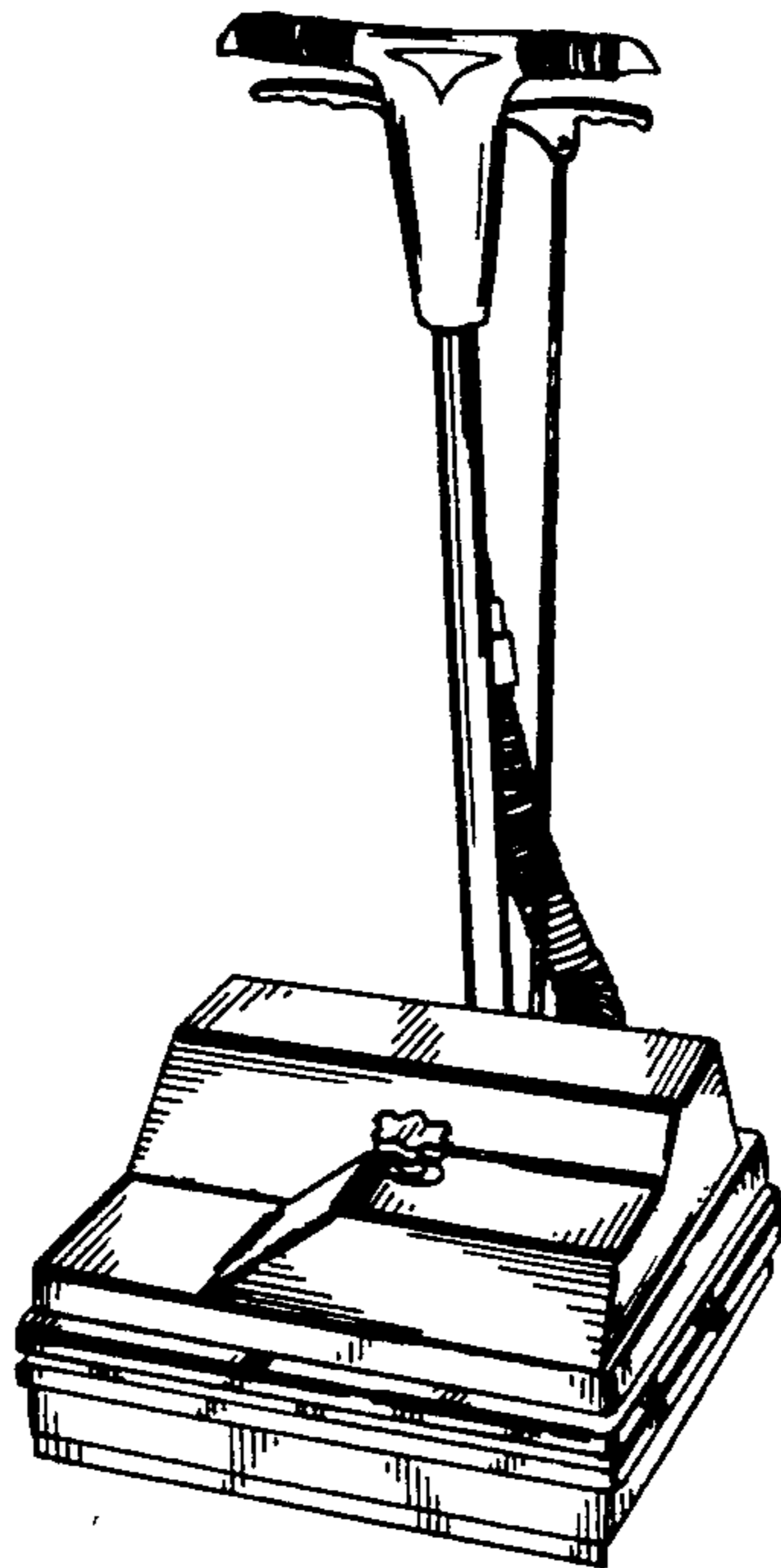
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a carpet extractor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a carpet extractor showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a rear perspective thereof; and
 FIG. 8 is a front perspective thereof.

The conventional electric cord is shown fragmentarily in FIGS. 2, 3, 4, 5 and 7, for ease of illustration.



