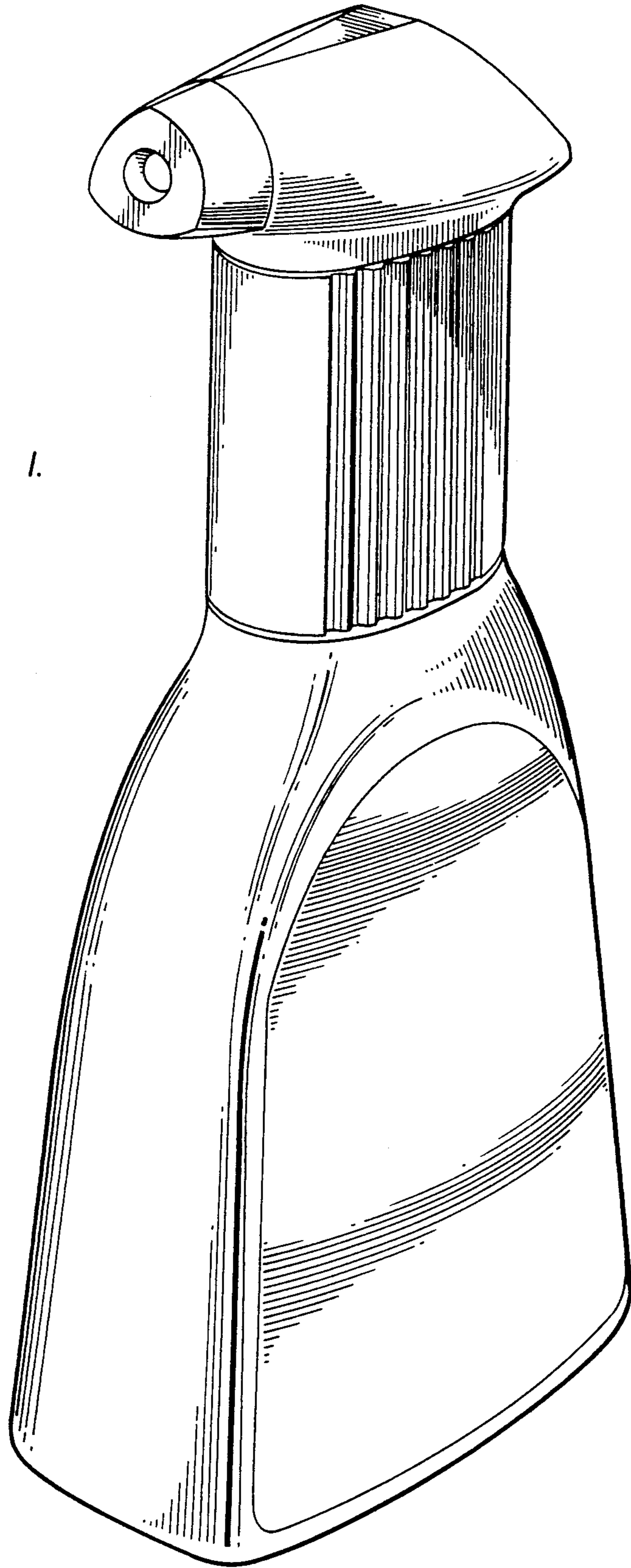
The ornamental design for a dispensing container for fluids, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a