DESCRIPTION  
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a leisure chair showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a right end elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the leisure chair showing it in an alternative position.

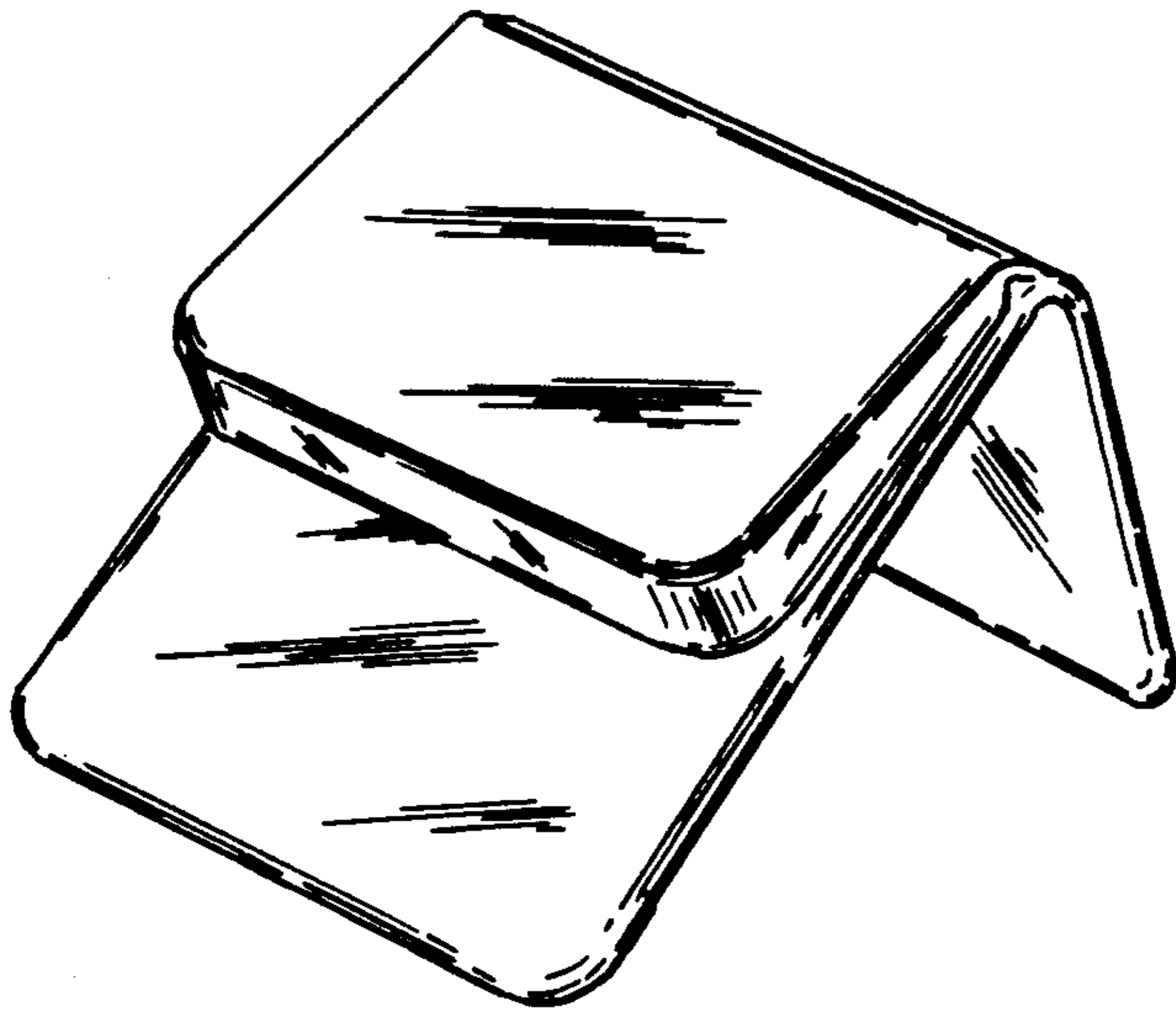

