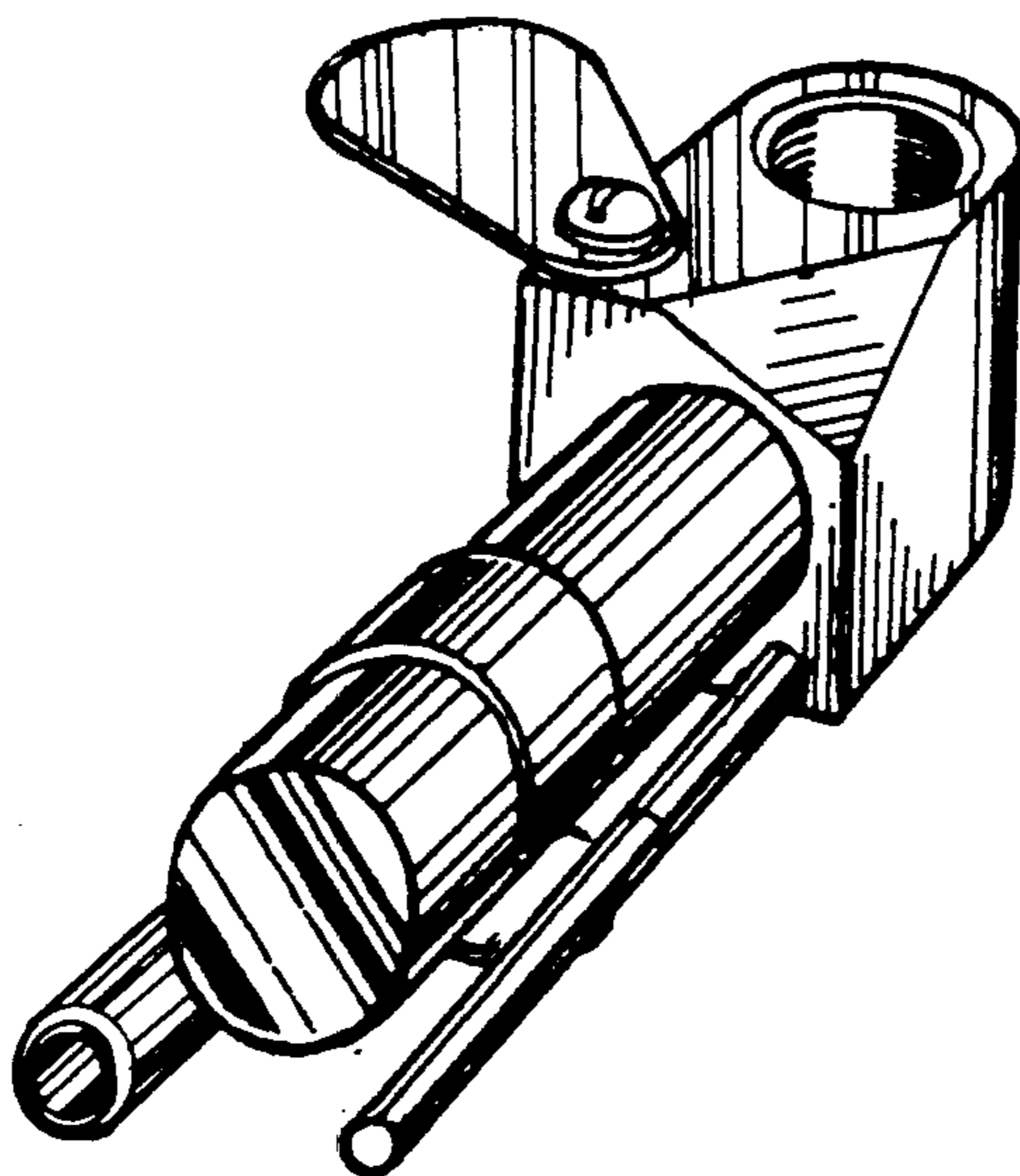

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a smoking pipe, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a smoking pipe, showing my new design, shown in the operative condition;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, shown in the storage condition;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the smoking pipe as it appears in FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof.



