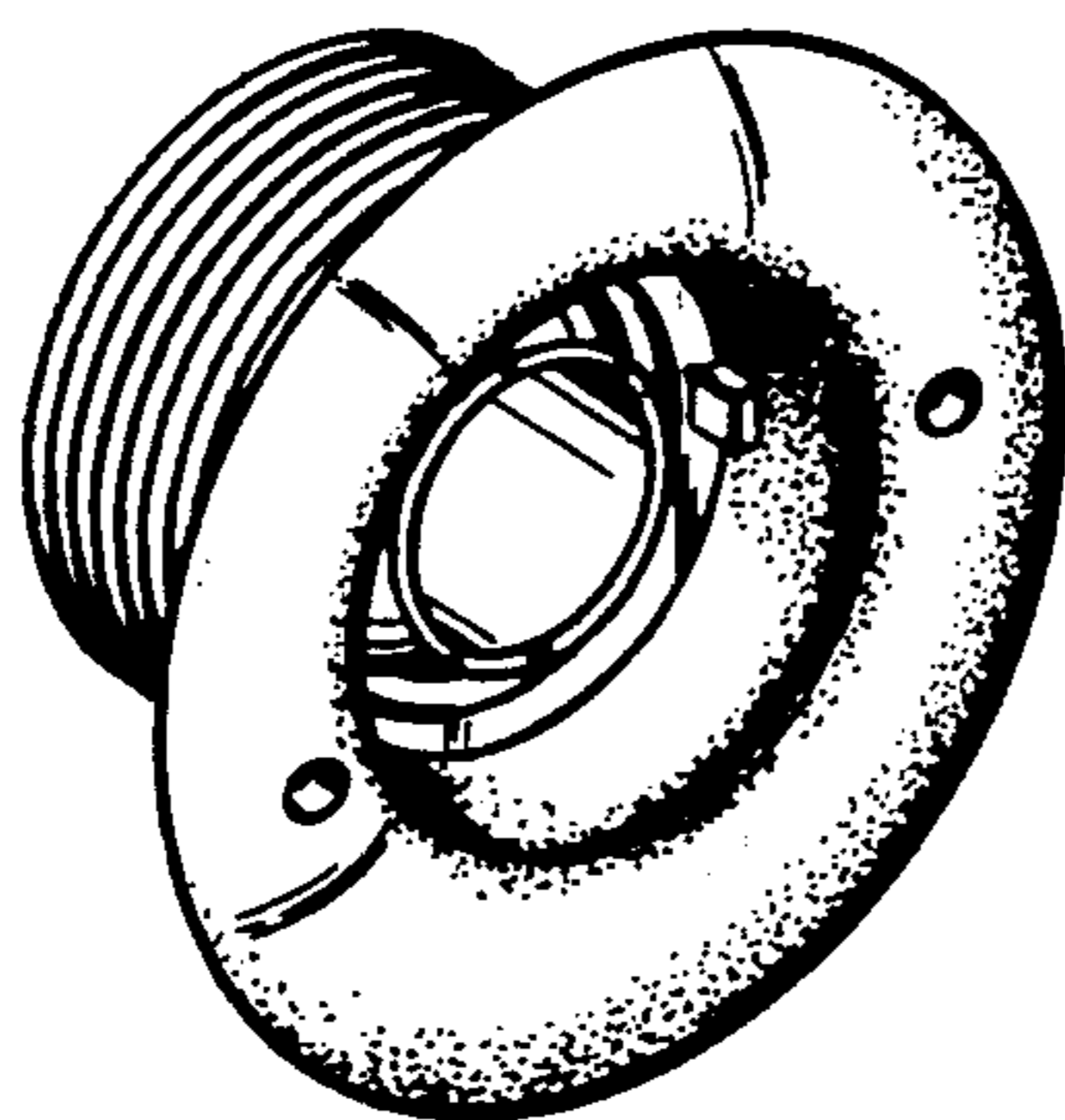
The ornamental design for a hydro-therapy fitting, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

