CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined upper hull and boat interior, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined upper hull and boat interior showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof. The bottom of the boat is shown in dashed lines in FIGS. 2, 4 and 5 for illustrative purposes only and does not form part of my claimed design.

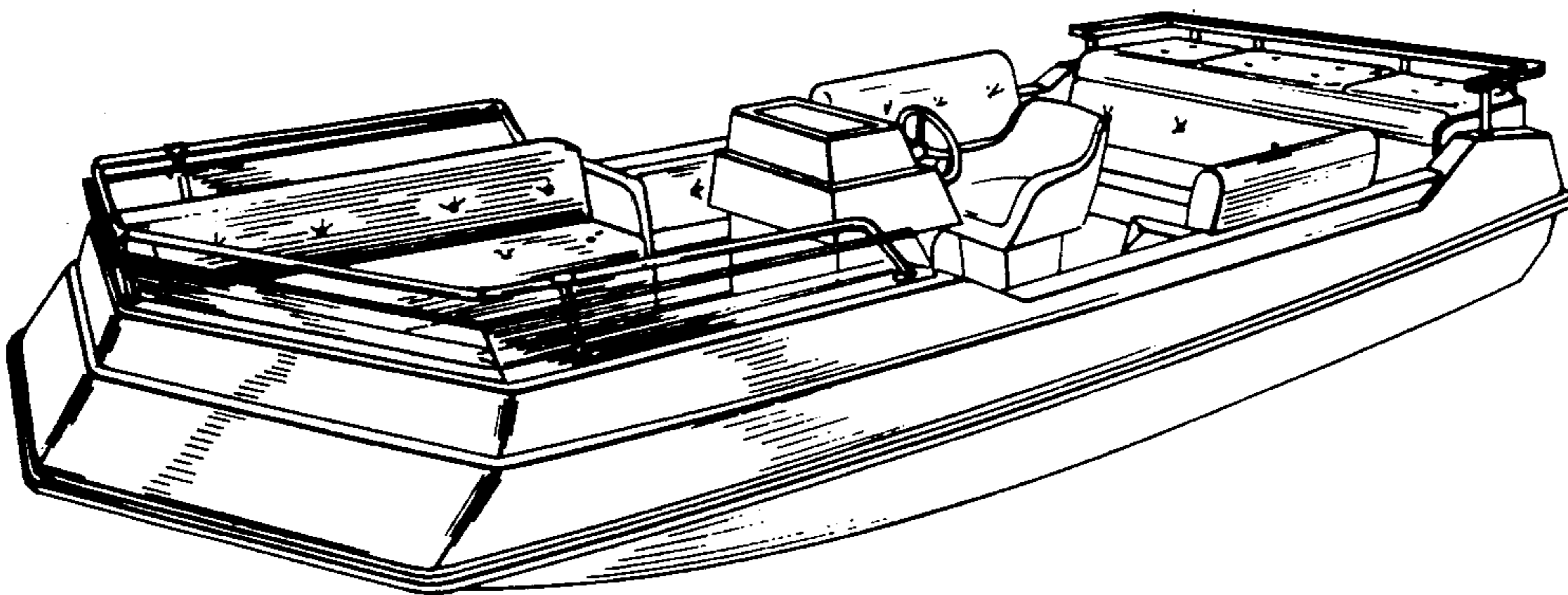

