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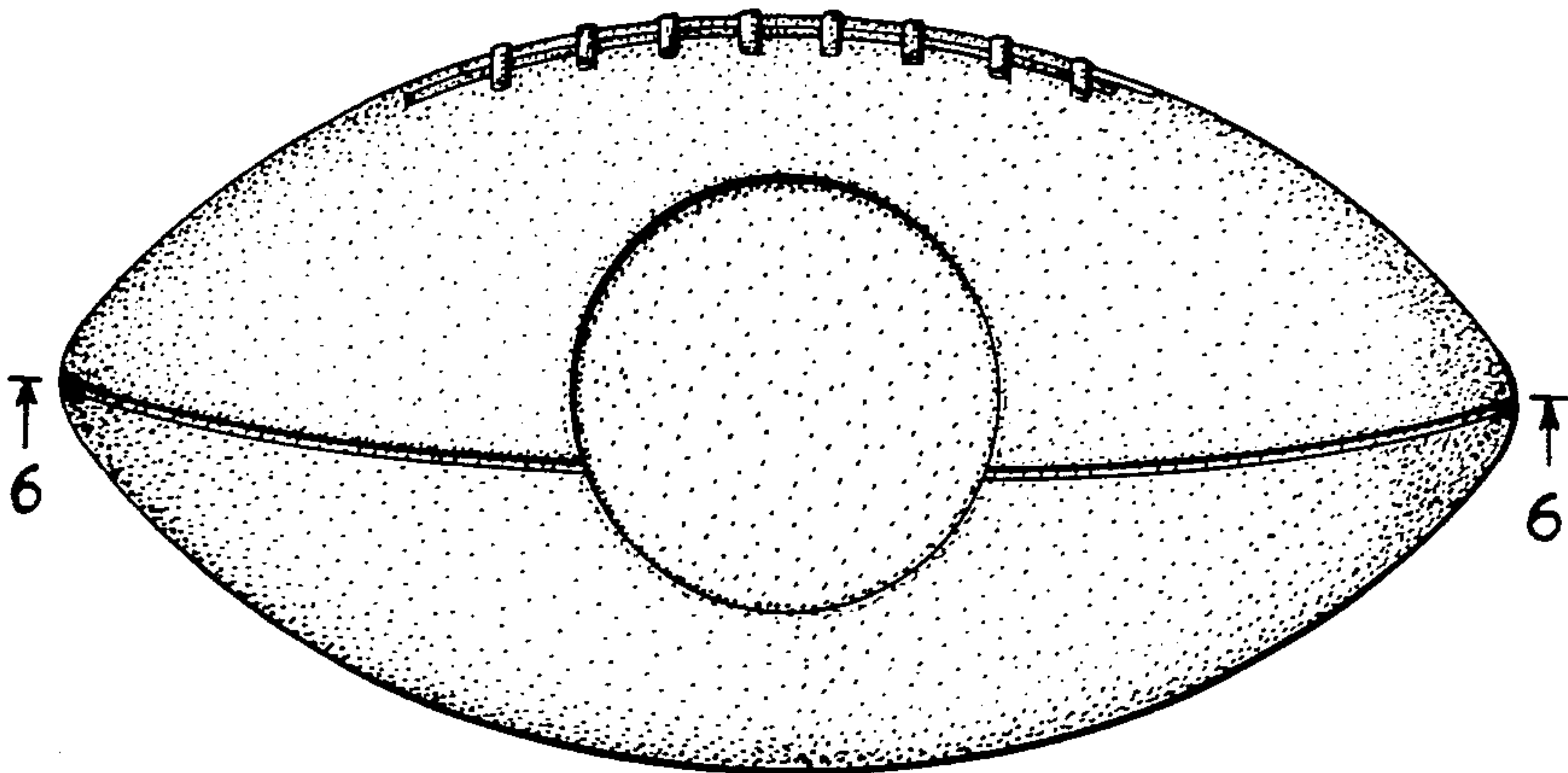

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a simulative photo frame showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 6—6 in FIG. 1.



