FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bass guitar showing my new design;

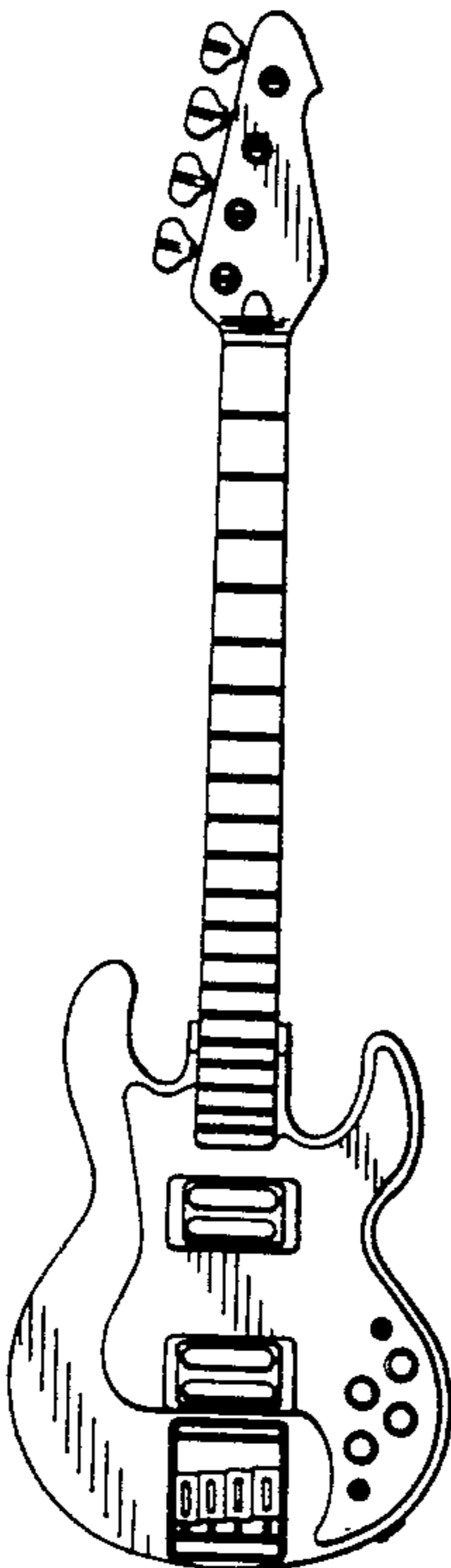
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view.



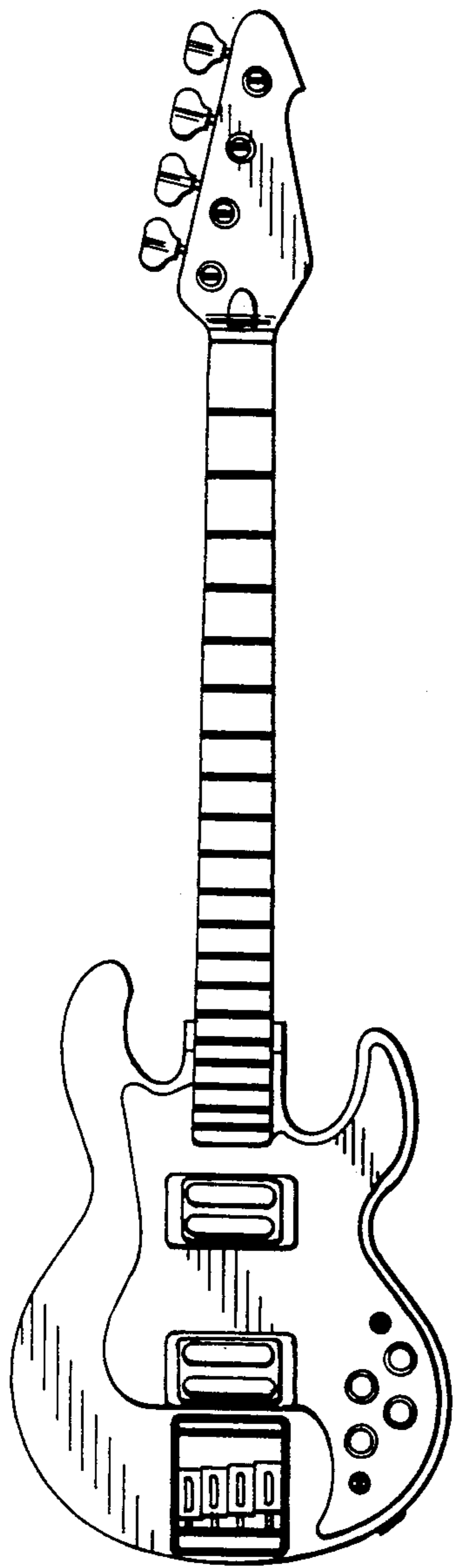

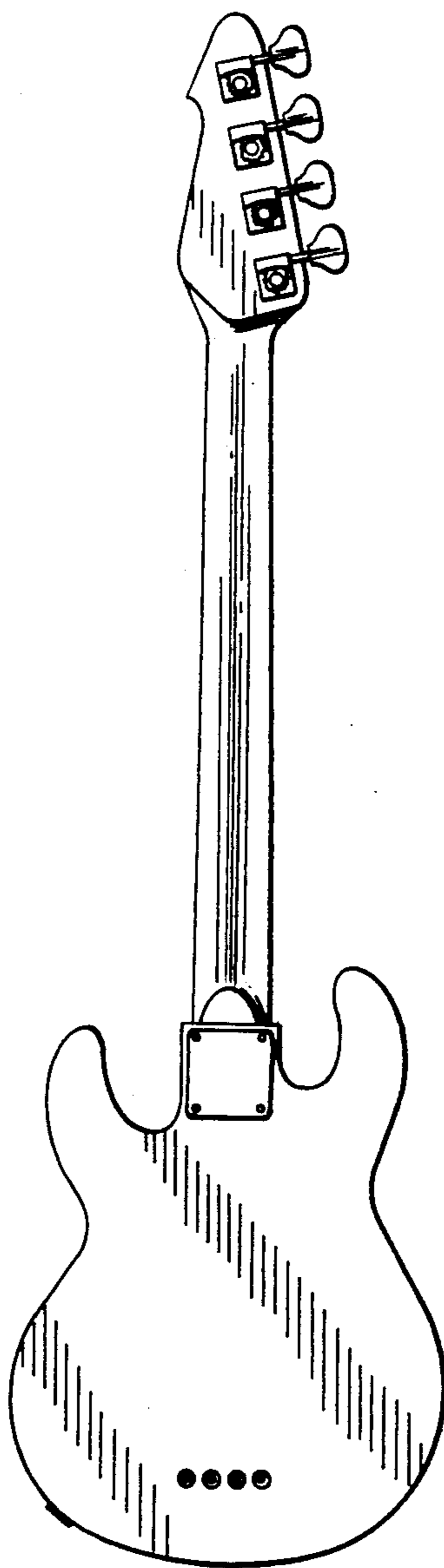

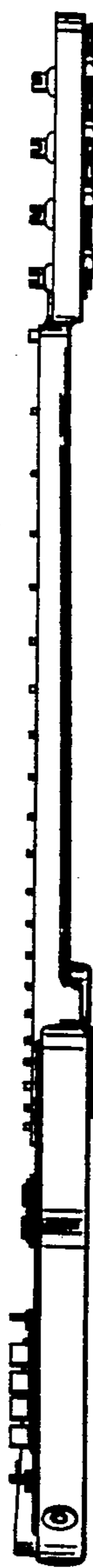
