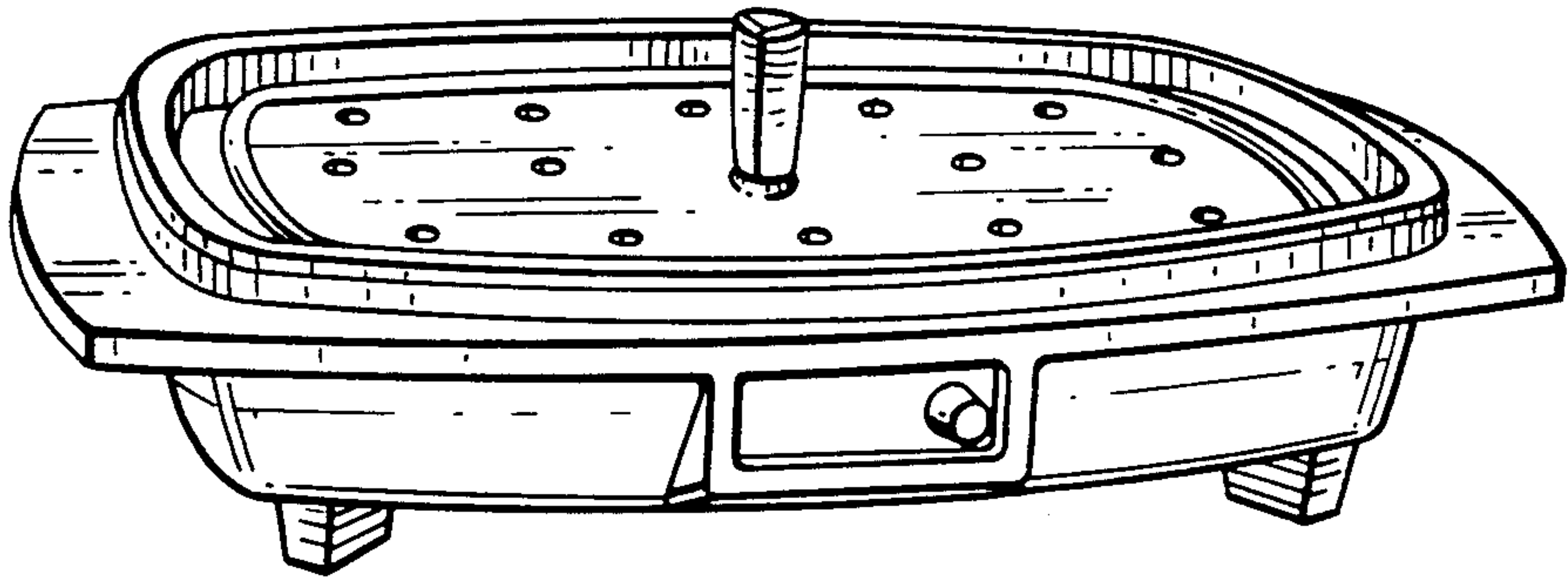
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sausage cooker, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sausage cooker showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.

The characteristic feature of our design resides in the handled perforated plate in combination with the base as shown.



