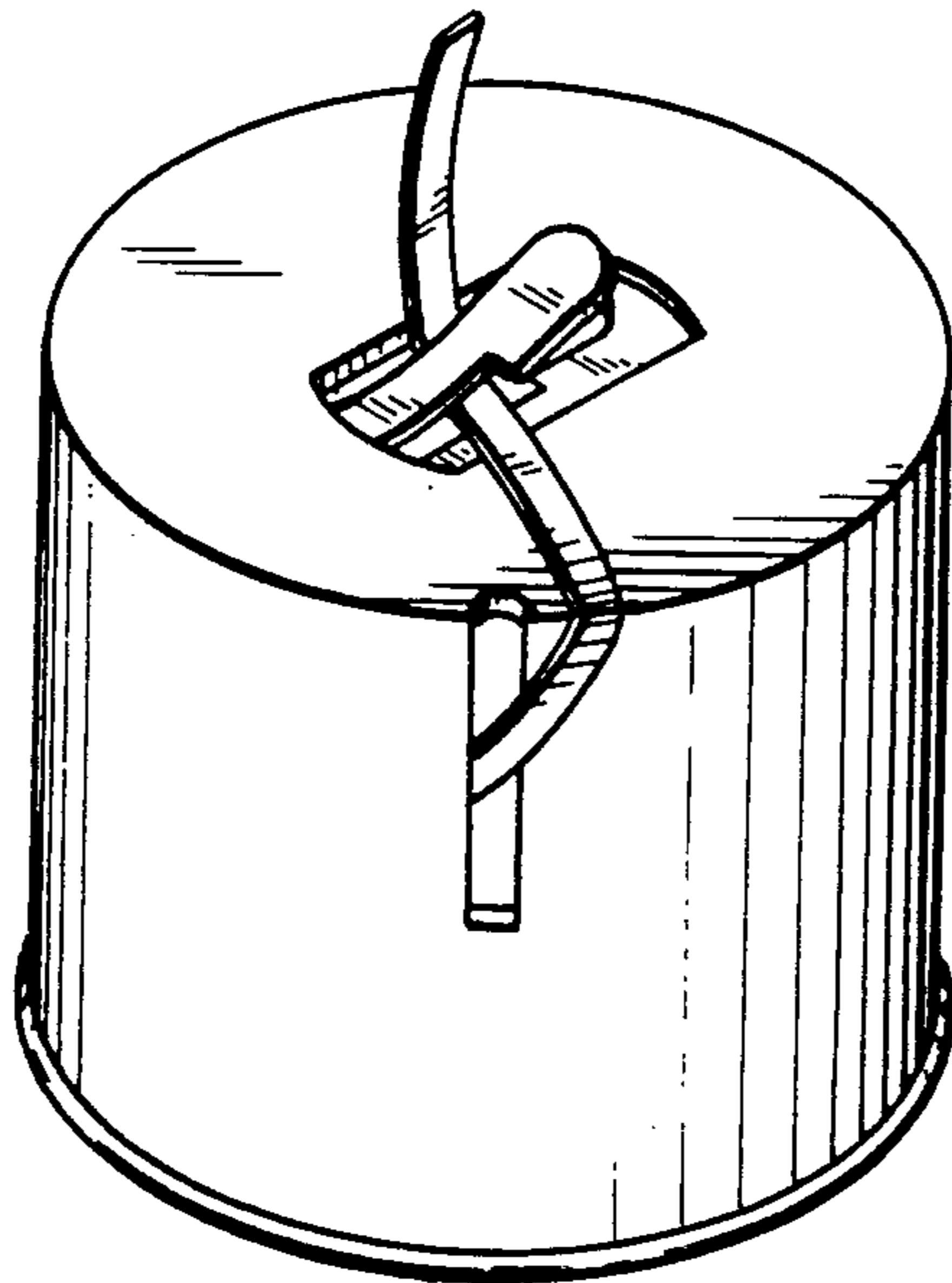

FIG. 1 is a top isometric view of a twist tie dispensing package embodying our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view; and FIG. 3 is a bottom isometric view showing the side opposite that seen in FIG. 1.



