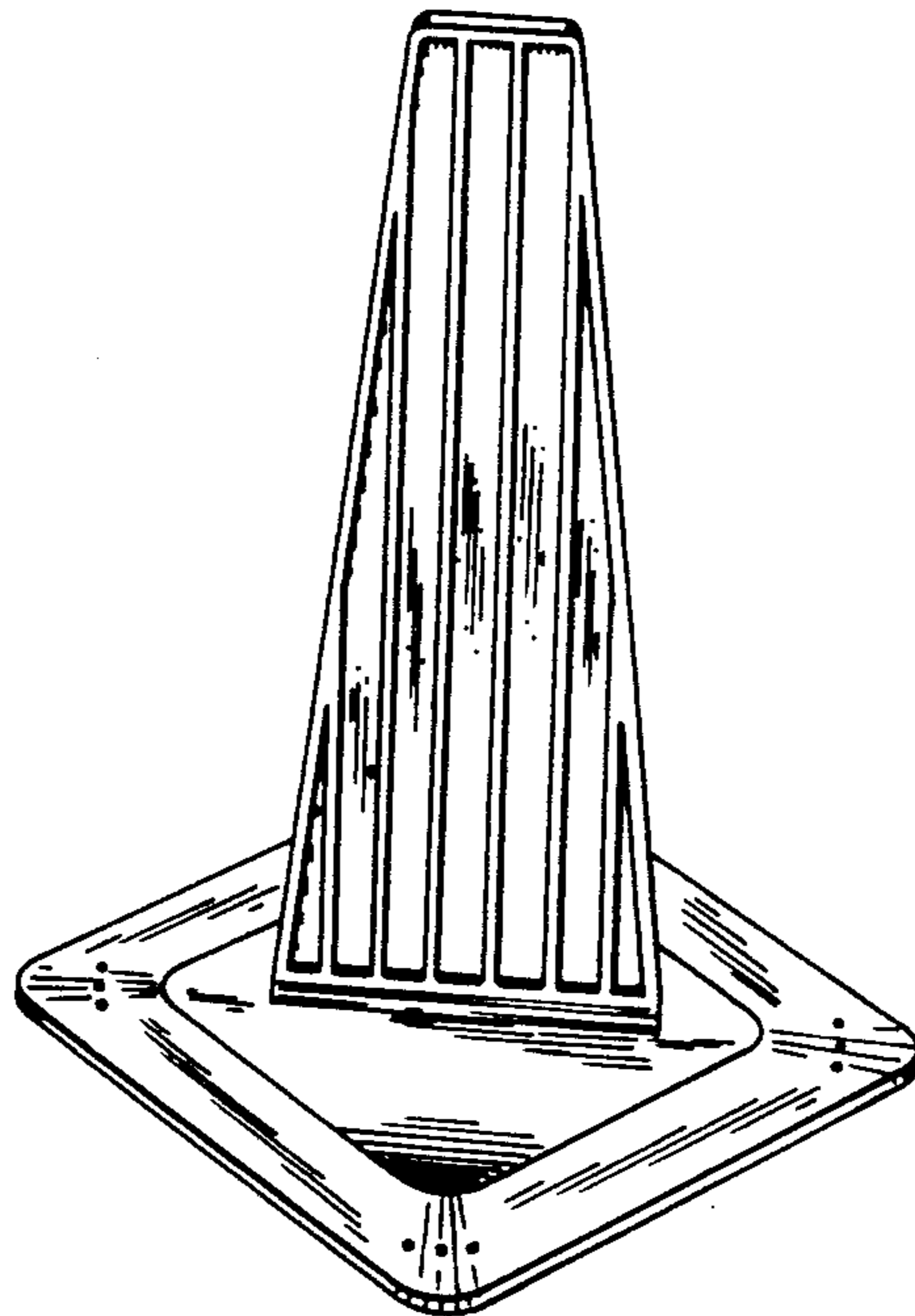

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a highway safety marker, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a highway safety marker showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;
 FIG. 3 is a front view thereof on an enlarged scale, the rear being a mirror image;
 FIG. 4 is a greatly enlarged cross-sectional view as taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a side view thereof on an enlarged scale;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof on an enlarged scale.