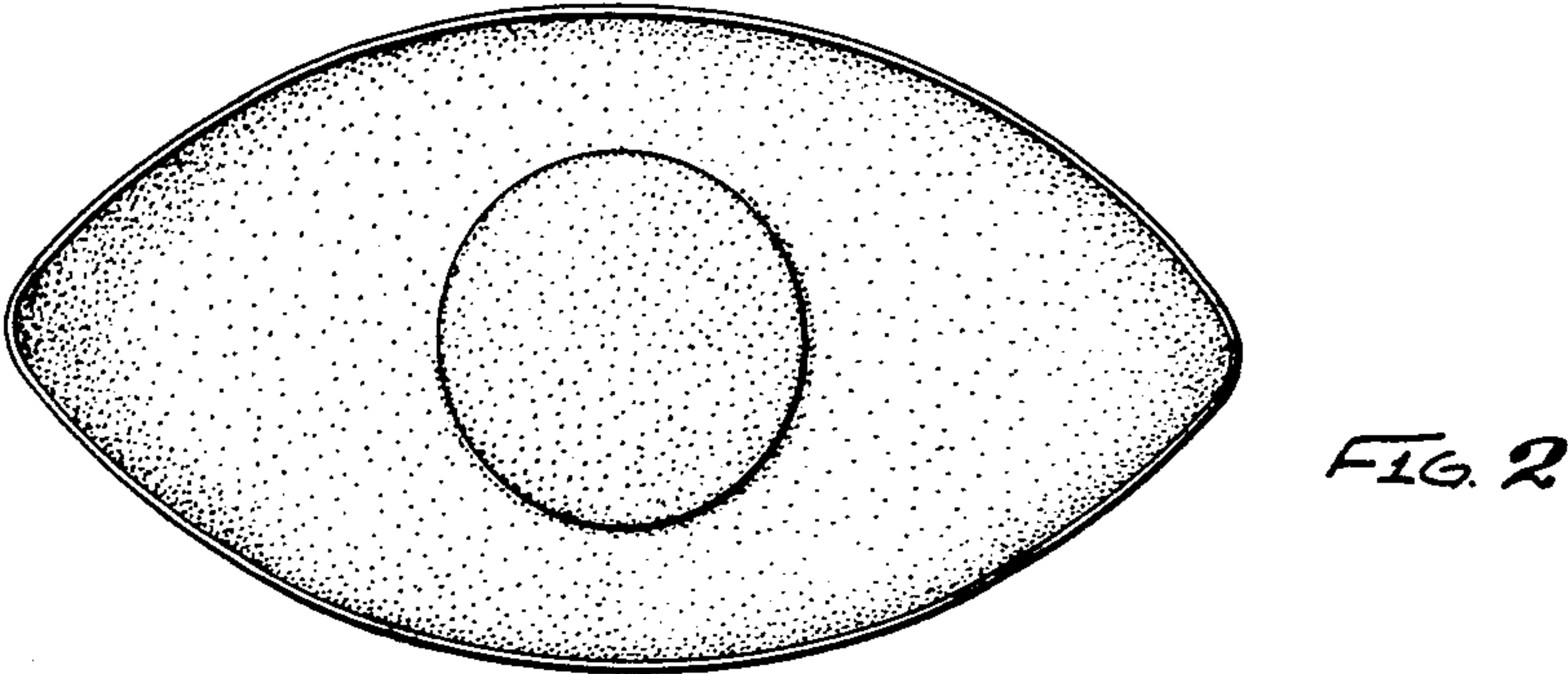
