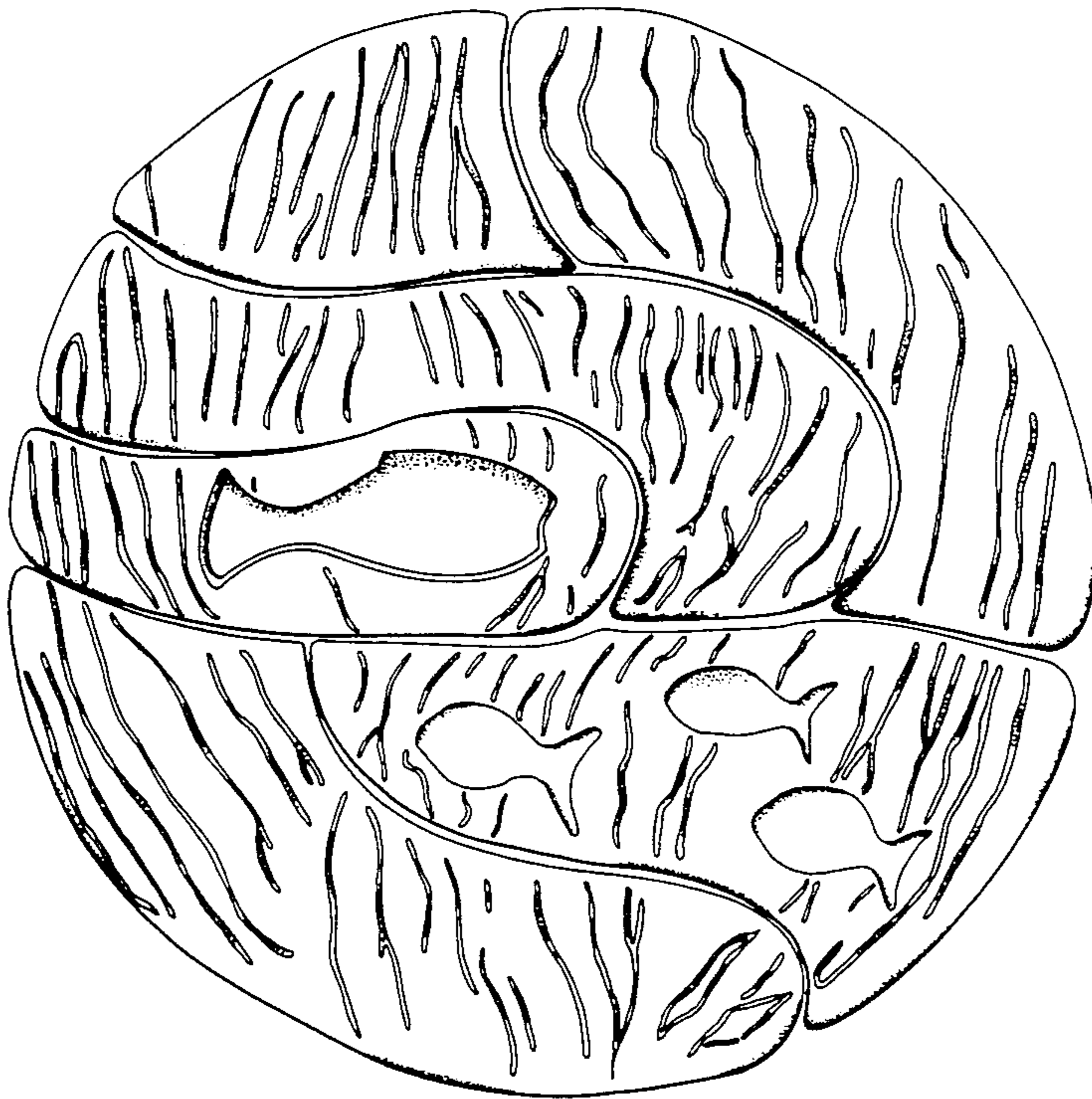
DESCRIPTION