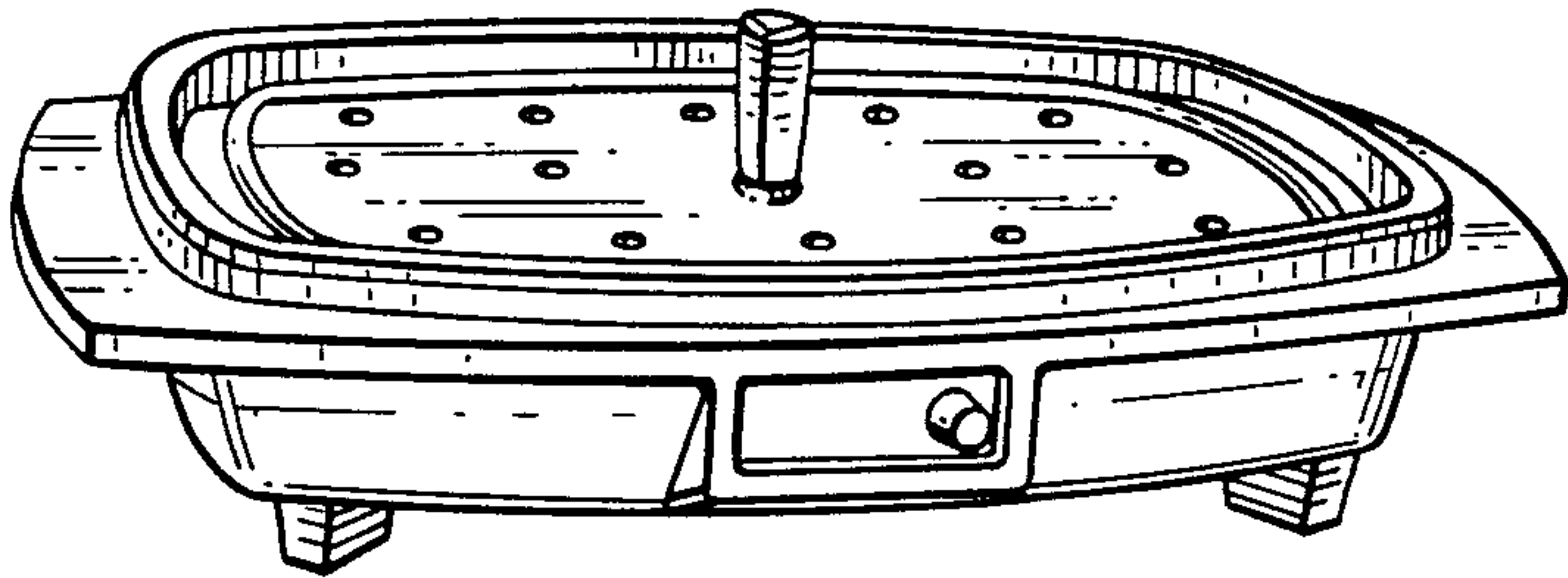

