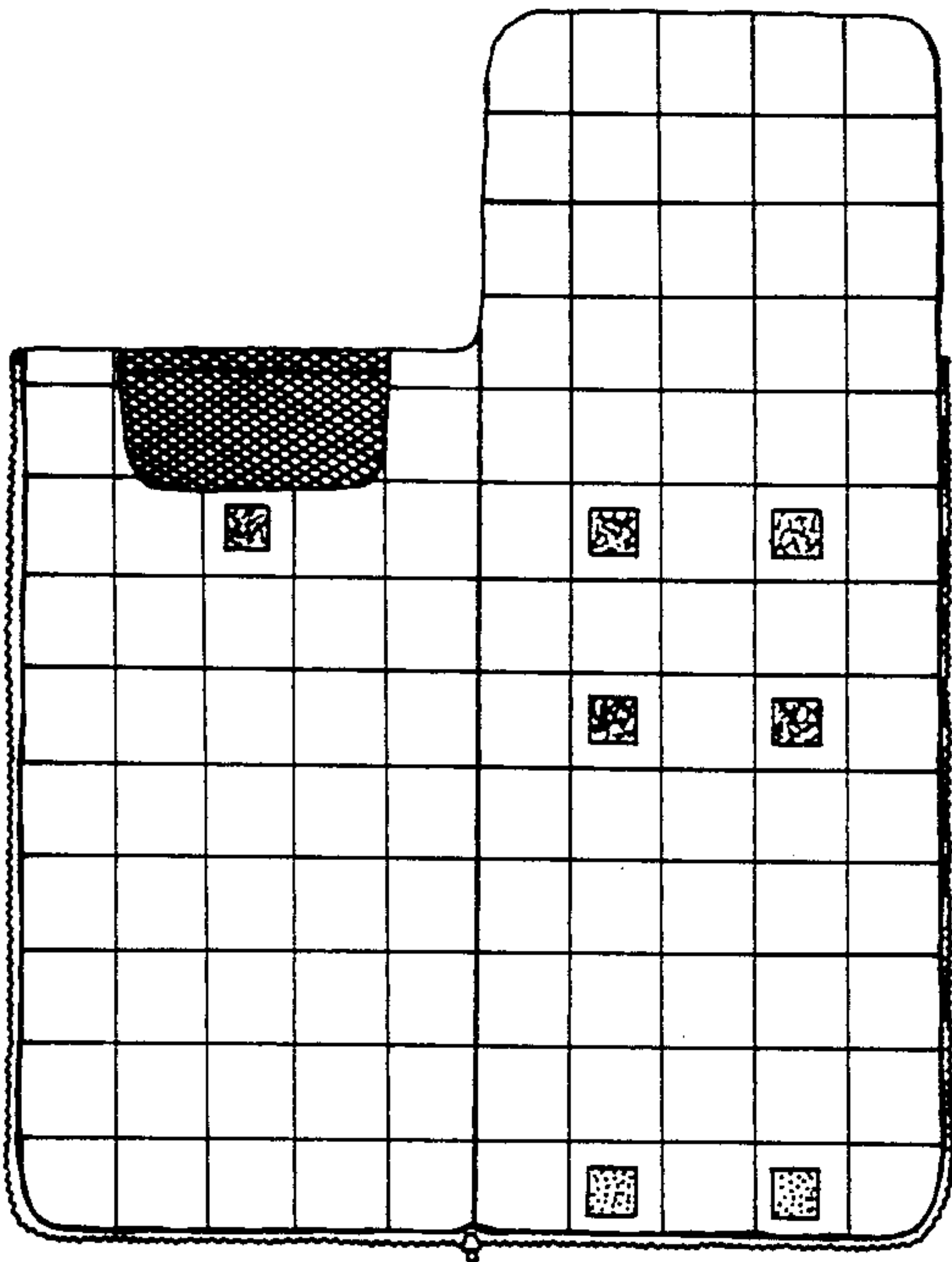

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for closeable weatherproof blanket for children, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a slightly perspective top view of the closeable weatherproof blanket showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof, showing the interior portion of the blanket in a fully open position;
FIG. 3 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, taken from the left hand side of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, taken from the top of FIG. 6;
FIG. 5 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, taken from the left hand side of FIG. 6;
FIG. 6 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof, showing the exterior portion of the blanket in a fully open position; and
FIG. 7 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, taken from the bottom of FIG. 2.



