[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a task light fixture, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a task light fixture showing my new design taken from the bottom, front and one side thereof;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the task light fixture of FIG. 1;

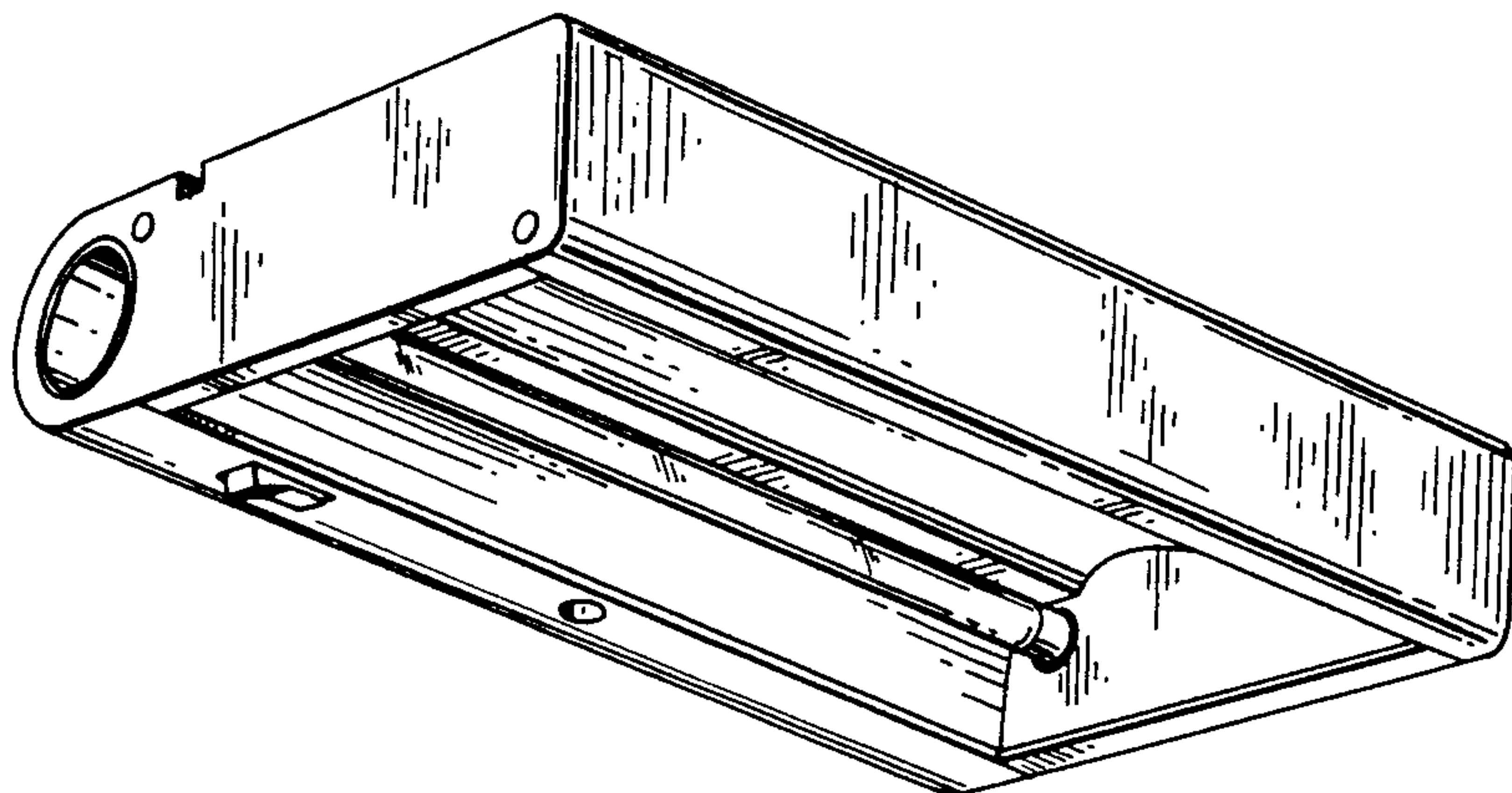
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the task light fixture of FIG. 1;