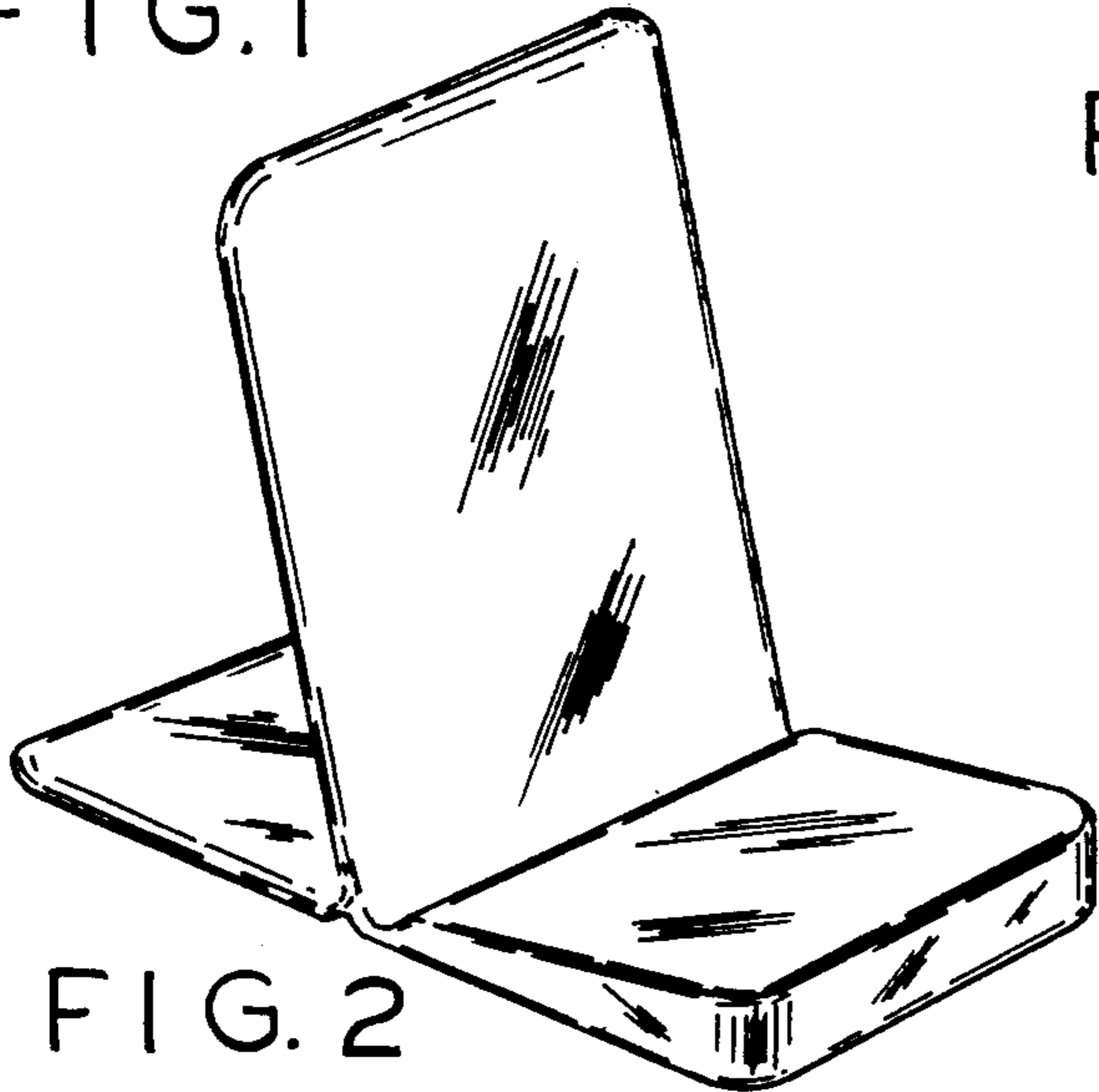

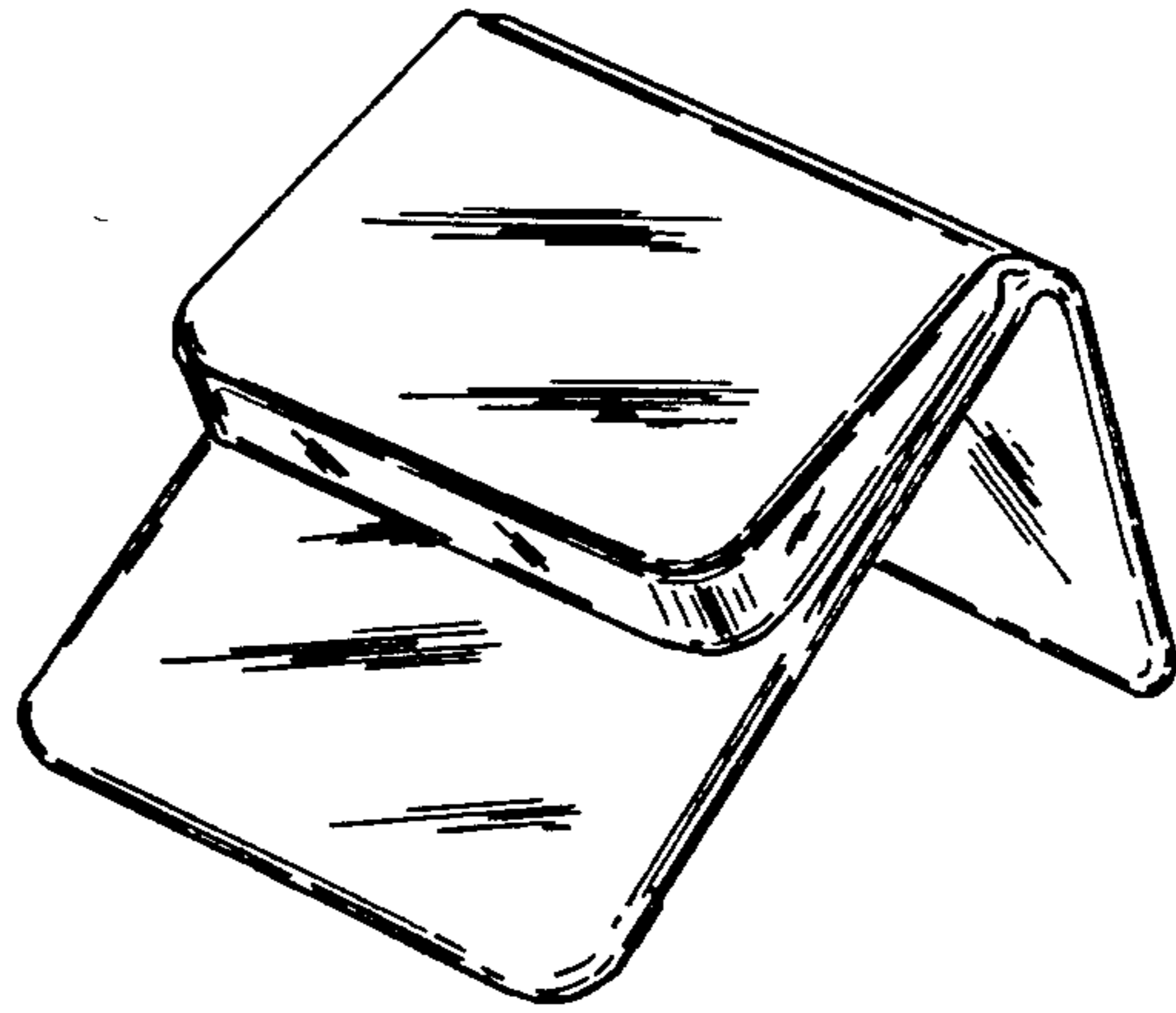

