DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a floating game board showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

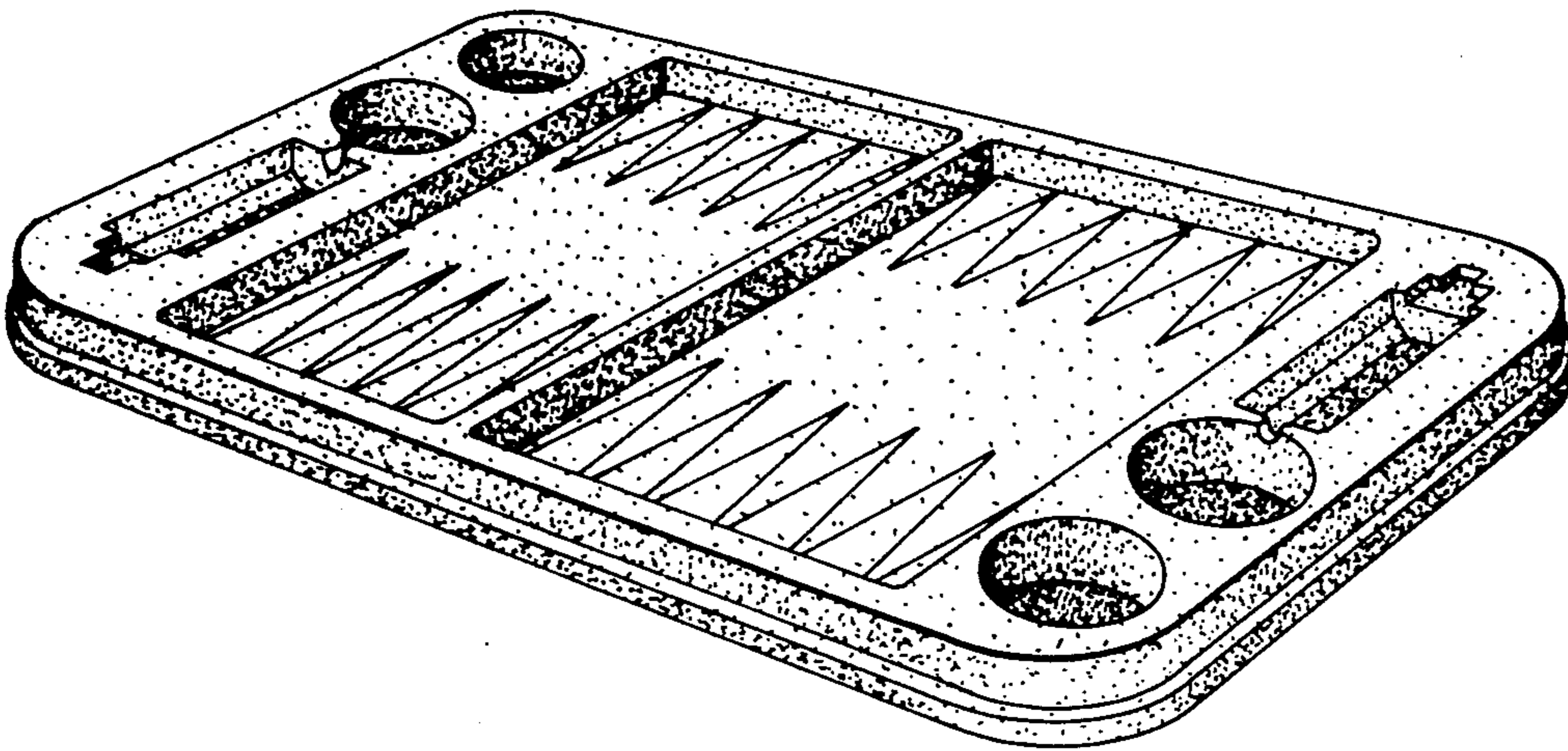
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

The side and end of the floating game board not shown are identical to the side and end shown.