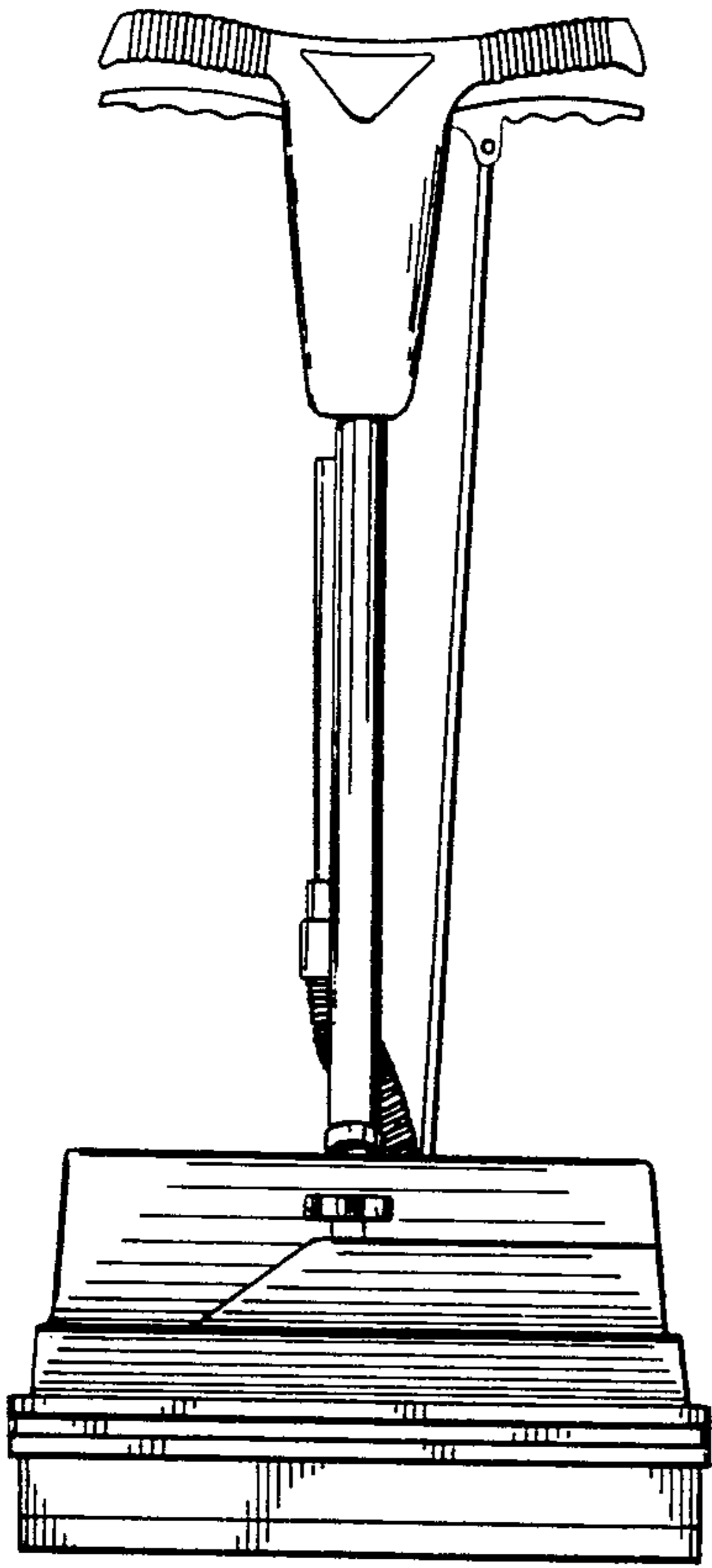