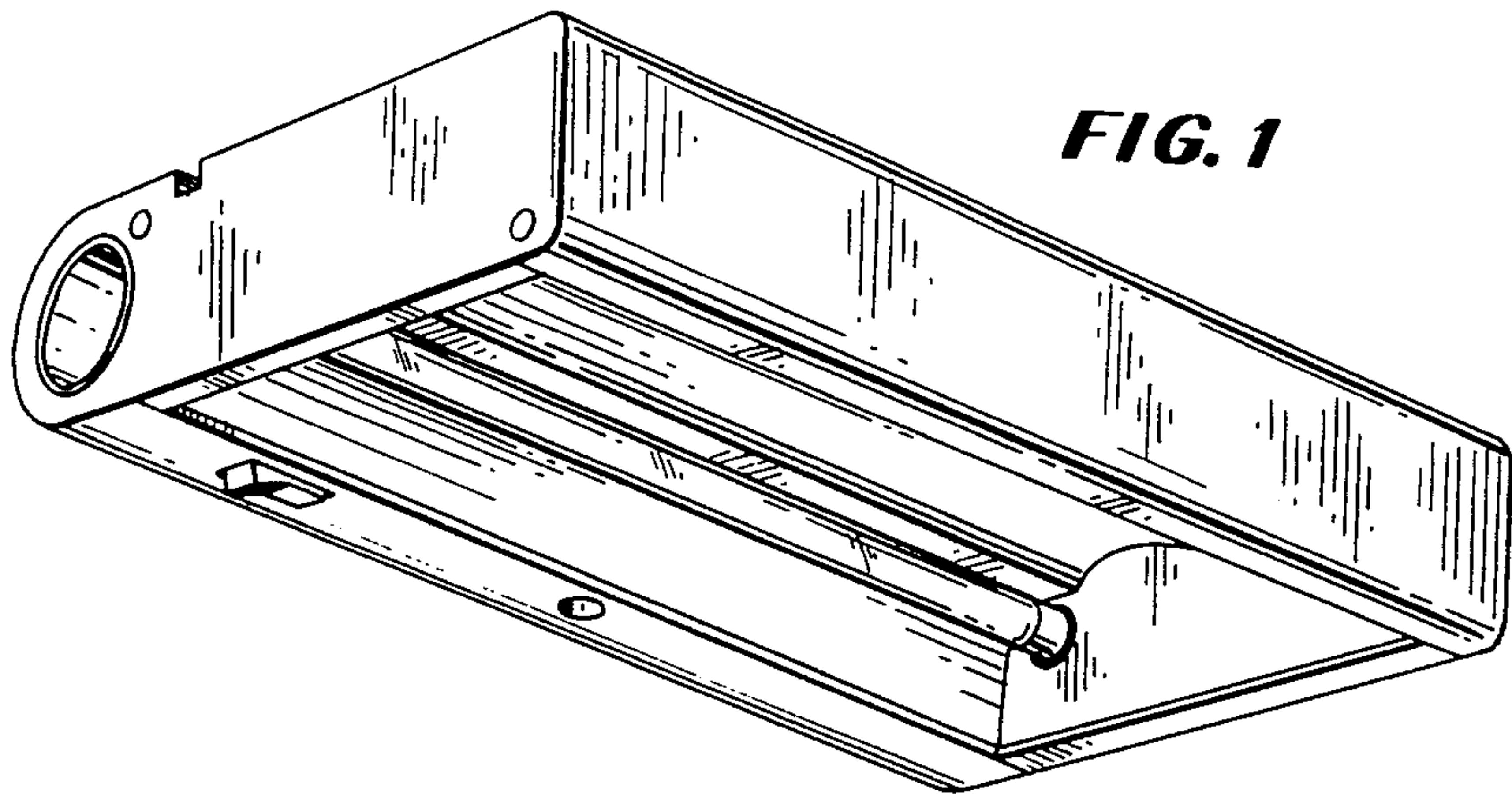
FIG. 4 is a left, side elevational view of the task light fixture of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a right, side elevational