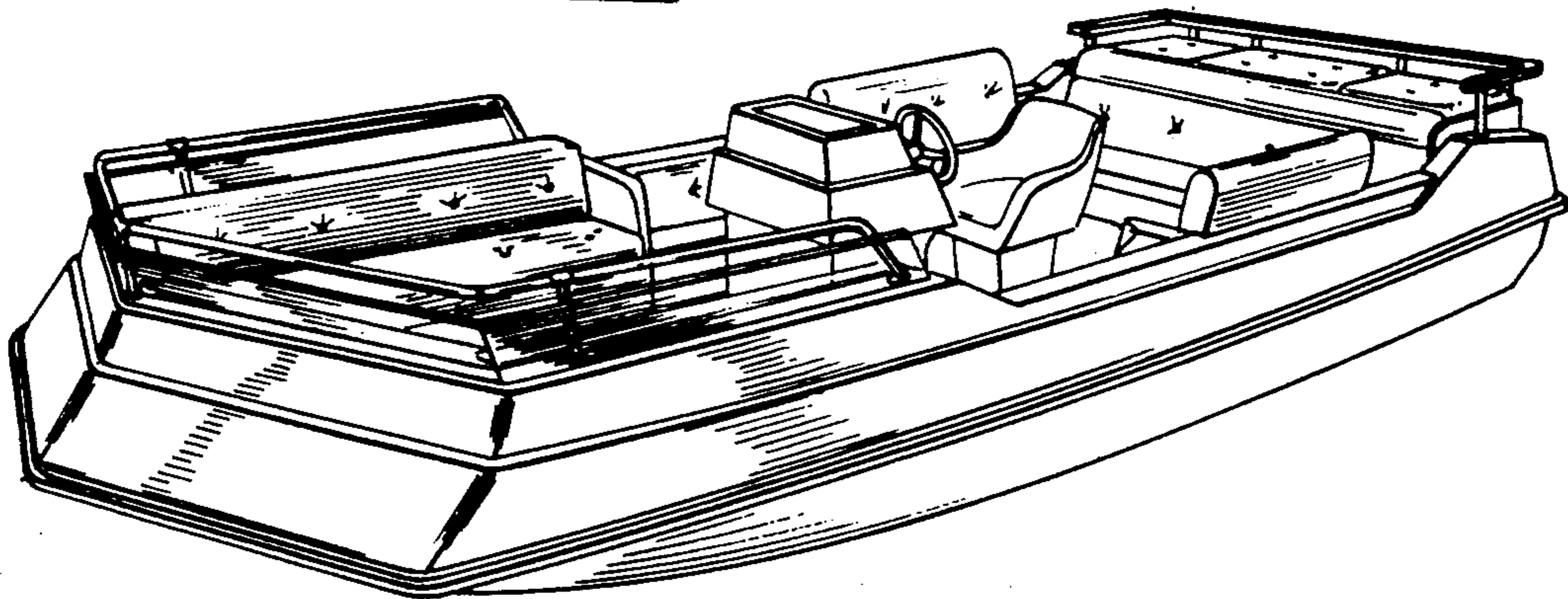

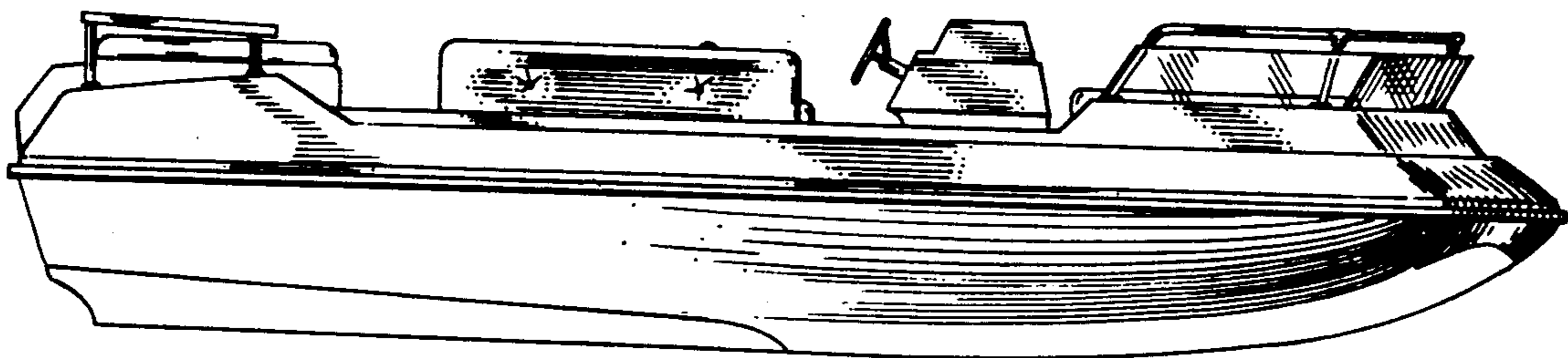

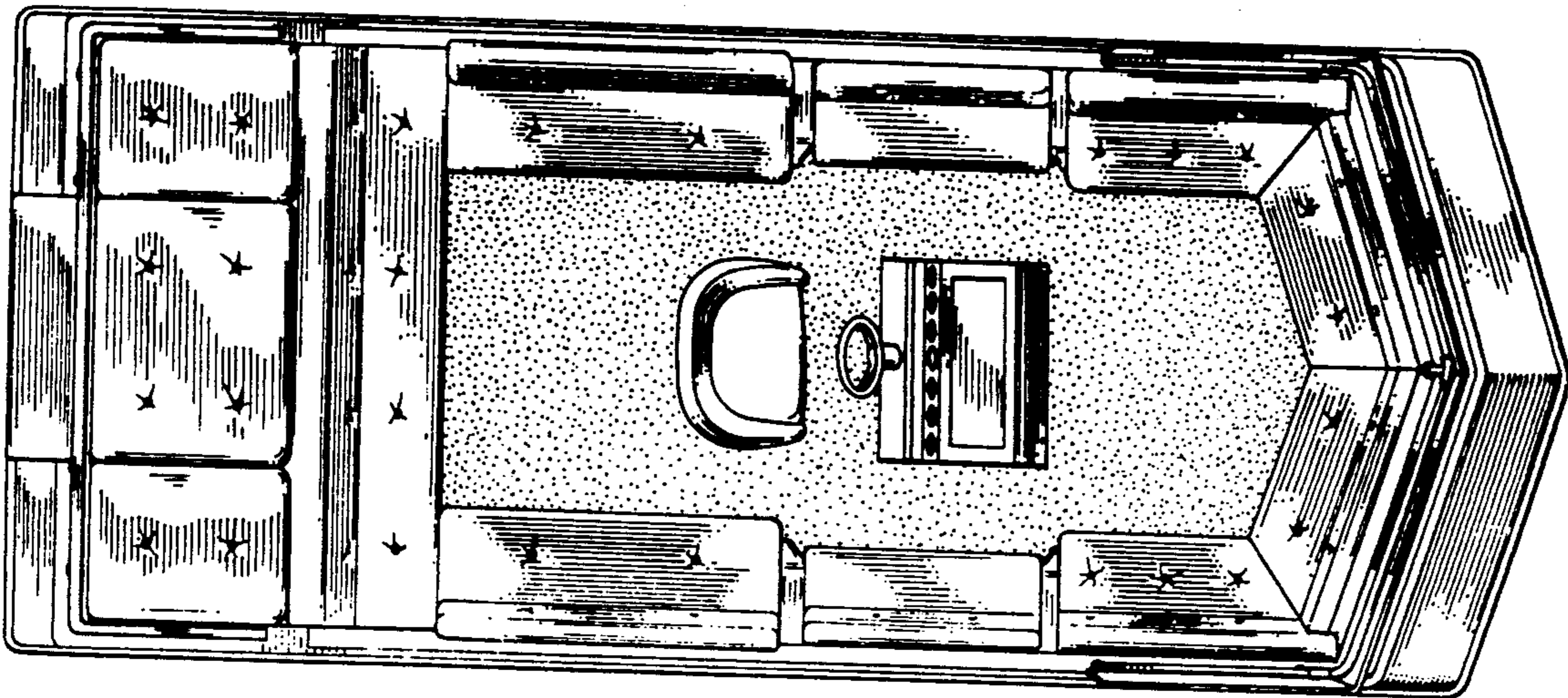

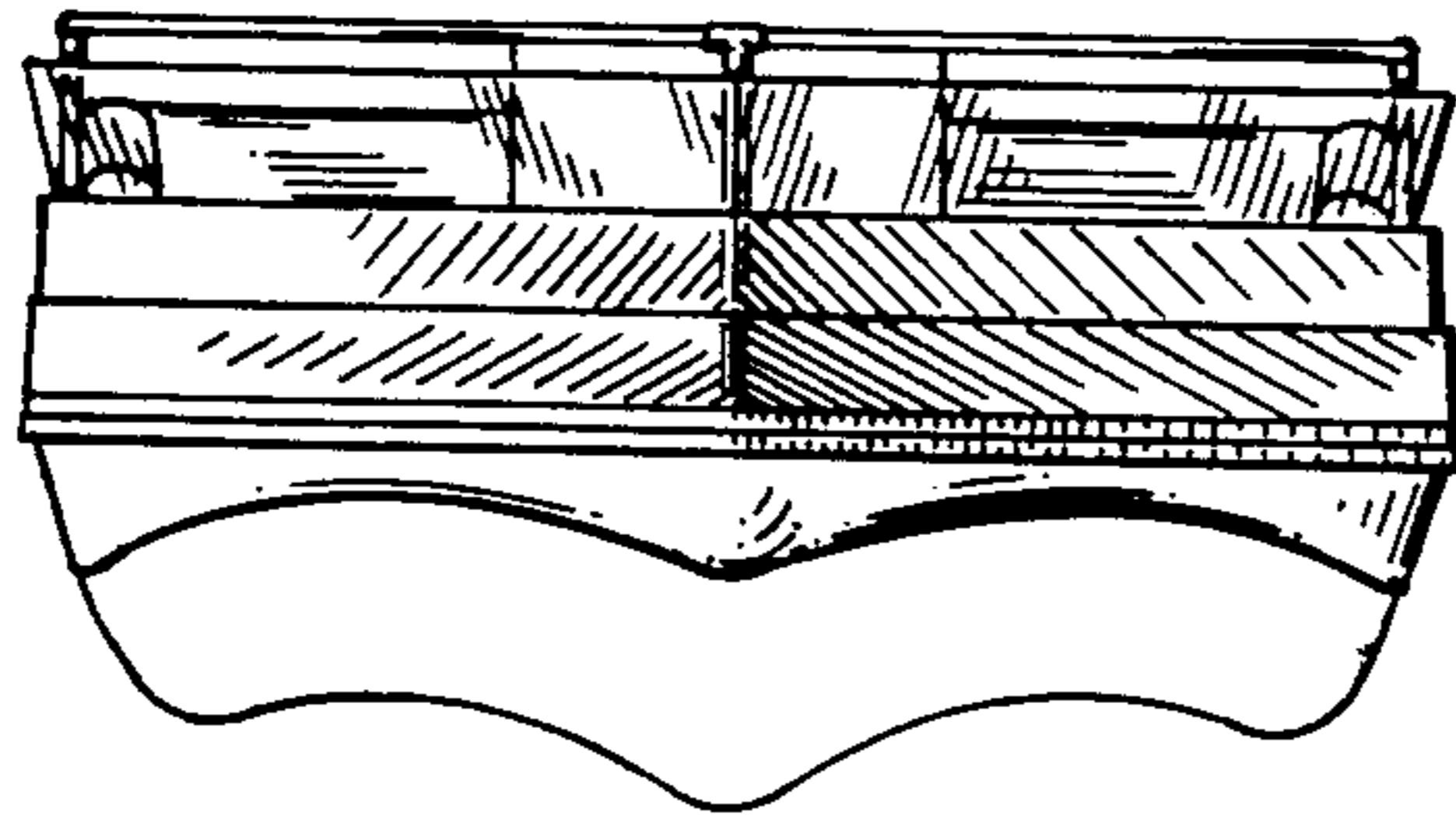