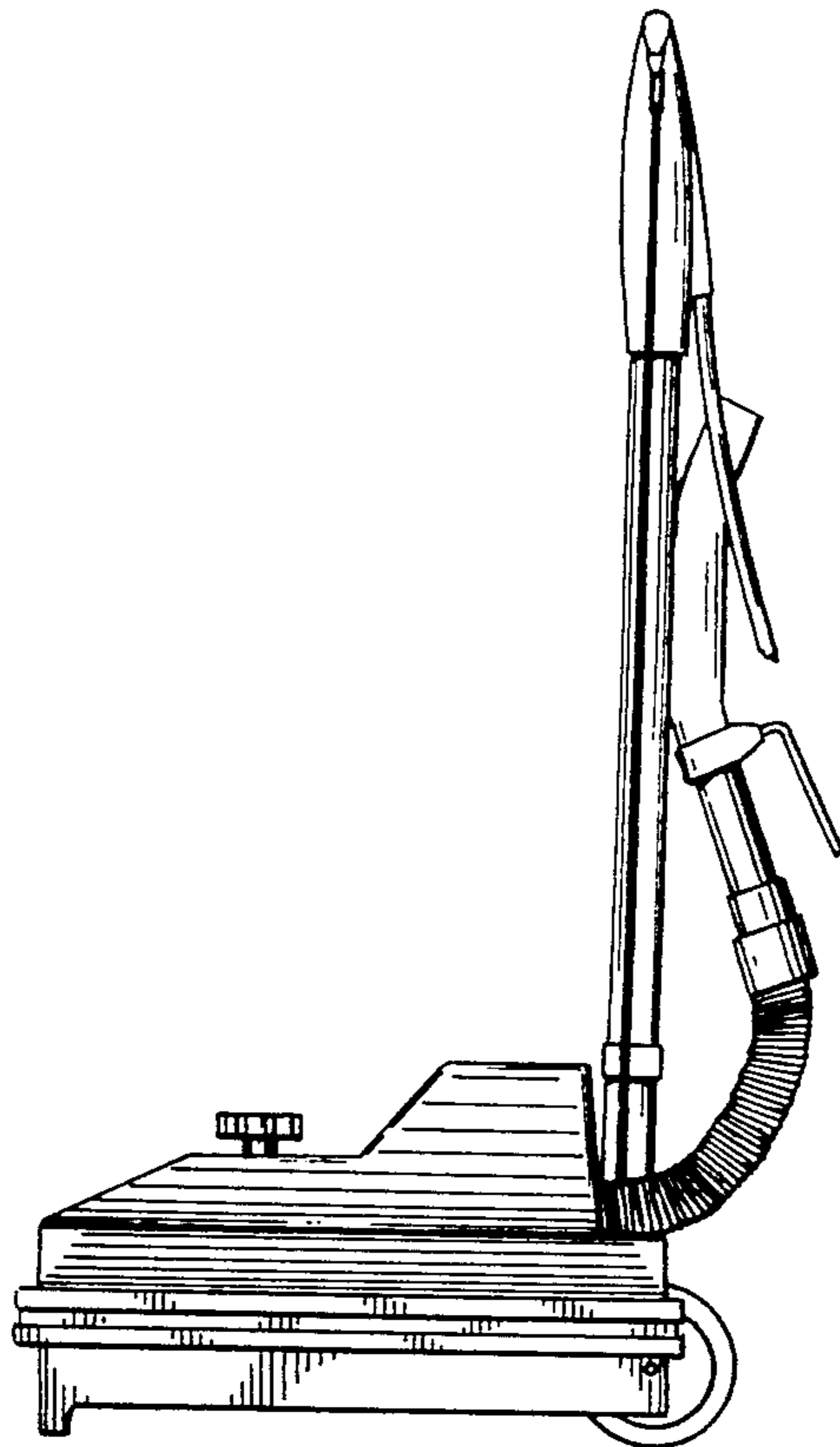