view of the task light fixture of FIG. 1;

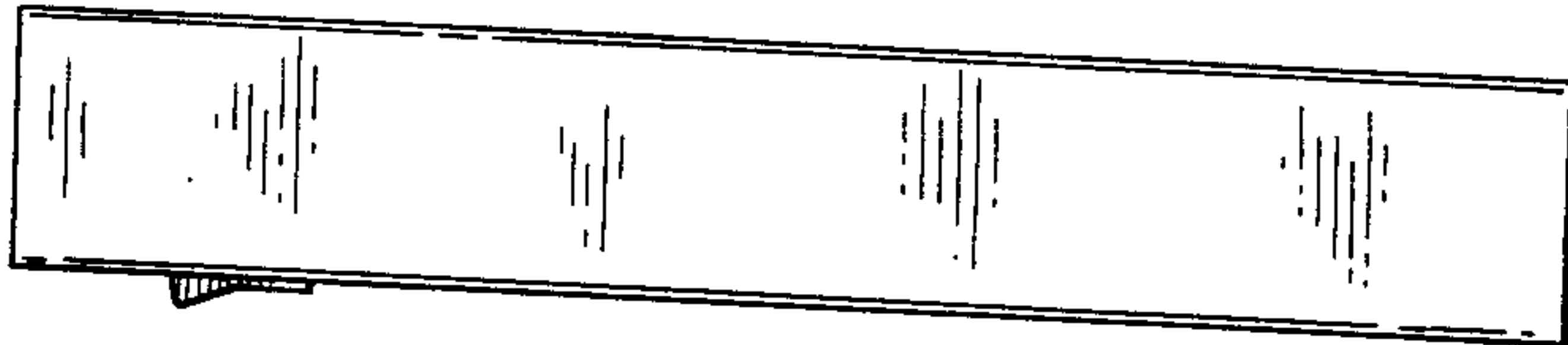
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the task light fixture of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the