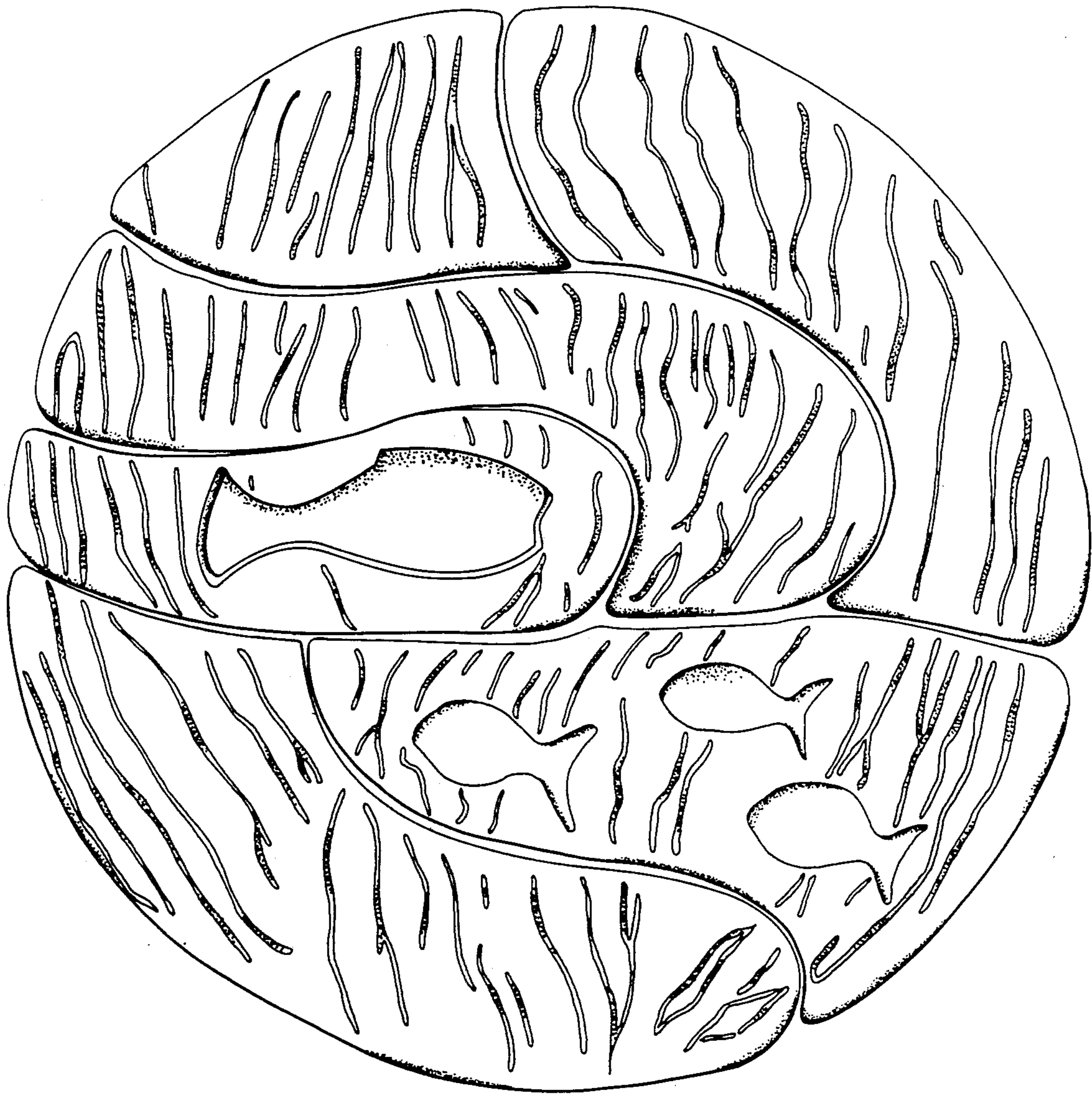

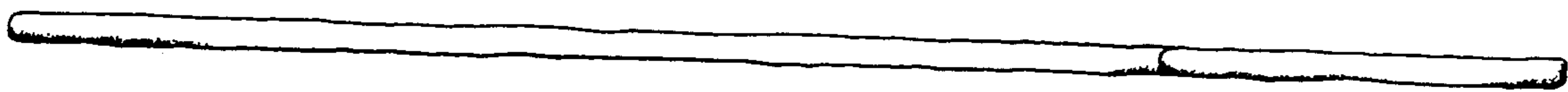