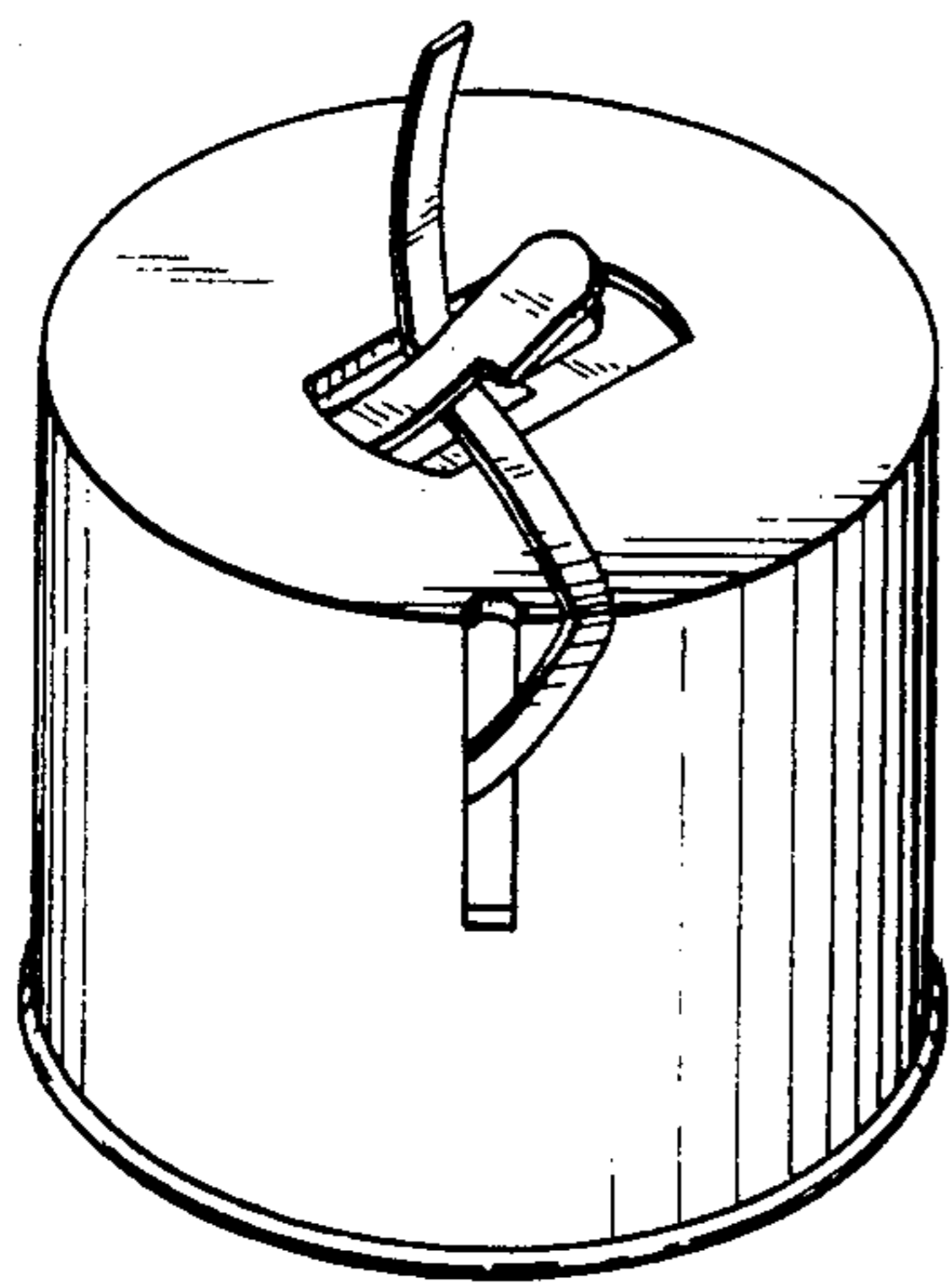

