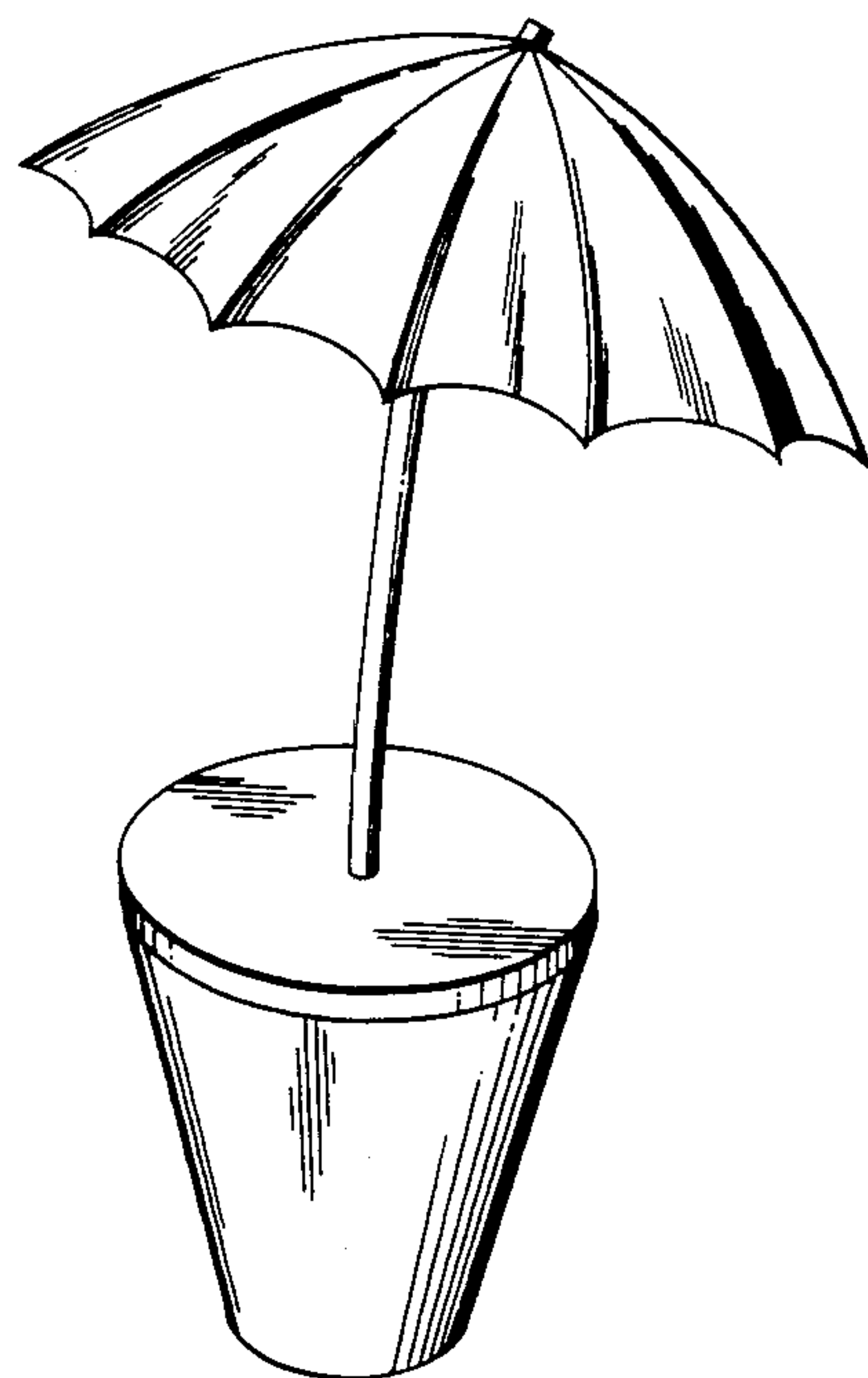

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a combined table and umbrella in accordance with this invention.
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.