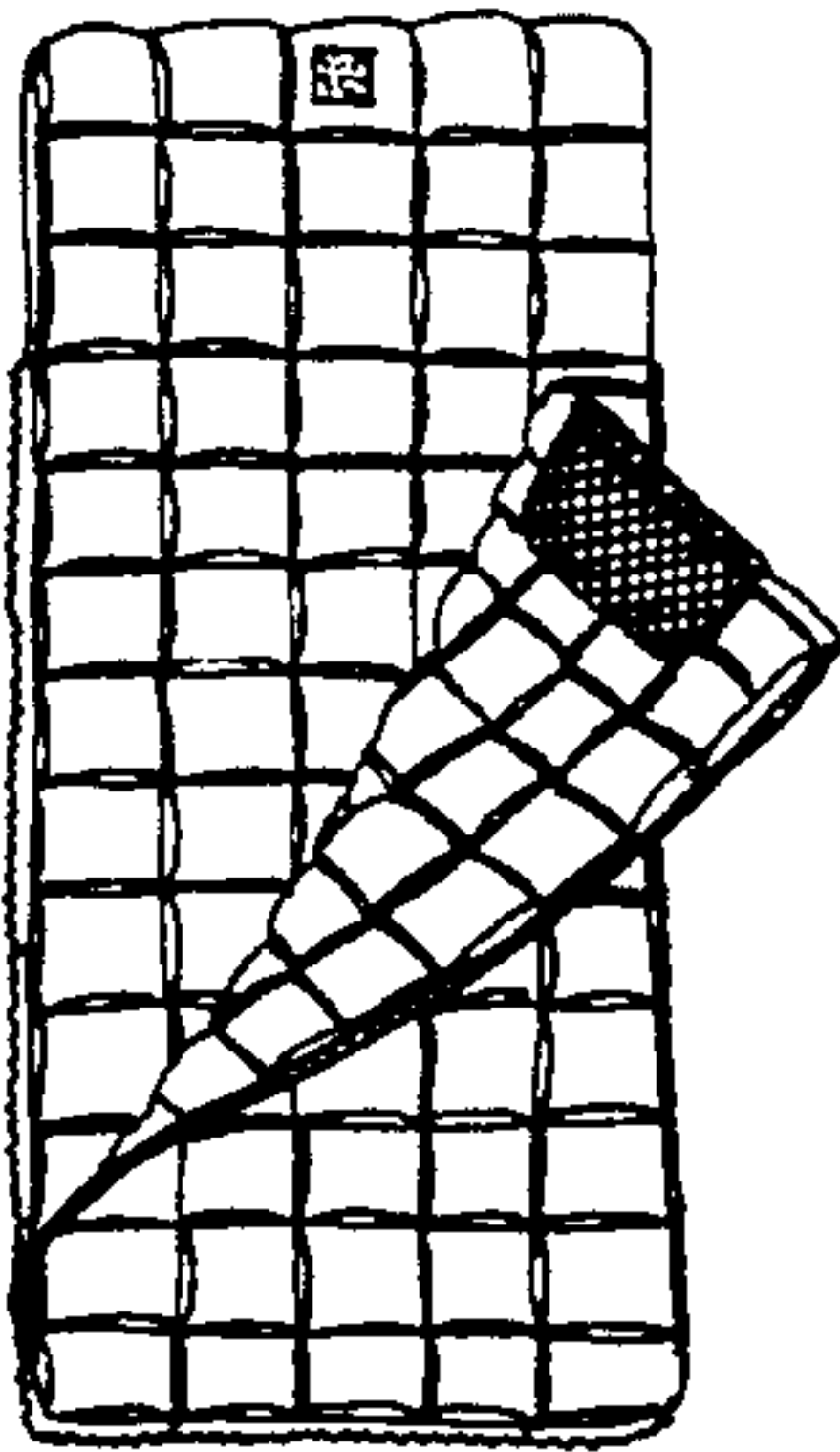