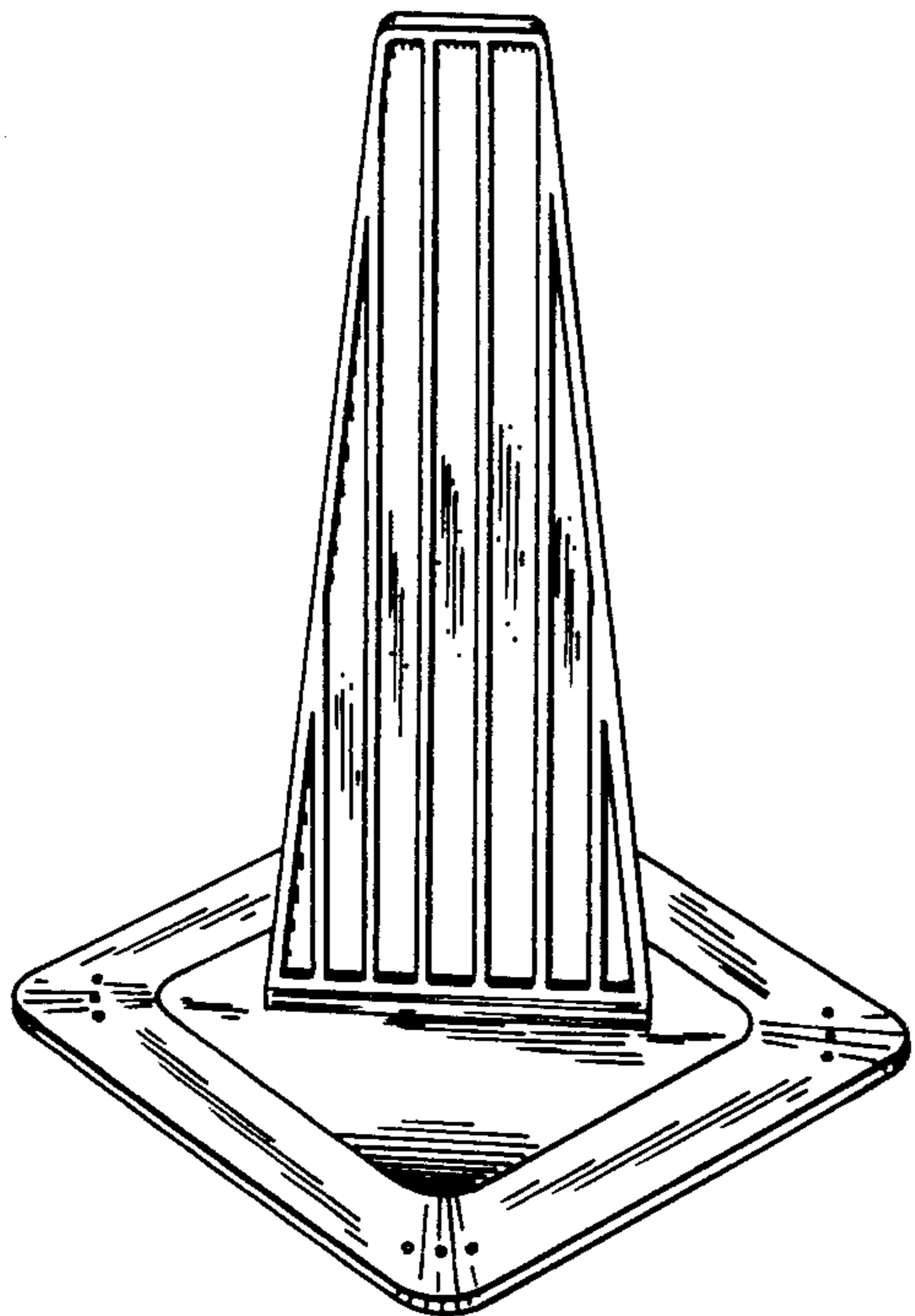