The undisclosed portions of the umbrella are conventional while the portion of the conical base not shown are the same in appearance as the portions shown.



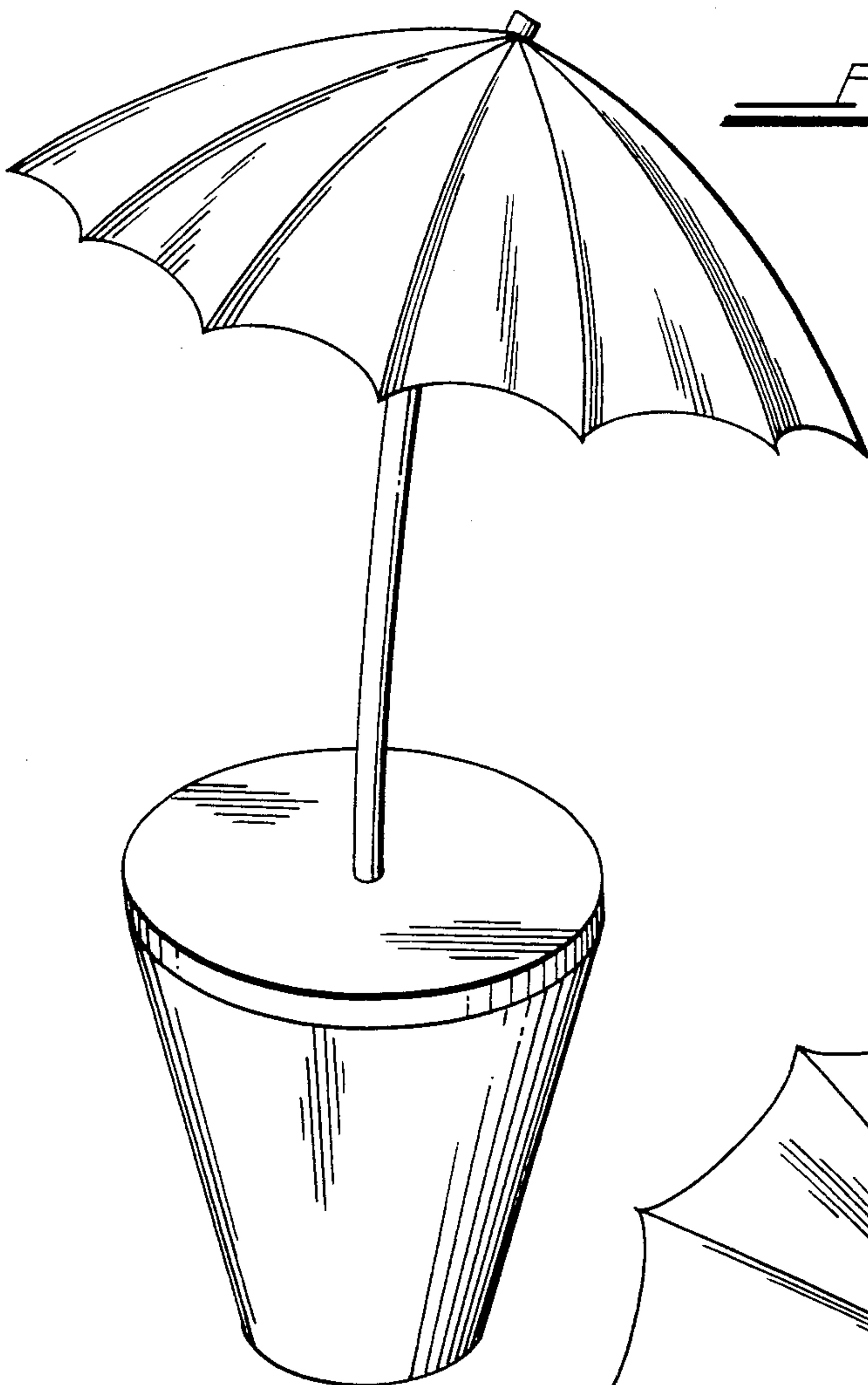

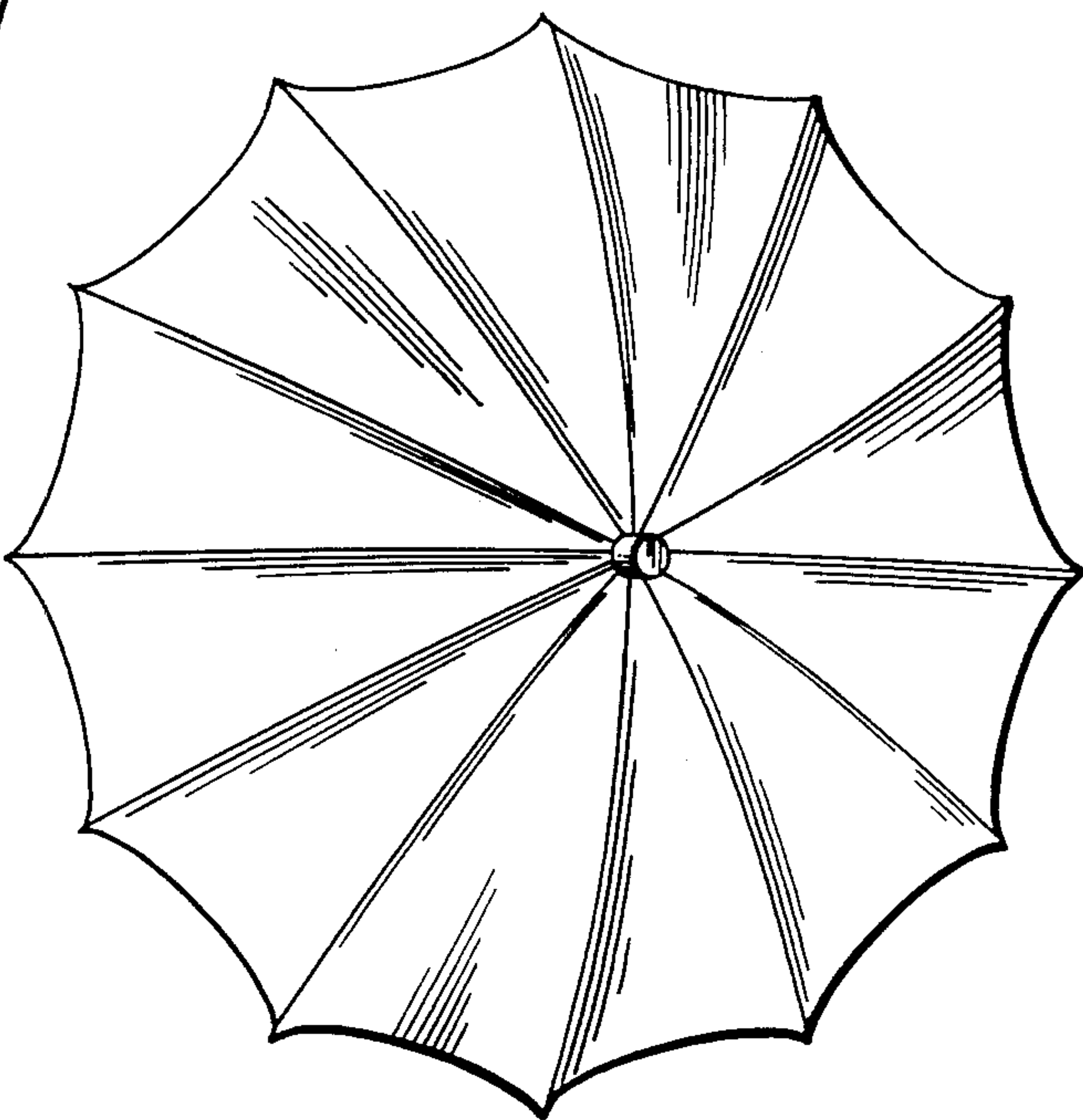