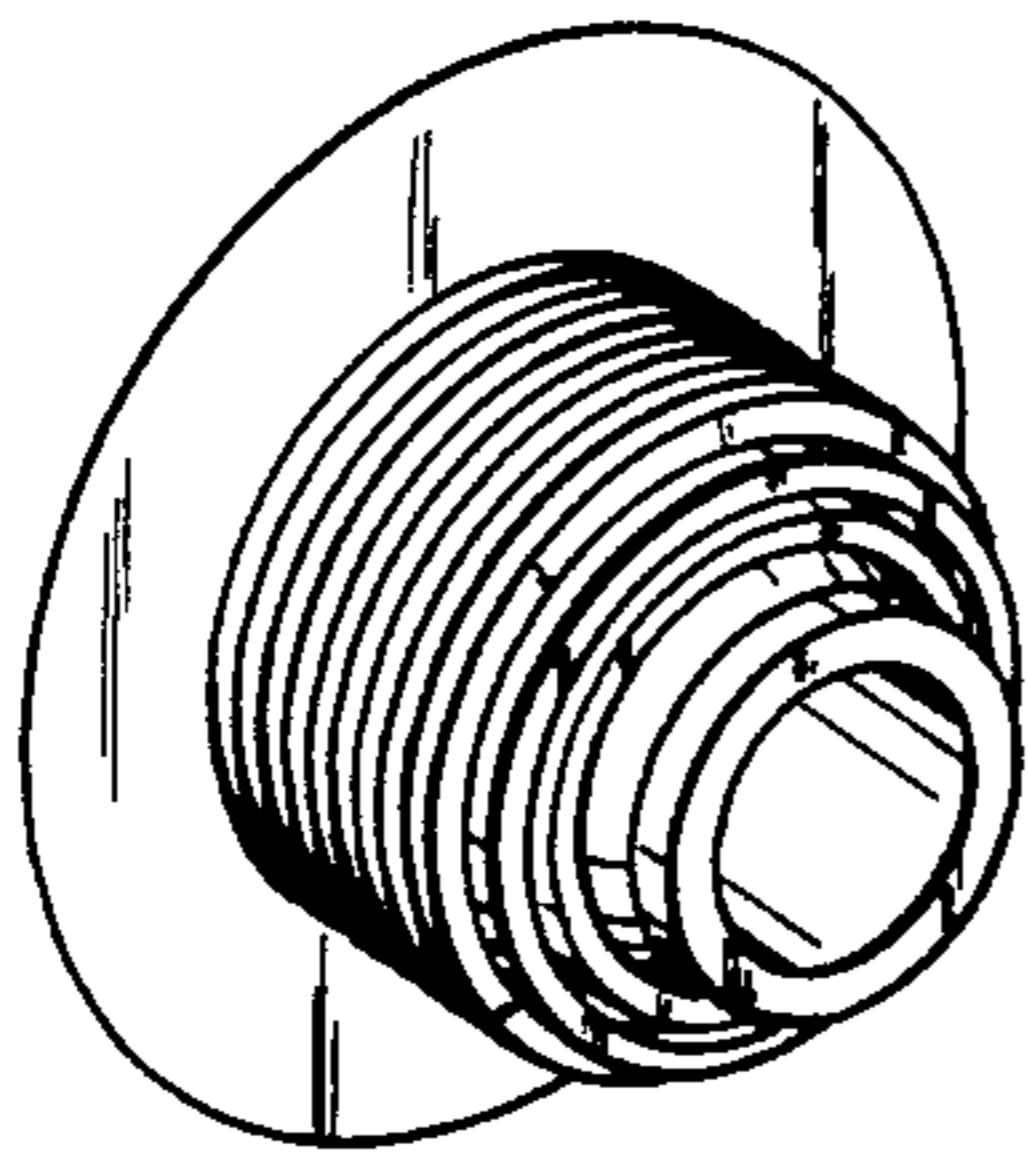
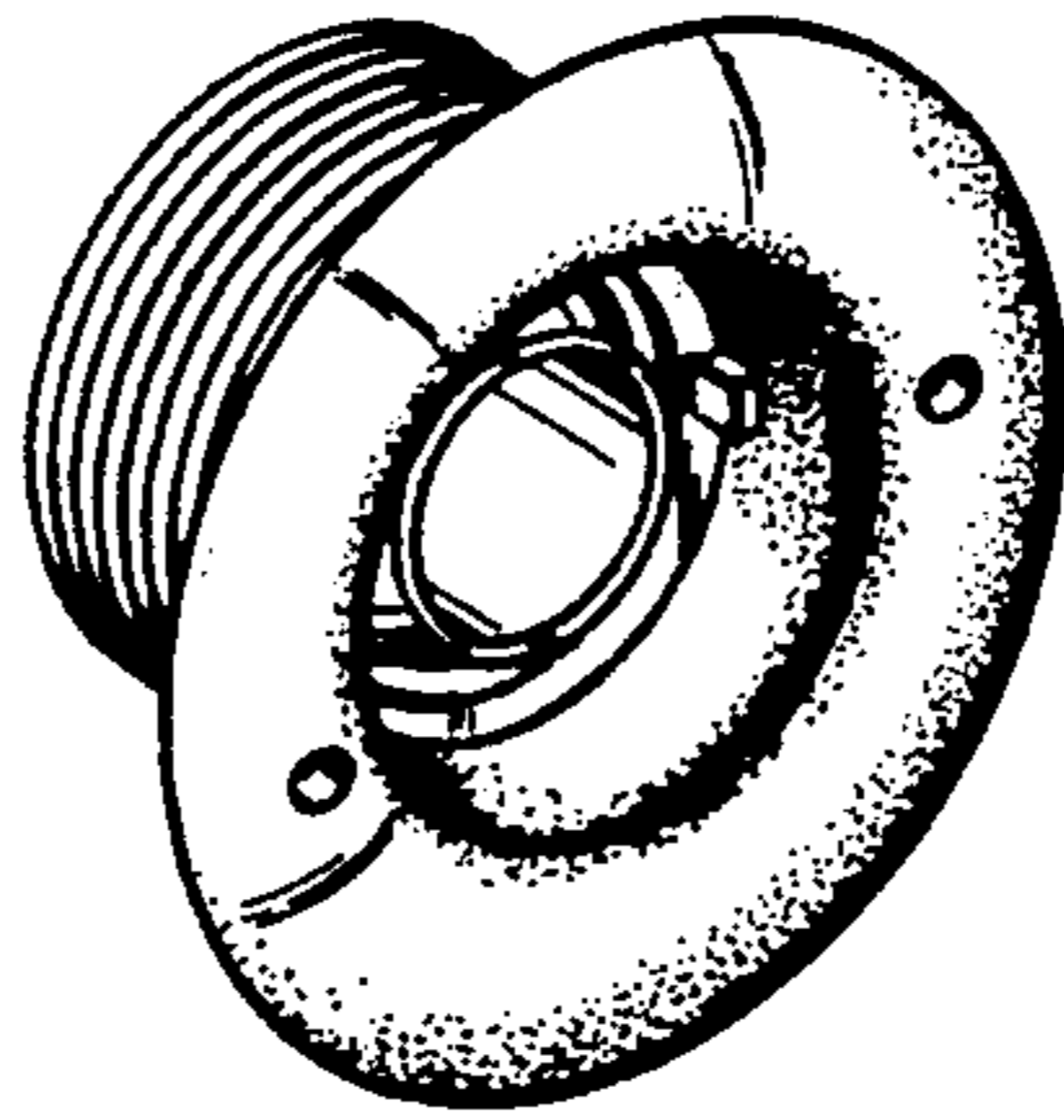
FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