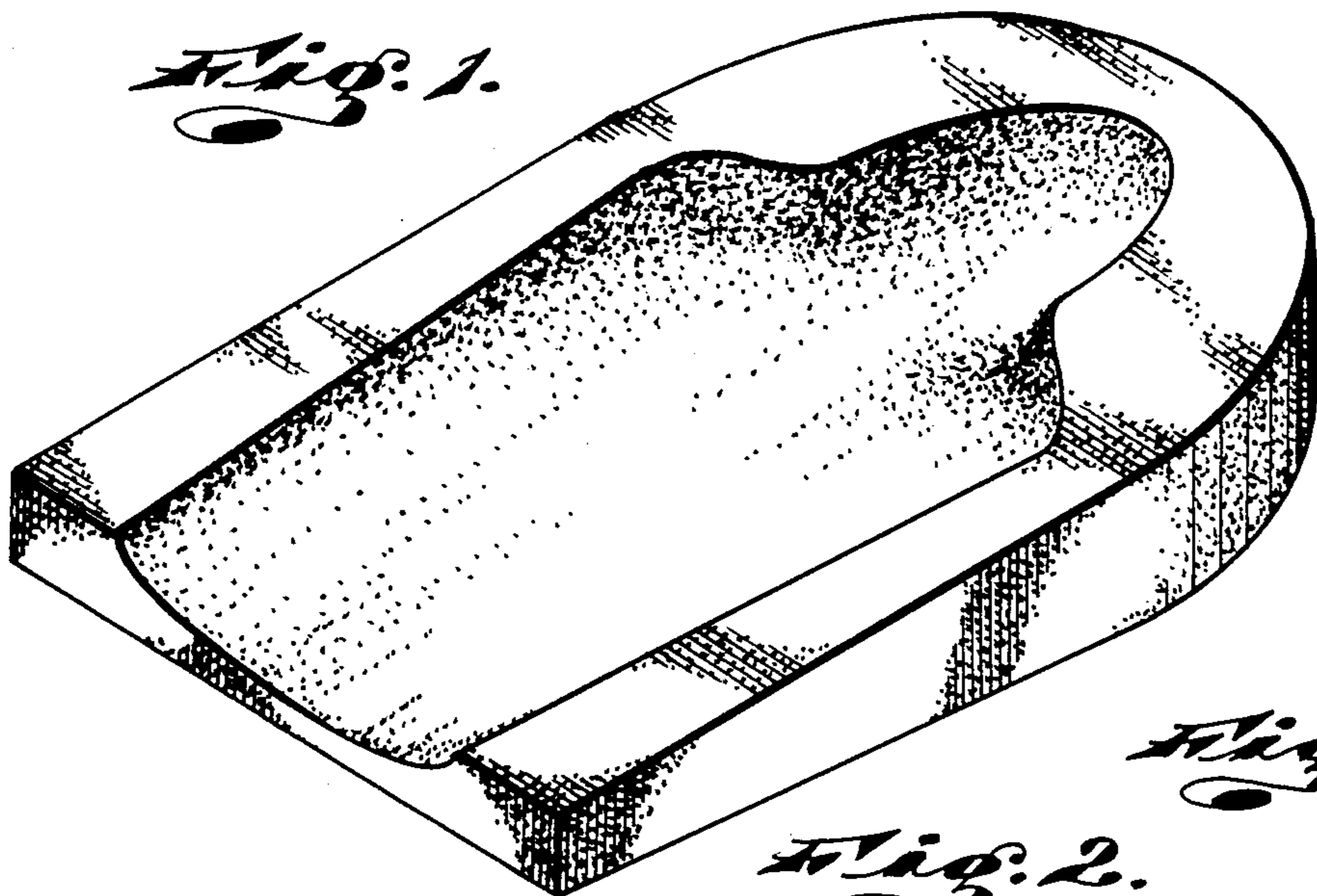

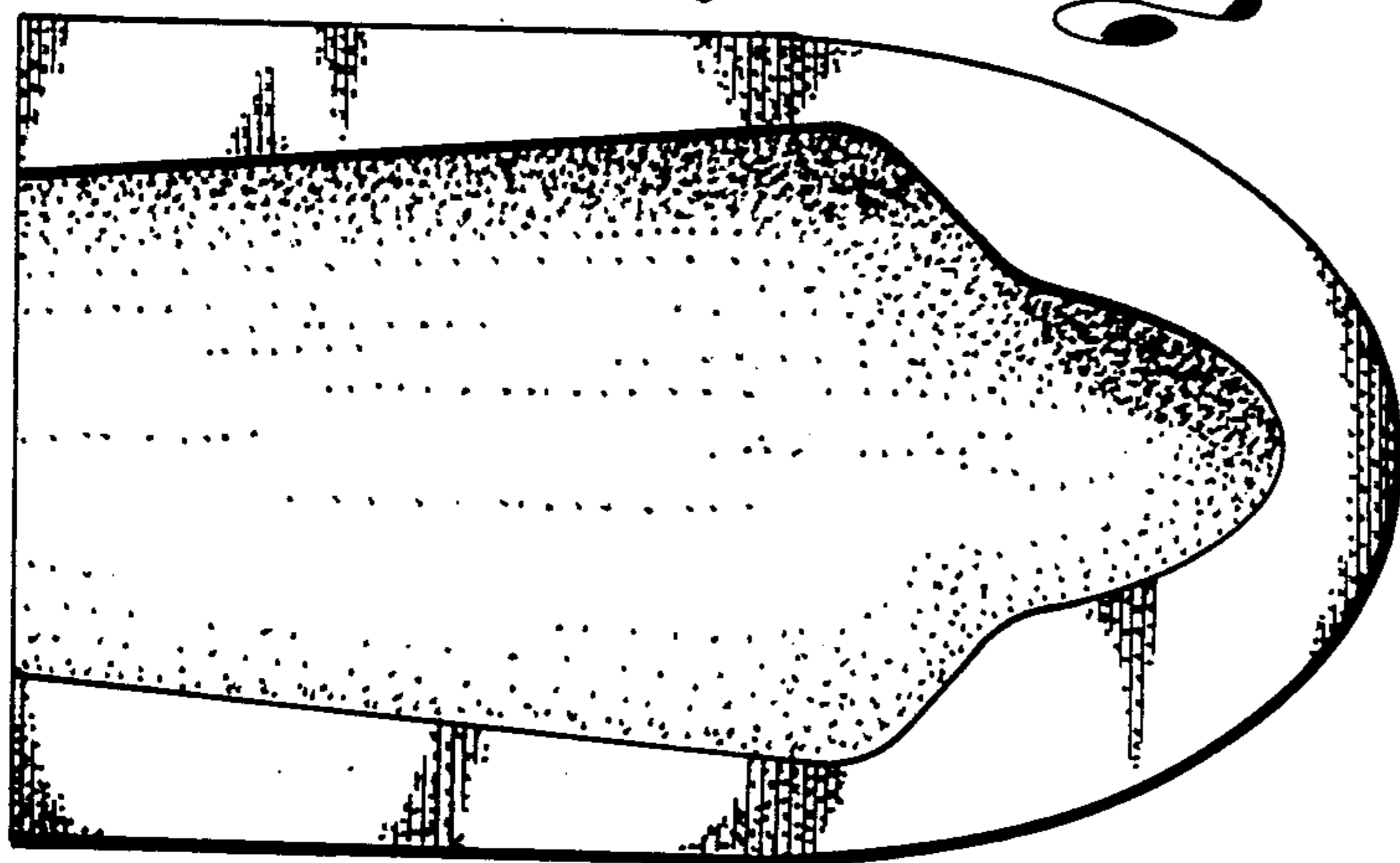