task light fixture of FIG. 1.

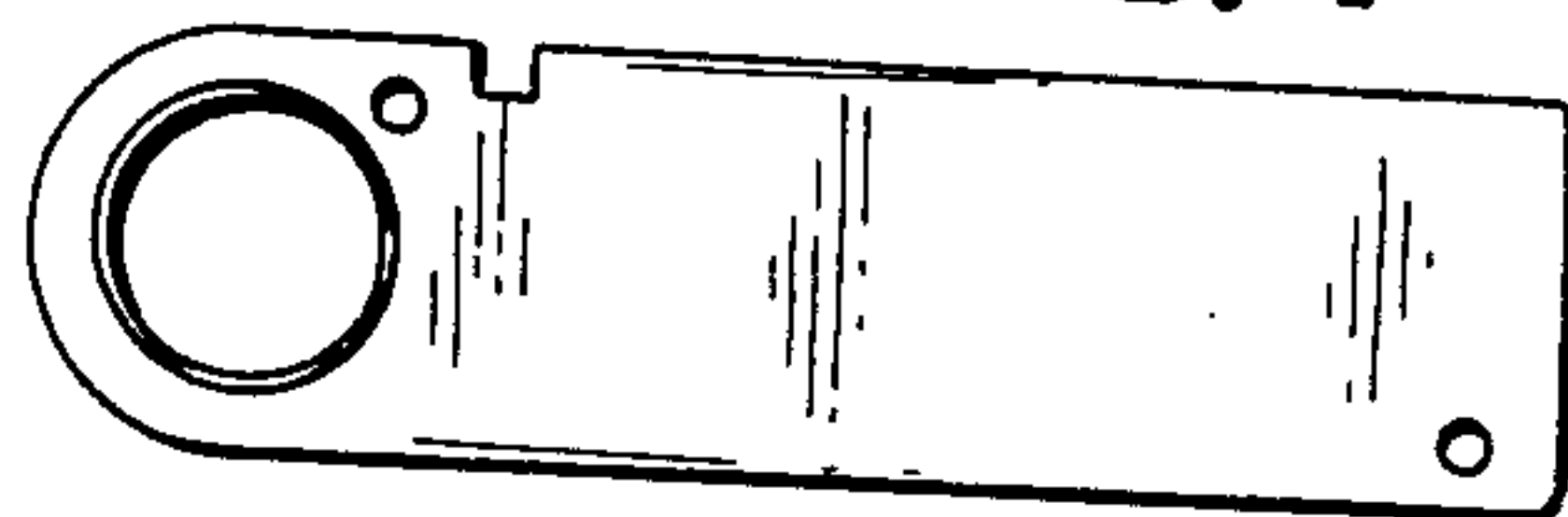




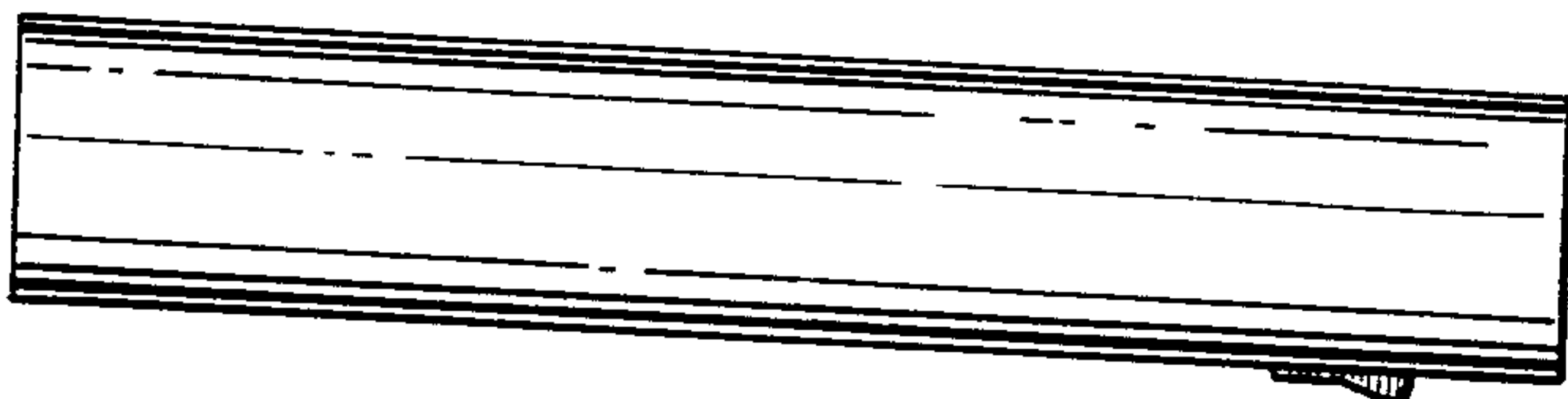

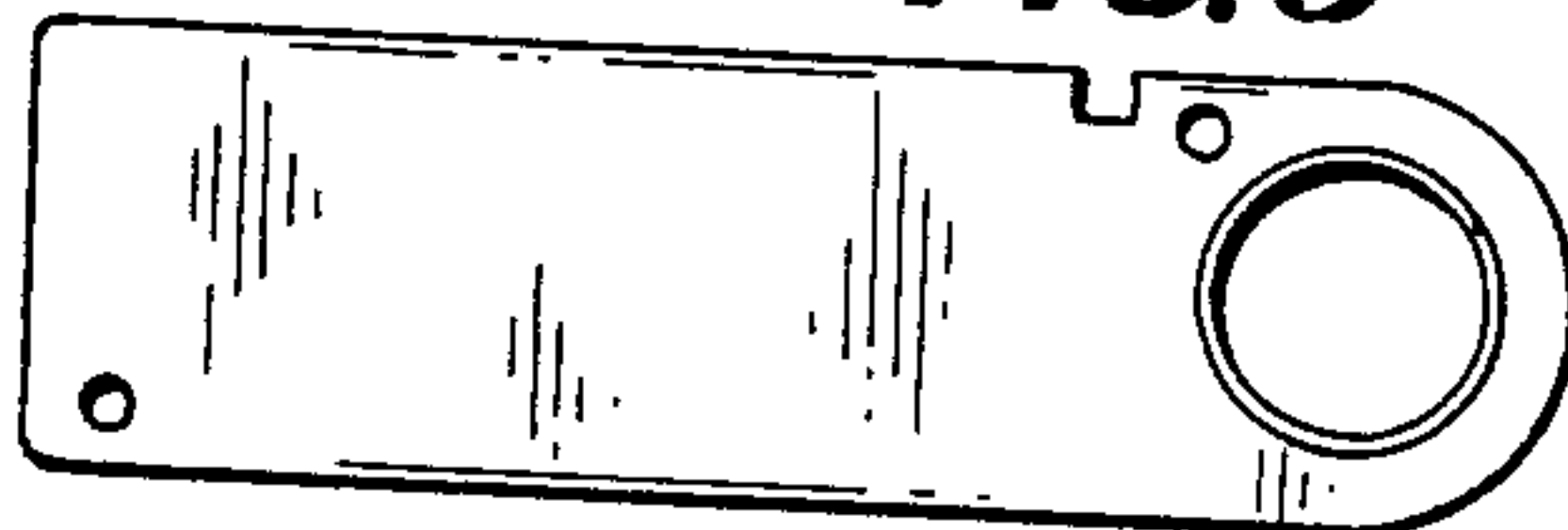

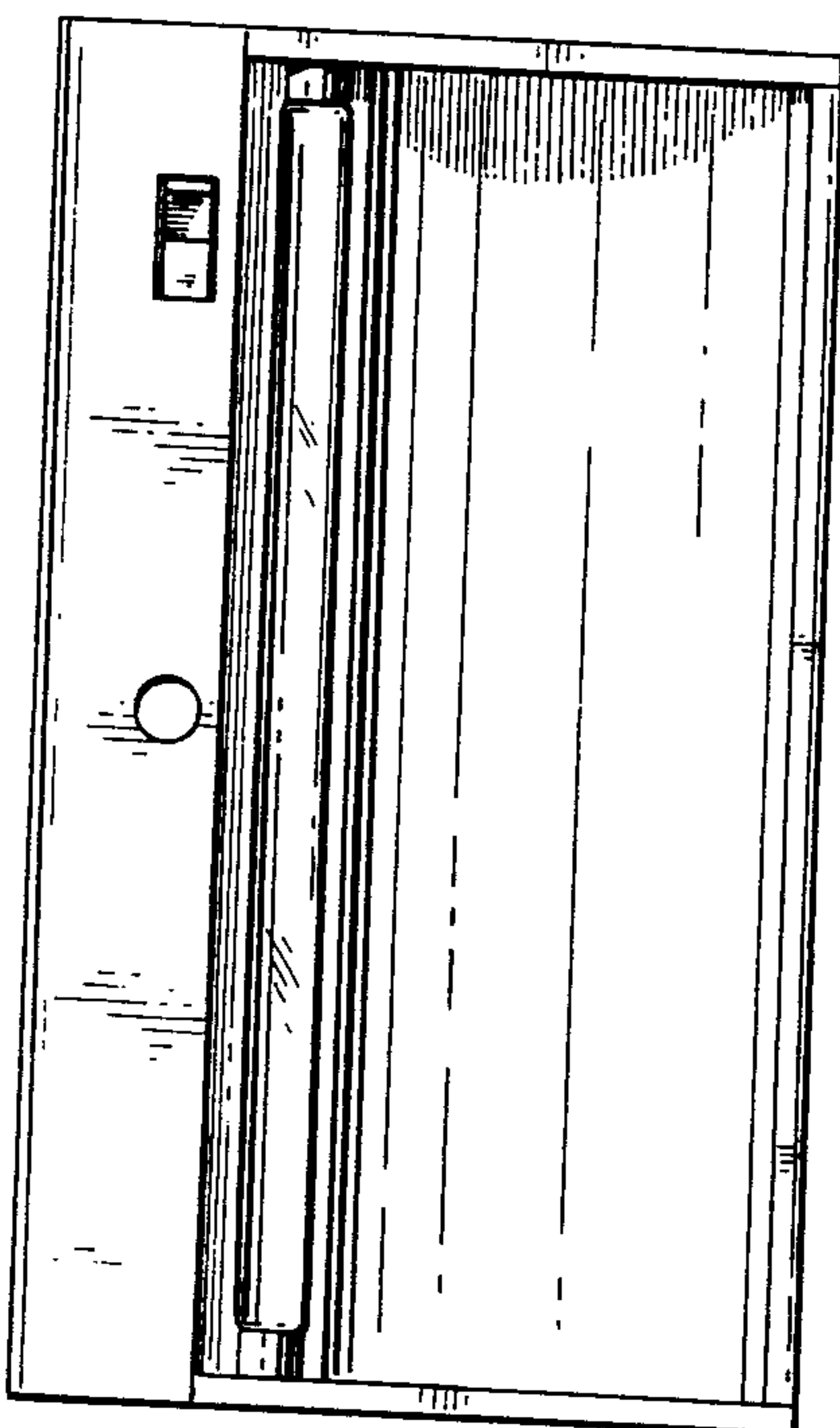