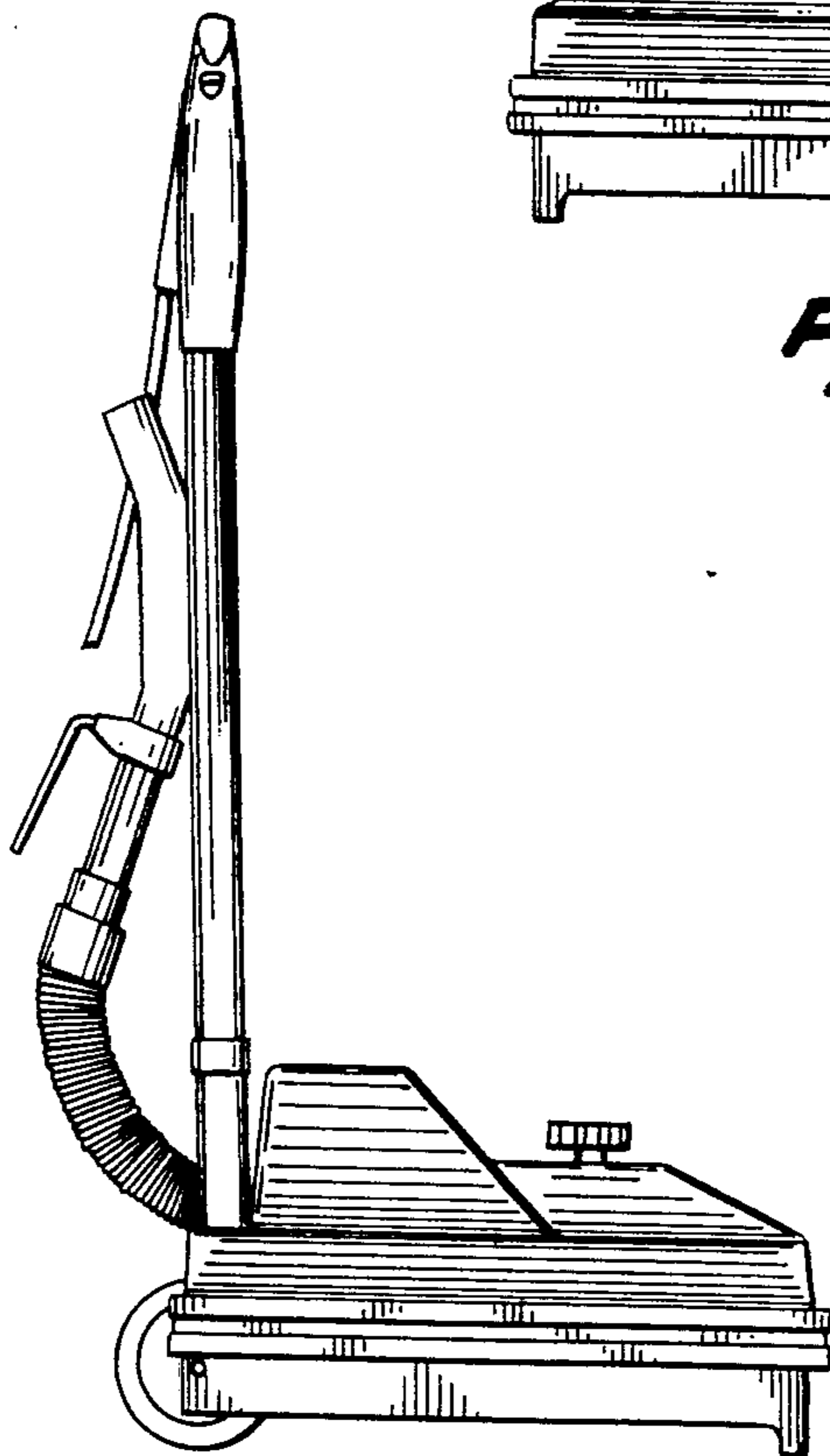