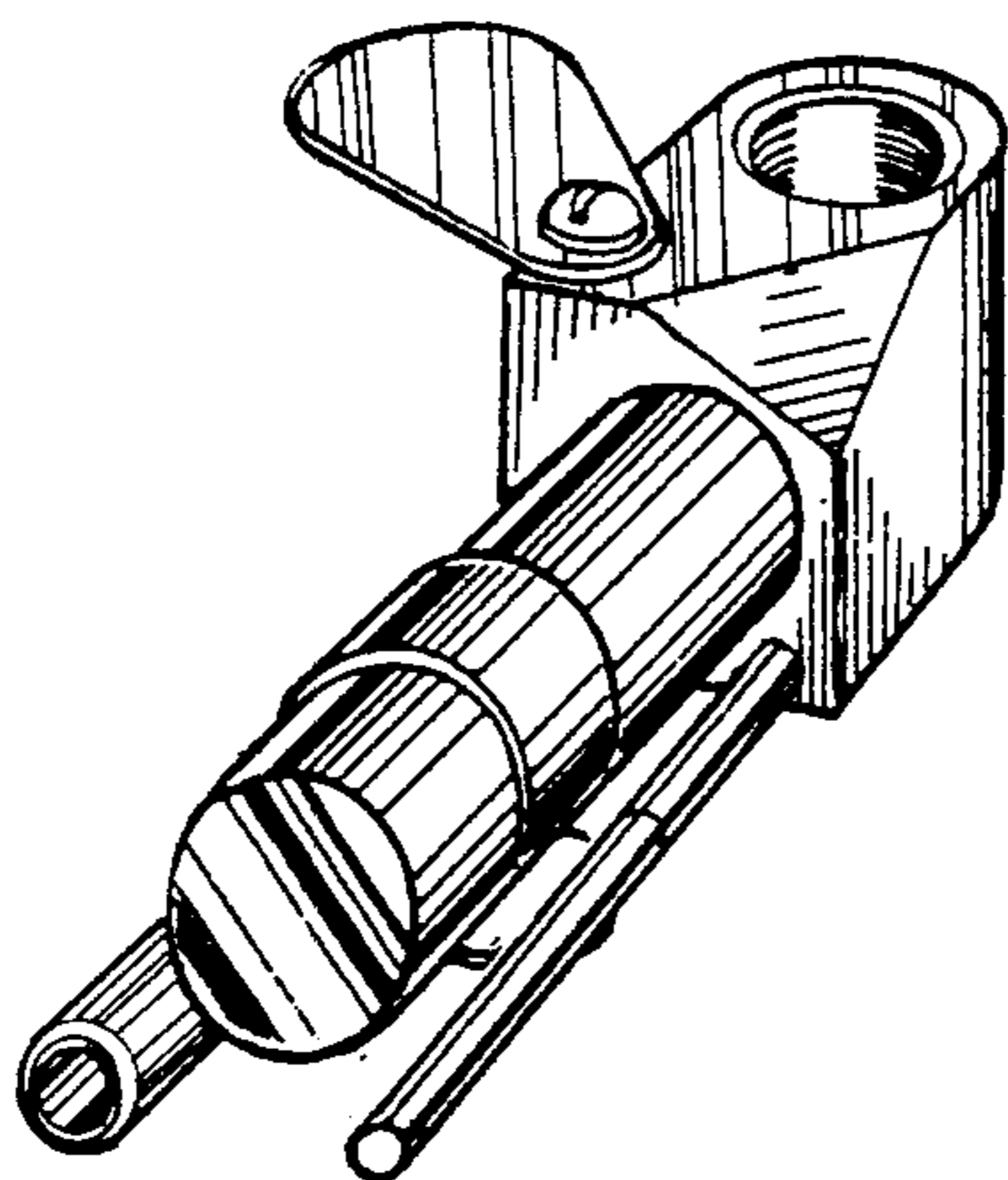

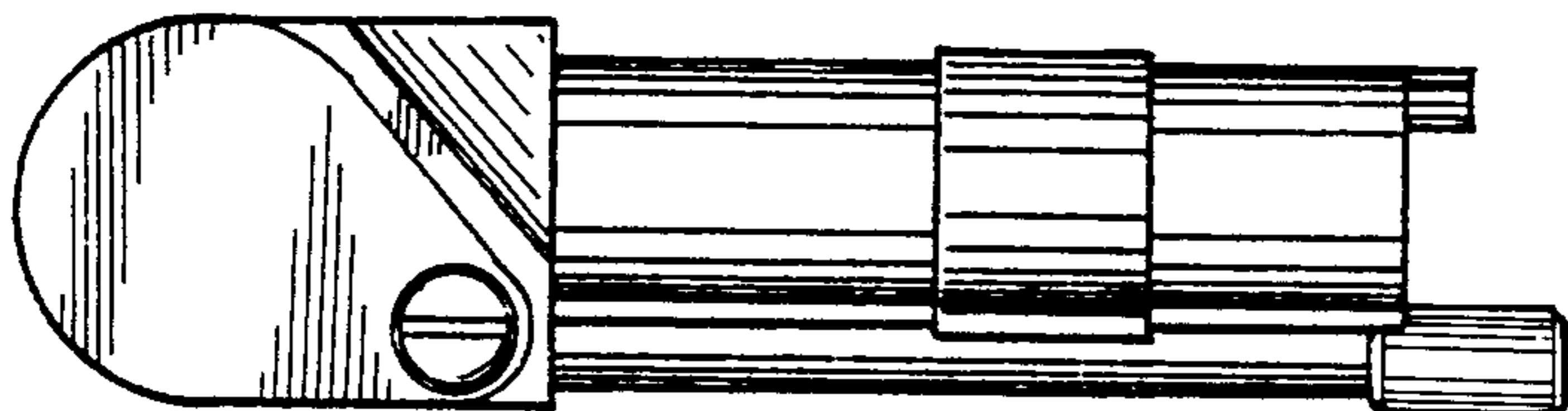

