DESCRIPTION

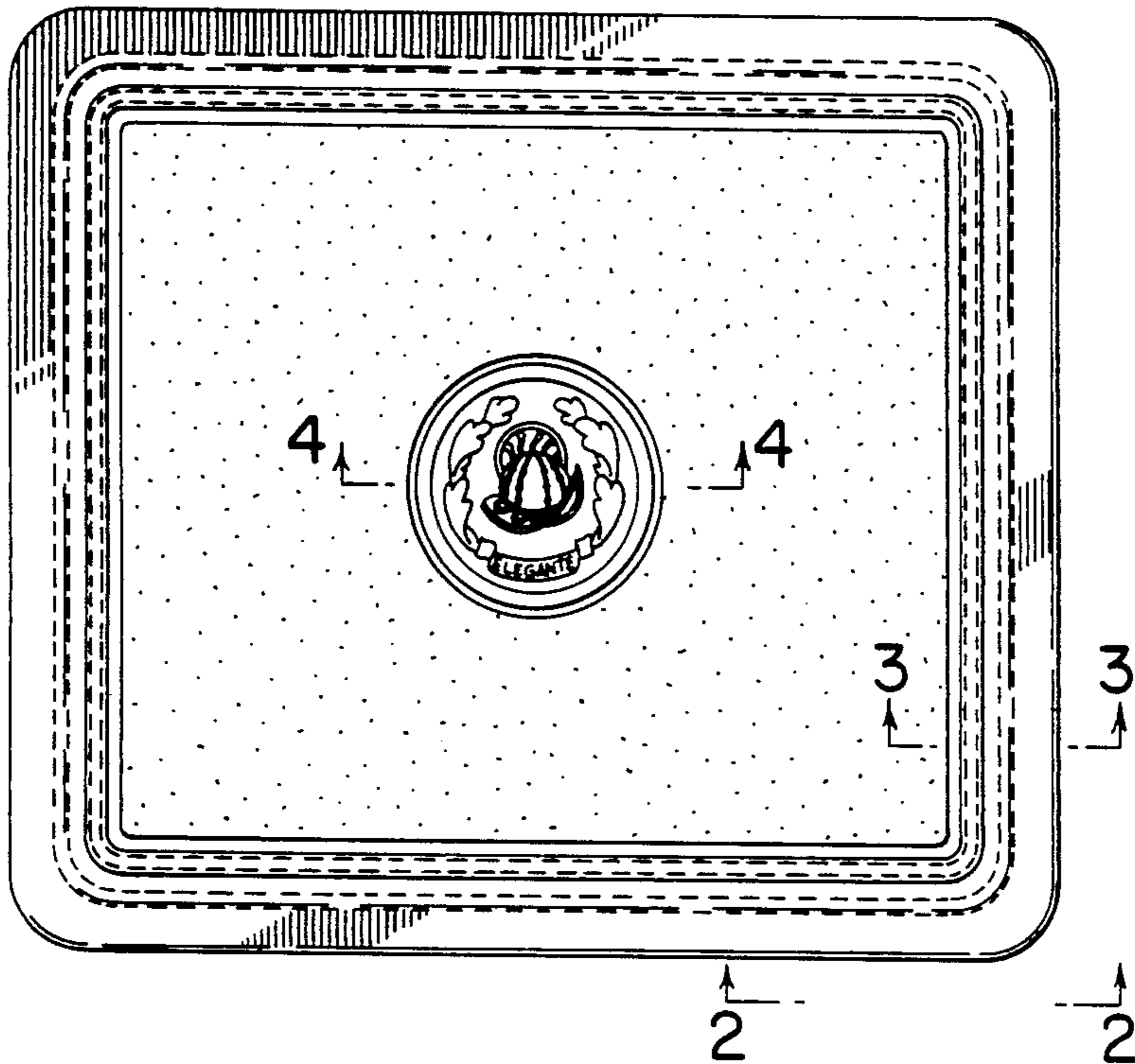
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a rear auto mat showing my new design with the details omitted and accurately shown in FIGS. 2, 3 and 4 for convenience of illustration.

FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary end elevational view looking in the direction of line 2-2 of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view on line 3-3 of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view on line 4-4 of FIG. 1.

The bottom of the mat is understood to be flat and unornamented.