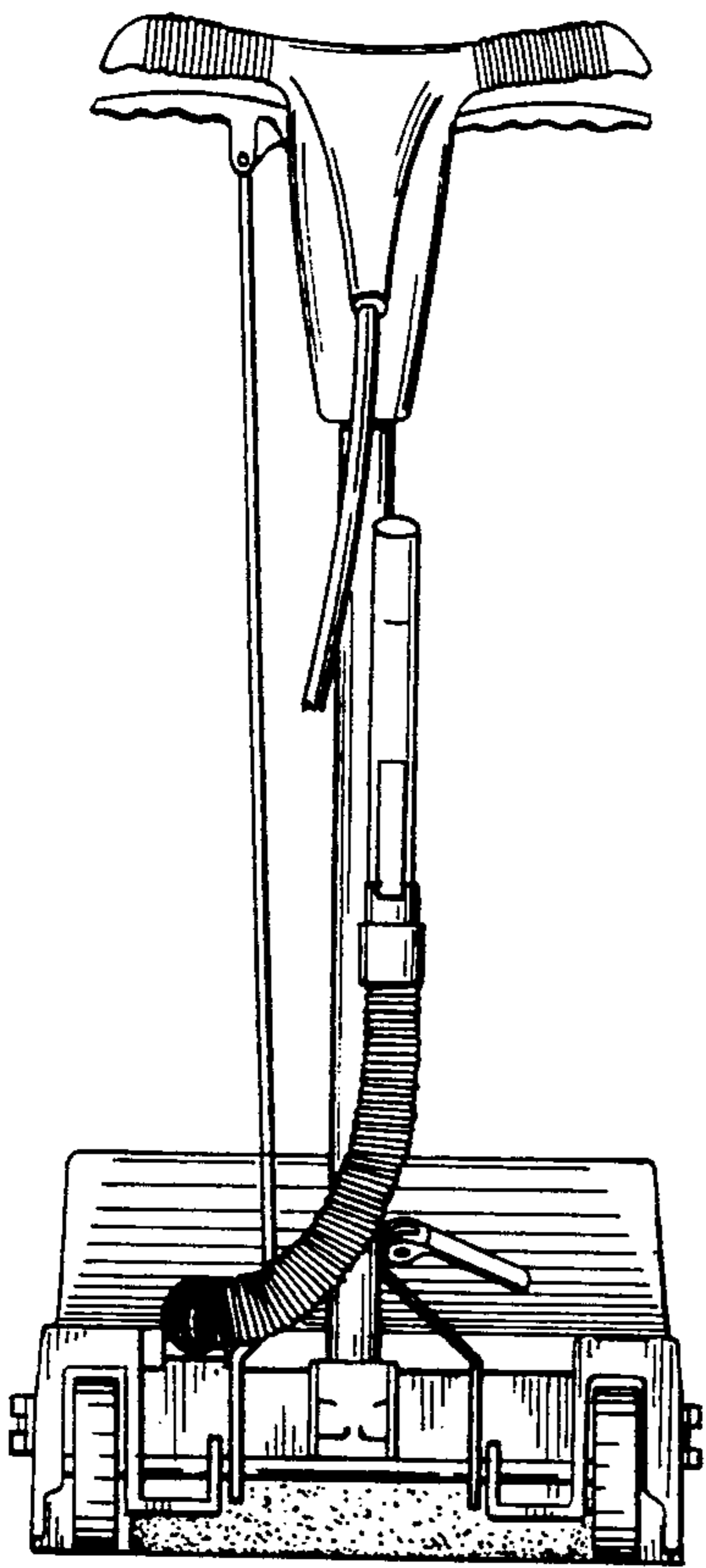

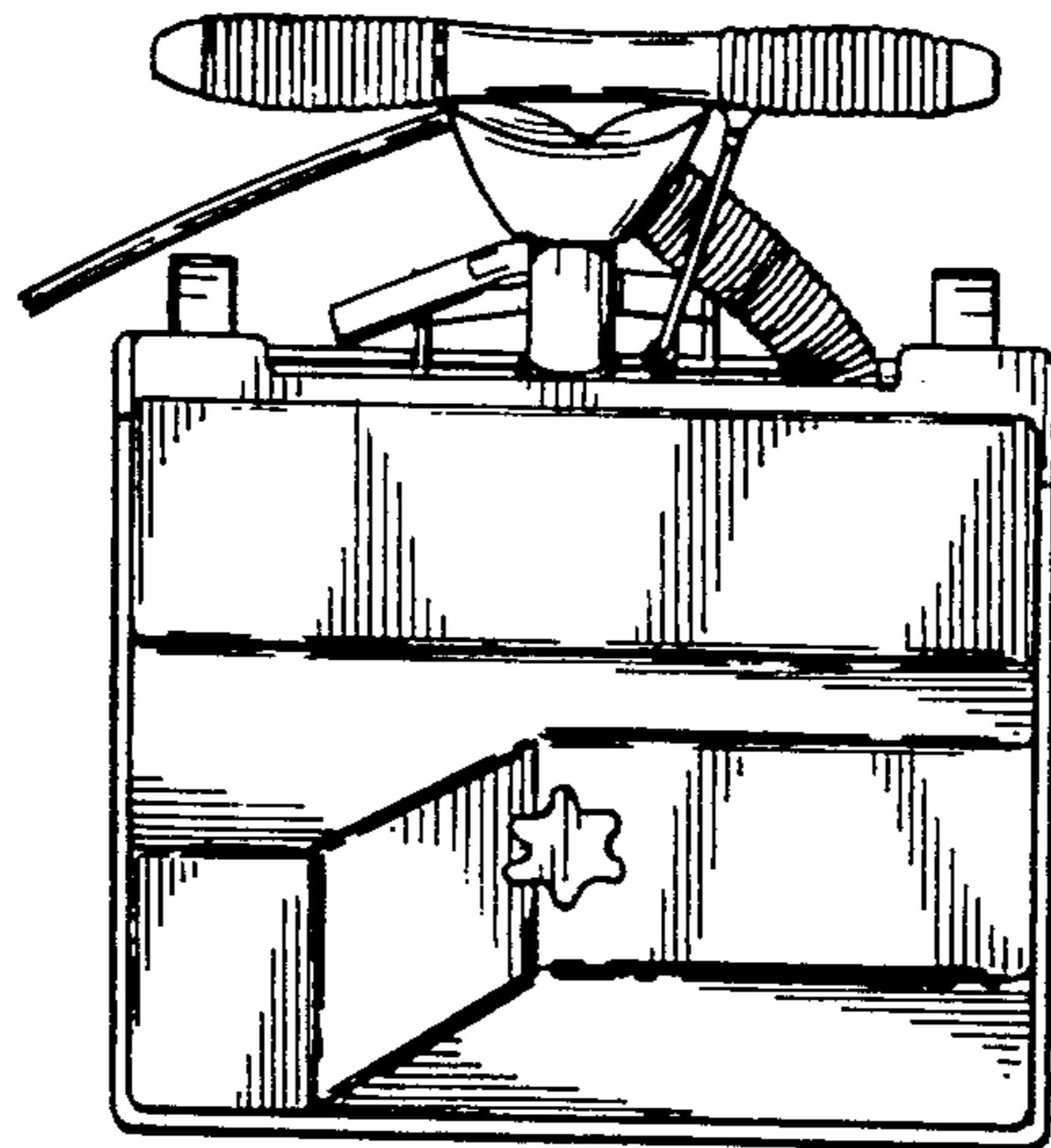