a hydro-therapy fitting showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the bottom rear and right side thereof; and

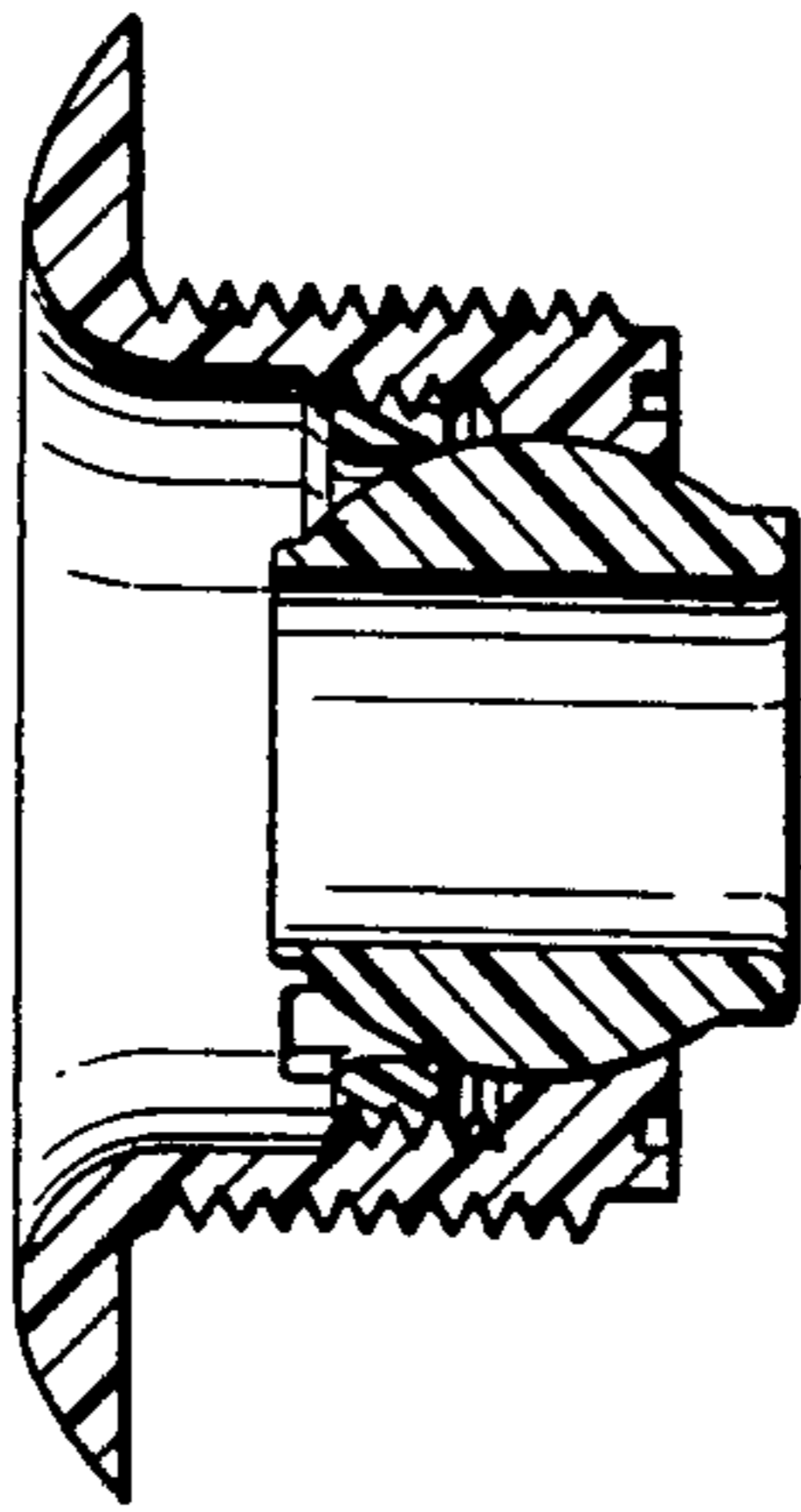
FIG. 3 is a cross sectional view taken on line 3-3 of FIG. 1.