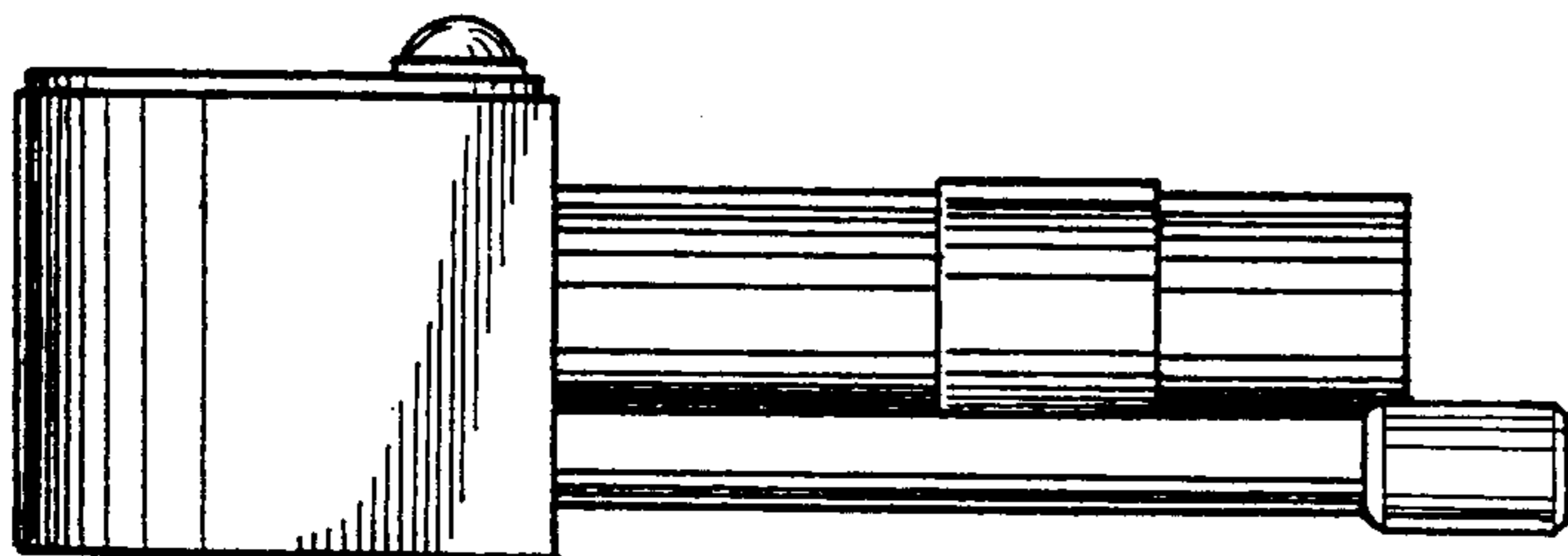