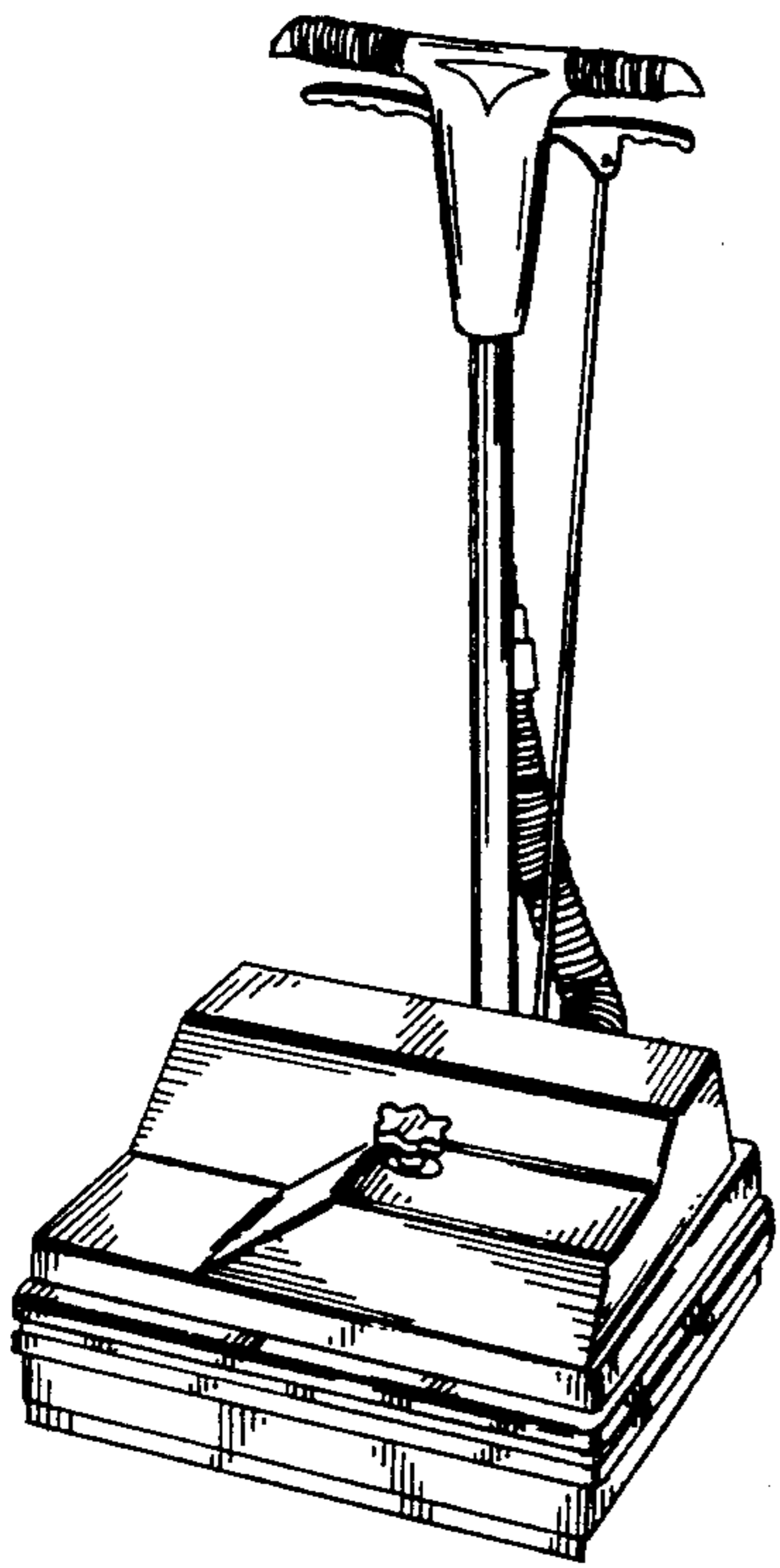