dispensing container for fluids embodying our design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

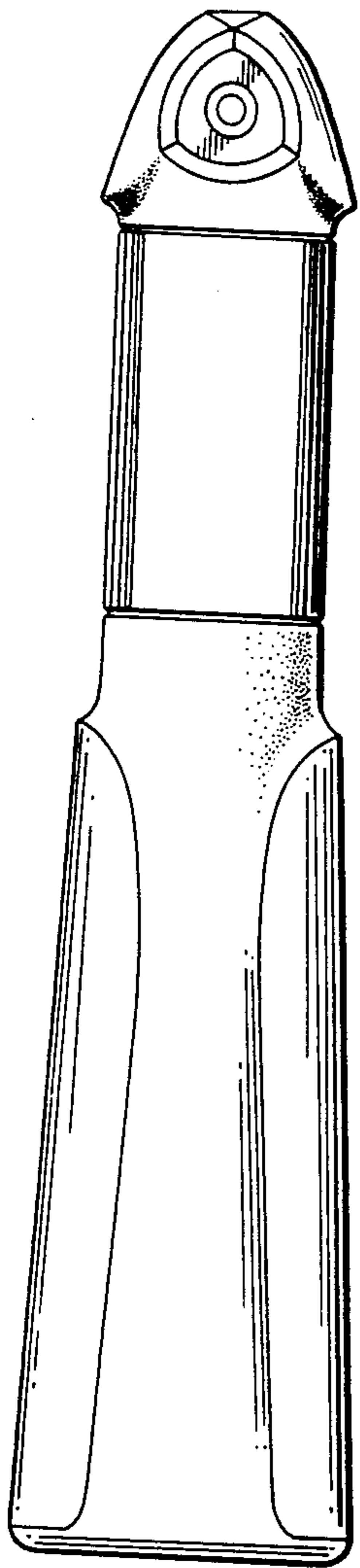