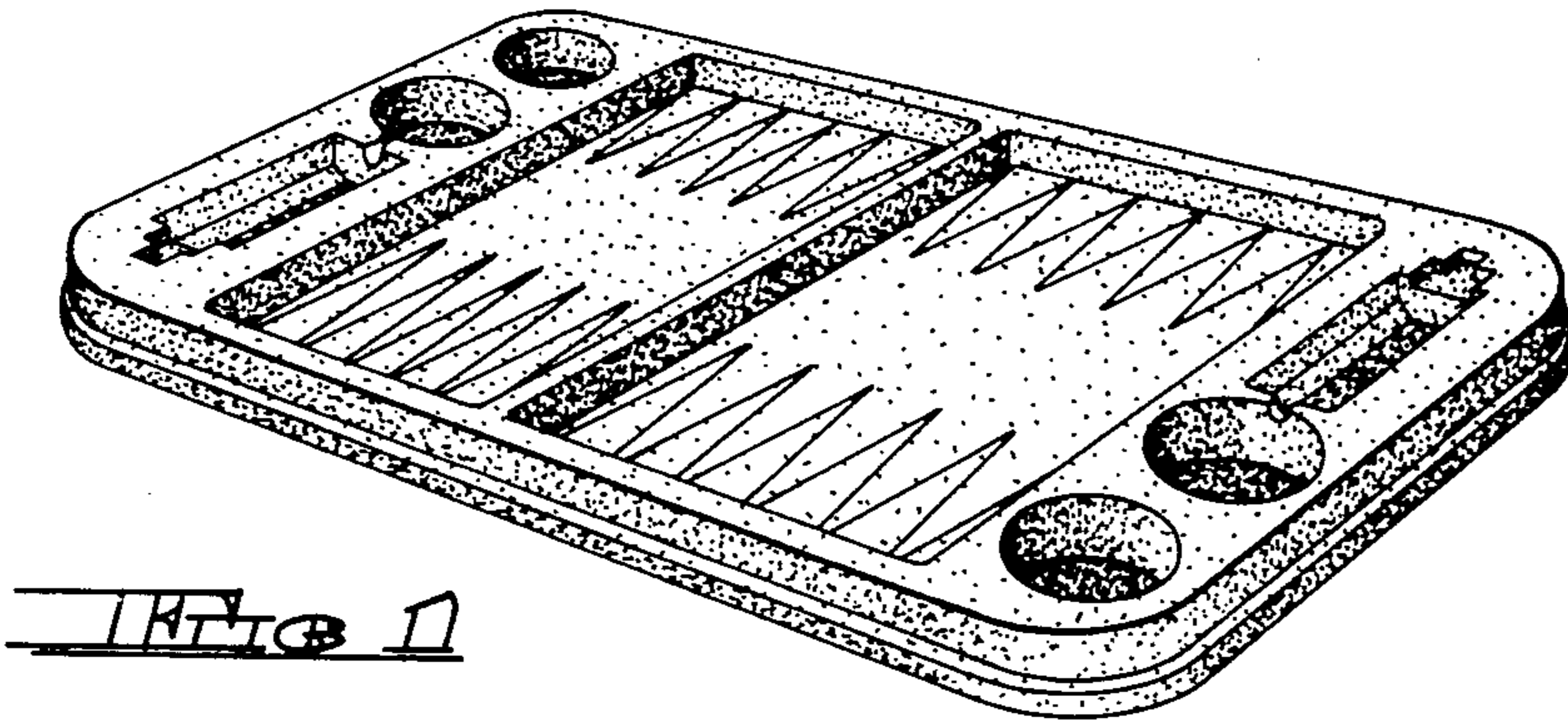

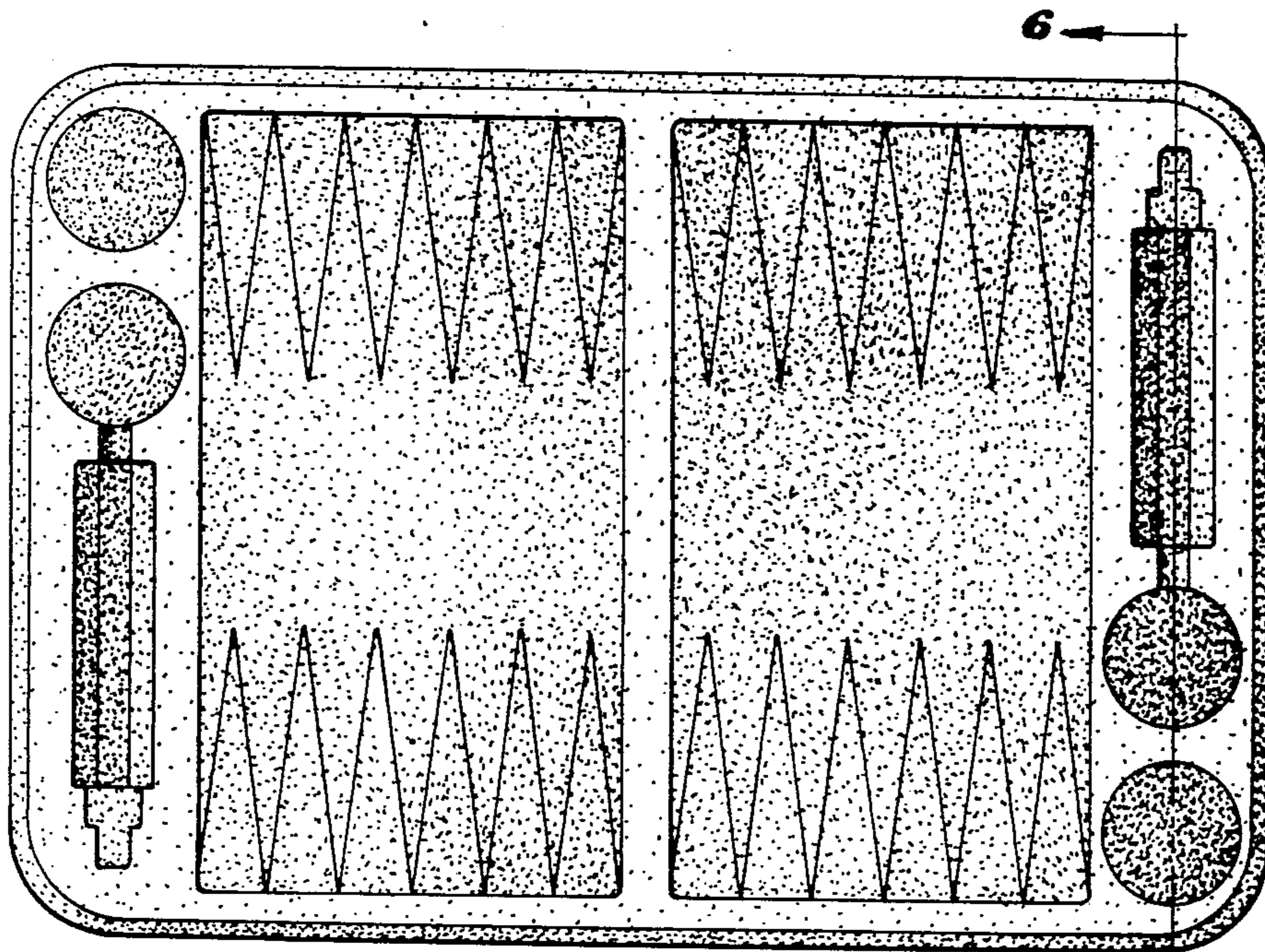