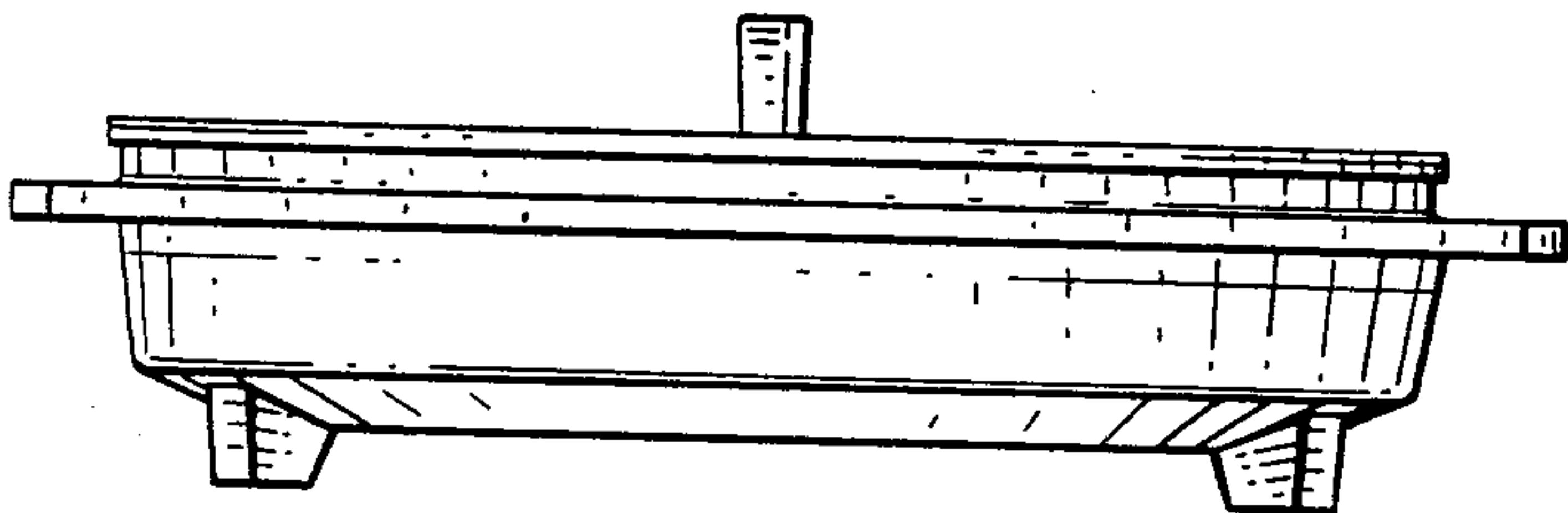