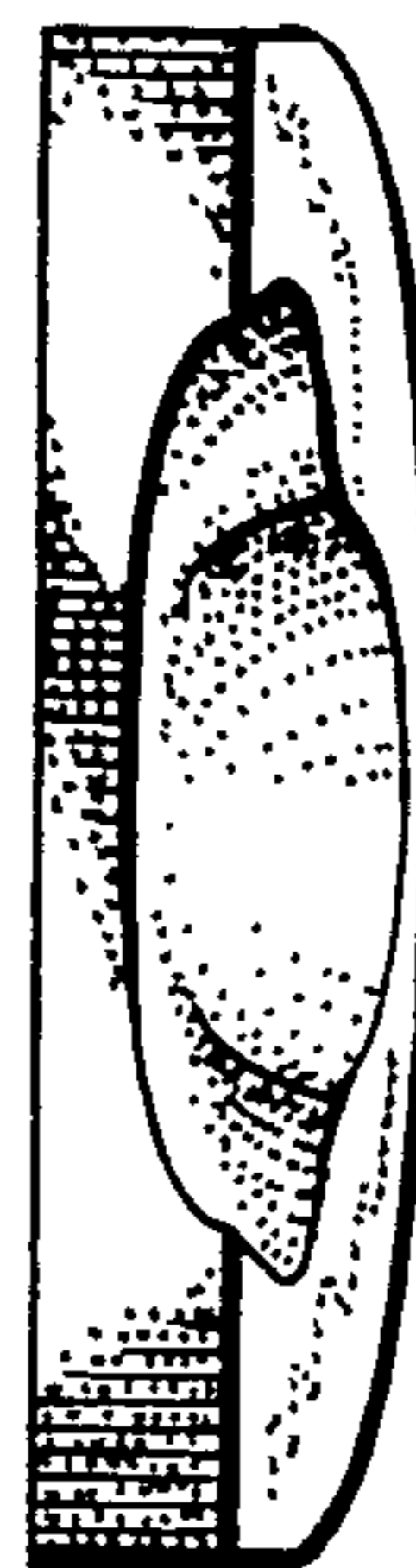

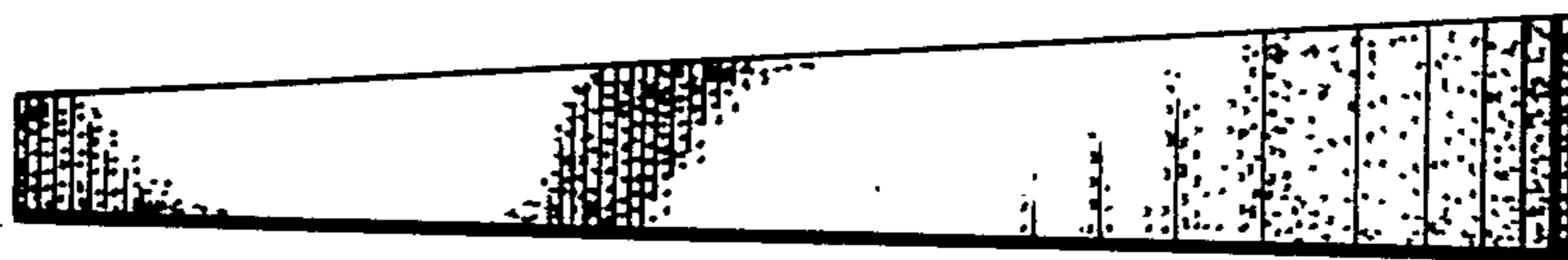