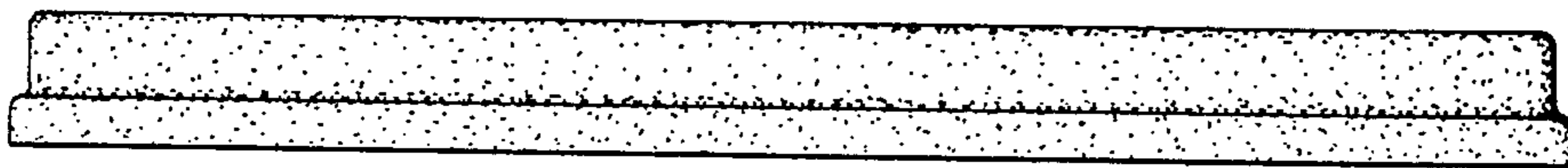

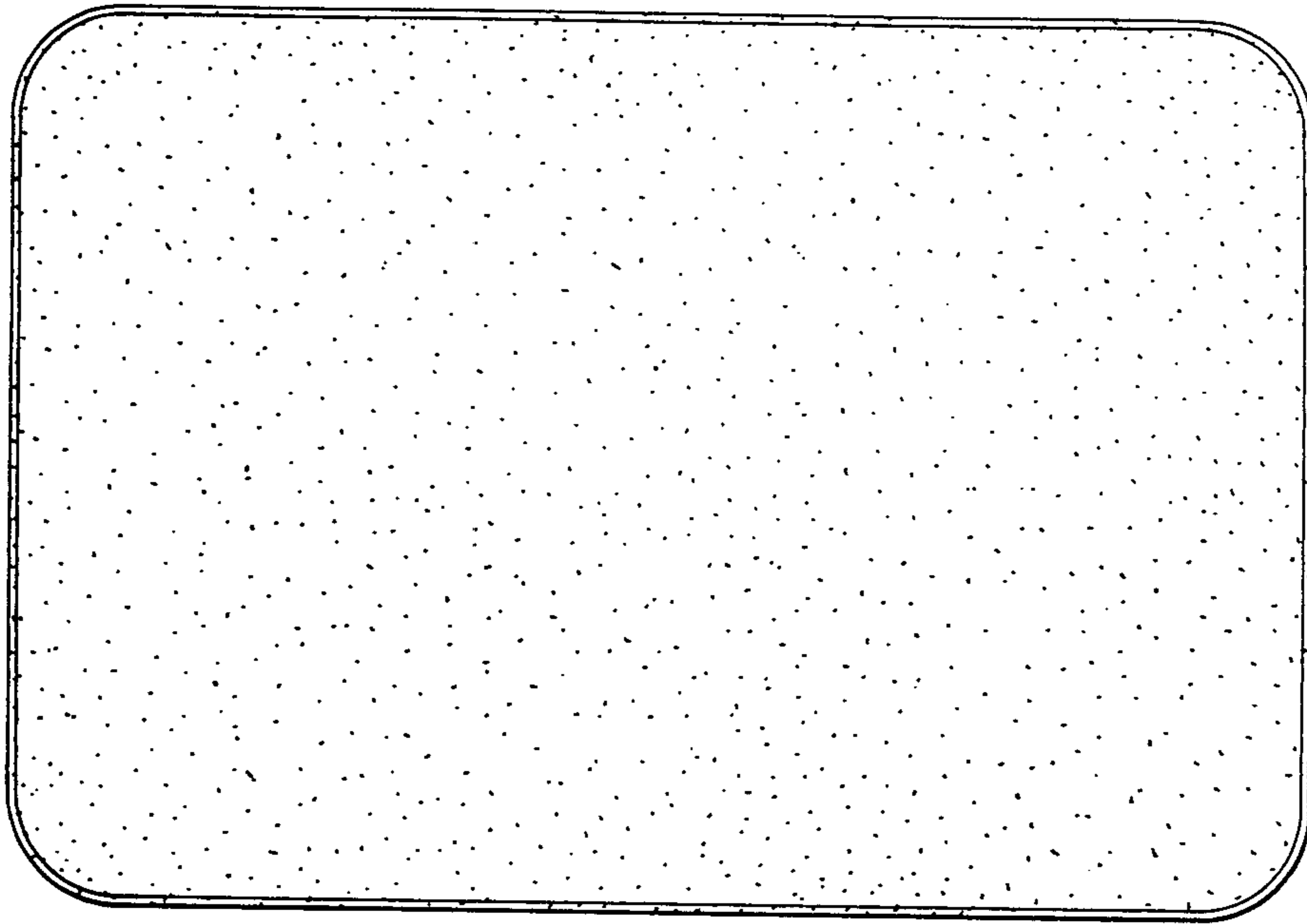