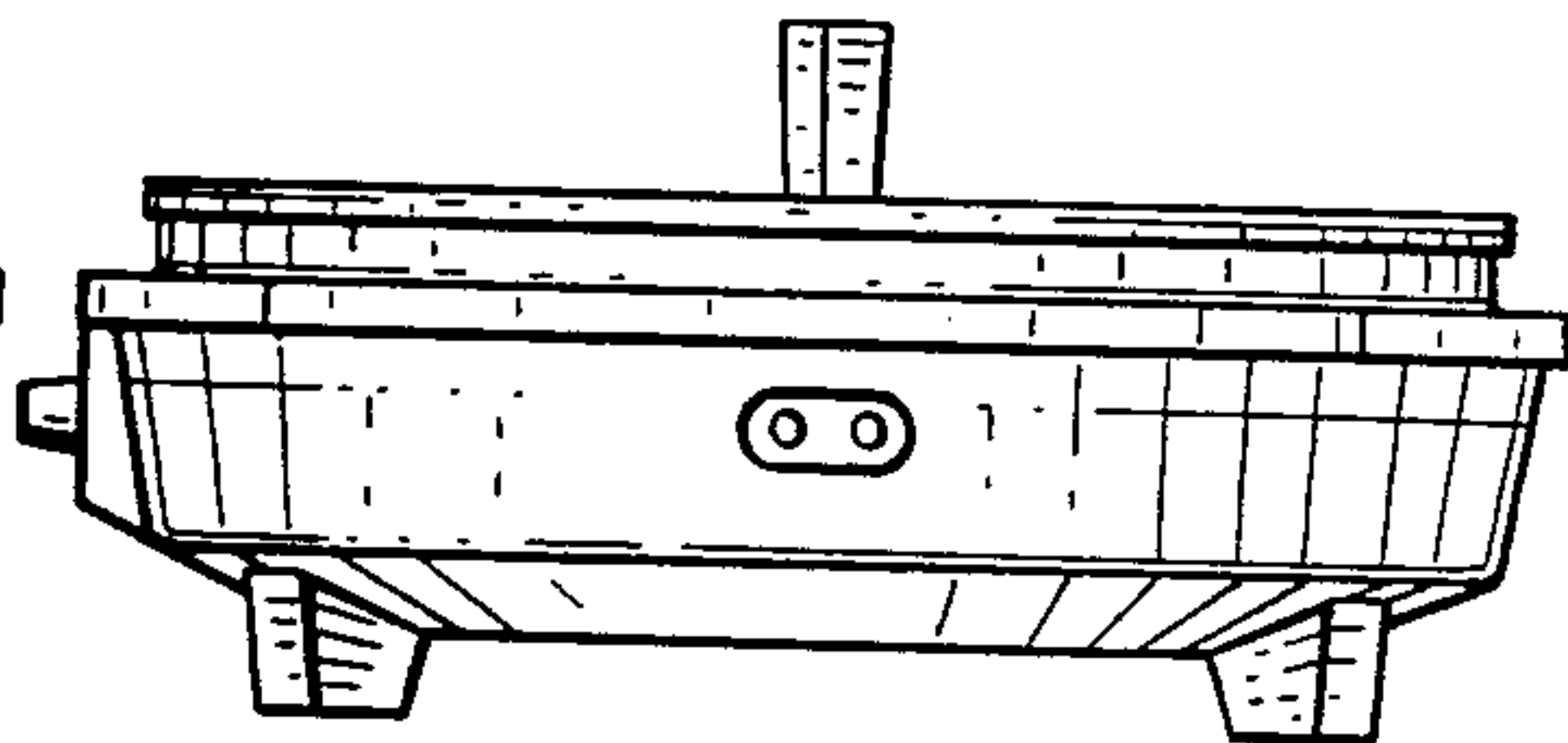

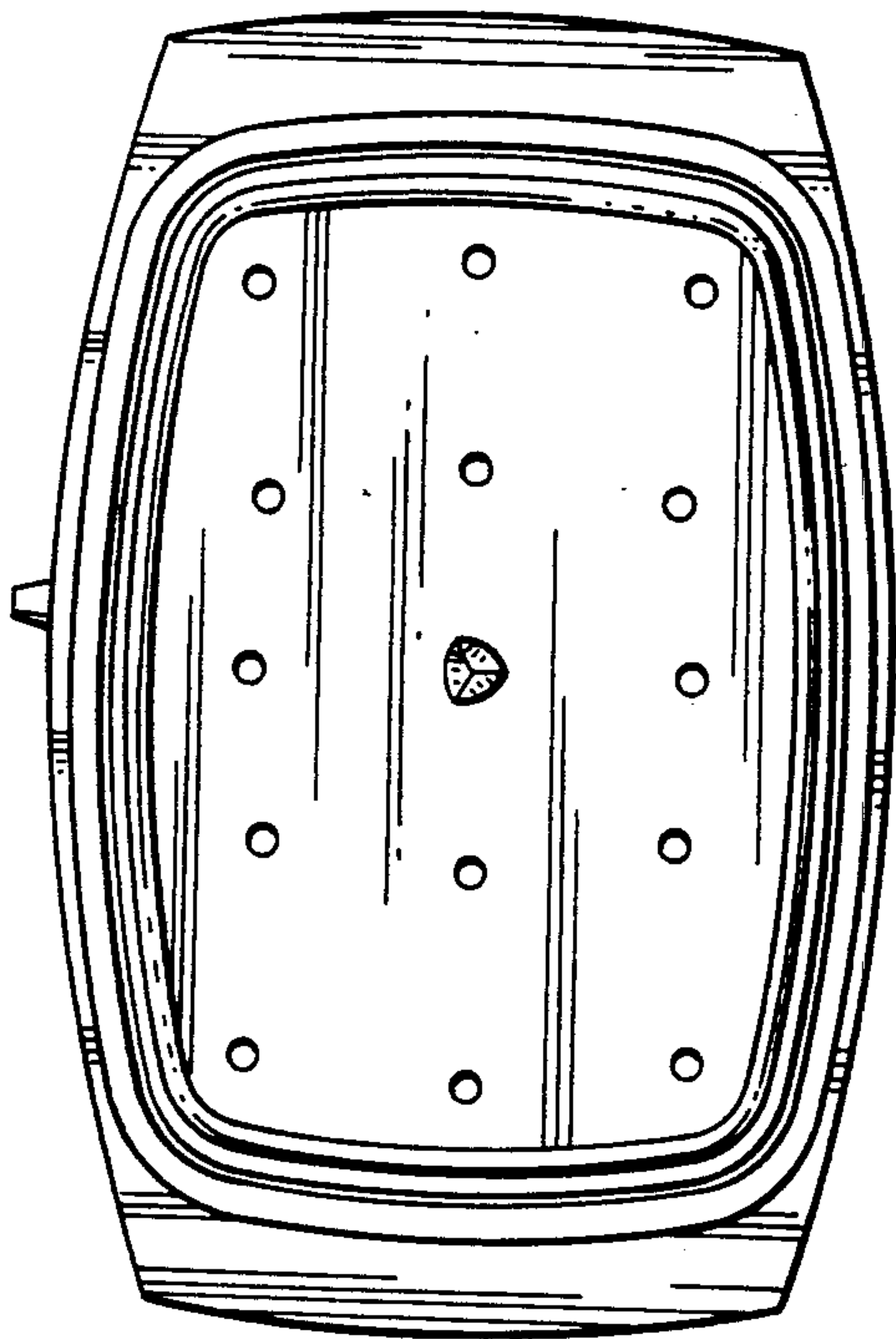