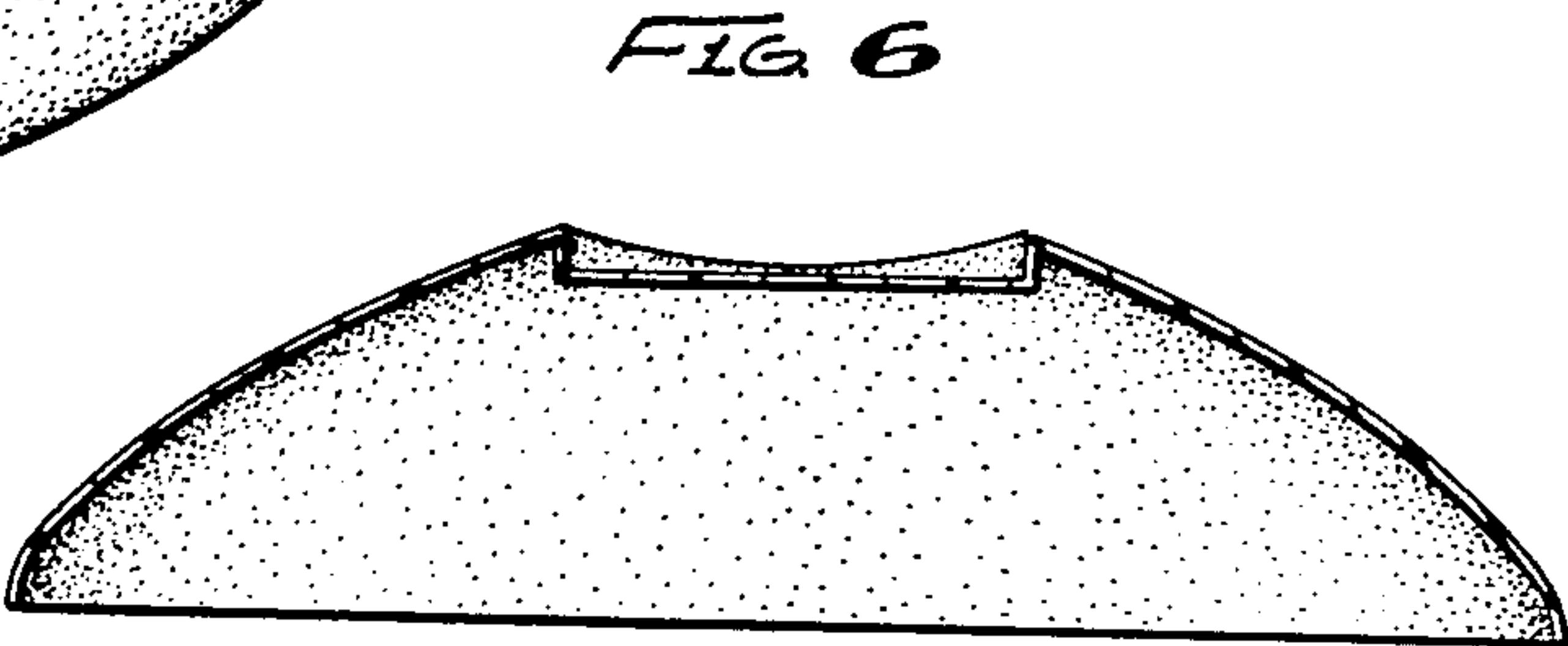