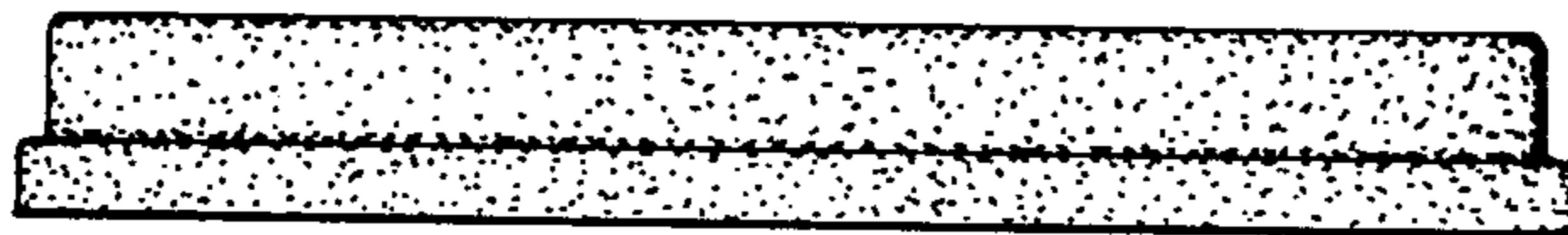

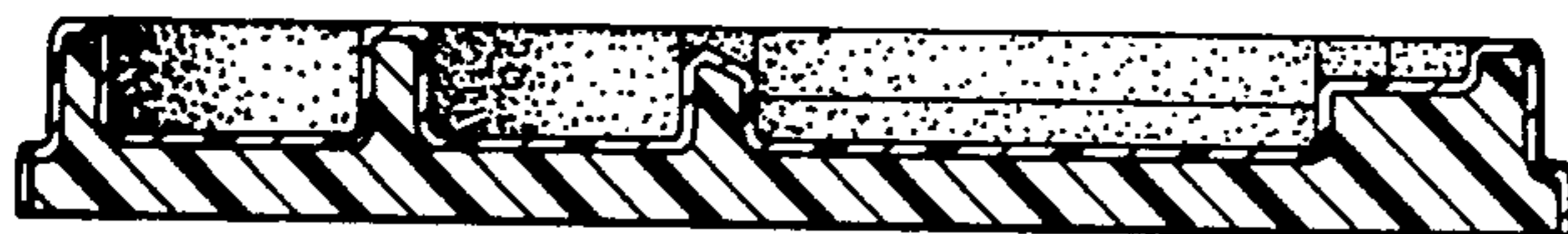