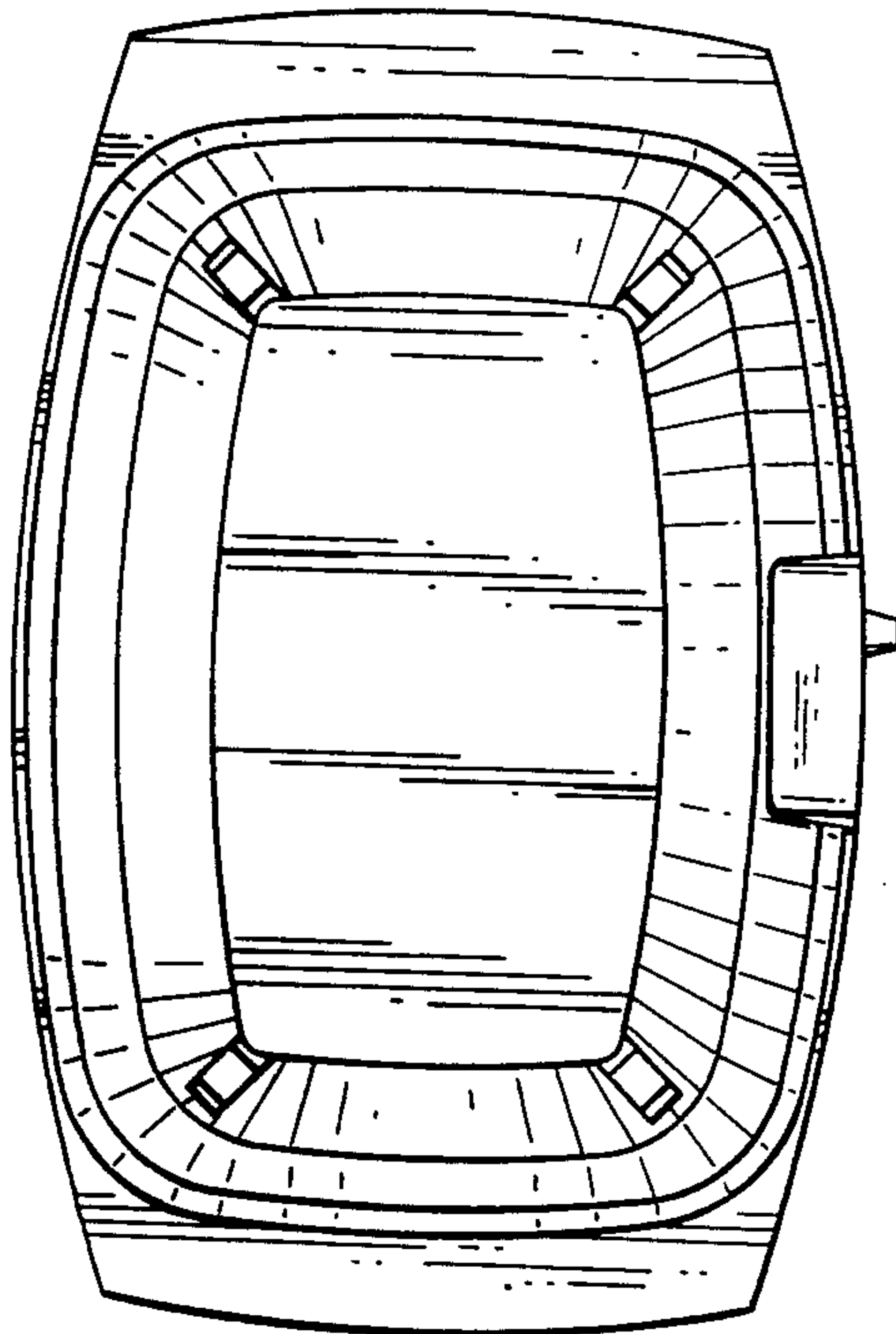