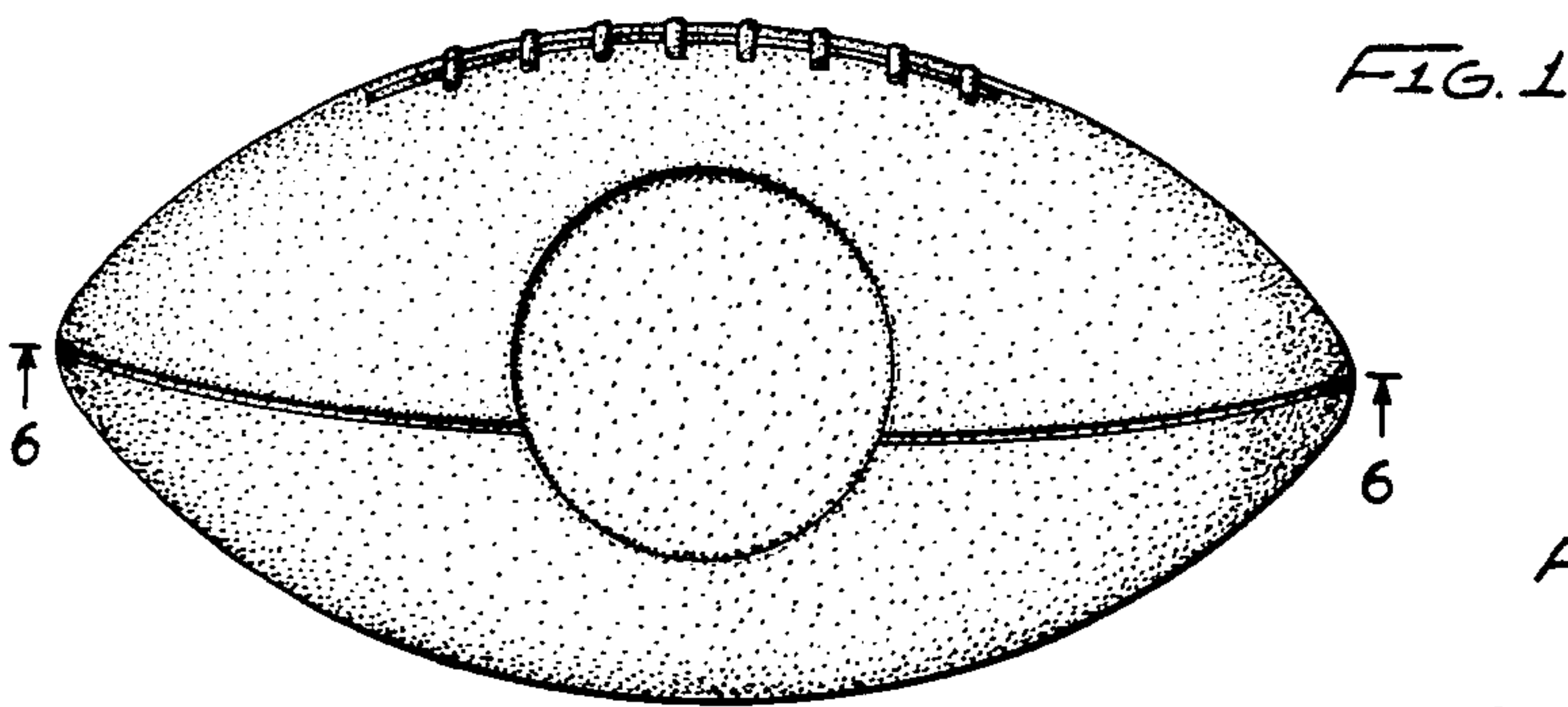

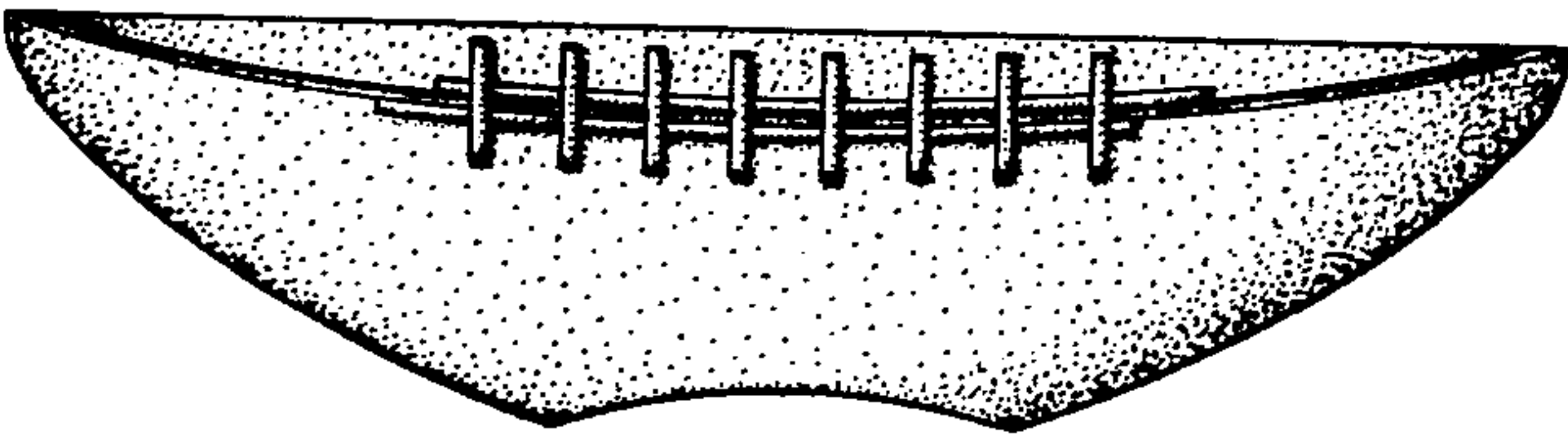