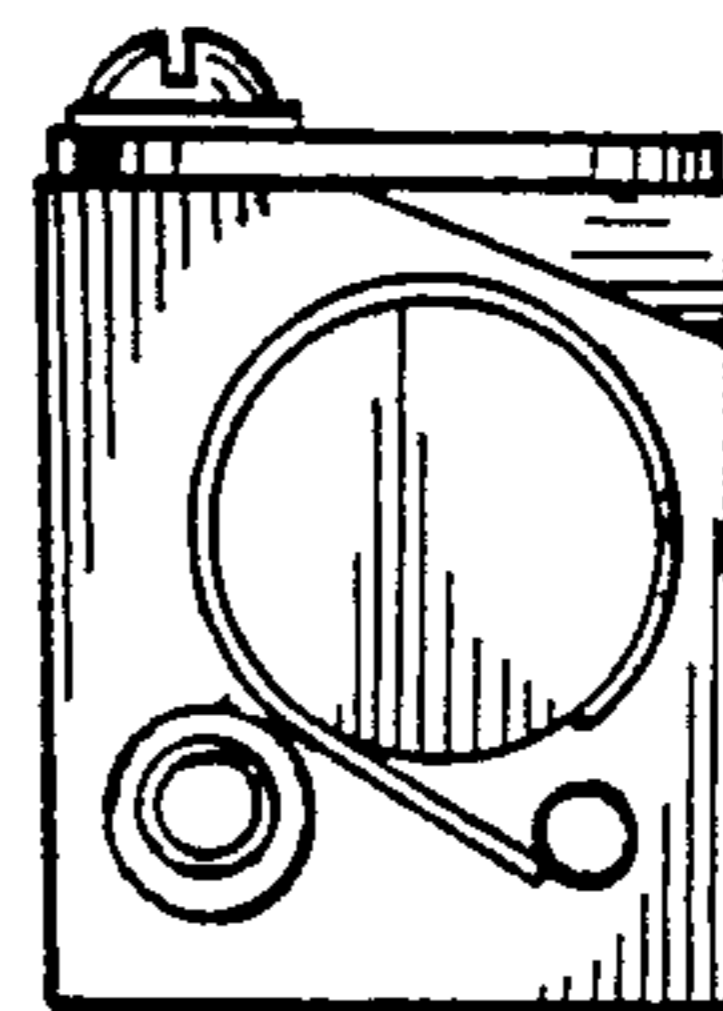

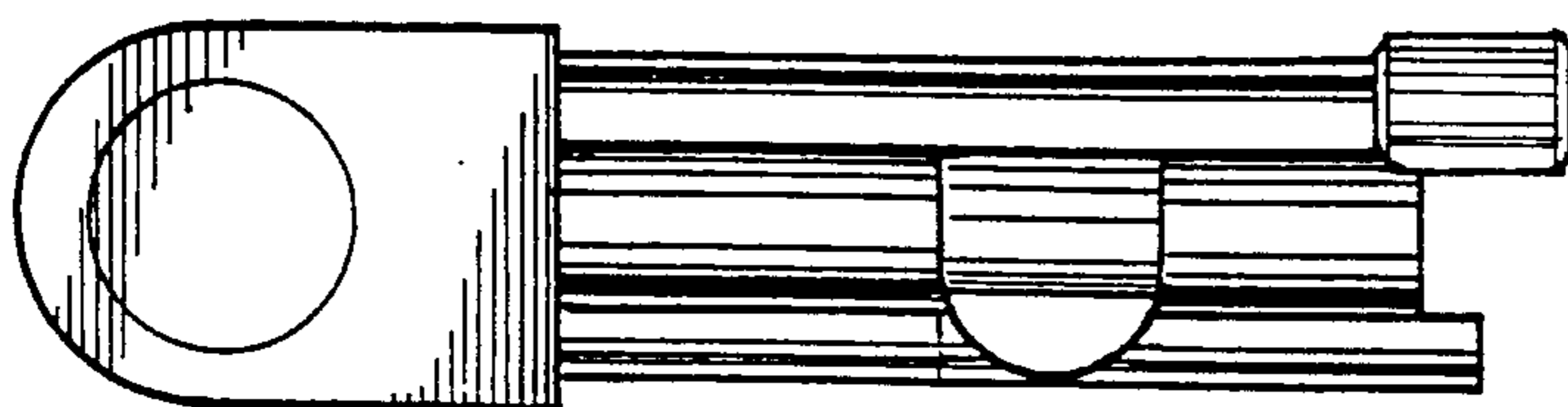