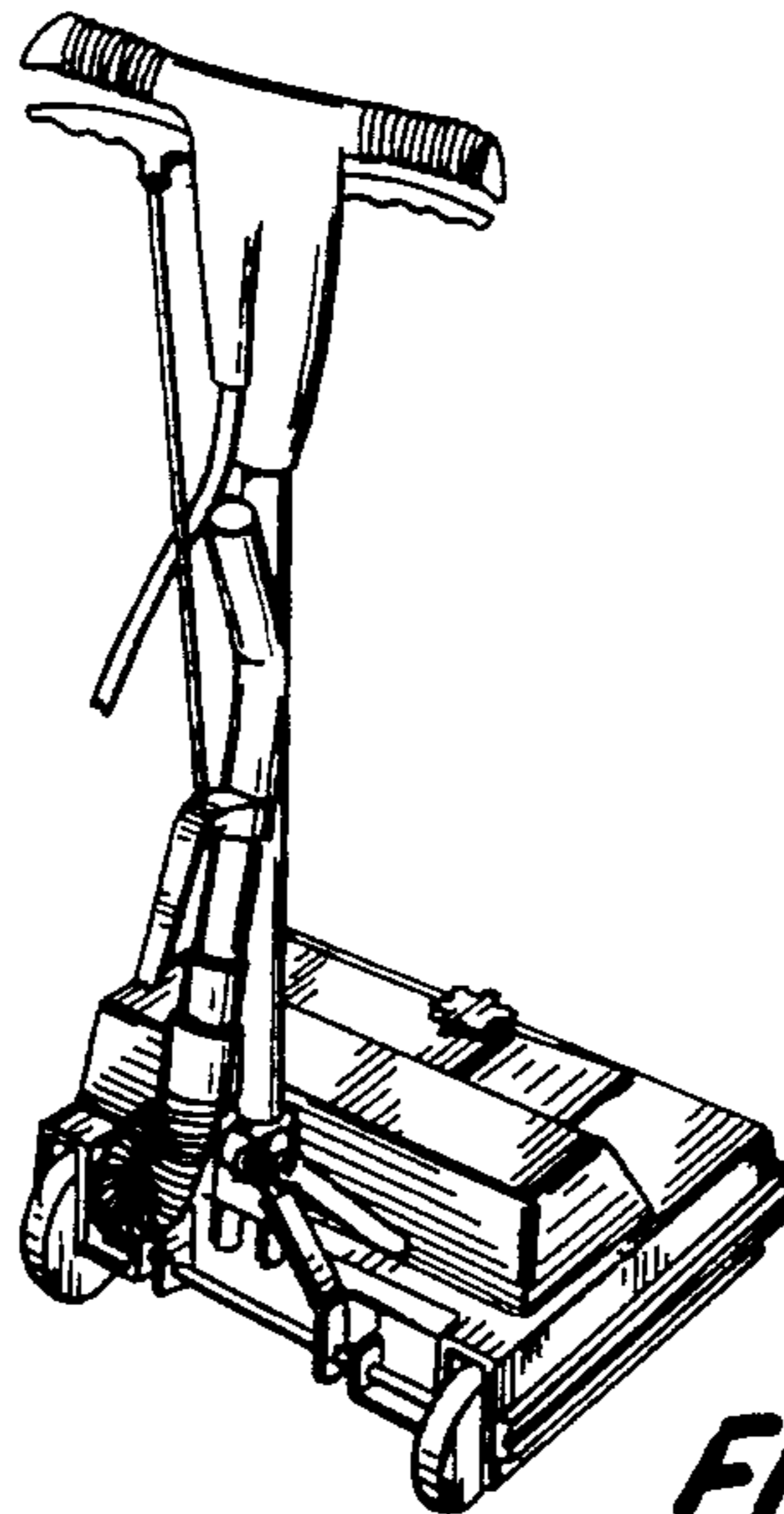