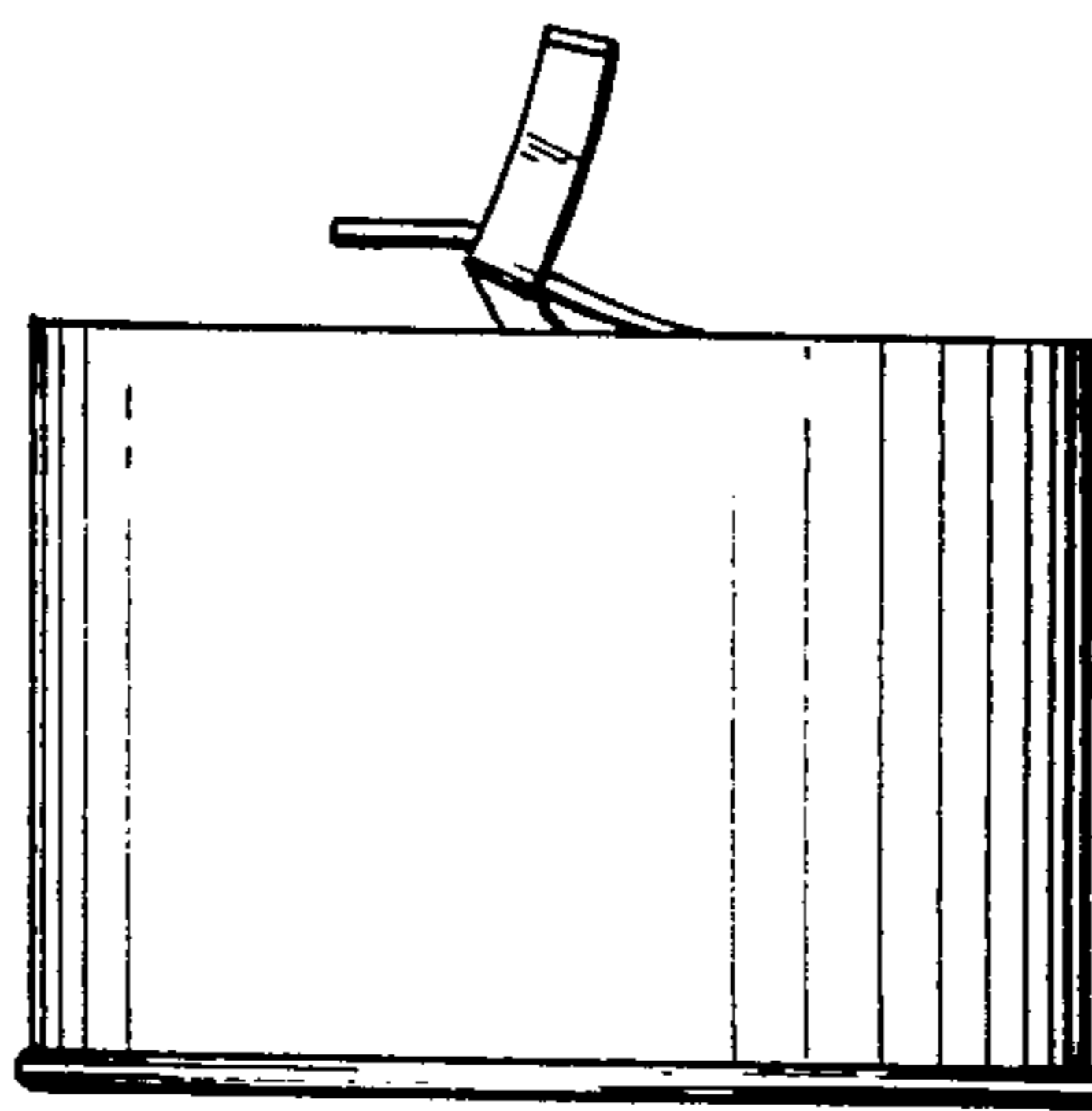