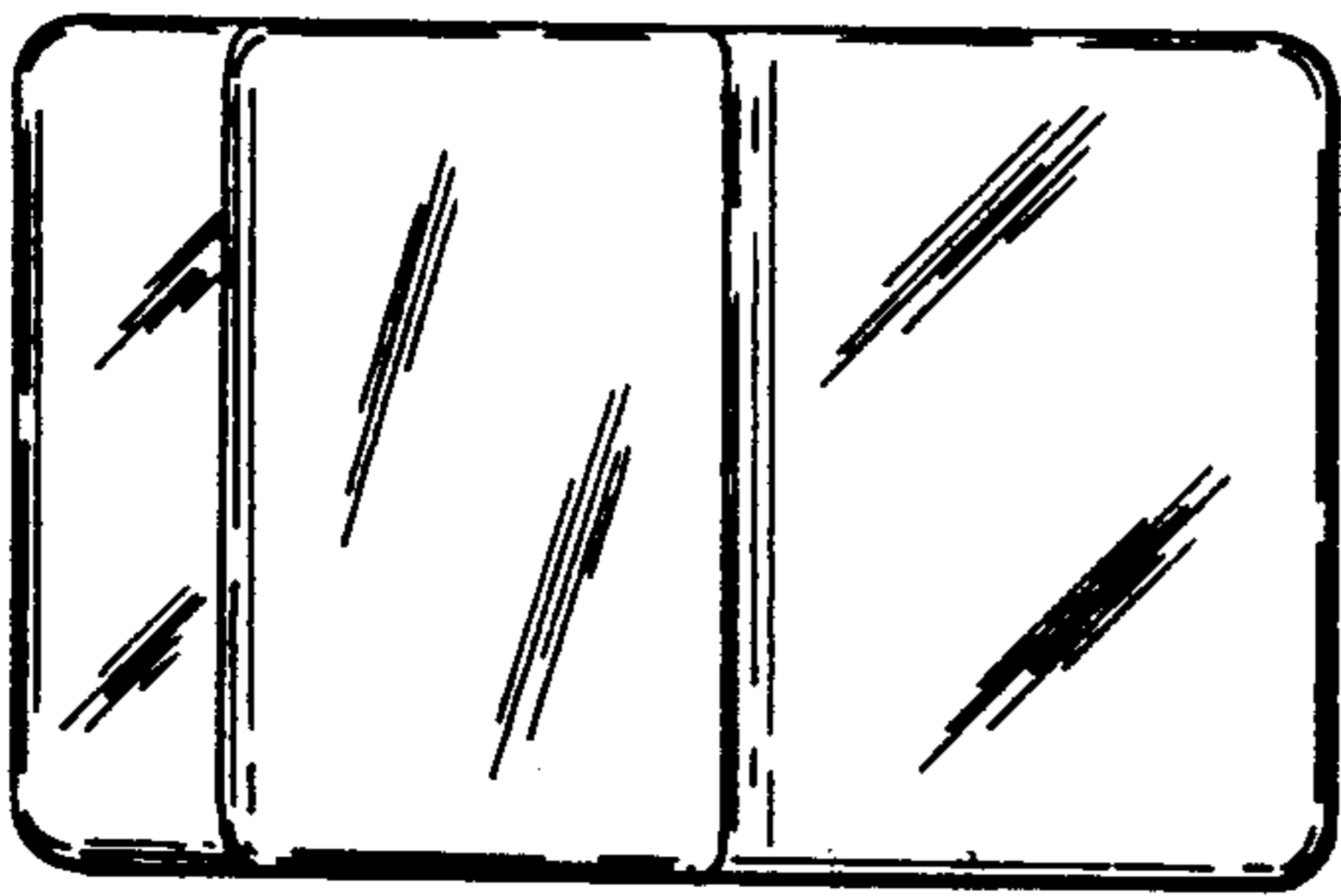

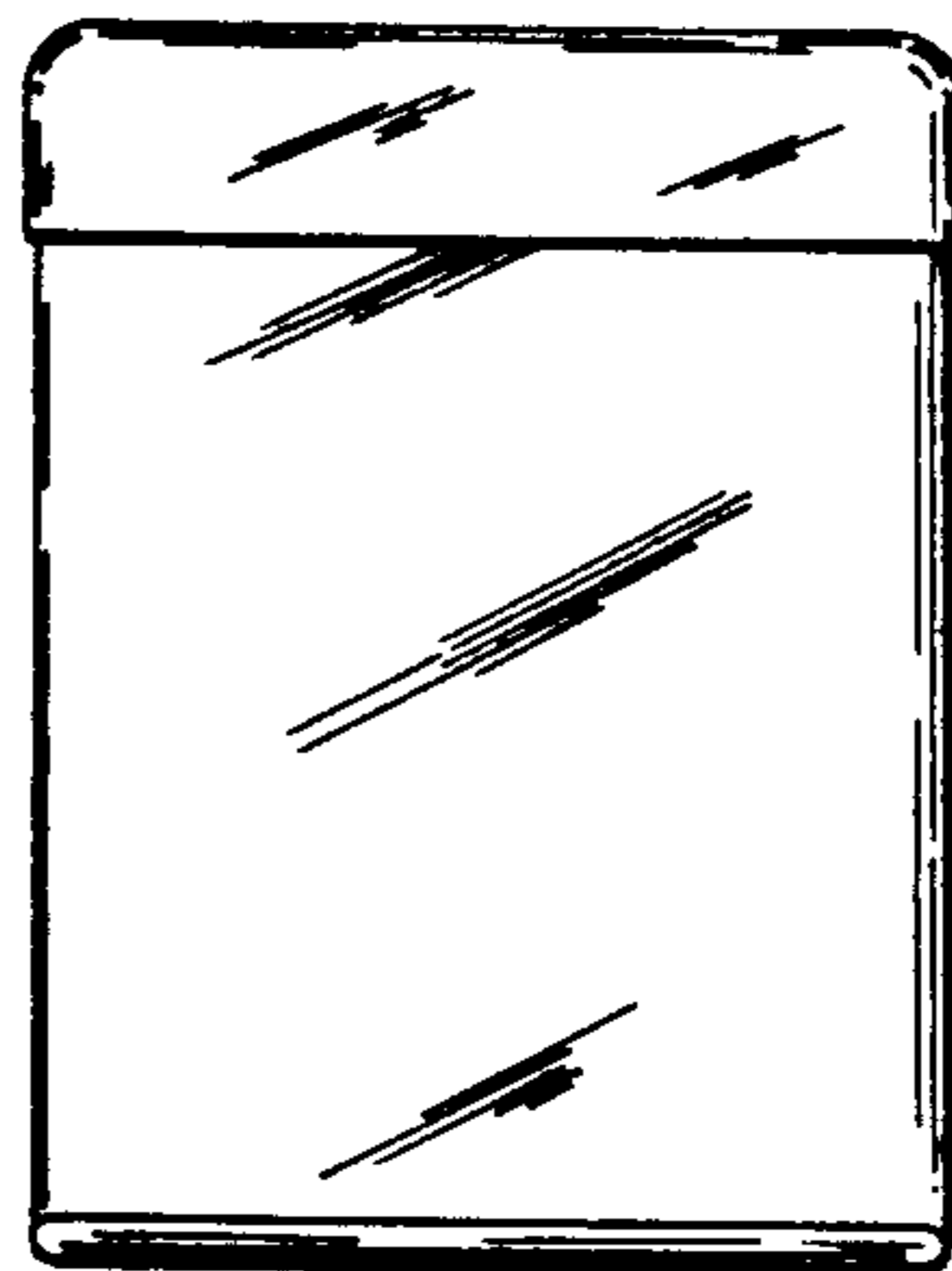