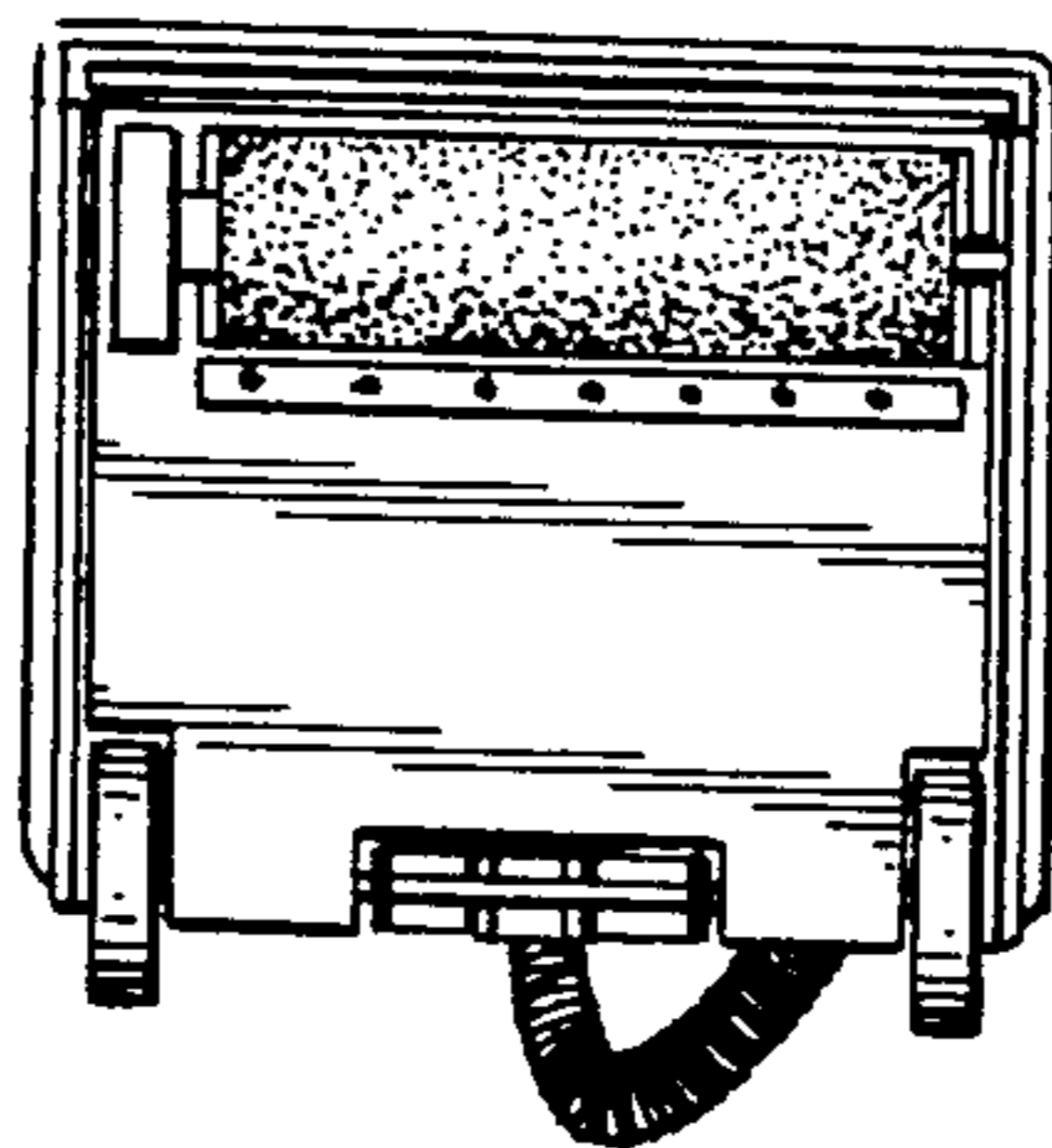