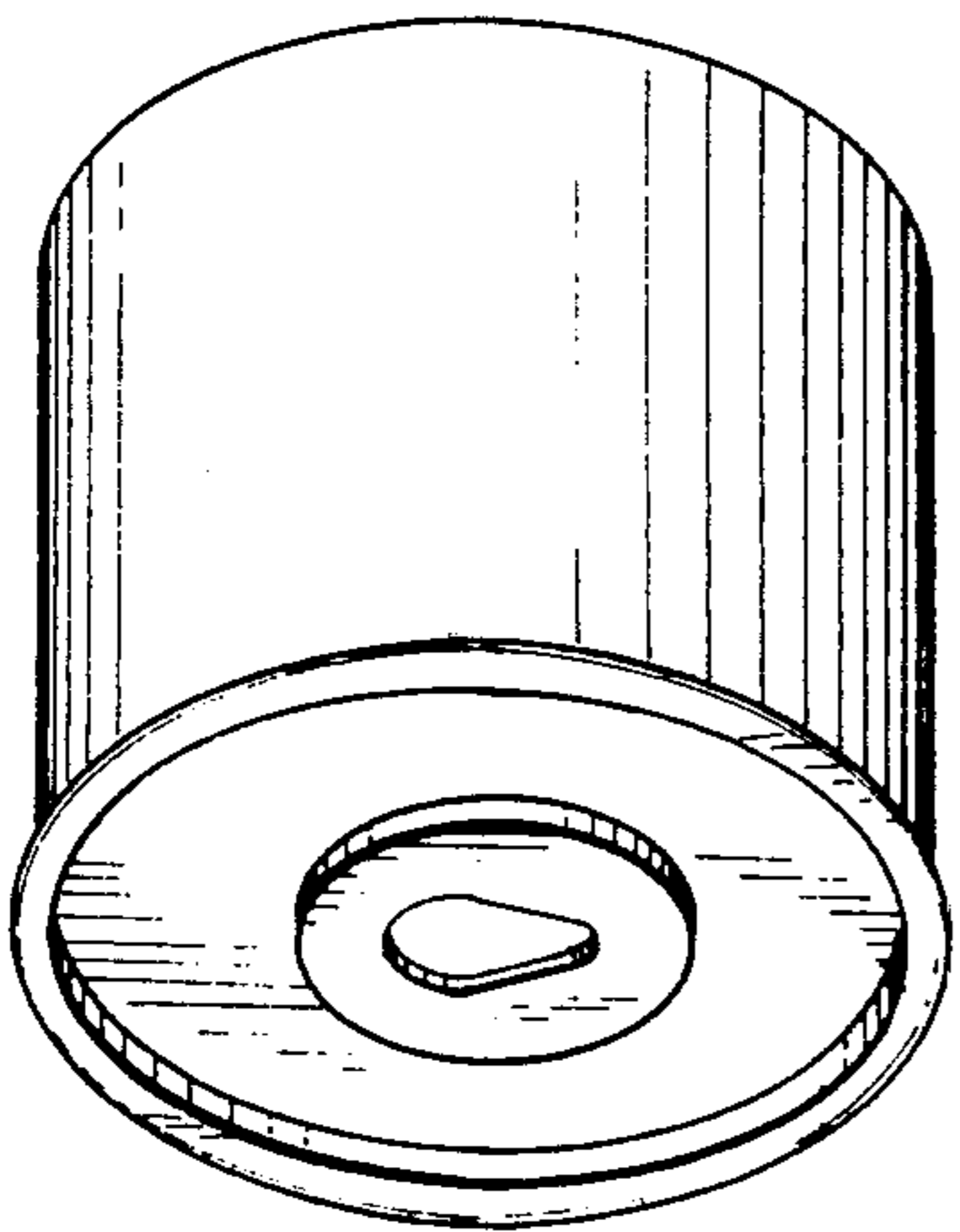