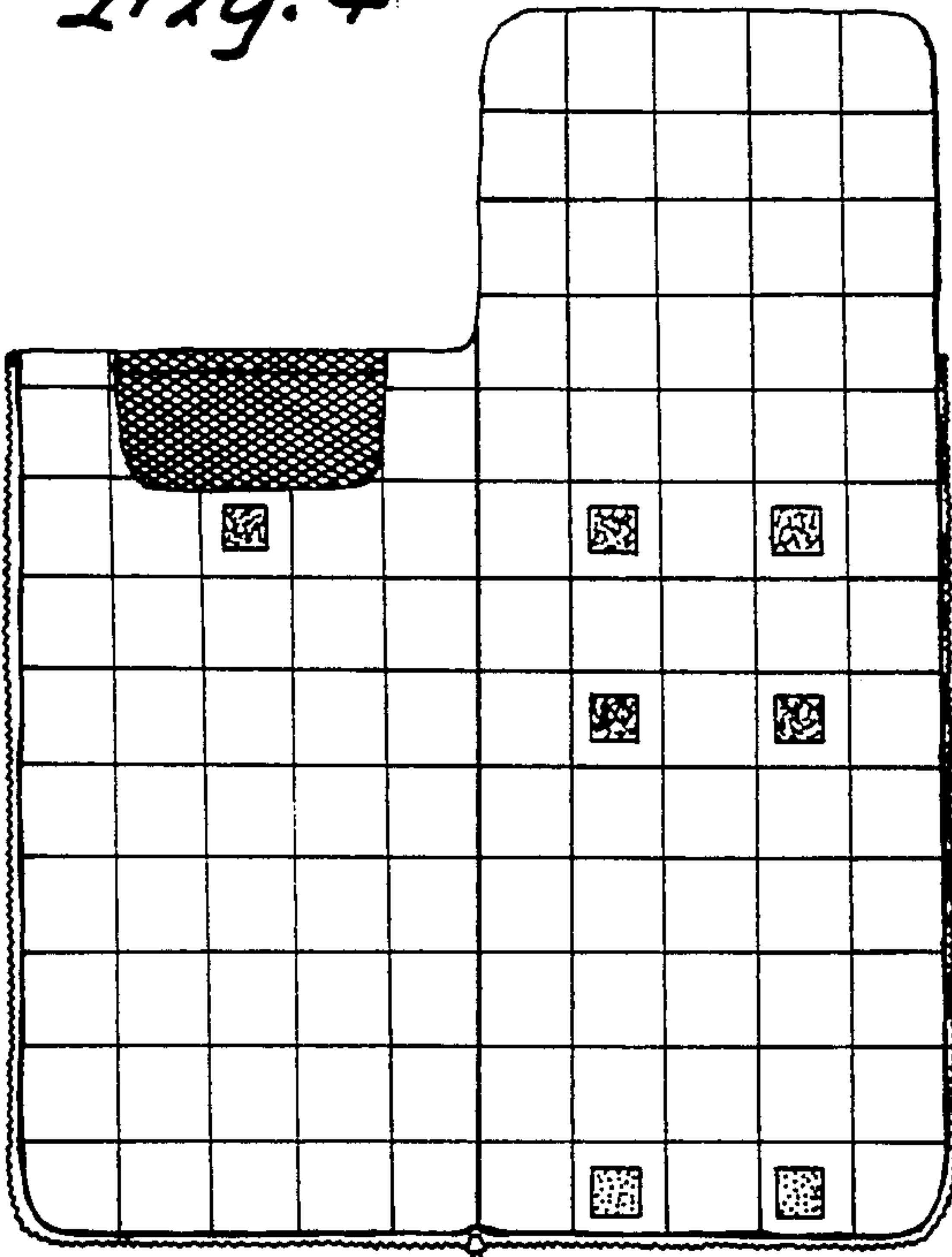