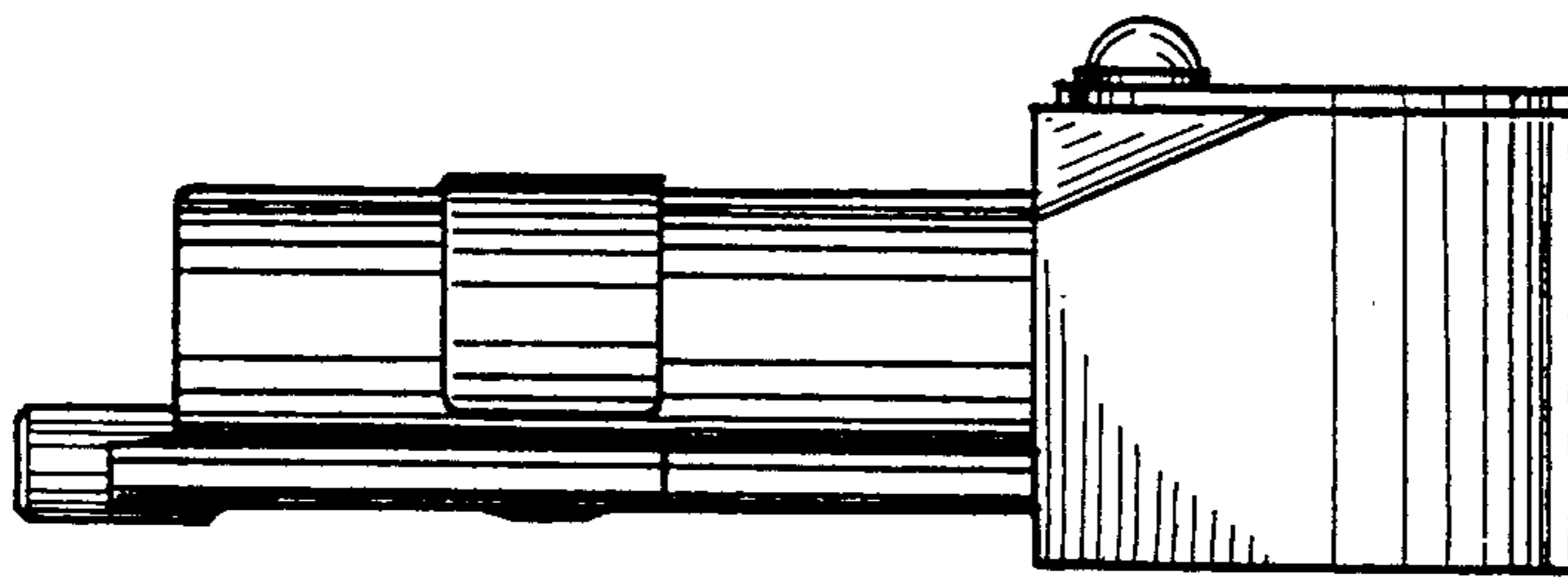

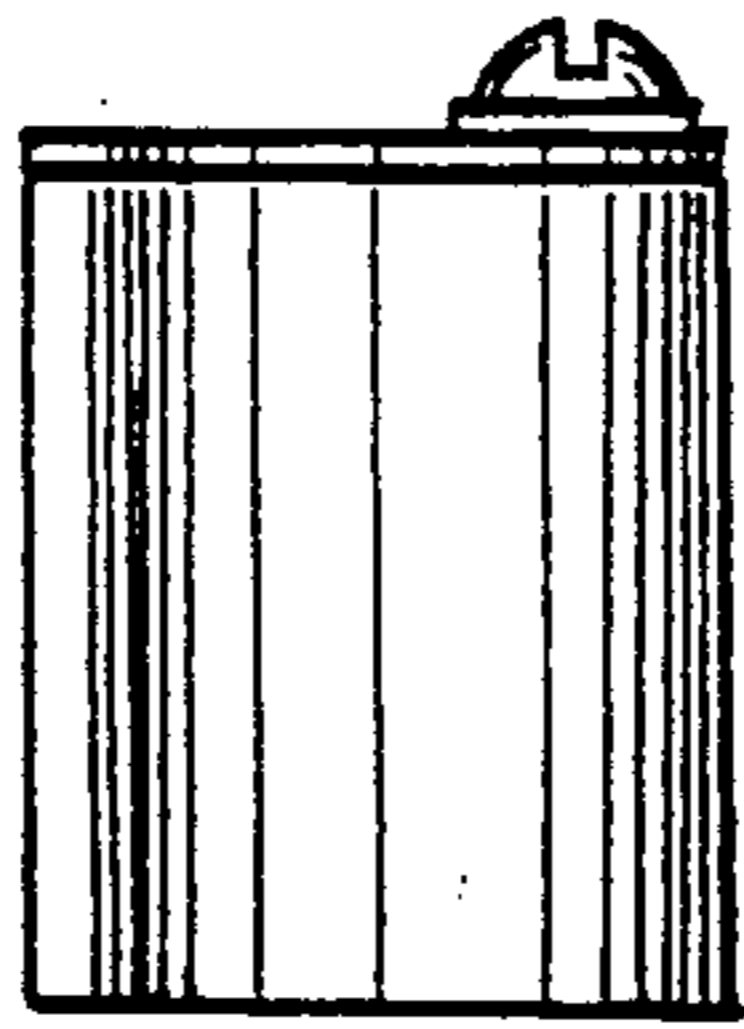