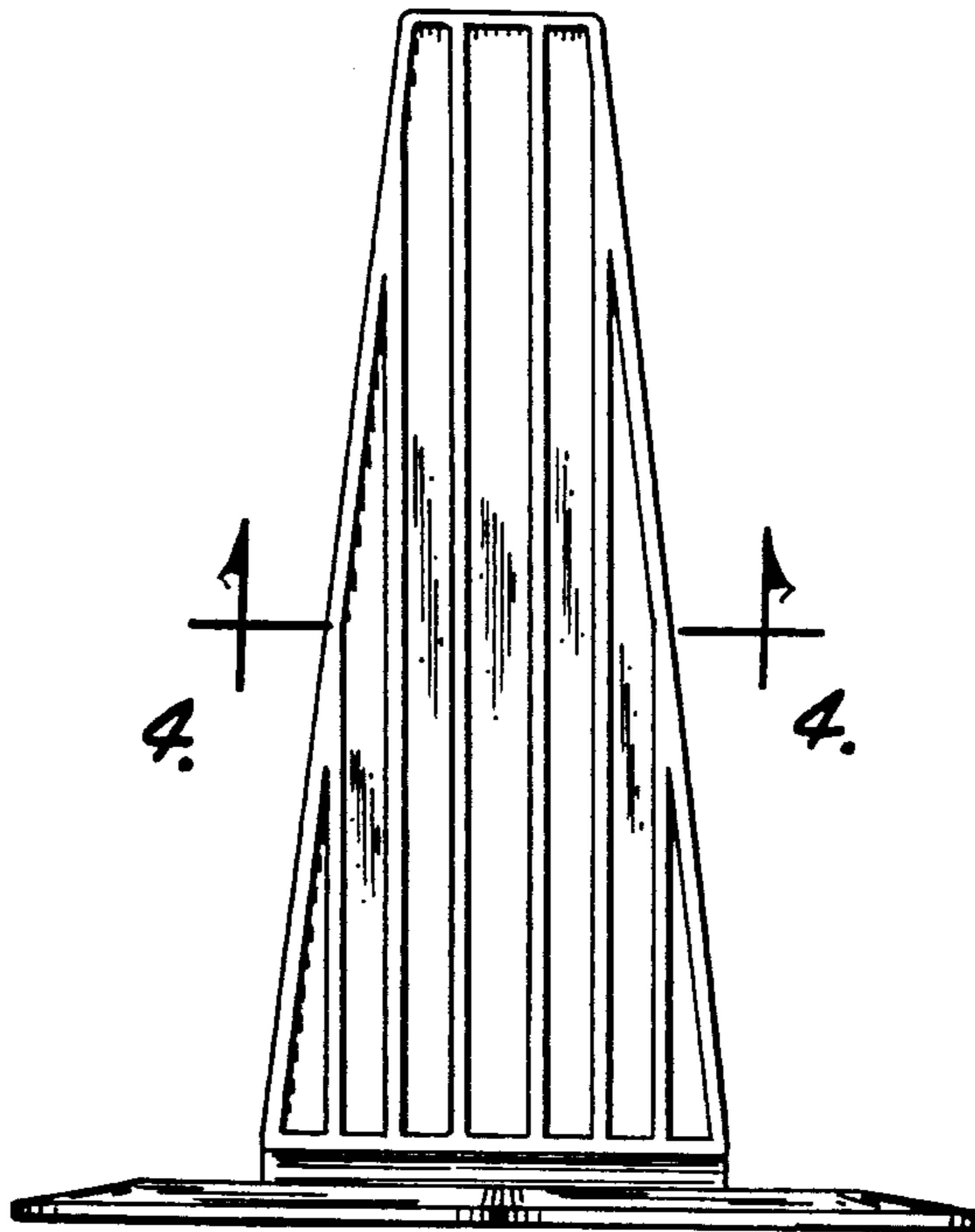