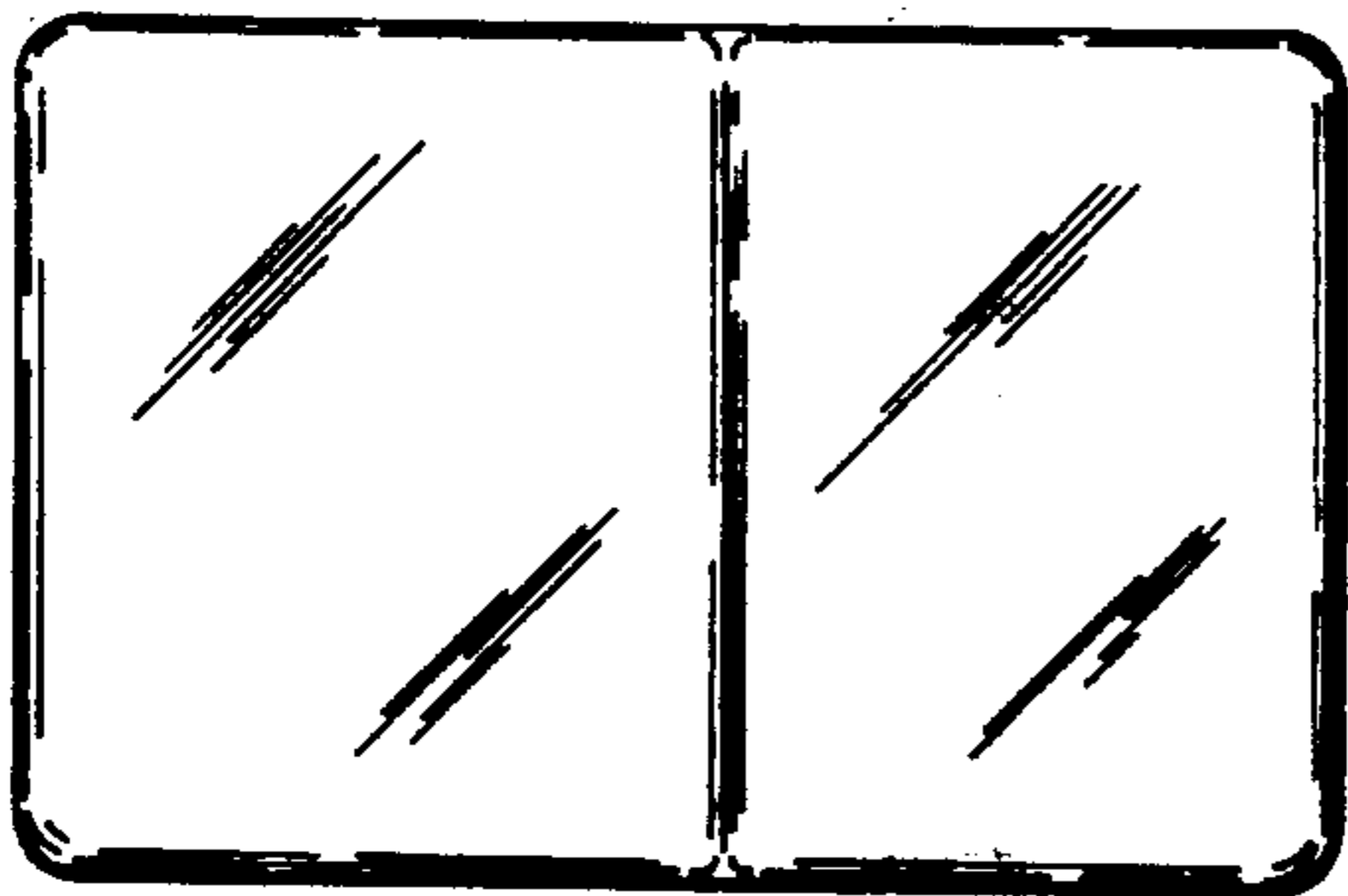

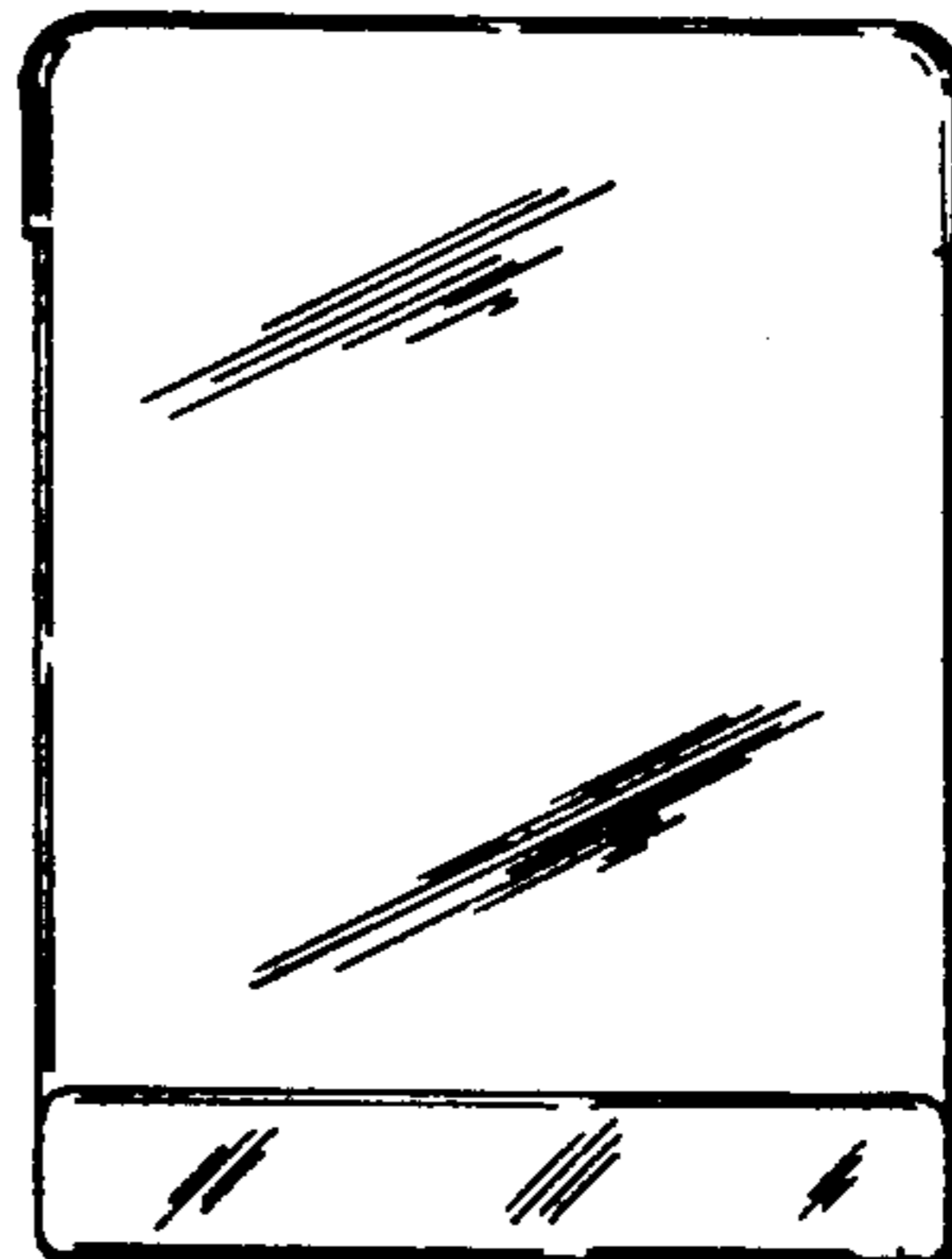