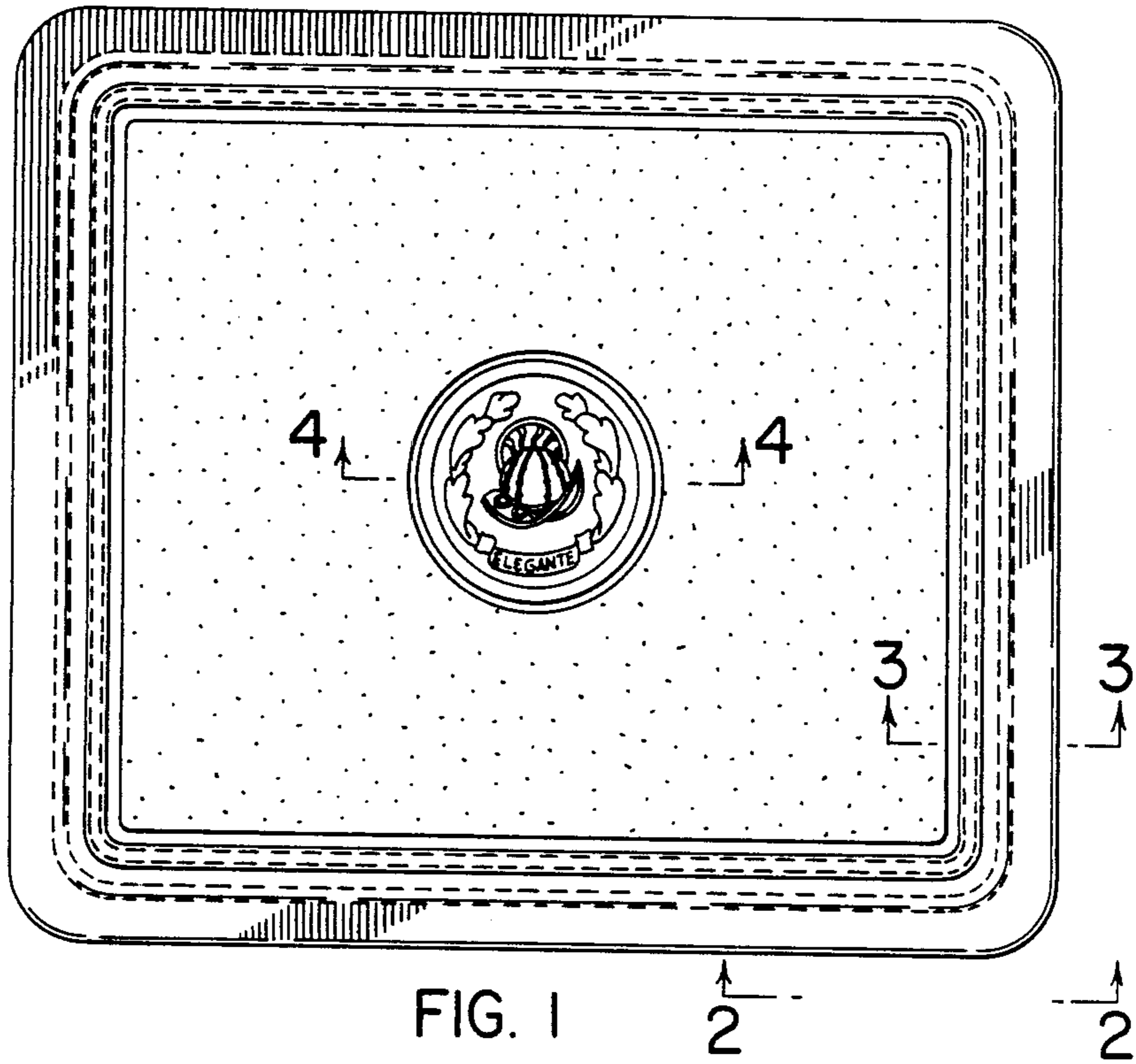

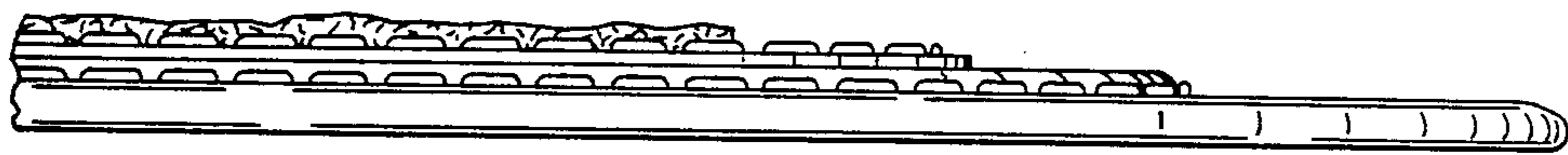

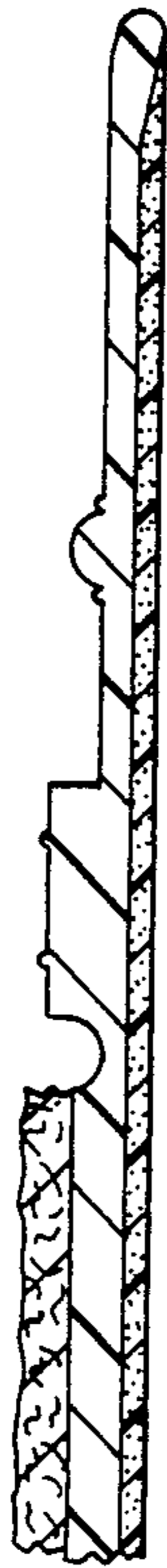