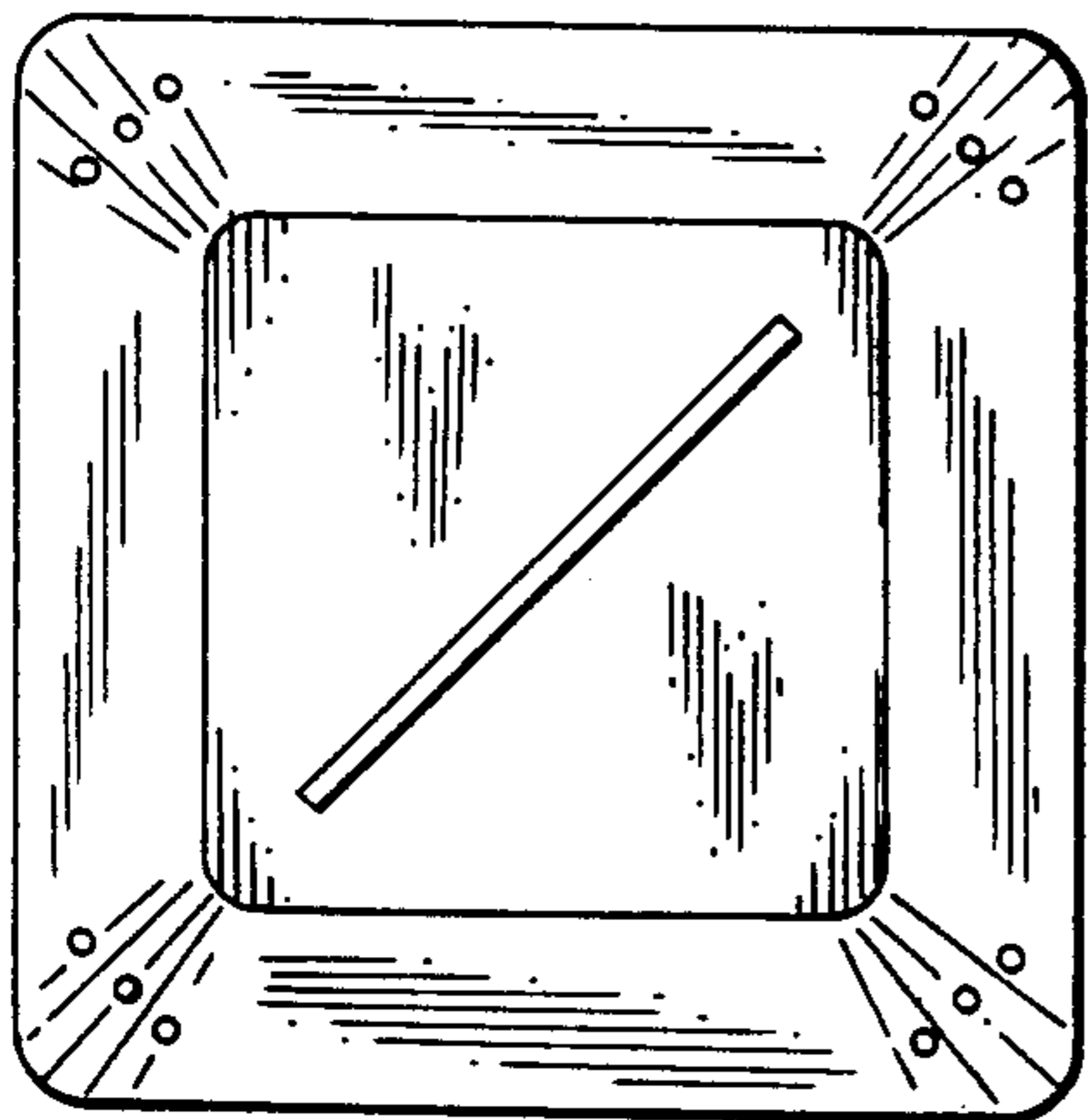