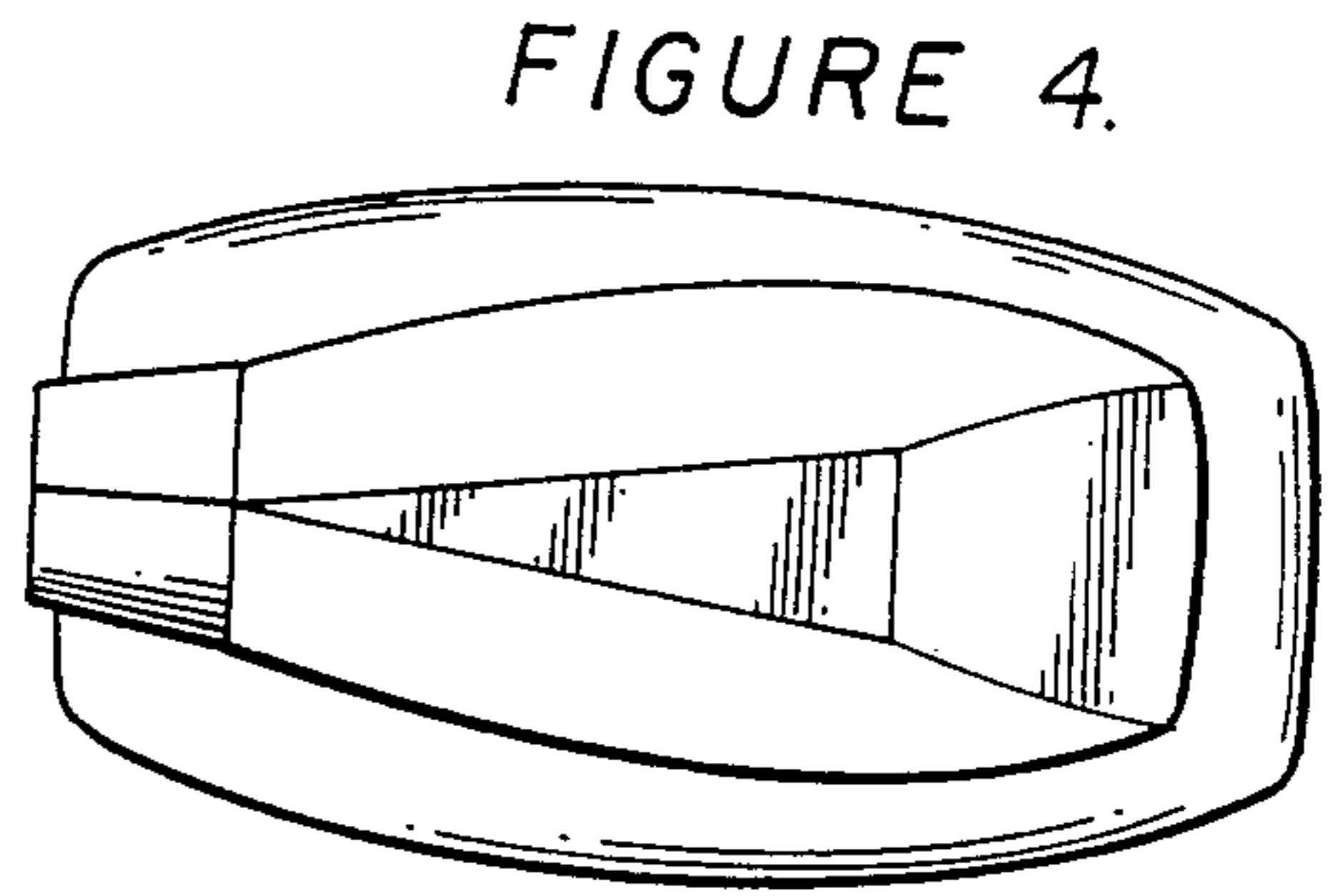

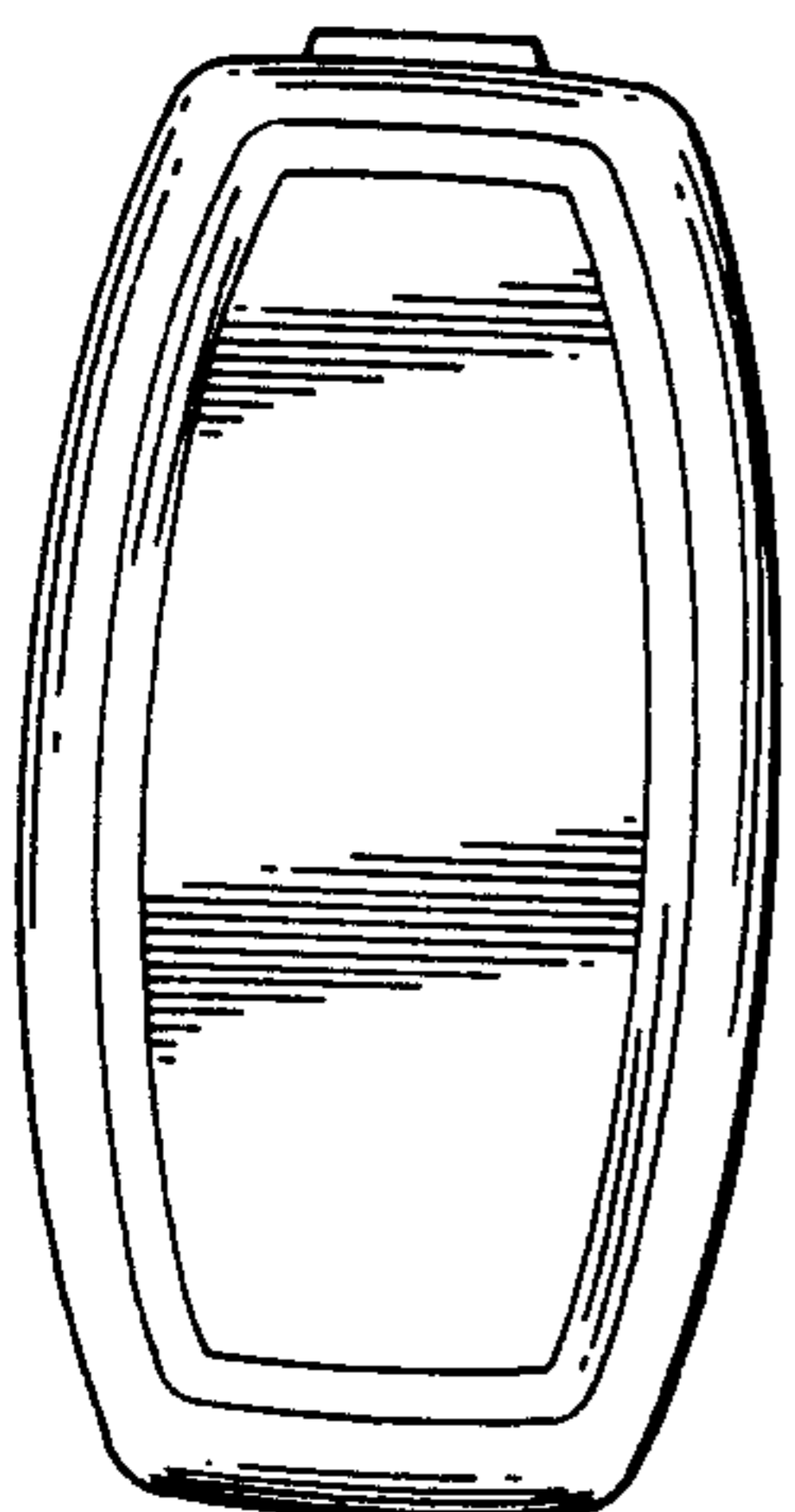

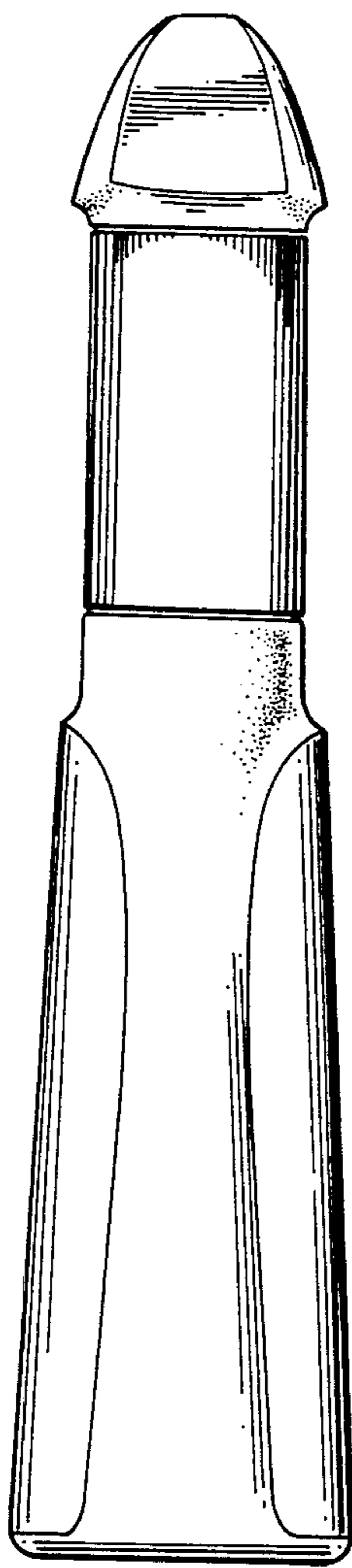