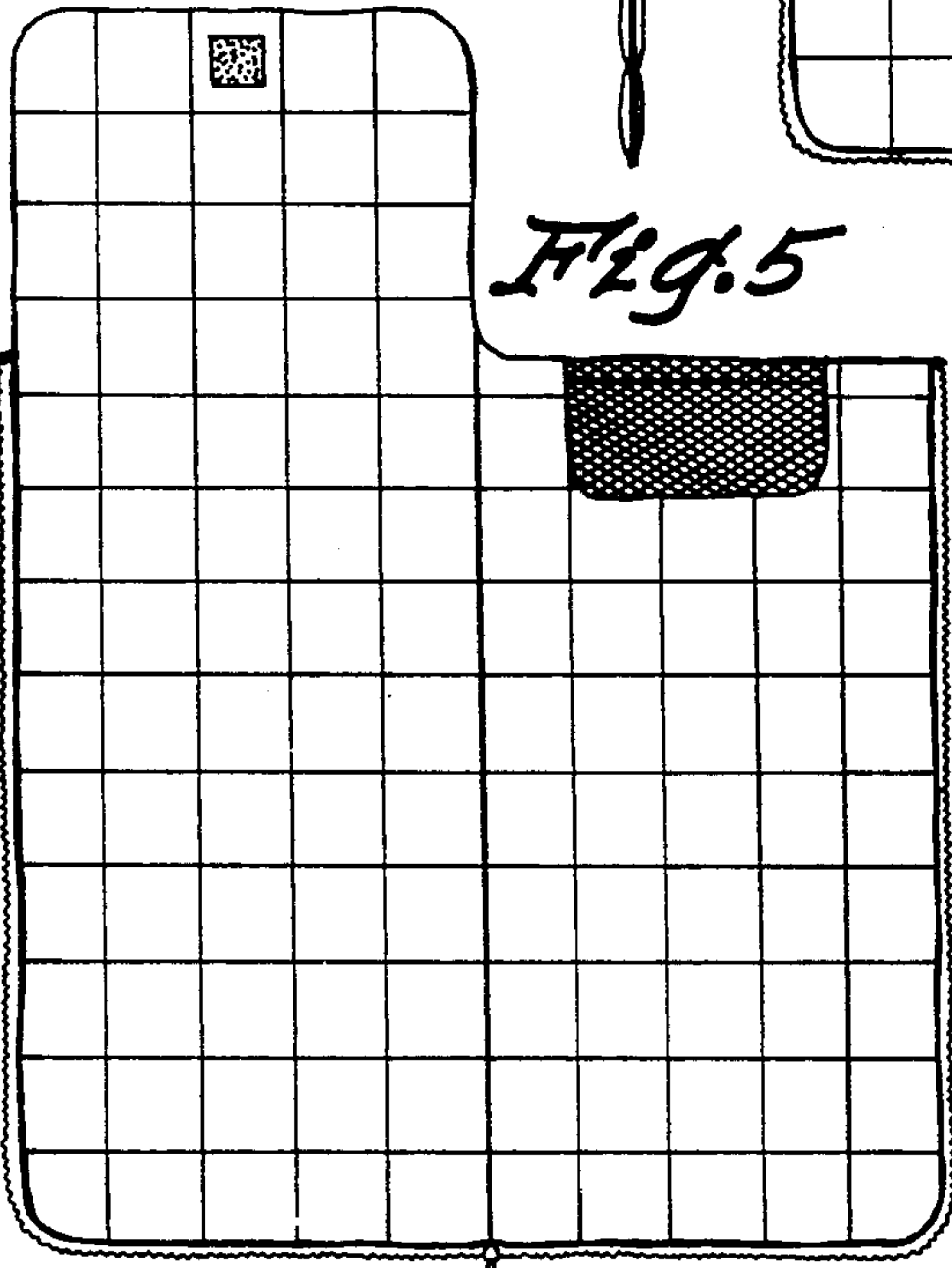