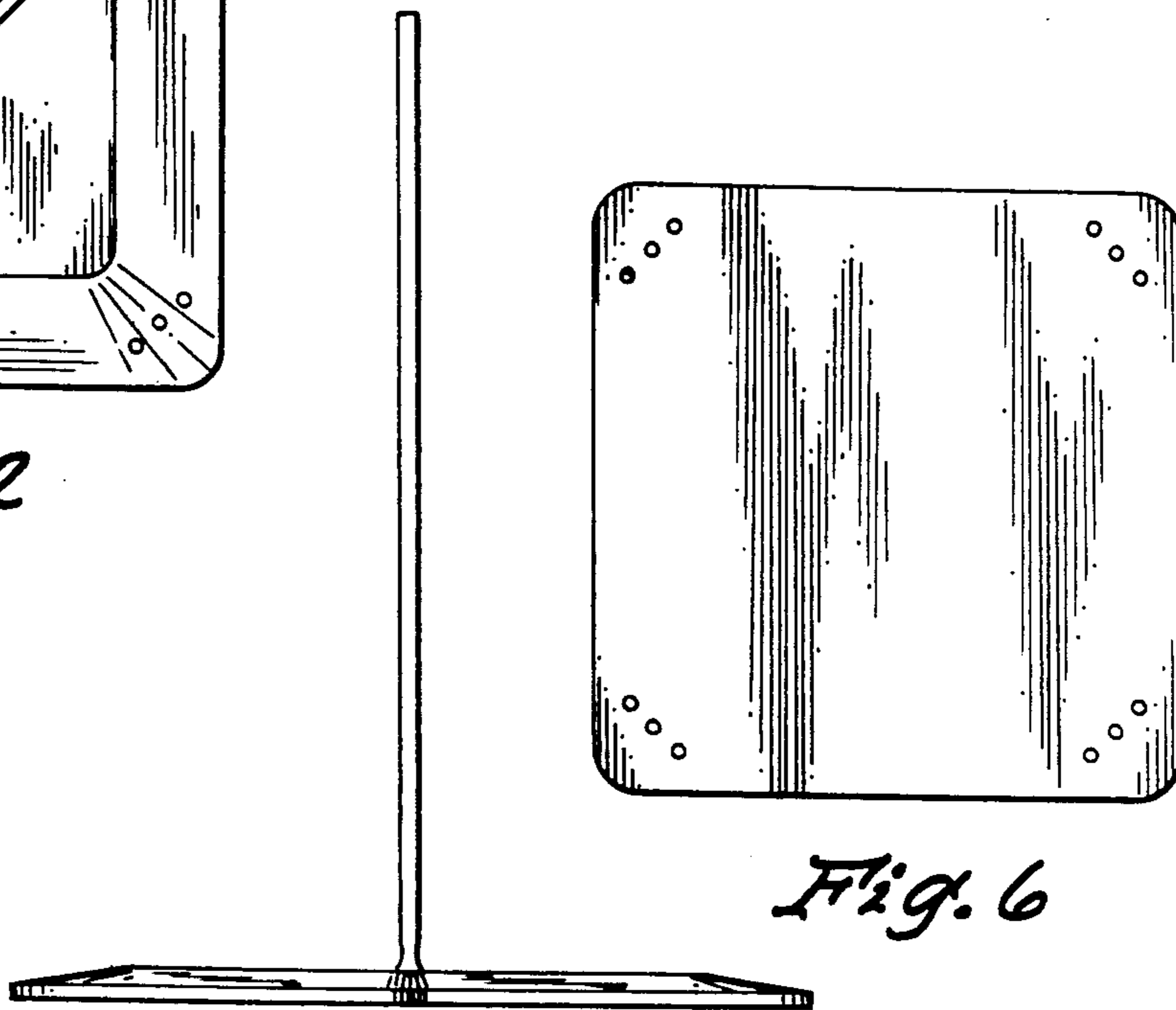