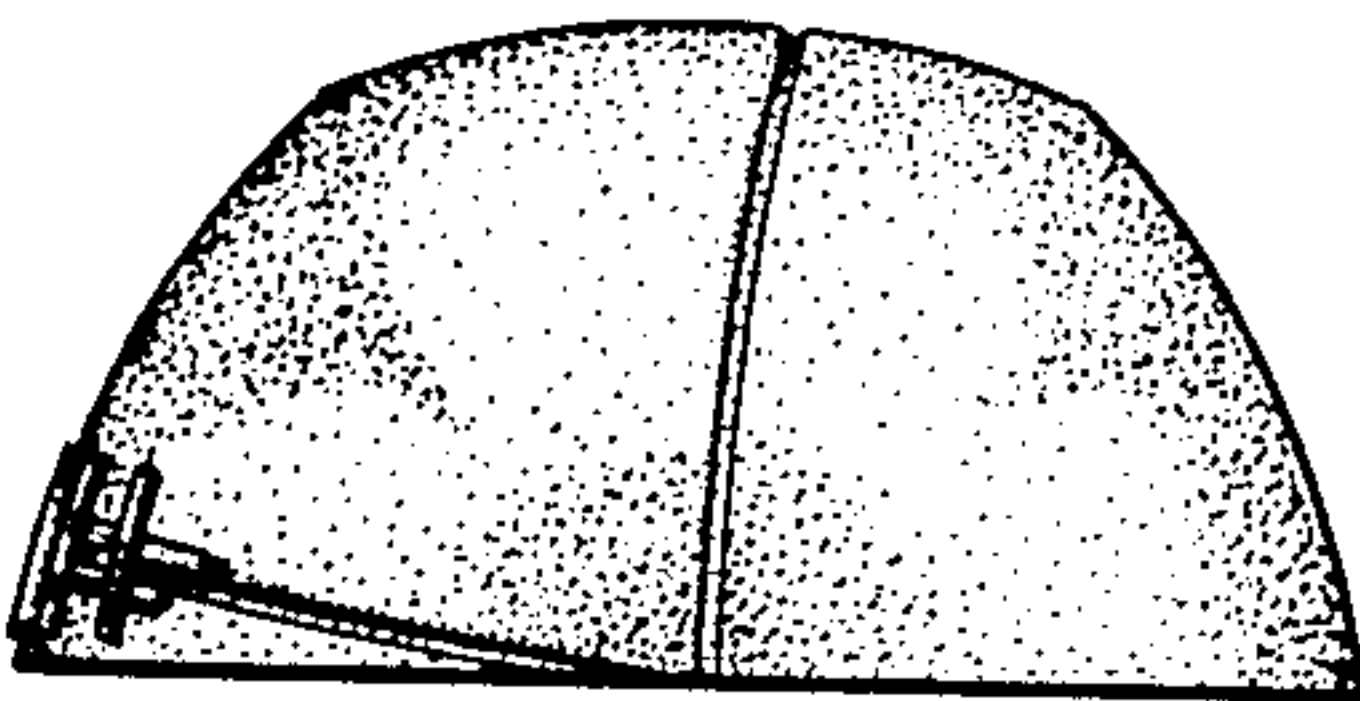
